Blood-Horse

HIS FATHER'S SON

Six years since the devastating stretch run which secured G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe glory for Michael Tabor's Montjeu (Ire), there was a distinct sense of deja vu at Longchamp yesterday as one of the best of his sensational first crop, **Hurricane Run (Ire)**, reached the same pinnacle. Like his brilliant sire, he had rested over the summer months after capturing the G1 Irish Derby and prepped in the tried-and-tested G2 Prix Niel here Sept. 11. He was a work in progress on those outings, but the masterpiece was complete after the 5-2 favorite had swept from a compromising position in rear under Kieren Fallon to

run down **Westerner (GB)** (Danahill) in the last 100 yards and win by two lengths. "Like father like son," his owner said. "He's come from an impossible position and has a turn of foot second to none." **Cont. p2**

When it comes to winning the G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere, Aidan O'Brien has the t-shirt and Susan Magnier and Diane Nagle's **Horatio Nelson (Ire)** (Danahill) was adding to a distinguished list of Ballydoyle heroes here yesterday. Untroubled in three starts so far, he had looked in need of some competition in the G2 Futurity S. at The Curragh last time Aug. 20 and got it here courtesy of **Opera Cape (GB)** (Barathea {Ire}). His lead was challenged and taken for 100 yards inside the final quarter, but the 3-5 crowd's choice wrested it back under Kieren Fallon's drive before asserting for a 1 1/2-length score. **Cont. p3**

SURPRISE ENDING

Purchased by trainer Patrick Haslam for a modest 8,000gns as a DONAPR juvenile, **Kinnaird (Ire)** (Dr Devious {Ire}) prompted owner Klaus Jacobs to reach into his pockets after winning the G2 May Hill S. at Doncaster that September. The chestnut filly was winless in five starts under the new colors last term and in her first three tries this season, but earned Jacobs belated compensation as she caused an upset at 69-1 in yesterday's G1 Prix de l'Opera Casino Barriere d'Enghien les Bains. "She deserves to win a group race, but this was something else," said Haslam's wife, Anne. "This is special, as she was a bargain-basement filly." **Cont. p4**

Storm Damage...

Hurricane Run went into the June 5 G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby) unbeaten and with a reputation as big as his sire's, thanks to a highly impressive five-length success in the May 9 G2 Prix Hocquart at this track. With the shrinking of the trip of the Chantilly Classic by 3/16 of a mile counting against him, his coronation was put on hold as he finished fast but too late to oust Shamardal. Purchased by Tabor soon after, his new connections did not have to wait any longer than June 26 for the imposing colt's first major return in the Curragh Classic. Besting the subsequent G1 Grand Prix de Paris and G1 St Leger winner **Scorpion (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) there, he emerged from his summer vacation for the Niel, used by so many Arc victors down the years.



How Paris Was Won...

Shuffled towards the back of the field by the early scrimmaging customary in this race, Hurricane Run had most of his rivals in front on the 'false straight' and was asked to close through the pack on the home turn. Switched off the rail briefly inside the final quarter, he was swung back to the inside when the coast was clear and surged to the front before extending his advantage with each stride. "I got shuffled at the start and didn't really want to be back that far, but there was plenty of pace, so I wasn't worried," commented Fallon, who was completing a treble of Group 1s on the afternoon. "I took the shortest way around and it got very rough turning for home, but I was lucky enough to have a horse to get me out of trouble. He traveled so well and I don't think I have ever ridden a horse with that turn of foot."

Half Dozen of the Other...

Trainer Andre Fabre was collecting his sixth renewal of the Arc, but refused to compare his latest hero. "They are not cars," he said. "Every horse is different, but is as special as only an Arc winner can be." Th next stop could be Belmont for the Oct. 29 GI Breeders' Cup Turf for Hurricane Run, who will remain in training at four.

The Vanquished...

