Maggie (Ire) (Xaar {GB}) by a neck in the G1 Cheveley Park S. on Newmarket's Rowley Mile. The 12-1 shot showed the same early dash that had typified her last performance to stalk the generous early fractions under Mick Kinane. Taking over at the quarter pole, she held **Wake Up Mag-**

gie at bay up the rising ground and was beyond recall as 15-8 favorite **Flashy Wings (GB)** (Zafonic) closed late. "She's a lovely filly and proved it in the Cherry Hinton," said trainer Brian Meehan. "We felt it was better to give her time and wait after that." **Cont. p2**

BALLYDOYLE BLITZ

Whatever the pecking order amongst the Ballydoyle juveniles this year, there is no doubting their strength in depth. Aidan O'Brien will unleash **Ivan Denisovich (Ire)**

(Danehill) in today's G1 Shadwell Stud Middle Park S. at Newmarket. Stablemate **Art Museum** (Storm Cat) was entered as well, but his participation is now in doubt. "We are struggling a bit with **Art Museum**," O'Brien said. "He had a stone bruise and we will see how he is--he's not a certain runner." Ivan Denisovich is more than capable of flying the Ballydoyle flag on his own. Like the stable's past winners **Minardi** and **Johannesburg**, the colt carries group-winning form into the race, having collected the G2 July S. July 6.

He got stuck in the testing ground when runner-up to **Silca's Sister (GB)** in the G1 Prix Morny when last seen at Deauville Aug. 21, but **Kieren Fallon** was in bullish mood yesterday. "He's a proper horse and, if we get no rain, I'd be very confident," he said. "He's a top-of-the-ground horse and he hated the ground in France last time." **Art Museum** has taken the same path as last year's hero **Ad Valorem**, doubling up at The Curragh in the space of a fortnight when taking a maiden race and the Sept. 18 Listed **Blenheim S.** **Cont. p3**

MAKING THE GRADE

Belmont Park will host five Grade I stakes worth a total of \$3.75 million tomorrow. The highlight of the card is the \$1-million **Jockey Club Gold Cup**, which drew a field of eight. **Flower Alley** (Distorted Humor) takes on his elders for the first time in the 10-furlong test. "When you get to October, it's generally the right time of year to try three-year-olds against older horses," trainer **Todd Pletcher** said. GII Pennsylvania Derby hero **Sun King** (Charismatic) will also give it a go in the **Gold Cup**, while the talented three-year-old **English Channel** (Smart Strike) challenges the older set in the **Joe Hirsch Turf Classic Invitational S.** and undefeated GI Alabama S. winner **Sweet Symphony** (A.P. Donna Blini scored over five furlongs on her May 7 debut at Newmarket. Second on easy ground in the June 1 Listed Hilary Needler Trophy at Beverley, she made virtually all in the Cherry Hinton, but jockey Mick Kinane is convinced that she is more than just a sprinter. "Brian's done a good job with her," Kinane said. "After I rode her last time, I said to give her a little time as she is scopey and has plenty of improvement in her. He's turned her out in great shape today and I was delighted to get a lead and go the pace I wanted to. She's very pacey, but she's capable of going further if she relaxes and gives herself every opportunity." Added Meehan, who sent out Magical Romance (Ire) to win this last year, "She's pretty tough and doesn't take any prisoners." Donna Blini will be put away now and brought back next spring. "She's obviously a Guineas filly and there will be no problem with the trip as long as they go a good enough gallop for her," Meehan remarked. This marked the third straight Cheveley Park S. winner purchased by McKeever St. Lawrence, who also bought the 2003 heroine Carry On Katie (Ire) and last year's victress Magical Romance. Donna Blini sold for 20,000gns at the 2004 Doncaster September yearling sales. "I bought her mother, Cal Norma's Lady, for a trainer called John Wilson, who used to train at Ayr," explained Johnny McKeever. "She won three on the trot as a two-year-old and she was one of my first good purchases 17 or 18 years ago when I started. This filly reminded me of the mother."

Wake Up Call...

Trainer Chris Wall said of runner-up Wake Up Maggie, "I was pleased with her attitude and she battled well. [Jockey Alan Munro] was quite confident that she will get a mile next year and we will give it a go." Ted Durcan, third aboard fast-finishing Flashy Wings, was not downbeat after defeat. "Overall, I'm really pleased as she just hit a flat spot from halfway," he explained. "In a stronger-run race, she would probably have won and probably wants seven now and a mile in time."

Fourth there, he returned to The Curragh and six furlongs for his next start in the Sept. 4 G3 Round Tower S., but was cut down in the final stride by Abigail Pett (GB). Back over an extra panel here, he was reserved in mid-division before grinding his way to the fore on the run down into the "dip." He collared Killybegs late on and pulled out more under a drive to withstand the rally of that game rival. "He's a tough little fellow, but when he gets to the front he thinks he's done enough and idles," jockey Kieren Fallon said. "The ground was soft at Goodwood and he's a top-of-the-ground horse and making the running didn't suit him at The Curragh last time as he likes a lead. Middle Park S. cont.

John Fretwell's **Always Hopeful** captured the July 29 G2 Richmond S. at Goodwood before being nosed out of the runner's-up spot by Ivan Denisovich in the Prix Morny last time and sets a solid standard of opposition to the O'Brien duo. "It was a good run on bad ground in France," trainer Eoghan O'Neill told *PA Sport*. "We were just behind Ivan Denisovich that day and yes, I'd be hopeful of turning the tables. It is another Group 1 race so it's going to be tough." Shoring up the quality are the June 14 G2 Coventry S. first and third **Red Clubs** and **Amadeus Wolf**. After their encounter at Royal Ascot at York, Ron Arculli's Red Clubs finished a remote third behind George Washington (Ire) in the Aug. 7 G1 Phoenix S. at The Curragh, while John Duddy and Brendan McDonald's Amadeus Wolf was turned over in a conditions race at Chester July 8. When their paths crossed in the G2 Gimcrack S. at York last time Aug. 17, it was the latter who prevailed by 1 1/2 lengths in receipt of five pounds from Red Clubs. Claire Riordan and Kieran Coughlan's **Prince of Light** is also worthy of respect, having stepped up off a York nursery success Aug. 16 to win the G3 Sirenia S. on the July Course, despite steering an erratic course in the closing stages last time Sept. 3.

Cregg Castle Stud secured the top-priced filly when going to €50,000 for hip **731** from the draft of Caherass Stud, a daughter of Noverre out of the smart mare Privity, who has produced the listed performer Private Business. Managing Director Matt Mitchell echoed his comments of Wednesday night when saying, "The sale has exceeded our wildest dreams and we couldn't have hoped for a better result. The race was put on for vendors and the sale has been a great vehicle to buy and sell. There were various dynamics here that have helped the sale, with the middle market being very strong and the prize money of the races also very attractive. The vendors have been rewarded and we thank them for that. This has been the best individual sale that Goffs have ever had and we have turned over [nearly] €55,000,000 over the last [four] days." At stud, he sired GISW Danger's Hour and GSW Triple Wow, herself the dam of champion Alywow. He was also the broodmare sire of South African Horse of the Year Surfing Home.

GREG'S GOLD INJURED GI Bing Crosby H. winner **Greg's Gold** (Lake George) has been injured and will miss the Oct. 8 GI Ancient Title Breeders' Cup H. at Santa Anita. "He chipped his [left] knee and might have done it in his last race," trainer David Hofmans said. "He'll have surgery this weekend and be out three or four months."
