### WORLD RECORD FOR TAYLOR MADE

Taylor Made Sales Agency set a world record for gross sales for a single consignment during the penultimate session of the 2005 Keeneland September Yearling Sale in Lexington. Taylor Made, which sent the last of its September offering through the ring yesterday, sold a total 360 hips for an aggregate of \$60,997,400. "I think that our company is very blessed," said Duncan Taylor. "We appreciate all of our customers--the buyers and sellers that put their faith in us and do business with us." Taylor expected a good sale, but didn't see the world record coming. "I knew we had a lot of good horses, but I also knew there were a lot of good horses in the sale," he said. "The question was would there would be enough buyers for all those good horses. It turned out there was--it was a tremendous horse sale." **Keeneland cont. p6**

### LEO LAYS IT DOWN

Princess Haya of Jordan's **Leo (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}) came into yesterday's G2 Royal Lodge S. at Newmarket without too many secrets, but belied his 8-1 tag to upset some more unexposed types and score by 1 1/4 lengths. Runner-up to **True Cause** (Storm Cat) in the Listed Stardom S. at Goodwood Sept. 10, he turned that form on its head, benefitting from the bold tactics employed by Jimmy Fortune to get the better of a persistent **Kilworth (Ire)** (Kalanisi {Ire}). "This track probably suited him more than Goodwood, as he's a big, long-striding horse," his rider commented. **Cont. p4**

### GLORY FOR GONBARDA

Gestut Auenquelle had waited a long time for a homebred to carry their colors to success in a domestic Group 1, but **Gonbarda (Ger)** (Lando {Ger}) finally got the job done in the yellow, red and black, besting **Simonas (Ire)** (Sternkonig {Ire}) by a head in yesterday's G1 Preis von Europa at Cologne. Coming off a game second in the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden Sept. 4, the 7-5 pick was made to battle all the way by that rival before digging in to prevail with a final thrust. **Cont. p3**

### ORBY MILLION STARTS TODAY

Goffs launch their re-labeled Orby Million sale at the Kill venue in County Kildare today in expectation that recent declines in the yearling market can be reversed. While the Orby has always been one of the highlights of the European sales calendar, the fall in figures over the past few years has led to a concerted attempt by the new management to revive its fortunes. Spread over the next three days, the auction now has a duo of races attached to it. The two events, set to take place next September, are the Goffs Million, where the winner scoops the eponymous purse in euros, and a fillies' contest entitled the Fillies Five Hundred, with a winner's purse of €500,000. Both races, which total €2.4 million in prizemoney, will coincide with the Ryder Cup nearby and it is the proximity of that sporting event which has driven the initiative to rename the old Challenge Sale, traditionally tagged on the day after the Orby, with its own identity. Known now as the Sportsman's Sale, it is set for Thursday and has its own sales race, worth €100,000, also to be run next September. The Orby always had a rich tradition and its recent graduates have done nothing to diminish its reputation. They include the G1 Grand Prix de Paris and G1 St Leger winner **Scorpion (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}), whose three-parts sister by Galileo (Ire) is offered by Grangemore Stud as [hip 75](#), one of the sale's highlights. Others to fly the flag at the highest level in recent times are the multiple Group 1-winning heroine **Alexander Goldrun (Ire)** (Gold Away {Ire}), **Vinnie Roe (Ire)** (Definite Article {GB}), **Grandera (Ire)** (Grand Lodge), **Castledale (Ire)** (Peintre Celebre), **Magistretti (Diesis {GB})** and G1 Phoenix S. winner **Damson (Ire)** (Entrepreneur {GB}). The latter also has a Galileo three-parts sibling in this year's sale, a colt offered by Croom House Stud as [hip 578](#). **Goffs cont. p2**

