UPSET AT THE PALACE

He was the outsider of the entire field at 20-1, but Con Marnane's **Palace Episode** (Machiavellian) failed to read the script and defied the odds to best **Winged Cupid (Ire)** (In the Wings {GB}) by 1 1/2 lengths in yesterday's G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster. Making a quick return after a fifth in last Saturday's G1 Dewhurst S. at Newmarket, he shadowed Winged Cupid throughout the

early stages before moving upside approaching the quarter pole. Driven to lead soon after, he drew safely clear before maintaining his advantage in the tiring conditions. INTERNATIONAL CAST ABOVE THE BORDER

Even with the GI Breeders' Cup Turf scheduled next Saturday at Belmont Park, a formidable field of 10 will line up for today's GI Canadian International S. at Woodbine. Earle Mack's **Electrocutionist** (Red Ransom) has tasted defeat only once out of seven trips to post. Campaigned in Italy for his first six starts, he took home the G2 Premio Carlo d'Alessio May 22 and the G1 Gran Premio di Milano June 19. He made the journey to York for the Aug. 16 G1 Juddmonte International S. and didn't disappoint, scoring by a neck last out. Adding Lasix for his North American debut, the bay looms the one to beat. **King's Drama (Ire)** (King's Theatre {Ire}), a well-beaten fifth in this event last term, has turned into a totally different animal this year since returning from the shelf. A 3/4-length winner over **Relaxed Gesture (Ire)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}) in Saratoga's GI Sword Dancer Invitational H. Aug. 13, he returned to finish second, by a neck to Better Talk Now in the GI Man O' War S. last out Sept. 10. **Cont p8.**

MOTIVATOR HURT; RETIRED TO ROYAL STUD

The Royal Ascot Racing Club's G1 Epsom Derby winner **Motivator (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}--Out West, by Gone West) has suffered a muscular injury and will miss his intended career finale in next Saturday's GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Belmont. "He worked absolutely brilliantly in his final piece of work, but pulled up slightly lame behind," the syndicate's Racing Manager Harry Herbert told *PA Sport*. "It was nothing life-threatening, but it was enough to put him out of the Breeders' Cup and therefore signal the end of his racing career. We are all desperately disappointed because we felt he had a great chance of taking the race in America by storm." As previously announced, the bay will enter stud next year at the Queen's Stud at Sandringham. **Cont. p2**

DIVA DOWN UNDER

Makybe Diva (GB) (Desert King {Ire}), a two-time winner of the G1 Melbourne Cup, added a victory in the A\$3-million G1 Cox Plate yesterday to her trophy case. The success made her the all-time leading money earner in Australasia. "This is the greatest moment of my life," said owner Tony Santic. "She is simply the greatest." **Cox Plate cont. p5**

ONGOING EPISODE Palace Episode was led out unsold at 44,000gns at the Tattersalls Breeze-Ups in April, but that proved to be Con Marnane's better fortune, and the colt quickly established himself as a smart juvenile with a debut score at Catterick July 20. The dark bay followed that with success in the Aug. 16 Acomb S. at York before filling third spot behind Leo (GB) in the Sept. 25 G2 Royal Lodge S. at Newmarket ahead of his outing in the Dewhurst. Trainer Kevin Ryan believes there were excuses for that latest effort. "I feel I messed up with the horse last week, as he's a late-maturing horse and we stepped his food up and I was probably a bit easy on him," Ryan explained. "He was a little bit fresh and got warm before that race, but today he was an absolute professional and really relaxed and cool about everything." Palace Episode was providing Ryan with his second Group 1 triumph after the success of Amadeus Wolf (GB) in the Middle Park S. last month. "It's been an unbelievable year and I feel blessed to have horses like these," he added. "The team at home have worked very hard and are getting the results, and it's very lucky for a trainer like me to get horses like these." Mark Johnston has next year's G1 Epsom Derby in mind for the runner-up, while Aidan O'Brien blamed the ground for the run of 5-6 favorite **Septimus (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), who came under pressure at halfway before staying on into third. "The ground is just desperate," he said. "He's a good-moving son of Sadler's Wells, and I'd expect better next year on good ground."



