IN THE MIX

Cherry Mix (Fr) (Linamix {Fr}), a half-length runner-up in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe last October, picked up his first win at the highest level with a two-length tally in yesterday's G1 Gran Premio del Jockey-Club e Coppa d'Oro at San Siro. The four-year-old was one of the Lagardere family's brightest stars last term, turning the G2 Grand Prix de Deauville into a procession in August and just missing at Longchamp. Purchased by Godolphin after that effort, he failed to shine on the Nad al Sheba dirt when fourth in the G2 Round Three of the Maktoum Challenge Mar. 5. He beat just one rival in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic three weeks later and was returned to Europe with a patient approach in mind. Making his belated return in the Sept. 4 G1 Grosser Preis von Baden, Cherry Mix finished fifth before trailing on his second crack at the Arc last time out Oct. 2. Taken straight to the front here, he enjoyed an easy time of it before turning on the pressure inside the final three furlongs. Never in any danger, he was kept up to his work to comfortably hold **Salutino (Ger)** (Monsun {Ger}) in the closing stages. Sent off at 5-1, Re-

united tracked pacesetting **Forest Music** (Unbridled's Song) before taking over when that rival began to tire in deep stretch and gamely held off the late rush of Miss Terrible for the win. "It was great to see this filly lay off the pace," commented winning trainer Neil Howard. "I told [winning rider] Robby [Albarado] to be as careful as you can the first quarter of a mile. Staying on the fence in the straight, he gradually wore into the long-time leader's advantage and, despite **Mirco Demuro**'s best efforts at keeping him hemmed in with **Dionisia**, he switched out to challenge inside the final eighth. Getting to **Lord of England** with 75 yards remaining, he was driven out to assert as **Dionisia** rallied to gain second on the line. Montare took time to grace the winner's enclosure this term, but performed with credit in smart company when runner-up to subsequent G1 **Prix Saint-Alary** winner **Vadawina (Ire)** in the G3 **Prix Cleomene** at **Saint-Cloud** May 1 and fourth behind G1 **Irish Oaks** heroine **Shawanda (Ire)** in the Listed **Prix de la Seine** here a fortnight later. After another second in the June 8 Listed **Prix Melisande** at **Fontainebleau** and a fourth in the June 26 G2 **Prix de Malleret** at **Saint-Cloud**, she returned from a break to get off the mark in the Listed **Prix des Tourelles** at **Chantilly** Sept. 1. The three-year-old filly was coming off a win in the Sept. 21 Listed **Prix Joubert** at **Maisons-Laffitte**. Stalking the early pace set by **Paita** while settled against the rail, she was short of room inside the final quarter until daylight appeared between the long-time leader and **Kocab**. Seizing the opportunity, she needed driving to assert in the last 50 yards, but was always holding **Kocab** in a thriller. "She's an improving filly and is doing really well in the fall," commented trainer **Jonathan Pease**. "The **Breeders' Cup** is too soon and **Hong Kong** is too far, so she'll be kept in training and try for a Group 1 next year." Trickle of Gold tore up the Delaware track this past summer, scoring three straight by a combined 25 3/4 lengths—all at this six-furlong distance. The dark bay filly was coming off an 8 1/4-length victory in a Sept. 11 optional claimer. Pressed on the lead through fractions of :22.03 and :44.85, Trickle of Gold pulled away down the lane for an easy win. "The toughest part about her is she stands on her back end in the gate," said winning rider Jeremy Rose. "After that, she's pretty easy to ride. She's quick out of there. She had no problem when that horse came up next to her. She doesn't have to have the lead, she's just that much faster than they are." Winning trainer Michael Gorham added, "As a two-year-old she had problems getting loose in the post parade. We turned her out and she kind of matured and after that she's come back super. I don't think she's ready for the Breeders' Cup level right now. We'll pick our spots and hopefully keep her on the roll that she's on."

Linda's Lad put two second-place finishes behind him when graduating in the Aug. 20 Listed Criterium du FEE at Deauville, but was back in the runner-up spot last time in the G3 Prix des Chenes Sept. 17. Up to lead early, he set even fractions before kicking on as they passed the quarter pole. He was pressed by the debutante Best Name in the closing stages, but the post came in time as his advantage withered. "He deserved that and Christophe [Soumillon] said he was shying away from the ground workers going downhill," owner Sean Mulryan's Racing Manager Herve Barjot said. "The [Nov. 12] G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud is a possibility, but it depends on how the horse is. He will be a typical Sadler's Wells next year and will stay a mile-and-a-half."
