An 11-1 outsider when he captured the GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar Aug. 21, **Borrego** (El Prado {Ire}) will be one of the favorites for the Oct. 29 GI Breeders' Cup Classic after posting an impressive 4 1/2-length victory over 12-1 **Suave** (A.P. Indy) in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont Park yesterday afternoon. "He did it like a nice horse today," trainer Beau Greely said. "I think he has definitely developed. That being said, we have the next

WHO WILL TRIUMPH IN ARC?

Today's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp has drawn the winners of 23 Group 1 races, including the English, Irish and German Derbies, St Leger, Irish Oaks, Coronation Cup and Grosser Preis von Baden, as well as the best stayer around and a defending champion. But, despite its depth every year, the Arc tends to conform to the same formula. In Michael Tabor's **Hurricane Run (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}), this year's field has the textbook favorite. Since 1991, three-year-old colts have dominated, playing second fiddle to their elders only four times. Suave Dancer, Peintre Celebre, Montjeu (Ire), Sinnidar (Ire) and Dalakhani (Ire) all fit the pattern as Derby winners who returned from a summer break ready to explode in the fall. Hurricane Run has history on his side, having won the June 26 G1 Irish Derby at The Curragh before a smooth prep in the course-and-distance G2 Prix Niel Sept. 11, a race used by eight of the last 11 winners. He is also in the hands of a five-time Arc winning conditioner in Andre Fabre and has the assistance of Kieren Fallon in the saddle. "I've got a very good horse and am drawn well in six, which is very important," Fallon said. "I think it's a competitive race this year and there are lots of horses with chances, but he'd got the best one." **Arc cont. p14**

Finally the Bride...

Borrego earned himself a reputation as a perennial runner-up when finishing second in five of eight starts last term without recording a win. The chestnut colt showed flashes, however, missing by just a length and a half behind Smarty Jones in the GII Arkansas Derby in April and by a half-length to Fantasticat in the GII Super Derby in September. Finally breaking the long losing streak with a score over optional claimers in the Santa Anita slop in February, the four-year-old was off at 25-1 in the Mar. 5 GI Santa Anita H. and finished a respectable third behind Rock Hard Ten. He took a break after that effort, returning to be third by a neck in the May 14 GII Mervyn Leroy H., but couldn't handle **Lava Man** (Slew City Slew) in his next two outings, finishing fourth to that rival in the June 18 GII Californian S. and a well-beaten second in the July 9 GI Hollywood Gold Cup H. Profiting from a hot pace in the Pacific Classic. Borrego came flying down the Del Mar stretch to beat Perfect Drift by a half length, and he was the beneficiary of fast fractions again yesterday at Belmont.

Not Exactly a Rosy Picture...

Trainer Todd Pletcher entered sprinter **Bishop Court Hill** (Holy Bull) to act as the rabbit for GI Travers S. winner **Flower Alley** (Distorted Humor), but the race did not play out as planned. Jockey Chantal Sutherland restrained Bishop Court Hill early, and the two stablemates wound up head-and-head on the front end through six furlongs in 1:11.30. The rabbit gave it up first, but Flower Alley had no answer when the field came to him at the top of the lane. Last for three-quarters, Borrego swept to the front at the quarter pole, opened up seven at the eighth pole and was taken in hand in the final sixteenth to win as much the best. "I really wasn't planning to move as early as I did, but he was doing everything so easy," said jockey Garrett Gomez, enjoying his first-ever Grade I double after piloting Taste of Paradise to victory in the Vosburgh S. earlier on the card. "I came about six-wide and let him go on his way. He was absolutely perfect."

No Excuses...

Flower Alley weakened from his early efforts to be fourth, but Todd Pletcher was not discouraged by the performance, and didn't blame the early antics of Bishop Court Hill for the loss. "Flower Alley was just a little too fresh," Pletcher said. "I know everyone is going to say that the rabbit is why he got beat, but Flower Alley was just too rank. It had nothing to do with the rabbit." As for the Classic, he added, "I think we will try again." The race could be in the cards for runner-up Suave and third-placed Sun King as well. "We'll see, but I think [the Breeders' Cup] is still on the radar," said Suave's trainer Paul McGee. "I'll get with the Siegels and make a decision." Nick Zito, trainer of Sun King, remarked, "We'll talk to Mr. Farmer and if he has a good month, why not?"