BREEDERS' CUP BULLETIN

MOTIVATOR RETIRED Connections revealed that **Motivator** pulled up lame after his final home workout yesterday and was found to have tweaked a muscle in

his off-hind leg. Ironically, it was on the same day last year that Motivator made the breakthrough when winning the G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster. He returned to win the May 12 G2 Dante S. at York before powering to a five-length success in the Epsom Classic June 4. That proved to be his last success, as he found Oratorio (Ire) too strong in both the July 2 G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown and G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown Sept. 10. He ran fifth behind Hurri-

cane Run (Ire) in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe on his final start Oct. 2, but had trained with his usual panache up to the setback this week. Trainer Michael Bell expressed his disappointment. "The frustrating thing is that he worked as well as he ever has this morning," he explained. "I don't think the vet has seen him for a lameness issue throughout his career, so for this to happen is gutting, especially when he was primed and ready to go. He was amazingly consistent in all his starts and this is sad." Motivator retires as the winner of four of his seven starts and with lifetime earnings of £1,192,457. The bay has been syndicated for £6 million to stand at the Norfolk venue. "He is fully syndicated by a great group of owners and breeders and I am sure he will enjoy a lot of success at stud," Herbert added. "He will be prepared for covering in February by some of the best breeders in the world and I'm sure he'll have a fantastic first book of mares. Motivator has got the looks, the charisma and the pedigree to make a fantastic stallion."

ROCK HARD TEN SUFFERS FOOT BRUISE**

Trainer Richard Mandella has delayed shipping GI Breeders' Cup Classic contender **Rock Hard Ten** (Kris S.) to New York due to a small foot bruise, according to *The Blood-Horse*. The towering colt worked seven furlongs in 1:25 3/5 at Santa Anita Thursday and the problem was discovered thereafter. "He came out of the work with a small bruise," Mandella told the publication. "We pulled the shoe, soaked the foot and put on a poultice." The GII Goodwood Breeders' Cup H. winner galloped this morning without the shoe and is scheduled for an Oct. 26 flight to the Big Apple. "[The bruise] has not interfered with our progress. He is responding well."

**TVG SPRINT, \$1,000,000, 3yo/up, 6f
HIGH FLY OUT OF SPRINT**

High Fly (Atticus), this year's GI Florida Derby winner, has suffered a condylar fracture of his right front leg and will miss the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, according to *The Blood-Horse*. He posted a four furlong gate workout at Belmont yesterday in :48 and the injury was detected afterwards. "It's similar to the one Afleet Alex had," trainer Nick Zito told the publication. "We are sending him to the New Jersey Equine Clinic [Sunday] morning. It is a non-displaced fracture. It didn't go all the way through. We're optimistic he'll be back next year." The chestnut followed a 10th-place finish in the GI Kentucky Derby with another 10th-place finish in the GI Preakness S. He fired a decent second off the layoff behind Silver Train in the GII Jerome H. last out Sept. 11...Jockey Jerry Bailey, who had the call aboard High Fly, has picked up the mount on **Roman Ruler** (Fusaichi Pegasus).

Taking to the Turf...

The Belmont Park turf course was the place to be yesterday morning, with five Breeders' Cup candidates stretching their legs (for times, see Workout Box). Trainer Todd Pletcher sent out Turf hopeful **English Channel** (Smart Strike) and Mile nominees **Host** (Chi) (Hussonet) and **Limehouse** (Grand Slam). "I thought they all worked well," Pletcher said. "They started off slowly and finished up good. They're all horses that have been running fairly consistently except for

Host, who is coming back on fairly short rest, so we only went a half-mile with him." Last year's Eclipse winner added, "The turf was obviously on the soft side and the cones were way out, so I wouldn't have expected the times to be real fast, but I thought they all finished up well and galloped out strongly. I decided to work the turf horses today because I thought we'd get better footing today than we would on Sunday and possibly Monday. The dirt horses, I chose to wait until Monday because if the forecast is right, the rain is supposed to stop around five in the morning and if we get a nice day Sunday, we should be in good shape for Monday."

