**PAMPERED PRINCESS REIGNS IN SPINSTER**

A useful filly on the South Florida stakes scene, **Pampered Princess** (Indian Charlie) broke into the big leagues with a score in the G1 Juddmonte Spinster S., Keeneland's major prep for the Breeders' Cup Distaff at Belmont Park Oct. 29. Close up to the moderate early

fractions carved out by **Tamweel** (Gulch), the bay overtook that foe at the top of the stretch, but a new challenger, **Capeside Lady** (Capetown), came on to assume command. Undeterred, Pampered Princess fought back and drew clear in the final strides to win by 1 3/4

lengths over closing **Pleasant Home** (Seeking the Gold). "Even though she had a lot of pressure on her, she handled it very well," said winning jockey Eddie Castro. "She is a very good filly and always gives me everything she has." Todd Pletcher-trained Capeside Lady held on for third, while the more highly-regarded entry from that barn, **Isola Piu Bella (Chi)** (Rich Man's Gold), was never a factor and came home sixth. *cont. p2*

**INTERCONTINENTAL TAKES OFF IN GALAXY**

With little left to accomplish in her sparkling career, Juddmonte Farm's **Intercontinental (GB)** (Danahill) added another feather to her cap with a professional victory in Sunday's GII WinStar Galaxy S. at Keeneland.

"She was more relaxed today, because she broke sharply," said winning trainer Bobby Frankel. "She's a great filly. If she would have run all her races like this, she would be undefeated." Employing the front-running tactics that served her well during a victory in her latest start in the

GII Palomar H. at Del Mar Sept. 3, the bay led by a comfortable margin through the opening half mile, turned back a mild challenge by **La Reina** (A.P. Indy) after three-quarters, and had to find more in the stretch to hold off the closing bid of **Wend** (Pulpit). *cont. p2*

**MOTIVATOR IS BREEDERS' CUP BOUND**

The Royal Ascot Racing Club's **Motivator (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) will run in the Oct. 29 G1 Breeders' Cup Turf at Belmont, it was announced yesterday. While Saturday's G1 Champion S. at Newmarket had been touted as an alternative for the G1 Epsom Derby winner, trainer Michael Bell confirmed that the sophomore would stick to the original plan. "We have done research on horses that have run in the Arc and then gone on to the Champion S. and they have a very poor record," Bell to *PA Sport*. "We feel the tactical speed he has will stand him in very good stead in Belmont. And, although the horse looks to have taken the Arc extremely well, to run 13 days later in back-to-back Group 1s is a big ask. It gives us more time and we can get his training routine organized and head to Belmont for the Turf." Motivator was suffering his third straight reversal when fifth behind Hurricane Run (Ire) in the Oct. 2 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe after seconds in the July 2 G1 Eclipse S. and Sept. 10 G1 Irish Champion S., but Bell confirmed that the colt was firmly on course for his final start before retiring to the Queen's Royal Studs at Sandringham. "He's been in great form," he remarked. "He's just being doing one canter a day, but he's healthy and well." Motivator may face a rematch with Arc winner Hurricane Run (Ire) in the turf.

**HOST POSSIBLE FOR BREEDERS' CUP**

Trainer Todd Pletcher said yesterday that **Host (Chi)** (Hussonet), winner of Saturday's G1 Shadwell Turf Mile S. at Keeneland in his first start in eight months, could be supplemented to the Oct. 29 G1 Breeders' Cup Mile at Belmont Park. "He's going to fly back to New York [Monday] and we'll evaluate him," Pletcher said. "I have to talk to [owner Eugene Melnyk] about the supplement situation. At this point, I'd say it is possible he would run in the Breeders' Cup." He added, "I think he's a top-quality horse and it was great to see him run that kind of race. We're certainly thinking about [the Breeders' Cup]." Five-year-old Host, a champion at two and three in his native country, was named Chile's Horse of the Year for 2003. His supplementary fee for the Mile would be \$200,000.

Septimus showed a liking for a battle when besting stable companion Arabian Prince on his debut at Leopardstown Sept. 10 and had to dig in again to provide Aidan O'Brien with his eighth renewal of this event since 1996. Settled towards the rear by Seamus Heffernan, he forced his way to the front rank in the straight. The bay tried to muscle between Altius and Rekaab, but looked booked for second as the latter started to draw away inside the final quarter. With the gloves off, Septimus went after that rival to lead with 100 yards remaining before putting his seal on the contest late. "I was delighted with him today and he's a fine, big horse," O'Brien commented. "It was a nice run first time in a very good maiden and he was dropped in today and learnt a lot. To look at him, he's scopey and rangy and will improve next year and could be anything. The G1 Racing Post Trophy [at Doncaster Oct. 22] is open to him, as are the distance races in France, but we'll wait and see how he is."

The Florida-bred had come into her own this year at age six, winning four of seven previous outings. Following her win in Delaware's Light Hearted H. July 17, the dark bay was fifth in the GII Honorable Miss H. at Saratoga Aug. 5, but rebounded to win the GIII Endine H. at Delaware Sept. 10. The mare broke alertly and tracked Smokey Glacken intently through the opening splits of :22 4/5 and :46. She moved up alongside turning for home and, despite a valiant effort from the favorite, prevailed after a stretch-long battle. "She didn't get the respect she deserves," said rider Aaron Gryder. "I came here with a lot of confidence. Her last race was very strong at Delaware. I've won three races on her now, and as long as I've just tucked her off the speed, she runs a lot better." Umpateedle is slated to sell as [hip 825](#) in the Taylor Made Consignment at Keeneland November, but she may start once more before then. "There is a good chance we could run her back in the First Flight [GII, Oct. 30] in three weeks," said trainer Mark Shuman. Azamour will be bidding for his fifth Group 1 success in the mile-and-a-half show-down, having annexed last year's G1 St James's Palace S. and G1 Irish Champion S. and the June 15 G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot at York this term before his King George triumph.
