MILE CROWN FITS NANNINA

When it came down to bare knuckles, it was Cheveley Park Stud's **Nannina (GB)** (Medicean {GB}) who pulled the killer punch to oust **Alexandrova (Ire)**

(Sadler's Wells) in yesterday's G1 Fillies' Mile at Newmarket. Sent off at 5-1, the Aug. 28 G3 Prestige S. winner was temporarily stuck in behind as that rival rolled to the front approaching the eighth peg, but her rally took her past in the final 100 yards and she held on for the short-head verdict. "It was a real test and she's a very game filly and gritted her teeth," commented trainer John Gosden, celebrating his third success in this contest since 2000. **Cont. p2.**

OUIJA BOARD BACK ON TRACK

With time running out to prepare for a title defense in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf and with just one start under her belt this season, the pressure was squarely on Lord Derby's **Ouija Board (GB)** (Cape Cross

{Ire}) in yesterday's G3 John Doyle S. at Newmarket. But the reigning Eclipse Award winning turf distaffer proved her readiness for another trans-Atlantic journey with a comprehensive 2 1/2-length victory over **Briolette (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells). "She was good again," was the reaction of a relieved trainer Ed Dunlop. "It's a great day for the team, as its been hard work. She picked up well and Frankie was very complementary and said 'she's a machine,'" he added. Ouija Board, who was making her first start since suffering an injury when seventh in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at York June 15, could turn around next week for either the G1 Prix de l'Opera or the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. **Cont. p7**

STAR IN THE NORTH Starcraft was not the best kept secret when he made the transition from his native country to Newmarket, having won the G1 Partsworld S. at Hastings, G1 Chipping Norton S. at Warwick and Australian Derby at Randwick last year. He furthered his reputation first time up when running onto the tails of Valixir (Ire) and **Rakti (GB)** (Polish Precedent) in the June 14 G1 Queen Anne S. at Royal Ascot at York, but flopped when sixth in the G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown July 2. Diagnosed with a pelvic injury thereafter, the Australian Syndicate's flagbearer finally delivered with a powerful display to win the G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp Sept. 4.

All Set Up...

The powerfully built Starcraft stayed on the stands' side to chase the Godolphin rabbit **Blatant (GB)** (Machiavellian) early as Rakti blazed his trail in the middle of the track. He took command on the approach to the quarter pole and was always holding Dubawi, who had crossed over from the center entering the 'dip' to scrap it out. "After Longchamp, it has been plain sailing as it was all about getting him right for the Moulin," trainer Luca Cumani commented. "I'm very relieved it's all gone the right way and I have enormous respect for Dubawi, but my horse is very good. We want to prove him to be the champion miler in the world, and I think we are three-quarters of the way to doing that." Dubawi will now point for the GI Breeders' Cup Mile at Belmont Oct. 29, and while Starcraft may also run that day, it won't necessarily be a rematch. "It's a short life and this is not a dress rehearsal so he may go for the [GI Breeders' Cup] Classic," winning owner Paul Makin told *Racing Post*. "I'm only disappointed Ghostzapper was retired, so Dubawi wouldn't be anything I would be worried about. He goes better on dirt, and I would also like to take the Sheikh's money in Dubai in March." Jockey Frankie Dettori took the blame for favored Dubawi's defeat. "I was on the best horse and I got beat--it is as simple as that," Dettori said. "I stayed put in the middle and got beat; it was a costly mistake. I wish I could ride the race again." As for Rakti, who wound up fourth, his jockey Philip Robinson told *Racing Post*, "I just wanted to keep away from the Godolphin pacemaker as I knew if I was with him I would be going too fast. It was nothing to do with better ground. This was just not his ground. When it is on the slow side like this he is not the same horse." Cheveley Park homebred Nannina was pitched into the July 5 G2 Cherry Hinton S. at Newmarket after a debut score at Pontefract June 19, but did too much too early and faded to fifth. Though she may have been on the wrong side of the track when third in the G3 Princess Margaret S. at Newbury 18 days later, she was much the best in Goodwood's Prestige last time. That experience helped her rate off this generous early tempo and battle under a determined Jimmy Fortune to win a pulsating match with Alexandrova and Kieren Fallon. "Kieren had Jimmy in the box, so Jimmy made the wise decision to go round and she had the whole last furlong to battle back," Gosden explained. "Medicean was tough, and she is too. She got up to beat a nice Sadler's Wells filly with the [G2] May Hill winner in third--it was a good race. I see her very much as a Guineas filly. She proved she liked the track and a nicely run mile here." Aidan O'Brien was delighted with the performance of the runner-up. "That was great and she would be more of an Oaks filly, I'd imagine, as she is bred to stay," he commented. Cheveley Park won this race two years ago with Red Bloom (GB), trained by Sir Michael Stoute. The Newmarket nursery raced both the sire and dam of the winner. "It's so important for the stud that we have a stallion like Medicean, who has produced winners of this caliber from his first crop," said Chris Richardson, the stud's managing director. In a spring devoid of proven weight-for-age stars, last-start G3 Cameron H. winner Collate (Aus) is widely considered to be the "form" horse and Mr Celebrity consolidated that theory with a narrow win here. Mr Celebrity failed to place in his first try in group company in the G3 Liverpool City Cup in February, but was runner-up to Collate in the Cameron H. at Newcastle Sept. 14. The lightly raced gelding has progressed, however, and closed from among the tail-enders with a barnstorming finish to win this by head from from promising Shania Dane, with G1 TJ Smith S. winner Outback Prince a further short head away third. Mr Celebrity will now contest the Epsom H. over the same trip. "He is a very exciting horse and could be anything," said trainer Gai Waterhouse.

