### HURRICANE'S CUP DECISION DELAYED

Connections of Michael Tabor's **Hurricane Run (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) will wait until next week to decide

whether the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe hero will run in the Oct. 29 GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Belmont. Conditioner Andre Fabre reported that the three-year-old emerged from Sunday's success unscathed and that he will remain in training next season. "The only serious possibility [of another race this year] is to

go to New York, but we'll wait a week before making a decision," Fabre told *PA Sport*. "He has taken the race well, but I want to see how he comes out of [it] and see his next work before committing to that." Fabre paid tribute to the colt's performance in cutting down Westerner (GB) for his second Group 1 success. "He's shown that kind of acceleration before, but it looked so spectacular because he was squeezed coming out of the gate and had to make up so much ground," he said. "He's still a teenager, and I'd expect further improvement from him. It's not that he'll get faster, but that he'll get stronger and he's got the right temperament."

### VIRGINIA WATERS RETIRED

Three-year-old **Virginia Waters** (Kingmambo--Legend Maker {GB}, by Sadler's Wells), who bested Maids Causeway (Ire) by 2 1/2 lengths in the May 1 G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket, has been retired. Owned by Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor and trained by Aidan O'Brien, the bay filly was Group 3 placed as a juvenile. She opened 2005 with a victory in the Apr. 10 G3 1000 Guineas Trial S. at Leopardstown, then made it two in a row in the British edition of the Classic. The Kentucky-bred failed to reproduce her Guineas form, however, finishing off the board in her next four starts. She managed a third behind Attraction (GB) in the Sept. 10 G1 Matron S. at Leopardstown, but was never in the hunt in her finale, Saturday's G1 Sun Chariot S., finishing 10th. Virginia Waters will be bred to Giant's Causeway next year. She retires with three wins from her 12 starts for earnings of \$589,211.

### TATTERSALLS OCTOBER STARTS TODAY

Following last week's triumphant Goffs sale, the eyes of the bloodstock world look to Newmarket, where Part 1 of the Tattersalls October Sale gets going at 11:30

a.m. today. This year's 688-lot catalogue is 13 percent smaller, with 103 fewer lots, than its 2004 equivalent, and the yearlings will be offered alphabetically by dam all week, rather than having two select openings days, as was the case last year. "They are a lovely bunch of horses and there is a real buzz about the place," said agent David Redvers at Park Paddocks yesterday. "I think it will kick off the same as at Goffs, but I find it hard to think that trade will continue at the same pace through to the end of the week. What was noticeable at Goffs was how much of the money was from Ireland, a lot of it from the building world. Whether that money comes over to Newmarket is a different matter." Tattersalls' 2004 trade was down significantly on the previous year, but marketing director Jimmy George was hopeful yesterday that the week's business would hold up. "The sales that have gone before this year have given us encouragement," said George. "And we have had a great year on the racetrack with Group 1-winning graduates like Motivator (GB), Shamardal, Proclamation (Ire), Pastoral Pursuits (GB), Goodricke (GB) and last year's sales-topper George Washington (Ire). "We've put together a good book this week and the people on the grounds seem to think they are a nice group of yearlings. We've all the ingredients for a successful sale." An international group of prospective purchasers have been looking over the yearlings over the past couple of days, including a half dozen parties from Japan and agents of the Hong Kong Jockey Club. While there has been speculation that, with the Muslim fasting period of Ramadan beginning today, Sheikh Mohammed and his brothers may not personally attend the sale, Maktoum agents were busy inspecting yesterday. The sale runs through Friday, beginning at 11:30 each morning.

**SHAWANDA INJURED** His Highness the Aga Khan's **Shawanda (Ire)** (Sinndar {Ire}) sustained an injury to her pelvis when running sixth in Sunday's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp. Connections believe the problem occurred as the G1 Irish Oaks and G1 Prix Vermeille heroine slipped on the home turn. "She was found to have displaced her pelvis a little," the Aga Khan's French racing manager Georges Rimaud told *PA Sport* yesterday. "It does not appear to be anything major, but it explains why she didn't carry on with her acceleration. Christophe [Soumillon] reported that she slipped on the bend. The vets are looking at her now and taking X-rays. We'll know more in a couple of days. She did not have a hard race yesterday, but that will probably be it for the season."