The Royal Ascot Racing Club's G1 Ep-som Derby **Motivator (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) traveled strongly behind the leaders and looked the likely winner when left in front soon into the straight, but could not match the winner's finish and faded into fifth. "He did very well, but this game is all about winning," trainer Michael Bell said. "It was slightly unfortunate that the gap opened a little bit sooner than we would have wanted in an ideal world, being in front with 300 meters to go on this ground and into a head-wind. If it had opened up later, Johnny [Murtagh] could have used that finishing burst to more effect, but I have to say the winner would probably have beaten us anyway." Ecurie Wildenstein's champion stayer **Westerner (GB)** (Danehill) excelled dropped back in trip and beat off all bar the winner in the straight, justifying the decision of owner Alec Wildenstein to divert the six-year-old from his usual gig in the G1 Prix du Cadran. "He's a wonderful horse and has run a big race," he commented. "He is so game and gives everything. He knows every trick in the book and maybe we'll now go to Hong Kong for the G1 Vase [at Sha Tin Dec. 11], if we are happy with him afterwards." The Niarchos Family's **Bago (Fr)** (Nashwan) was not far off repeating last year's winning exploits, producing a late rush from rear on the outer to finish third. Connections confirmed that the four-year-old will contest the Oct. 29 GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Belmont and G1 Japan Cup in Tokyo Nov. 27 before being retired.

Horatio Nelson looked almost lethargic in winning a Curragh maiden on debut June 24 and G3 Superlative S. at Newmarket July 7 and was not hard pushed to extend his unbeaten record in the Futurity S. on his last start. Like the O'Brien winners of this race Giant's Causeway, Rock of Gibraltar (Ire), Hold That Tiger and Oratorio (Ire), he had done all that had been asked of him and took the next step up in stride to complete the Marcel Boussac/Jean-Luc Lagardere double. "He's a very nice horse to train and is very relaxed with a lovely attitude," his trainer said. "He has lots of speed, so we'll see how he comes out of this race and decide what to do in the next couple of weeks." Despite the heat applied by Opera Cape, the winning jockey was never concerned. "I knew I had plenty in hand, as he's a tough little horse and was doing nothing in front," Fallon explained. "He was lobbing and I knew if something came to me he'd pick up and he did. He's got a great attitude and is still a baby, so I can't wait to ride him next year." Jeff Smith, owner and breeder of the runner-up, was not too downcast. "I'm very happy with his run, but would have preferred to win," he said. "I think Horatio Nelson stayed better, but my horse proved he has the quality to run in the G1 2000 Guineas next year." Rumplestiltskin was one of the first of the Ballydoyle juveniles to hit the ground this spring and soon annexed her first stakes in the June 6 Listed Swordlestown Stud Sprint S. at Naas. She suffered her sole reversal when third in the G3 Albany S. 11 days later at Royal Ascot at York, but returned from a break to win the G2 Debutante S. at The Curragh Aug. 7 and the G1 Moyglare Stud S. back there last time Sept. 4. Hemmed in as Quiet Royal drove for home inside the final quarter here, the even-money pick was extricated by Kieren Fallon and swamped that rival in the final 50 yards to score by a length. "She's a very special filly and always has been," trainer Aidan O'Brien said. "Kieren gave her an unbelievable ride and is a masterful jockey. We came here to see if she was a Guineas filly and she saw out the mile well and answered all those questions." Added Fallon, "She likes to be covered up and amongst horses. She's got a lot of ability and is a very good filly, but she likes to be ridden that way. When she worked in the spring, I thought a lot of her and she's fulfilled her expectations." Criquette Head-Maarek was accepting the defeat of Quiet Royal gracefully. "My filly showed a lot of quality today, but the winner is top-class and we were beaten by a better horse," she said, adding that she would not run again this season. Kinnaird was not disgraced on her sophomore bow when fourth behind Attraction (GB) in the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas at The Curragh last May and when fifth behind that rival in the G1 Coronation S. the following month. Second on her next three starts, including her seasonal sign-off in the G2 Blandford S. at The Curragh in September, she returned to be third on her four-year-old debut in the May 21 G2 Ridgewood Pearl S. Seventh in the G2 Windsor Forest S. at Royal Ascot at York June 15, she was third in this year's renewal of the Blandford