Most of the top sires of recent times are represented, including Danehill, Giant's Causeway, Green Desert, Kingmambo, Machiavellian, Montjeu (Ire), Pivotal (GB) and Sadler's Wells, while there will be a significant amount of excitement generated by the first crop of Rock of Gibraltar (Ire), who has the most entries of the freshmen at 22. Pat O'Kelly's Kilcarn Stud, predominant amongst the leading vendors at this sale over the past few years, were responsible for the 2003 topper **Echo of Light (GB)** (Dubai Millennium {GB}). Amongst the offerings from the celebrated County Meath nursery this time is [hip 421](#), a Sadler's Wells colts out of **Nuts in May** (A. P. Indy), a half-sister to GI Breeders' Cup Classic hero Pleasantly Perfect from the family of Distant View. Miss O'Kelly is fully supportive of the work of Chairman Eimear Mulhern. "I'm hoping that the sale is a success, as Eimear has worked very hard and deserves a real chance," she said. Managing Director Matt Mitchell echoed those comments. "At this point the omens are positive," he remarked. "The prizemoney for the two races is exceptional and, although it is stating the obvious, the reality is they will be won by horses sold here this week. The feedback and reaction to the catalogue has been very good and, overall, we're very optimistic." Selling for the Orby Million begins at 12 noon today and tomorrow and at 10 a.m. Wednesday, with the Sportsman's Sale getting underway at 10 a.m. Thursday. Gonbarda took the Apr. 23 Listed Jean Harzheim-Rennen at this track before finishing fourth behind Iota (Ger) in the G3 Schwarzgold-Rennen here May 16. She trailed that rival again when filling the same spot in the June 5 G1 Preis der Diana (German Oaks) at Hamburg, but returned to that venue to win the G3 Alice-Cup July 1. Her defeat of Collier Hill (GB) in the July 24 G1 Deutschlandpreis at Dusseldorf was flattered when that rival collected last Sunday's G1 Irish St Leger, and she covered herself with glory when battling into second behind Warrsan (Ire) in the Baden-Baden feature on her latest start. Stalking the early pace under Filip Minarik, she grabbed the lead at the top of the three-furlong straight before being joined by Simonas and Eduardo Pedroza. Headed by that rival soon after, she showed all her tenacity to regain the advantage in the closing stages and land the spoils.

After opening his account at Doncaster May 28, Leo felt the cool draft of Horatio Nelson (Ire) when beaten 2 1/2 lengths into second in the July 7 G3 Superlative S. on the other track at this venue. Soft ground was blamed for his sixth in the Aug. 20 Listed Criterium du FEE at Deauville, but he rebounded to finish second in the Stardom S. on his latest start. The chestnut was taken straight to the lead and shared duties with Kilworth before edging ahead inside the final quarter and drawing away up the rising ground. Kilworth may return for the Oct. 15 G1 Dewhurst S. City of Troy (GB) (Grand Lodge) was hammered down to 11-8, but failed to land a blow in the final push and stayed on into fourth. "He traveled up very well and there wasn't really an excuse," jockey Darryll Holland explained. "Maybe the ground was on the slow side for him and probably blunted his finishing speed, but he ran an okay race." Much water has flowed under the bridge since Baron's Pit took the G3 Norfolk S. at Royal Ascot in June 2002, but he did manage a third to Choisir (Aus) in the G1 Golden Jubilee S. at that meeting a year later. Lightly raced since, he started off 2005 with a win for his new yard in a conditions event at Kempton Apr. 12 before finishing third in the July 16 Listed Hackwood S. at Newbury. He failed to build on those efforts when seventh in the G3 Phoenix Sprint S. at The Curragh Aug. 7 and only fifth in the Listed Starlit S. at Goodwood 15 days ago, but blinkers were applied here in an attempt to revive the spark. Showing early dash in the headgear to dispute the lead with Avonbridge, he dropped back passing the quarter pole, but was switched out by Johnny Murtagh for one last lunge. He responded with a surge in the uphill climb to the line to inhale both Avonbridge and Fayr Jag, who had looked to have the race won under a Richard Quinn drive. "I think the blinkers helped, as he's getting older and has had plenty of problems," Murtagh commented. "He was traveling well and, when he got behind and Richard came on my outside, he loved being in the middle. He really battled well then and stretched out in the last 50 yards and was on form today." Quinn was pleased with the effort of the runner-up. "That would be as slow as he'd want the ground, but it was a very good effort," he said.