Trainer Bobby Frankel worked the duo of **Three Valleys** (Diesis {GB}) (Mile) and **Intercontinental** (GB) (Danehill) in company. While Intercontinental handled the soft course in her stride, her stablemate struggled on the going. "The course seemed good," Frankel said. "Intercontinental worked well, but I'm not sure about Three Valleys on turf this soft. I don't really want it any softer for the Breeders' Cup than it was today, but I think Intercontinental would be okay." **Breeders' Cup Coverage cont.**

Makybe Diva is certainly the star of the show. Exported to Australia after failing to find a buyer in England as a weanling, the bay captured the 2003 G1 Melbourne Cup for David Hall before the trainer was called up to Hong Kong. Lee Freedman then took the reins, and the grand mare added another Melbourne Cup, a Sydney Cup, the G1 BMW and the Australian Cup to her Group 1 haul. She kicked off this season by winning the G2 Feehan S. over 1400 meters. Her trainer and jockey insisted she was better than ever, but some considered her vulnerable at Moonee Valley with its tricky contours. But she made it look easy, winning by 1 1/4 lengths without ruffling a hair and returning to scale relaxed enough to tolerate emotional jockey Glen Boss dropping the reins altogether to put on a Diva mask along with 30,000 spectators. The rider waved his hands in the air as he rode along the fence and thanked the people for loving his mount.

Makybe Diva was in superlative form leading into the race, and Boss, who has partnered the mare to six Group 1 wins, remained supremely relaxed despite intense pressure. Light rain fell throughout the day before clearing for the feature race and Boss settled Makybe Diva fourth last before going five deep and

setting her alight at the 700-meter mark to ensure she was within striking distance of the leaders rounding the home turn. Lotteria and veteran Fields of Omagh, winner of the race in 2003, battled for the minor placings as Boss urged the mare forward with his hands and she went on to post a clear win. "Lee said, 'Don't get there too late, and I knew that nothing gets her from behind,'" said

Boss. "With this crowd behind me, I feel like I can go to another level. You think it can't get any better than two Melbourne Cups--I am so thankful to be a small part of this great mare's career, there is nothing she can't do." Makybe Diva becomes only the third horse to add the grueling 3200-meter Melbourne Cup victory to the 2040-meter Cox Plate--Phar Lap (Aus) and Might and Power (NZ) being the others. Freedman, whose veteran Mummify (Aus) was euthanized earlier in the week, admitted he was tongue-tied. "She is the best horse I have ever trained, to do what she had done today," he said. "It has been a fairy-tale ride, the last 12 months. Time has been ticking away very slowly, we having been hoping for this for so long. I don't think this country has seen such a good horse for the past 30 or 40 years. We wanted to make it a staying test, so Glen Boss went early on her." With the \$1.8 million first prize purse pushing her earnings to A\$11,401,865, Makybe Diva has surpassed Sunline (NZ) (A\$11,401,865) and Northerly (Aus) (A\$9,341,850). Her connections have not yet decided whether she will seek a three-peat in the Melbourne Cup Nov. 1 at Flemington. Humoristic won four of her 11 starts last term, but didn't make it to the winner's circle this season until taking an optional claimer at Pimlico Aug. 26. The bay had come close in a couple of graded-stakes tries, running third in the GIII Gallorette H. in May and second in the GIII All Along BC S. at Colonial Downs in July, but was let go at long odds here after fading to sixth as a 33-1 outsider in the Sept. 24 GIII Noble Damsel H. at Belmont Park.

Showing improved speed in her Meadowlands bow, she pressed a solid pace from second, took over after six furlongs and maintained a daylight lead to the wire as favored Delta Princess closed from the clouds for second. "When you look at [the past performances for] this filly, it takes a lot to get her going," said jockey Harry Vega, who was riding the winner for the first time. "I didn't think I would get that close to the pace. She was really pulling me, tugging right along. She wanted to go on the turn, so I just let her."