Shakespeare disappeared after winning the Caltech S. at Gulfstream Park in March of 2004, and trainer Bill Mott thought he had been retired. But the colt resurfaced earlier this year and, once again under Mott's tutelage, ran his record to a perfect three-for-three in a Saratoga allowance test July 27. The bay made his graded-stakes bow in the Sept. 11 GI Belmont Breeders' Cup H., winning by 3 3/4 lengths in a course record 1:45 for the nine panels, and was the 9-10 chalk to carry his form into Grade I company. Settled off snail-like fractions of :50.72 and 1:15.91, he kept the leaders in his sights as they picked up the pace at the half-mile pole and went after leader English Channel as they raced into the stretch. It looked like the favorite would go on about his business, but English Channel made a race of it, battling all the way to the wire to just miss. "He was great," Mott said. "I think he answered all the questions I had. Obviously, he didn't run away from his field, but that may be better because he showed he could fight a little bit. A lot of horses won't win a dogfight. He showed he had it in him." Added jockey Jerry Bailey, "He's the kind I get up early in the morning for." Shakespeare will now try to follow in the hoofsteps of his sire, who won the 1987 Turf Classic en route to victory in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf. English Channel and third-place finisher Ace will also contest the Turf. Coming off her championship campaign, Ashado was sent off the odds-on choice in her first three starts this season. She finished a disappointing fifth in the Apr. 9 GI Apple Blossom H. and was beaten by longshot Silmaril when second in the May 20 GIII Pimlico BC Distaff S., but got back on track with a win in the June 18 GI Ogden Phipps H. The bay romped by 9 1/2 lengths in the July 31 GI Go for Wand H. two starts back, but finished a distant fourth in the Aug. 26 GI Personal Ensign S. Bothered by a bruised foot in that race, the four-year-old filly recovered to train smartly for this race and was once again the crowd's choice. Ashado prompted Dream of Summer (Siberian Summer) early, took control after six furlongs and held off the determined Happy Ticket. "You have to say now that she's one of the top mares, maybe of all time," Pletcher said. "I think it puts her in position if she finishes first or second in the Breeders' Cup [Distaff] she can break the [North American distaff earnings] record." Azeri currently holds the record with earnings of \$4,079,820. Ashado needs \$368,381 to surpass her--a win in the Distaff is worth \$1.2 million, and second is good for \$400,000. GI Alabama winner Sweet Symphony (A.P. Indy) couldn't mount a rally and finished fourth. "Jerry [Bailey] just felt that she was flat," trainer Bill Mott said. "She didn't tug on him at the half-mile pole like she usually does. The Breeders' Cup would not be as much of an option as it was before." Riskaverse and Wonder Again have been bumping heads since their sophomore season, and renewed their rivalry yesterday at Belmont in a thrilling edition of the Flower Bowl. Riskaverse pulled off the upset at 8-1 in this race last year, then closed out the season with an eighth-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf.

She began her six-year-old campaign when eighth behind Sands Springs in the GII Just a Game Breeders' Cup H. June 11, but followed up with a respectable fourth in the GII New York H.

July 2. The dark bay was unable to duplicate that effort at Saratoga, finishing eighth in the GIII Balston Spa Breeders' Cup H. last out Aug. 29. Let go as the longest shot on the board here, Riskaverse stayed within striking distance as Sand Springs