After a short spell in the wilderness, Mubtaker has reverted to his best, justifying odds-on favoritism with customary enthusiasm. The veteran pushed Dalakhani (Ire) to the limit in the 2003 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, but his sole success during the 2004 campaign came in his favorite race, the G2 Geoffrey Freer S. last August. It took him until this year's renewal of that race Aug. 13 to show his spark, and he followed a runner-up placing there with scores in the Aug. 27 Listed March S. and Sept. 9 Listed Troy S. Keen in a stalking second off the moderate early fractions, he led the sprint approaching the quarter pole and held Self Defense all the way to the line. "He's very game and has a big heart," jockey Richard Hills commented. "He does have a lot of problems with his legs, but keeps coming back up and he's come right at the right time." Spaghetti Mouse tried two turns for the first time in a stakes at Hastings Park in June and led gate to wire to beat Alabama Rain by 3/4 of a length. The bay hit the board in his next two starts, but was pressured early in a stakes test Aug. 14 and faded to fifth. Off at 7-2 in his latest appearance, he battled on the front end early and held on well late to finish second, just a half length behind Appearance Fee. With that rival scratched, it would have been logical for the bettors to take a look at Spaghetti Mouse, but they let him go at boxcar odds and he made them pay. The colt was allowed to settle off the early pace after a sharp break, kicked it into gear as they raced out of the turn and hit overdrive down the lane to win as much the best.

**No Resting on Their Laurels...**

Duncan Taylor was pleased by the success of the Keeneland September Sale, but Team Taylor Made won't spend much time patting each other on the backs. "There are still places we can improve, and we're going to do that," Taylor said. "We always set new goals, and we always have the goal of doing the best we can for every customer. We don't want to sell more horses, but we want to sell a higher caliber of horses, and we want to help our customers make a profit." There will be a little celebrating, however. "We'll take a group of the guys and go golfing tomorrow to celebrate, but it will just be a half day," he remarked. "Then we have to get back and starting thinking about November, the breeding season, setting stud fees, what horses should go in Keeneland January. We have to get back to the grindstone."

The top-selling lot at Keeneland yesterday was hip 4622, a colt by Stormy Atlantic out of South Sea Blues (Cure the Blues). **STARCRAFT FOR THE CLASSIC?** The connections of **Starcraft (NZ)** (Soviet Star), the winner of Saturday's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S., have confirmed that they are considering running the chestnut in the Oct. 29 G1 Breeders' Cup Classic at Belmont. Trainer Luca Cumani said yesterday, "It's a jump into the unknown running on dirt, but the owner [Paul Makin] is quite sporting and keen on new challenges, so I wouldn't be averse to it. He's very athletic and used to running on tight tracks in Australia, so that wouldn't be a problem. The problem is whether he goes on dirt or not, and that's not a surface we can train for in England. It is a challenge I would relish." Starcraft, a three-time Group 1 winner in Australia, was recording his second success at the highest level in Europe, having taken the G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp Sept. 4.

**RAKTI BELMONT BID IN DOUBT** Gary Tanaka's **Rakti (GB)** (Polish Precedent) may sidestep the G1 Breeders' Cup Mile after his below-par fourth to Starcraft (NZ) in Saturday's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. Despite earlier indications that the six-year-old would ship to Belmont for the Oct. 29 contest, trainer Michael Jarvis is concerned that the underfoot conditions may not be suitable. "Nothing has ever been set in stone and the point about the Breeders' Cup is that the ground at Belmont at the end of October can be very soft, so we will have to keep a close eye on the weather," he told *PA Sport* yesterday. He added that the G1 Hong Kong Mile at Sha Tin Dec. 12 will still be Rakti's career finale.