Arc day at Longchamp provided a fairly accurate summary to the way the whole season has gone in Britain, Ireland and France this year. The very valuable Arc provided yet another rich prize--the fifth Group 1 success of the year--to a first-crop son of Montjeu. But chasing Hurricane Run home in second place came Westerner, a very versatile son of Danehill--the stallion who had achieved a remarkable Group 1 double in the feature two-year-old events earlier in the afternoon, through Rumpelstiltskin and Horatio Nelson.

As Danehill currently holds a lead of more than £500,000 over Montjeu on the British and Irish sires' table, it looks as though it is going to be this son of Danzig who will succeed Sadler's Wells as champion sire. The chances are, though, that Montjeu will take the title of champion sire in France--a title won by Danehill in 2001 and 2002.

I have already written enough about Montjeu this year, but I need to point out the affinity he appears to have with mares whose pedigrees include Sharpen Up. Motivator, the Derby winner who finished a creditable fifth in the Arc, has a Sharpen Up mare as his second dam and so does Hurricane Run.

The Arc winner's second dam, Hone, acts as a reminder of Sharpen Up's rise from rags to riches. Hone belonged to Sharpen Up's first crop and was sold for only 220 guineas as a foal in 1974, at around the time that eight 1975 nominations to Sharpen Up were sold at public auction for an average price of £505. Yet Sharpen Up achieved so much through the likes of Kris and Sharpo that he had become a resident at Gaineway Farm by 1981. With Diesis and Pebbles adding to his reputation, his fee rose as high as \$75,000, and he sired Trempolino, Sanglamore and Selkirk at that fee.

As it is a daughter of Kris who ranks as the second dam of Montjeu's Derby runner-up Walk In The Park, Sharpen Up appears in the pedigrees of three of Montjeu's very best winners. This links to the success that Sadler's Wells and another of his best mile-and-a-half sons, In The Wings, have enjoyed with Sharpen Up line mares.

In The Wings has the distinction of having sired Group 1 winners from daughters of Sanglamore and Diesis, and he has another Group 1 winner out of a mare by Kris's son Common Grounds. In The Wings also sired the Group 2 winner Weightless from a Selkirk mare, plus a Group 3 winner from a daughter of Kris.

Sadler's Wells' matings with Sharpen Up mares produced nothing better than a Group 2 winner, but Kris sired the dam of his top winners Moonshell and Doyen, plus the second dam of the redoubtable High Chaparral. Selkirk is the broodmare sire of Quiff, the Sadler's Wells filly who nearly added the St Leger to her victory in the G1 Yorkshire Oaks, so this is a tried-and-tested formula for producing top-class mile-and-a-half horses.

Moving on to Rumpelstiltskin--whose fairytale name is more suggestive of a colt than a filly--this daughter of Danehill now boasts a juvenile record very similar that that of her magnificent second dam, Miesque. The Irish filly, already a Group 1 winner over seven furlongs, finished very strongly to win the Prix Marcel Boussac, in the process improving her record to five wins and a third from six starts. Nineteen years earlier we had seen Miesque--already a Group 1 winner over seven furlongs --come from last to first in the Marcel Boussac, improving her record to three wins and a third from four starts.

Rumpelstiltskin's connections must be hoping that the similarities continue, as Miesque went on to gain a further eight Group 1 victories, including two in the Breeders' Cup Mile. Of course it takes an extremely good filly to win on Breeders' Cup day.

As I pointed out in the recent publicity for the Kingmambo-Escena filly, five of the eight fillies or mares which won the Breeders' Cup Distaff between 1988 and 1995 have so far produced Grade I winners and another, the dual winner Bayakoa, is the second dam of the multiple Grade I winner Affluent.