For the second consecutive year, Perfect Drift (Dynaformer) faltered as the heavy chalk and this time Super Frolic was the immediate beneficiary. Formerly a solid performer in Florida, the chestnut shifted to Delaware Park, where he was fourth in the June 11 Brandywine H. before taking a June 26 allowance. Third in that track's R.R.M. Carpenter Memorial H. July 16, he was most recently a good fifth in the GI Pacific Classic Aug. 21, where Perfect Drift was runner-up. Well placed along the inside as Lord of the Game tussled on the front end with Desert Boom, Super Frolic came out for the drive and outfought a very courageous Lord of the Game to the wire. Perfect Drift, favored at 4-5, never appeared entirely comfortable over the off going and was a very even fourth.

In a dramatic renewal, Anna Monda kept it simple to wire this contest and return to the winner's spot. Sent on the road after winning the May 8 G2 Henkel-Rennen (German 1000 Guineas) at Dusseldorf, she ran seventh in both the G2 Prix de Sandringham at Chantilly June 5 and the G3 Oak Tree S. at Goodwood last time July 29. Torsten Mundry kept something back for the finish this time, and his restraint paid off as the chestnut filly opened up an unassailable lead in the straight. The 1-2 favorite Martillo (Ger) (Anabaa) failed to pick up when asked and could only stay on at one pace. The race was marred by the fall of Eagle Rise (Ire) (Danehill) with a quarter-mile remaining; the five-year-old was later found to have shattered his near fore elbow.

Silverfoot returned from an eight-month hiatus to take his seasonal opener, a nine-furlong allowance over a yielding Keeneland turf course Apr. 23. The grey added a popular victory in the GIII Louisville H. at Churchill Downs May 30 before heading out on the road. Second to Better Talk Now in the GI United Nations H. at Monmouth July 2, he never factored in his next start, the GI Sword Dancer at Saratoga Aug. 13, and returned to his Midwest base. Silverfoot broke alertly here, but was taken back to last at the opening half-mile call in :51.98. After moving into contention whilst four wide on the turn, the favorite switched inside in the lane and opened up to win going away. Rochester, who doubled up in this contest 2002 and 2003, mirrored his runner-up finish last year.

Spruce Run failed to make an impact in a pair of starts over the winter at Gulfstream Park, finishing eighth in the GIII Appleton H. Feb. 12 and a well-beaten 10th in a fourth-level allowance Mar. 3 before being rested for his preferred Monmouth meet. The veteran nearly got the job done in the one-mile GIII Red Bank H. May 28, leading past every pole before getting caught in the final jump to be second by a neck. Outclassed when sixth in the GI United Nations S. over 11 furlongs July 2, the chestnut was a no-excuses ninth in the GIII Oceanport H. at Monmouth Aug. 7, but bounced back in his latest to annex the Labor Day S. by two lengths at Mountaineer Park. Getting another turf course with plenty of give in it, Spruce Run was a forward factor as Old Deuteronomy (Storm Cat) duelled on the front end with Wimplestiltskin (Petionville). Angled out at the head of the long Hawthorne stretch, he charged through from between horses to lead on the wire. Favored Fort Prado found running room in upper stretch and appeared headed towards victory, but was outfinished by the winner.

She never factored when seventh in a division of the De La Rose S. won by Path of Thunder (Thunder Gulch) up at Saratoga Aug. 11 and was coming into this off a troubled second-place effort in the Sept. 4 Goldfinch S. at Monmouth Park. Never far from the front beneath jockey Richard Migliore, Bright Abundance came wide into the stretch, assumed command at the eighth pole and held off a strong late run from favored My Lordship for her first graded stakes victory. "She's been unlucky all year long," said winning trainer Christophe Clement, whose brother Nicolas picked the winner out of last year's Tattersalls Autumn Horses-in-Training Sale for 95,000 guineas. "She's a good filly. She really likes the one-turn mile at Belmont." Clement indicated that Bright Abundance could go next in the GIII Athenia S. at Belmont Oct. 15.

What do you do for an encore? Like Yogi Berra said, it ain't over 'til it's over. Until there's not a slaughterhouse left in this country, I will not stop.

Who inspires you the most? Staci Hancock, because she caught my imagination when she went to Germany and bought back Gato del Sol because she figured he was at risk.


You could probably use a vacation now. What's your favorite spot? San Roque, province of Cadiz, Spain, where I have a house.

And your drink of choice? A gin martini.

She needs to rebound from a disappointing effort when eighth in the Haydock Sprint Cup on her last outing to provide Richard Hannon with his third renewal.

NOTEBOOK FILLY TOPS SATURDAY SESSION

A filly by the popular Florida stallion Notebook attracted a final bid of \$85,000 to top Saturday's round of bidding at the Keeneland September Yearling Sale in Lexington. Consigned by Taylor Made Sales Agency as agent, the Apr. 5 foal is a daughter of Cut n' Double (Cutlass) and is a full sister to West Virginia Oaks winner Elise's Notebook. Richard Matlow, agent, signed the winning ticket. With two days of selling yet to come, the auction remains well ahead of the pace of 2004. A total of 3,168 horses have been sold for gross receipts in excess of \$380 million, a Thoroughbred industry record. The cumulative average of \$120,202 represents a 13.5-percent improvement over last year while the \$47,000 median is 4.4 percent better than a year ago. The penultimate session of the sale begins this morning at 10 a.m.
