**DISTORTED HUMOR'S FEE JUMPS TO \$150K**

WinStar Farm announced that **Distorted Humor** (Forty Niner--Danzig's Beauty, by Danzig), who currently has four crops to race, will stand for \$150,000 in 2006, up from \$60,000 this year. Leading freshman sire in 2002, the chestnut hit the big time the following season when a chestnut colt from his first crop of foals, **Funny Cide**, won the Kentucky Derby and Preakness S. before rounding out the year with a three-year-old championship. This season, he is represented by GI Clement L. Hirsch Turf Championship S. winner **Forty Niners Son**. He was also represented by a \$1.1-million yearling at Keeneland September. With 30 stakes winners to date, the stallion has amassed progeny earnings in excess of \$18 million. According to *The Blood-Horse*, **Distorted Humor's** new six-figure stud fee puts him fourth, behind **Storm Cat**, **A.P. **ARROWFIELD BUYS INTEREST IN STARCRAFT**

Arrowfield has purchased an interest in Paul Makin's multiple Group 1 and Classic winner **Starcraft (NZ)** (Soviet Star--Flying Floozie {NZ}, by Pompeii Court) and the five-year-old is scheduled to retire to Arrowfield for the 2006 Southern Hemisphere breeding season. A fee will be announced later. "Starcraft is quite unique," Arrowfield chairman, John Messara told *Thoroughbredinternet*. "He is, in fact, Australia's best internationally performed horse since Strawberry Road (Aus) over 20 years ago." Australian and New Zealand champion three-year-old of 2003 and 2004, **Starcraft** is also the World's best Miler according to the latest IFHA rankings. Messara also confirmed that there may be shares available in **Starcraft** as well as the opportunity for Northern Hemisphere stud participation. "From our Australian point of view, I am just very pleased that he is so good on turf as that is what works here," Messara said. "If he were to win the Breeders' Cup Classic on dirt, then I guess it would widen our horizons for him as a stallion." **Starcraft** is scheduled to run on Breeders' Cup day at Belmont Park Oct. 29 and he is pre-entered for both the Mile and the Classic.

"He went terrific," trainer **Richard Mandella** said after the work. **Rock Hard Ten**, who is coming off a one-length victory in the Oct. 1 **GI Goodwood Breeders' Cup H.**, will ship to New York Sunday. "We'll probably just get him there and just gallop him," **Mandella** added. "Maybe a little open gallop before the race but not much."

Undefeated **Lost in the Fog** (Lost Soldier) worked five furlongs at Golden Gold Fields yesterday in 1:00 2/5. Regular rider **Russell Baze** was in the irons for the three-year-old's final work before next Saturday's **GI Breeders' Cup Sprint**. "It was a nice, steady work," trainer **Greg Gilchrist** said. "I told Russell to err on the side of caution. Slower is better than faster. I would rather have a horse that is fresh than over-trained. This horse is fit. Conditioning should not be something to worry about." Approximately 200 fans turned out to view **Lost in the Fog's** workout. The speedy sophomore is expected to ship to New York Saturday.

**Imperialism** (Langfuhr) worked under cover of darkness at Belmont Park Wednesday, going five furlongs in :58 2/5, according to trainer **Kristin Mulhall**. "The time wasn't on the work tab because the clockers weren't quite there yet," **Mulhall**, who was aboard for the work, said yesterday. "It was excellent, probably the best work I've ever felt. He was very strong. He's normally not that good of workhorse." **BC notes cont. p2**

"She broke behind two workmates and finished well. I wasn't planning on running, but [owner] Mr. [Gary] Tanaka was keen on it. We know it's a very hard field, but she is doing extremely well since the Yellow Ribbon."

**ALBERTO V05 JUVENILE FILLIES, \$ 1,000,000, 2yo, f, 1 1/16m**

**Sensation** (Dixie Union) breezed five furlongs at Belmont Park yesterday in 1:01.21 in company with Trippi Appeal, who was credited with the same time. "I thought it was a good work," said trainer Stanley Hough. "She settled good and the horse she worked with, they complement each other well." A winner of three of four starts, Sensation won the Oct. 2 GIII Astarita S. by 5 1/2 lengths. Her only loss to date is a fourth-place effort behind Adieu and Folklore in the GII Spinaway S. "The Spinaway was her third race in six weeks and she didn't break well in the race," Hough explained. "She settled in, then got shuffled back and never really got into the race. She's better when she can get into it. [The Juvenile Fillies] is going to be an interesting race. I think she fits with those fillies even though a few of them have won in longer races."