"As Personal Ensign and Hollywood Wildcat have both bred Breeders' Cup winners," I wrote, "there is good cause for thinking that winners of the Distaff could become the foundation mares of the future--especially as Personal Ensign's daughter My Flag has produced a third generation of Breeders' Cup winners in Storm Flag Flying."

Whatever these Distaff winners achieve, they will be hard pressed to match Miesque's achievements as a producer. Her first two foals, Kingmambo and East Of The Moon, both became Classic winners and her third foal, Kingmambo's brother Miesque's Son, failed only narrowly to become a Group 1 winner. Kingmambo now has 15 Group 1 winners to his credit, while Miesque's Son has sired the multiple Group 1 winner Whipper.

Although Miesque hasn't been able to maintain this remarkably good start, her fourth foal, Moon Is Up, became a Listed winner and her fifth foal, Monevassia, is the dam of Rumpelstiltskin. As a daughter of Mr. Prospector, Monevassia is a sister to Kingmambo and Miesque's Son. There is another sister, in the Listed-placed Inventing Paradise, and there's a three-parts sister in East Of The Moon's Group 3-winning daughter Moon Driver, by Mr. Prospector.

Miesque also has two young daughters by Storm Cat, so there is every chance that a lot more high-class performers are going to flow from this female line. The Niarchos Family is also fortunate enough to have Prix Marcel Boussac and Breeders' Cup Mile winner Six Perfections, who is out of a half sister to Miesque.

Don't forget either that Miesque's group-winning son Mingun will soon be embarking on his stallion career at Lane's End. This royally bred son of A.P. Indy earned a Timeform rating of 117, so represents an attractive bet at his opening fee of \$7,500.

**WOKE UP DREAMIN RETIRED** Five-year-old **Woke Up Dreamin** (Holy Bull--Dreamlike, by Storm Cat), ninth in Saturday's GI Vosburgh S. at Belmont Park, has been retired. The bay was sent off the 5-2 second choice in the seven-panel Vosburgh off back-to-back wins in the June 11 GII True North BC H. at Belmont ([video](#)) and the July 10 GII Smile Sprint H. at Calder ([video](#)), but faded down the lane after showing brief speed in his final start. "He's got feet problems," owner Mike Pegram told *The Blood-Horse*. "We're very disappointed, but [trainer Bobby Baffert] figured it best to retire him." Woke Up Dreamin broke his maiden at two, but was winless in just two starts at three and managed only an entry-level allowance score in his two outings at four. He came into his own this season, however, winning four of eight appearances and running third in both the GIII El Conejo H. and the GIII L.A. Times H. He retires with six wins, a second and three thirds from 16 career starts for earnings of \$578,475. Stud plans have not yet been finalized.

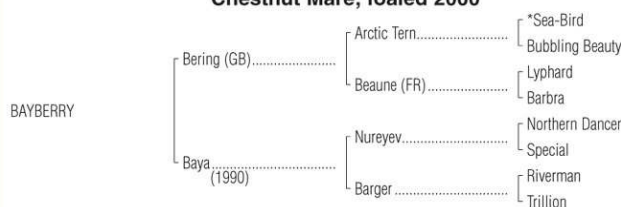

The race became an adventure for the A\$1.1-million yearling when early leader **D'Lanach (NZ)** (Exploding Prospect) appeared to bounce off the rail at the 1000-meter mark. That rival leapt and stumbled badly, causing Darci Brahma to run into him. The incident allowed **Dr. Green (NZ)** (Fusaichi Pegasus) to skip clear, but Darci Brahma picked himself up and set off after the new leader. The two battled head-to-head to the wire, with Darci Brahma earning a hard-fought victory. Despite the mishap, the bay finished the 1400 meters in a New Zealand record 1:19.97. Darci Brahma, New Zealand's champion two-year-old of 2004-2005, will likely wrap up his sophomore season in the Oct. 22 G2 Wellington Guineas at Trentham and the Nov. 12 G1 Christchurch Casino New Zealand 2000 Guineas at Riccarton.
