Blood-Horse

BALLYDOYLE BOMBARDMENT

Ballydoyle is carrying out the equine equivalent of a blitzkrieg with a team of four in today's G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster. Of the quartet, jockey Kieren Fallon has chosen Derrick Smith's unbeaten **Septimus (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), and the hint should be taken. Stepping up off a Leopardstown maiden success Sept. 10, the tough colt followed the tried and tested route of the stable's past Racing Post Trophy heroes Saratoga Springs and Brian Boru (GB) by winning the G2 Beresford S. at The Curragh Oct. 9. "He could be anything," Aidan O'Brien said after his latest success. O'Brien has an enviable back-up team as he seeks his fifth renewal. **Dylan Thomas (Ire)** (Danehill) and **Arabian Prince** (Fusaichi Pegasus) were second and third, respectively, in the G3 Autumn S. at Salisbury last time Oct. 8. Both have strong claims in a race won by second-strings Aristotle (Ire) and High Chaparral (Ire) in the past. **Winged Cupid (GB)** (In the Wings {GB}) looks the main obstacle to the Ballydoyle assault after courageous scores in a Sandown maiden on debut Aug. 11 and in the prestigious Haynes, Hanson and Clark Conditions S. at Newbury Sept. 16. His build-up has been interrupted by a foot abscess, but connections are hoping it will not affect his performance. "Everything's fine for him now and there's no reason to think he won't run a good race," conditioner Mark Johnston told *PA Sport*. "We obviously know he has the ability, but we won't know how he will handle the ground until Saturday. You would have to think that it could be an advantage though because he is bred to go over soft conditions." Con Marnane's **Palace Episode** (Machiavellian) was third behind Leo (GB) in the Sept. 25 G2 Royal Lodge S. at Newmarket, and jockey Neil Callan is expecting an improved showing over an extra panel here. "He's done well this year for a late foal and he'll definitely stay all of the mile trip," Callan said yesterday. "He ran a good race in the Dewhurst and, with stamina coming into play, we'd be hopeful of his chance here." **Field, p3**

A WINNER AS ALWAYS

Asi Siempre (El Prado {Ire}) continued her stateside progression by outbattling **Dynamite Lass** (Dynaformer) in the GIII Valley View S. yesterday at Keeneland. After chasing European standout Shawanda (Ire) in a pair of stakes outings in France, the grey filly capped her tenure under Carlos Laffon-Parias with a victory in the Listed Prix Mme Jean Couturie at Vichy in July. In her first U.S. outing, she came flying to be second in the GI Garden City Breeders' Cup S. at Belmont Sept. 10, then visited the winner's circle following a local allowance score Oct. 7. The odds-on chalk got off to a poor start and settled into stride near the back of the pack. It took her awhile to find her best stride in the stretch, but, with Dynamite Lass coming hard on the outside, the favorite pinned her ears and got the win. "We're going to run her in the GII [Mrs. Revere S.] at Churchill next and then give her a break," said winning trainer Patrick Biancone. "She should have a big year next year." BREEDERS' CUP BULLETIN

MIGLIORE TO MISS BC Jockey Richard Migliore sustained a broken bone in his left leg in a paddock accident Thursday at Belmont and will be forced to miss next Saturday's Breeders' Cup. "The horse behind me got loose and ran up on my horse," Migliore explained. "My horse reacted by leaping forward and ducking to the right, so my body went left. It sounded like a tree branch snapping, so I knew it was broken." The break will not require surgery, and the 41-year-old rider expects to be back in the saddle after four to six weeks of recovery. "The good news is that it was a clean break and I think I'll be able to return before Dec. 1," he added. Migliore was scheduled to ride **Artie Schiller** (El Prado {Ire}) in the Mile and **Nothing But Fun** (Dixie Union) in the Distaff. "It's going to be difficult not being part of the Breeders' Cup," he admitted. "Unless I get some kind of commentating job, I'll just root for the people who have supported me from home. I wasn't just looking forward to riding Artie Schiller and Nothing But Fun, I was looking forward to working horses and seeing people you don't see unless the Breeders' Cup is at your home track." Migliore injured his wrist in a spill the day before last year's Breeders' Cup, but rode favored Artie Schiller to a close 12th-place finish, and was later found to have broken his wrist.

After winning first time out, the bay captured the GIII Arlington-Washington Lassie Sept. 18 and has been pointing for the

Breeders' Cup since. "She's lightly raced because with two-year-olds, it's very easy to go over the top before you want to," Mitchell added. "In her workouts in Chicago, we've given her race-like conditions where she'll sit behind horses, take some dirt and split horses, which is probably why she was able to go wire-to-wire at six furlongs in her first start and then rate going a mile in her second start."

Darley's **Henny Hughes** (Hennessy) posted his first breeze since transferring to Kiaran McLaughlin's barn after finishing second in the GI Champagne S. Oct. 8. The chestnut covered a half-mile in :47. "We were going to wait until Sunday to work him, but with the weather forecast--it looks like rain, rain--for a maintenance work, we decided to work him this morning," McLaughlin explained. "We've only had him for 10 days, but he's a pleasure to be around. He's push-button and he's classy. We hope that in a minute and 40 seconds, we can make him a champion." Gary Stevens was aboard in the Champagne, but Edgar Prado will have the mount in the Juvenile.

Has an erratic pattern, and is one of the few horses in training these days to have started nine times without Lasix, which may not be a coincidence. She adds the diuretic for this, a strong move for trainer Patrick Biancone, who has been doing well recently. She's never run fast enough to make a serious dent here, but a new top is not out of the question.

3 For All We Know	Stephen Got Even	116

Was wildly overbet in the Coaching Club off one-turn figures that were only decent, and then eased in her last. She's not fast enough with these even around one turn and there's no reason to expect major improvement.

Is a solid sprinter that has been managed well, but she's over her head here.

5 Amazing Buy	High Yield	116

RMTC Prioritizes Withdrawal Guidelines:

Following their meeting Oct. 16-17 in Lexington, Kentucky, the Board of Directors of the Racing Medication and Testing Consortium has commissioned Dr. Rick Sams of Ohio State to develop an action plan, timeline and research priorities to establish guidelines for withdrawal times for therapeutic medications commonly utilized by racetrack veterinarians. RMTC Executive Director Scot Waterman stated, "With 28 pari-mutuel horse racing states having adopted, or in the process of adopting, the RMTC Model Medication Policy, the consortium is focused on the next step of developing guidelines for horsemen and veterinarians on withdrawal times for therapeutic medications. Some states already have recommended withdrawal times, but the problem is the recommended withdrawal times are not uniform from state-to-state and some jurisdictions issue no withdrawal guidelines at all. The consortium needs to take the same tact we took in developing the Model Medication Policy--recommendations from our Scientific Advisory Committee based on existing, peer-reviewed scientific research. If they can reach a consensus on a withdrawal guideline, then the RMTC can make a recommendation. If not, then additional scientific research will have to be funded."

FNRY to Sponsor NY Racing Industry Law Conference:

The Friends of New York Racing Inc. will sponsor a New York Racing Industry Working Group Conference Nov. 15 at the Albany Law School. The conference will be hosted by the Racing and Gaming Law Program of the Albany Law School's Government Law Center. "The purpose of the conference is to bring together a diverse sector of the state's racing industry to develop a consensus on proposed 2006 reform racing legislation," said Bennett M. Liebman, coordinator of the Racing and Gaming Law Program.
