Blood-Horse

OUTSIDE LOOKING IN

Chalk up one more challenge for **Starcraft (NZ)** (Soviet Star). The connections of the big chestnut opted to put up \$800,000 for their star to run in the marquee event of Saturday's Breeders' Cup World Thoroughbred Championships, the \$4.68-million GI Classic - Powered by Dodge, but were dismayed that he will break from post 14 for his dirt debut. "We got the 'visitors' draw," said trainer Luca Cumani. "He'll just have to run a bit faster now. We're giving a lot of ground

away, and ground given away is ground lost. It was going to be hard, but 14 makes it even harder." The five-year-old, with Pat Valenzuela slated to ride, is 12-1 on the morning-line. The 3-1 morning-line favorite didn't fare much better. **Saint Liam** (Saint Ballado) drew the 13 hole. When jockey Jerry Bailey was asked what he would do about the bad post, he responded, "Cry?" But the Hall of Fame rider expounded. "I think they were going to use the chute, but there wasn't the money to get it ready for Breeders' Cup Day," he explained. "It makes for a very unfair race, and there really isn't anything you can do to make up for a bad post. If you try and save ground, you are going to have to use your horse very hard leaving the gate, and then you won't have anything left at the end." The 7-2 second choice, **Rock Hard Ten** (Kris S.), will break from the rail, while the 9-2 third choice, **Borrego** (El Prado {Ire}), drew 11. "The post is fine," said trainer Beau Greely. "For where we're breaking from, I don't think it's a big thing. It's not like we're going to the front. We can tuck in anyhow."

Defending Their Honor...

Four of last year's Breeders' Cup winners are back to defend their titles: **Better Talk Now** (Talkin Man) has drawn post four in the \$2.28-million GI John Deere Turf; **Singleary** (Sultry Song) will break from post nine in the \$2.025-million GI NetJets Mile; **Ashado** (Saint Ballado) is slated for post three in the \$2-million GI Emirates Airline Distaff; and **Ouija Board (GB)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) will defend her title from post 13 in the \$1.06-million GI Emirates Airline F/M Turf.

FRONT AND CENTER The shortest-priced favorite in all eight races is unbeaten **Lost in the Fog** (Lost Soldier), who has been tabbed at even-money in the \$1.06-million GI TVG Sprint. He will break from post seven in the 11-horse field. "The configuration of Belmont, the start of the three-quarters has a short run to the first turn," explained trainer Greg Gilchrist. "So I would have been happy with anything but the outside." The acclaimed sprinter will have to face a host of early challengers Saturday, including 30-1 **Lifestyle** (Indian Charlie), who will start from the nine hole. "All the tough horses are inside of us," noted trainer Wesley Ward. "We have a lot of early speed, so we could wind up on the lead. We're very excited about where we are."

FOUR NO-SHOWS A quartet of runners that had been expected to race Saturday did not pass the entry box. Turf hopeful **Alkaased** (Kingmambo) went to the track yesterday morning, but trainer Luca Cumani said, "His blood was bad this morning." **Keeneland Kat** (Hennessy) was withdrawn due to a respiratory ailment. "She scoped clean after her breeze on Monday," explained trainer Kelly Breen, "but after she galloped [Wednesday] morning, she weezed and coughed a couple of times. She wasn't 100 percent this close to the show, so the only thing to do was scratch. We don't want to take any chances with her." Sprint candidate **Pomeroy** (Boundary) worked four furlongs in :49 3/5 at Turfway yesterday morning, but exited the move with some lameness. "It looks like it's in his foot," explained trainer Patrick Biancone, "but we're not sure yet." **Three Valleys** (Diesis {GB}) will forego the Mile due to an ailment. "He's been fighting a cough and he's got mucus," explained trainer Bobby Frankel. "As simply as I can put it, he's not right. I can't run him in a race like this right now."