(Dynaformer) dictated the early pace. Angled out in deep stretch by jockey Jose Santos, the Fox Ridge Farm colorbearer hit her best stride and was able to fend off a challenge from her old rival to become the first distaffer to take consecutive runnings of this race. "She loves Belmont," trainer Pat Kelly said. "We've been playing catch-up all summer. She hurt her ankle in the New York H. We had to back off her and start all over again. She's a great filly. She's the best filly I've ever had. I'm glad she bounced back and showed everyone who she is. Our goal is to get to the Breeders' Cup this year. Our old friend Wonder Again was second. Off the board in his first three starts this season, Taste of Paradise returned from a 3 1/2-month layoff to run eighth in the July 3 GI Triple Bend BC H. at Hollywood Park, then improved to be third in the GI Bing Crosby H. four weeks later. The six-year-old was coming off a rallying third-place effort in the Aug. 21 Pat O'Brien BC H. at Del Mar, but was ignored in his first appearance at Belmont Park. Reserved at the back of the pack off fast fractions, he closed ground from the inside at the top of the lane. Jockey Garrett Gomez angled Taste of Paradise to the outside near the final furlong and the dark bay hit the gas, sprinting past the leaders and drawing clear. "A lot of the riders out in California have said that as soon as he goes into the turn, he tries to back out a little bit," said trainer Gary Mandella. "The best remedy for a horse like that is to get him on a wider turn. We've been wanting to run him here at Belmont Park. The winner will be back for the Oct. 29 GI Breeders' Cup Sprint. Peeress fared better than her connections' 9-4 favorite Chic (GB) (Machievallian), who stayed on at one pace into fifth in the middle of the track and was reported not to have handled the ground.

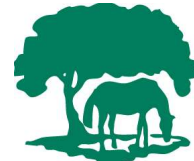

Old Hands...

Saeed Manana's six-year-old **Warrsan (Ire)** (Caerleon) is no back number, having won the Epsom's G1 Coronation Cup in 2003 and 2004 and the last two renewals of the Grosser Preis von Baden. He bids to emulate the 2002 hero Marienbard (Ire) in following up here after winning Germany's premier event last time Sept. 4. "Last year he got pushed up against the fence and taken out of the race and had to come wide, yet still finished ninth," trainer Clive Brittain explained. "This is a warrior and he's gone and done it, whereas a lot of these have still to go and do it." Ecurie Wildenstein's **Westerner (GB)** (Danehill) was third at Baden-Baden and is diverted from the G1 Prix du Cadran on the undercard, in which he has been beating up lesser stayers for the last two years. He has nothing more to prove over marathon trips, having reached the pinnacle when collecting the June 16 G1 Ascot Gold Cup at the Royal meeting at York and Alec Wildenstein is confident he can make an impact over this shorter test. "He's drawn on the inside and we have no problems with that, it's a good position," he told *PA Sport*. "Ideally we would have preferred a little more rain in Paris this week, but he acts on most ground and it was good to firm when he won the Gold Cup." The royal blue of the Wildenstein silks have been carried to success four times and he is not the first stayer to test these waters. "Another Gold Cup winner Ardross (Ire) ran well to finish second in the Arc and I think we've got a good chance of being in the first three."

Let It Rain...

Despite the rain turning the ground to the easy side of good, connections of last year's runner-up **Cherry Mix (Fr)** (Linamix {Fr}) would welcome an even wetter lead-up. Since taking the Niarchos Family's **Bago (Fr)** (Nashwan) to a half-length 12 months ago, he has been out of sorts but showed a glimpse of promise when fifth in the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden last time Sept. 4. He represents the Godolphin operation successful three times since 1995. "Cherry Mix had his final piece of work earlier this week and is in good form," trainer Saeed bin Suroor commented. "He is doing very well and we are happy with him. We were a bit disappointed by his run in Germany, but think softer ground will help him a lot--soft ground and a mile and a half are the key for him." Another who needs plenty of give is Baron Georg von Ullmann's **Shirocco (Ger)** (Monsun {Ger}), who ran away with the G1 Deutsches Derby last July on heavy ground. He was third on his return behind **Pride (Fr)** (Peintre Celebre) in the G2 Prix Foy over course and distance and also hails from the Fabre barn.

Al Kuwari also went to €250,000 for hip 12, the dual Listed-winning three-year-old colt **Hockney (GB)** (Zafonic), who ran fifth in yesterday's G2 Prix Chaudenay at Longchamp. His Highness the Aga Khan's G1 Prix Jean Prat runner-up **Starpix (Fr)** (Linamix {Fr}) was offered by trainer Jean-Claude Rouget as hip 46 and it was Paul Nataf who had the final say at €310,000 on behalf of clients from Qatar. Meridian International were also busy and purchased four lots including hip 2, the four-year-old Listed Prix de Boulogne winner **Atlando (Ire)**, who reached €300,000 and is due for export to the States.