**PAIR OF TWO-YEAR-OLDS OUT OF BC**

Two juveniles have defected from next Saturday's Breeders' Cup, according to *The Blood-Horse*. **Dressed to Kill** (Formal Gold), a multiple stakes-placed maiden pre-entered in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, sustained a fracture in her left front pastern. "On Tuesday, she had a routine gallop and then took a funny step," trainer George Weaver told *The Blood-Horse*. "When she got back to the barn she was sore and then we discovered a fracture in her front left. It was pretty ambitious to enter her in there since she is a maiden, but we thought she had run well in all her races. But these things happen and you just have to roll with the punches and keep going." Dressed to Kill is expected to continue her career upon her recovery. **Sharp Attack** (Storm Cat), first on the also-eligible list for the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, was withdrawn from consideration for the \$1.5-million contest; no specific reason was mentioned.

**MARYLAND STALLION STATION ADDS TWO NEW STALLIONS** Maryland Stallion Station has announced the addition of two new graded stakes winners to its roster in 2006, **Gators N Bears** (Stormy Atlantic--I'll Be Along, by Notebook) and **St Averil** (Saint Ballado--Avie's Fancy, by Lord Avie). Stud fees for both stallions will be announced at a later date. The five-year-old Gators N Bears has been one of the East Coast's toughest sprinters, winning the GIII Maryland Breeders' Cup H. and the GIII Jersey Shore Breeders' Cup H. as well as finishing third in the GI Frank J. DeFrancis Memorial Dash. He is scheduled to compete in that contest once again Nov. 19. "We're really excited to have a horse of the caliber of Gators N Bears join our stallion roster," said Maryland Stallion Station President Don Litz. "He's not only a world-class sprinter, but also an imposing physical specimen, and we're confident he will be very popular with mid-Atlantic breeders." The bay has earned over \$800,000 to date while winning 10 of 31 career starts. He will be joined next season by St Averil, purchased by Stan Fulton as a \$500,000 FTKJUL yearling. Second to Lion Heart in the GI Hollywood Futurity in 2003, the dark bay captured the GII Santa Catalina S. at three the following season. He was sidelined for much of the rest of 2004, but has returned this year to post allowance victories at Hollywood and Del Mar. The four-year-old has been purchased by Maryland Stallion Station and Bradley Thoroughbreds. Turned over to trainer Graham Motion, he has been entered in Saturday's GIII Cliff Hanger S. at the Meadowlands. "We think St Averil offers something special to breeders in this region," Litz added, "because he not only possesses high-class miler speed, but has a pedigree that is a great outcross for the Northern Dancer and Mr. Prospector line mares which are in such proliferation today. He is a great addition to our roster and provides a terrific complement to both Gators N Bears and our other stallions." **Jockey Club Issues 2005 RMB Stats:**

The Jockey Club yesterday released 2005 statistics based on reports of mares bred through Oct. 13. According to the reports, 3,097 stallions covered 58,739 mares in North America. Those figures represent approximately 90 percent of the mares bred in 2005. The number of stallions declined 4.4 percent from 2004, while the number of mares bred decreased one percent. The number of stallions bred to 100 or more mares increased from 117 last year to 126 in 2005. Those 126 stallions covered 15,971 mares, or 27.2 percent, of all mares reported bred. Lion Heart led all stallions with a record 233 mares bred, 11 more than Chapel Royal. Also covering more than 200 mares during the 2005 breeding season were Giant's Causeway (215) and Fusaichi Pegasus (213). "Although we haven't received reports for about a quarter of all stallions despite the requested Aug. 1 submission date, the RMBs submitted to date indicate a continuation of the trend toward larger stallion book sizes," commented Matt Iuliano, The Jockey Club's vice president of registration services. "Historically, this trend is accompanied by an increase in live foal and registration percentages, which would support our previously announced forecast of 37,300 registered foals for 2006."
