BUMPER ENTRY FOR THE BIG APPLE

A total of 117 individual horses, including four defending champions from last year's event at Lone Star Park, were pre-entered Monday for the 22nd running of the Breeders' Cup World Thoroughbred Championships scheduled for Saturday, Oct. 29 at Belmont Park in New York. The number of pre-entered horses is the highest since the 2000 Breeders' Cup at Churchill Downs when 135 horses were pre-entered. Four of the eight fields were oversubscribed, including the \$4-million Classic, which is set to feature a mouthwatering clash between 'Beast of the East' **Saint Liam** (Saint Ballado), 'Best of the West' **Rock Hard Ten** (Kris S.) and **Borrego** (El Prado {Ire}), who carried



his best left-coast form to New York and decimated the field in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup. The 10-furlong event could also have a kiwi flavor should the connections of **Starcraft (NZ)** (Soviet Star) choose to roll the dice. The winner of the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. and the G1 Prix du Moulin would be one of the choices in the GI NetJets Mile and has that race as his first preference. The lone returnee from last year's Classic is **Perfect Drift** (Dynaformer), who will become the first horse to run in the race for four consecutive years. The six-year-old gelding looms a longshot threat, as he comes off a disappointing fourth to **Super Frolic** (Pine Bluff) in the GI Hawthorne Gold Cup.

Thought to be a candidate for this race, **Island Sand** (Tabasco Cat) has been retired after displacing her soft palate following a Sunday workout at Belmont Park. The winner of this year's GII Delaware H., the four-year-old filly had previously been operated on for an entrapment. "Her epiglottis took so much damage when it became entrapped and and it displaced again," trainer Larry Jones told the *Blood-Horse*. "There is a huge polyp on it. It is restricting her air and we can't keep it from displacing." Island Sand kicked off her three-year-old season with a victory in Aqueduct's Busanda S. The runner-up in the GII Fantasy S. and the GI Kentucky Oaks, the dark bay posted her most important victory in the GI Acorn S. at Belmont Park. She retires with a career record of 19-5-5-2 and earnings of \$1,182,777. She will be bred next year to A.P. Indy.

Europe's Fearsome Foursome in Turf...

Europe had a five-race winning streak in the GI John Deere Turf snapped last year by the unheralded **Better Talk Now** (Talkin Man), but put forth an excellent team in racing's version of the Ryder Cup. **Motivator (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}), five-length winner of the G1 Epsom Derby over the 12-furlong distance of the Turf, was upset by Classic contender **Oratorio (Ire)** (Danehill) in the G1 Coral Eclipse S. and in the G1 Irish Champion S. and was most recently fifth in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Oct. 2. The Niarchos Family's **Bago (Fr)** (Nashwan) was third in his title defense at Longchamp and has had a consistent, if not spectacular season. His lone win in five starts came in his seasonal bow in the G1 Prix Ganay in April. **Azamour (Ire)** (Night Shift) may be the most formidable of the quartet. The Aga Khan homebred posted a 1 1/2-length victory over **Ace (Ire)** (Danehill) in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. in June followed by a 1 1/4-length success in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth II Diamond S. in July. The bay was most recently fifth as the favorite in the Irish Champion at Leopardstown Sept. 10.

Ministers of Defense....

In addition to Better Talk Now, other horses looking to double up in their respective Breeders' Cup events include **Singletary** (Sultry Song), who upset last year's Mile at 16-1; **Ouija Board (GB)** (Cape Cross {Ire}), who looks to go back-to-back in the Filly & Mare Turf and give Europe its fourth winner in five years; and **Ashado** (Saint Ballado), who will try to cap her career with a repeat success in the Distaff. The champion three-year-old filly of 2004 is one of eight horses that will be saddled by Todd Pletcher, who will also have solid chances in the Classic with **Flower Alley** (Distorted Humor); in the Juvenile Fillies with **Adieu** (El Corredor); and with **English Channel** (Smart Strike) in the Turf. Should all four returning champions make the starting gate, it will be the first time since 1993 (Pasaena, Lure, Thirty Slews and Fraise) that as many defending champions will race.

Winning Streaks on the Line....

Three of the strongest favorites on the program will be putting significant winning streaks at risk on Breeders' Cup Day. **Lost in the Fog** (Lost Soldier) can nail down honors as champion sprinter and consideration for top three-year-old if he makes it 11-for-11 in the Breeders' Cup Sprint, but will face the first serious pace pressure in the form of the likes of **Pomeroy** (Boundary) and **Wildcat Heir** (Forest Wildcat). In the Juvenile, **First Samurai** (Giant's Causeway) goes in search of a third Grade I victory and fifth in as many starts. His arch rival **Henny Hughes** (Hennessy) is back for another crack, while GII Del Mar Futurity hero **Stevie Wonderboy** (Stephen Got Even) will try to overcome a lengthy layoff in his first start beyond seven furlongs. **Leroidesanimaux (Brz)** (Candy Stripes) has not lost a race since January 2004 and looks for his ninth consecutive score in a tough renewal of the Mile. He will likely have to deal with **Starcraft (NZ)** as well as **Artie Schiller** (El Prado {Ire}), who had his spotless Belmont record erased by **Funfair (GB)** (Singspiel {Ire}) in the GII Kelso Breeders' Cup H. Oct. 2.

NYRA TO CONSOLIDATE DOWNSTATE TRACKS? In a sit-down chat with the editorial board of the *Saratogian* newspaper, New York Racing Association President Charles Heyward suggested that racing in the New York metropolitan area could take place exclusively at Belmont Park while nearby Aqueduct Racetrack could be converted into a gaming facility. A reported 4,500 video lottery terminals (VLTs) are expected to be installed at the Ozone Park oval next year and could generate as much as \$662 million for NYRA, the paper reported. NYRA, which has lost \$38 million over the last two years, could be forced into bankruptcy and might have to cease racing in early 2006 without an influx of capital. The association also faces the renewal of its franchise at the end of 2007. Heyward believes the land around Aqueduct can be better utilized. "Put a luxury hotel there," Heyward told the *Saratogian's* editorial board. "Let somebody build and develop that. You don't need two tracks." Heyward added that he would advocate the installation of an all-weather surface at Belmont to accommodate winter racing.