Sept. 18, but was ignored by the Parisians. Slowly out of the gates, she recovered to share pacemaking duties with Mona Lisa before being committed by Kevin Darley at the top of the straight. Gaining the edge at the quarter pole, she clung determinedly to her advantage as that foe staged a game rally against the fence. Favored Alexander Goldrun picked up from rear, but failed to bridge the gap late on. "I am disappointed, as she does her best every day," trainer Jim Bolger said. "This is the first time in her career that she has run below her form, but that's horse racing. We have the invitation to Hong Kong [for the G1 Hong Kong Cup at Sha Tin Dec. 11] and we intend taking that up, but obviously if I wasn't happy with her in a month we wouldn't be going. John Deer's Avonbridge came with a sharp rattle from rear to emulate his half-brother Patavellian (Machiavellian), who took this for the same connections two years ago. There was a lengthy inquiry, as the winner crossed paths with a weakening rival in the closing stages, but the Longchamp stewards let the placings stand. Successful in the G2 Prix du Gros-Chene at Chantilly last year, Avonbridge got off the mark first time this season in the Apr. 30 G3 Palace House S. at Newmarket and was third in this year's renewal of the June 5 Prix du Gros-Chene before running second in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket July 7. Seventh in the G1 Nunthorpe S. Aug. 18, he warmed up for this with a third in Sunday's G2 Diadem S. on Newmarket's Rowley Mile. The bay was rated in rear off the early speed duel, then sliced through the pack and inhaled his rivals to catch barn-mate Striking Ambition in the final strides. "I was quite lucky on Patavellian when I won this," jockey Steve Drowne said. "I got a lovely run through that day and it opened up again today." Reefscape made the breakthrough as one of Europe's premier stayers here. Not lacking in pace over middle distances, he captured the G2 Prix Chaudenay in his final start at three. The gray was second in three of his first five outings of '05, finishing two lengths behind Alcazar in the Aug. 21 G2 Prix Kergorlay at Deauville, and picked up his first win of the year when denying Ostankino in the G3 Prix Gladiateur Sept. 11. In front through the opening stages here, he relinquished the lead to an eager Snulex shortly after midway, re-rallied to take control two furlongs out and was gamest under the wire. "You couldn't dream of finding a more genuine horse," said trainer Andre Fabre. "He's always there, whatever the ground, and will stay in training next year, when the G1 Ascot Gold Cup will be his target." Alcazar goes next in the Oct. 23 G1 Prix Royal-Oak. Among the sires represented in the catalog are the popular Midlantic stallion Allen's Prospect, Carson City, Devil His Due, Distorted Humor, Dixieland Band, Dixie Union, El Corredor, El Prado (Ire), Forestry, Forest Wildcat, Grand Slam, Holy Bull, Honour and Glory, Langfuhr, Lost Soldier, Malibu Moon, sire of 2003 sales graduate Declan's Moon, More Than Ready, Mr. Greeley, Not For Love, Salt Lake, Silver Deputy, Smart Strike, Stephen Got Even, Successful Appeal, Tale of the Cat, Thunder Gulch, Victory Gallop, Wild Rush and Yankee Victor. New sires in the catalog include Aptitude, Broken Vow, Buddha, Freud, Mizzen Mast, Monarchos, Officer, Songandaprayer and Yonaguska. A Maryland-bred colt by Silver Deputy brought \$500,000 to top last year's sale, which saw an increase of nearly 20 percent in the average and 26.3 percent in the median.

Before she goes through the ring, however, Riskaverse will wear Fox Ridge's colors in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf, a race in which she ran a well-beaten eighth last year.

A half to graded stakes winner Cozzy Corner (Cozzene), Riskaverse has won nine of 31 starts and banked over \$2.1 million.

RICKMAN SR. DIES William M. Rickman, Sr., who helped put racing at Delaware Park back on the map in the mid-1980s, died Friday at Shady Grove Adventist Hospital in Rockville, Maryland. He was 84 years old. The father of the current track president, William M. Rickman, Jr., the senior Rickman, a developer of office buildings in Rockville, acquired the then-shuttered Delaware Park in late 1983 in partnership with Maryland horseman William Christmas. The track reopened in the spring of 1984 and Rickman Sr. took full control of the track in the winter of 1985, intent on returning Delaware Park to national prominence. The growth of the facility in the Delaware Valley progressed steadily, but took off in 1995, with the legalization of slot machines. In addition to his son, Rickman Sr. is survived by his companion Dean Jones, daughters Sheila Kessinger, and Zoe Roa, Cynthia Rickman, Lynn Green and 10 grandchildren.
