### A HUNCH PLAY IN THE ALCIBIADES

With a forecast for rain, wind and temperatures in the lower 60s for the opening day of the Keeneland fall meeting, Jim Tafel's **Coolwind** (Forest Wildcat) rates at least a hunch play in this afternoon's GII Darley

Alcibiades S. But there appears to be talent to back it up. The first foal from Tafel's Grade III winner Scoop (Gone West), she overcame some traffic trouble to win her maiden at first asking on the Arlington Million undercard Aug. 13 and the dark bay gave a good account of herself in her latest, finish-

ing third to the promising Original Spin in the GIII Arlington-Washington Lassie S. going a one-turn mile Sept. 18. Coolwind may have made the lead too soon that afternoon and can be a factor with a better-timed ride from Eddie Razo Jr. **Ex Caelis** (Fusaichi Pegasus) was bet down to even-money for the Lassie and ran well enough to be second, one length ahead of Coolwind. The dark bay has improved with each start at increasing distances, and the two turns of this event should suit her well. **Performing Diva** (Storm Cat), a homebred full sister to Vision and Verse, was only fifth in her Aug. 12 bow at Saratoga, but added Lasix and wired a 6 1/2-furlong maiden by three lengths Sept. 3.

### KINGMAMBO COLT HEADS TATTS DAY 3

A striking grey son of Kingmambo became the first millionaire yearling at Tattersalls' 2005 October Sale Thursday morning when Gainsborough Stud principal Maktoum Al Maktoum paid 1.25-million guineas for the colt out of G2 Nassau S. winner Last Second (Ire) (Alzao). Mohammed Jaber, an associate of the Maktoum family, bid for the colt, who was bred by Faisal Salman's Belgrave Bloodstock and consigned through Chris Budgett's Kirtlington Stud. Japanese agent Nobutaka Tada was the immediate underbidder. "He had everything, the looks, a great head

and it's a fantastic family," said Jaber. "It is up to the boss [Sheikh Maktoum] who he races for, whether he runs for him or in Godolphin's colours. The boss had seen him twice since the beginning of the sale and loved him. We thought he would probably make about 800,000 guineas, but he made a bit more, that's why we were discussing whether to go on." Last Second, dam of Group 3-winning two-year-old Aussie Rules (Danehill), is back in foal to Kingmambo and set to visit Storm Cat next year. **Tattersalls October cont. p2**

Coolmore's purchases were led by a 570,000 guineas Montjeu (Ire) half brother to Jim Bolger's smart juvenile Modeeroch (Ire) (Mozart {Ire}) consigned from Ballylinch Stud. Frank Stronach was one of the unsuccessful bidders on the colt, but he elaborated on his plans to get more involved in European racing after paying 300,000 guineas for a Montjeu (Ire) 3/4-

brother to G2 Lancashire Oaks winner Pongee (GB) (Barathea {Ire}). "Luca Cumani will train this colt, and the seven I have bought will be split between him and [fellow Newmarket handler] Jeremy Nosedà," said the Adena Springs owner. "We have a very

large operation; this is an international game and Tattersalls is a great center for horses, I will also have a few mares over here. They are a well-prepared bunch of yearlings this week." Cumani will also train a 450,000 guineas Sadler's Wells filly out of G1 Prix Vermeille winner Pearly Shells (GB) (Efisio) for a undisclosed new client of Charlie Gordon-Watson. "She was very special and I was delighted to get her," commented Gordon-Watson. "She's a long-term breeding prospect." The sale finishes today with a session starting at 11:30 a.m.

Schaefer H. on the Preakness undercard May 21. Freshened up off that effort, the chestnut returned to dismantle a Saratoga allowance by 7 1/4 lengths Aug. 26. For **Ice Wynnd Fire**, this is his Breeders' Cup. The grey gelding, third in last year's GI King's Bishop S. and second in the GII Jerome H., comes into this off back-to-back wins at the Spa Aug. 6 and Aug. 28.

### BREEDERS' CUP TACKLES NTRA DEAL, NYRA SITUATION

The Breeders' Cup board of directors didn't take formal action during an Oct. 4 retreat, but did reach consensus on extension of the organization's management agreement with the National Thoroughbred Racing Association. In an unrelated matter, Breeders' Cup President and NTRA Commissioner D.G. Van Clief Jr. said officials have discussed the rapidly developing situation in New York, where the New York Racing Association has said it's running out of money. Belmont Park, operated by NYRA, is scheduled to host the Breeders' Cup World Thoroughbred Championships Oct. 29. "We've had discussions on the circumstances in New York," Van Clief said. "At this point, we're planning on moving ahead with our plans for Belmont." When asked if Breeders' Cup is concerned about the possibility of NYRA filing for bankruptcy, or not being able to meet its financial obligations, Van Clief said, "It's premature and inappropriate to be specific about the nature of our discussions [with NYRA officials]." ### Eleven Hundred Horses and Counting...

Speaking before the Kentucky Thoroughbred Farm Manager's Club earlier this week, Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation Operations Director Fred Winters told the group of the growing demands on the TRF, which now cares for more than 1,100 horses, and asked members to pitch in by getting involved in foster care and social security programs. Winters would like Kentucky farms to use available free space and paddocks to take in retired TRF Thoroughbreds and to assume the expenses of caring for them as part of the TRF's on-going efforts to find a safe haven for as many retirees as possible. "We feel as though we, meaning everyone in this industry, have created this problem and we should all take responsibility for developing a solution," Winters said. "A foster care farm program is one way a farm owner can help us with this ever-increasing problem. We're looking for folks to help us with the problem of taking care of so many horses because this problem has grown appreciably in recent years." Winters noted that the number of horses cared for by the TRF has doubled in the 18 months he has been employed by the organization and that donations have not nearly kept pace with the growing horse population.

While noting the financial pressure that has put on the TRF, Winters also voiced his pleasure that so many owners and trainers are now choosing the TRF option rather than sending horses to slaughterhouses. "We have so many horses right now because our education program is starting to get through to people," he said. "What we need to do now is have these owners and trainers get together and send us as many as they can before they're so injured they're basically done and can't be adopted out by us." Owners and trainers can also help by donating a small portion of their winnings to the TRF, which the group sees as a way to create a social security system for horses. Trainers Todd Pletcher and Graham Motion and owners John and Susan Moore are among the first to sign up for the social security program. Horsemen could also choose to donate \$5 each time they start a horse. Winters noted that should just 60 percent of the owners in North America donate \$5 each time they start a horse, the amount donated to the TRF would be \$1.47 million annually.