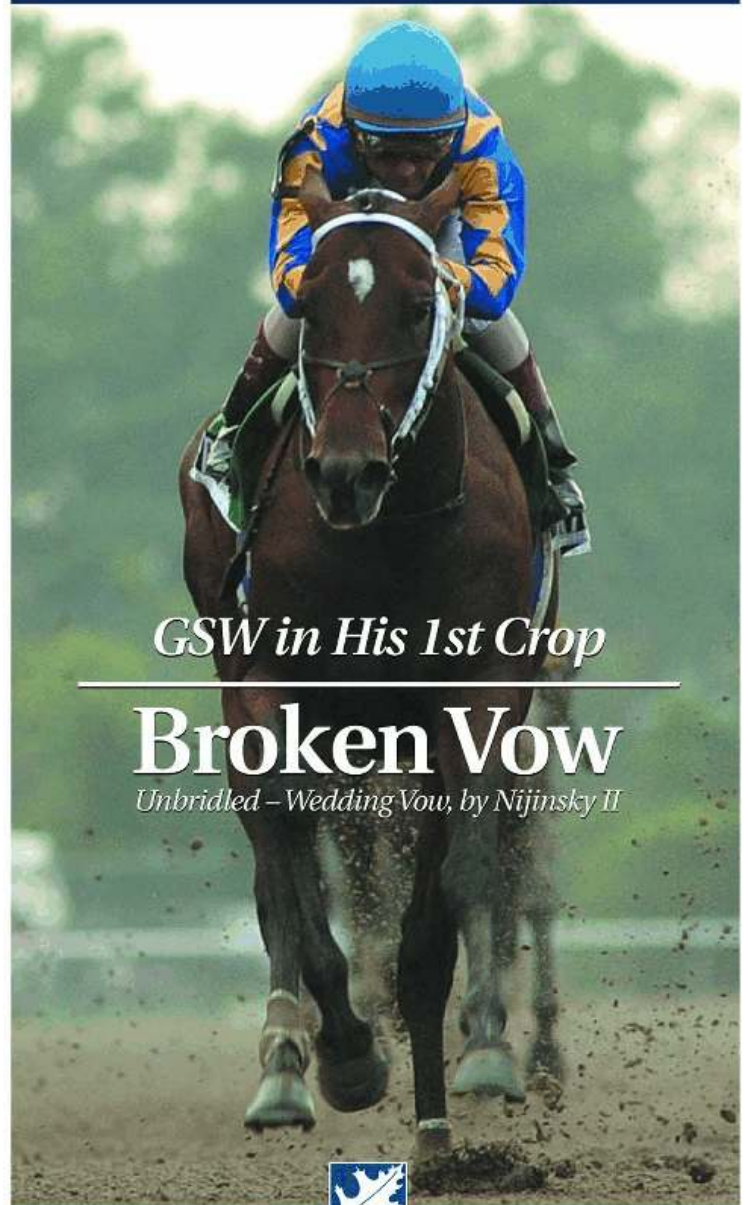

KILWORTH TOPS TATTS WEDNESDAY Former trainer David Loder, acting on behalf of an undisclosed client, topped Tattersalls' Autumn Horses In Training Sale in Newmarket yesterday, paying 360,000gns for two-year-old **Kilworth (Ire)** (Kalanisi {Ire}), runner-up in the G2 Royal Lodge S. at Newmarket. California-based trainer Bob Hess was the underbidder on the colt with trainer Neil Drysdale's wife Shawn another bidder. "He'll go out to Dubai for the winter, and hopefully, he'll be a contender for the UAE Derby," said Loder. **Hazyview (GB)** (Cape Cross {Ire})--like Kilworth (Ire) offered by trainer Neville Callaghan--is another set to be campaigned in the Middle East after Anthony Stroud outbid fellow agent Richard O'Gorman for the colt at 310,000gns. "He's for an existing client and will hopefully be a horse for the Dubai Carnival," said Stroud. Juddmonte's three-year-old colt **Palomar** (Chester House), bred by Fred Seitz, was bought as a dual-purpose prospect for 320,000gns by owner Sir Robert Ogden through racing manager Barry Simpson. "I'm not sure of the plans for him--he could carry on running on the Flat, but jumping is obviously a possibility. He'll probably go to Sir Robert's place now and we'll sort out a trainer," said Simpson. G2 Richmond S. winner **Always Hopeful (GB)** will continue his racing career in Hong Kong in the ownership of Tom Li after being bought for 270,000gns by agent Willie Leung of Magus Equine. The sale concludes today with a session starting at 9:30 a.m.

GIANT'S CAUSEWAY COLT TOPS F-T FINALE A colt by leading sophomore sire Giant's Causeway was the star of the show at yesterday's final session of the Fasig-Tipton October Yearling Sale, selling for \$200,000 to the account of BBA Ireland. Hill 'n' Dale Sales Agency consigned the chestnut colt, who is the second foal from the graded stakes winner Prospectress (Mining). He was one of 207 yearlings to sell yesterday for a total of \$3,376,000 and an average of \$16,309.

Keeneland Pitches in for Hurricane Relief:

The Keeneland Foundation, in partnership with the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association, Thoroughbred Charities of America, Starquine and the Casner Family Foundation, announced the results of a hurricane relief effort launched during the September Sales. To date, more than \$1,036,676 has been raised to assist in the relief efforts following the devastation wrought by Hurricane Katrina in late August. GONSKI TO DARLEY Gonski (Aus) (Danehill), a last-start fourth in the G1 Caulfield Guineas Oct. 8, has been sold to Darley Australia. Olly Tait, manager of the stud, said the colt, who has raced five times for two wins and a second, would race in Darley's colors in Saturday's GI Salinger S. over 1200 meters at Flemington. "After that we will just see how he goes," said Tait. "He is a very nice son of Danehill with a very nice bottom line, being out of a Marauding (NZ) mare." Asked when it was likely Gonski would join the stallion roster at Darley's Aberdeen base in the NSW Hunter Valley, Tait said: "He has still got plenty of racing to do; first things first, and then we will think about his stud career." An A\$400,000 yearling purchase from the Collingrove draft at Magic Millions 2004 for trainer Tim Martin on behalf of owner Eddie Hayson, the one-time Golden Slipper favourite's two-year-old campaign was hampered by hoof problems after he won brilliantly on debut at Rosehill in December 2004. Gonski resumed a short-priced favourite at Warwick Farm on August 30, finishing fourth after suffering an injury when he banged his head on the starting stalls, causing a nose bleed. The free-running colt was second in the Listed Heritage S. at Rosehill in Sydney Sept. 17 before overcoming a virus to win the Listed Concept Sports S. at his final outing before the G1 Caulfield Guineas, in which he was fourth to the Bart Cummings-trained God's Own. Martin said it was likely Gonski would be spelled after the Salinger to target Melbourne's rich autumn sprints.

SUNLINE FOALS ZABEEL COLT The sensational Australasian mare **Sunline (NZ)** (Desert Sun {GB}) foaled a colt by Zabeel (NZ) last Saturday at Coolmore Stud in the Hunter Valley. The champion mare will be bred this year to Rock of Gibraltar (Ire), the sire of her yearling filly of this year. "She's very similar and quite headstrong like her mother," part owner Trevor McKee said of the yearling. "At the moment, she's here on the farm and she'll be named next autumn. That's when she'll be getting educated to race and, with a bit of luck, she'll have some of her mother's ability." McKee said all of Sunline's progeny would be retained by her owners.
