LANE'S END SETS SAINT LIAM'S FEE AT \$50,000

Lane's End Farm has set the stud fee for Saturday's GI Breeders' Cup Classic winner **Saint Liam** (Saint Ballado--Quiet Dance, by Quiet American) at \$50,000, live foal. Saint Liam, retiring for the 2006 season, joins fellow Classic winners A.P. Indy and Pleasantly Perfect at the Versailles, Kentucky, nursery. "We're excited about him for a lot of reasons," said Lane's End's Bill Farish. "First of all, because he was such a great racehorse. Also, we're very excited to be standing a son of Saint Ballado. There has been a lot of interest in him, especially for that stud fee." The leading candidate for Horse of the Year honors, Saint Liam was first or second in 15 of 20 starts, winning four at the Grade I level and earning in excess of \$4.4 million. As for when Saint Liam will arrive at Lane's End, Farish said there wasn't a set date. "We don't know for sure," he said. "Like any horse coming off the track, we'll give him some time to let down."

STEPHEN GOT EVEN STUD FEE ADJUSTED

Stephen Got Even (A.P. Indy--Immerse, by Cox's Ridge), whose son Stevie Wonderboy was an impressive winner of Saturday's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, will stand the 2006 breeding season at \$25,000 live foal. The nine-year-old Lane's End stallion is also the sire of multiple graded stakes winner Don't Get Mad and graded stakes winner For All We Know. Stephen Got Even stood the 2005 season at a fee of \$12,500. His previously announced 2006 fee was \$15,000.

ANOTHER GIANT

Aidan O'Brien sent out a son of Giant's Causeway to win last year's G3 Killavullan S.--subsequent G1 2000 Guineas winner Footstepsinthesand (GB)--and it was a case of deja vu yesterday as he repeated the feat to bag a seventh success in the race. **Frost Giant** (Giant's Causeway) made a quick reappearance after a maiden third at Doncaster Oct. 3 and benefitted from that debut experience to score in commanding fashion at Leopardstown yesterday. Prominent from the outset, he was pushed to the front in early stretch and came under a typically forceful Kieren Fallon drive to dominate **Abigail Pett (GB)** (Medicean {GB}) in the closing stages. "He felt good today and has improved so much from Doncaster," Fallon commented. "He just went away and did it nicely at the finish. Rank outsider Heavenly Romance outfinished the always-tough Zenno Rob Roy to set the tote board alight. The five-year-old daughter of Sunday Silence won her first graded stakes in last December's G2 Hanshin Himba S., then came back eight months later to be second in the G3 Queen S. Aug. 14. Last time out, she won the G2 Sapporo Kinen Aug. 21, but was let go at better than 75-1 to make it two straight off the two-month break. In mid-pack early, Heavenly Romance found room on the inside and surged late to deny the post-time favorite. "She did a really good job!" exclaimed jockey Mikio Matsunga. 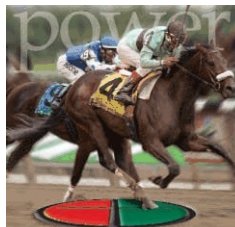

For only the second time in its 22-year history, the Breeders' Cup Classic fell to a member of the Hail To Reason male line. Whereas the 1989 Classic went to a son of Halo in Sunday Silence, the latest renewal provided a fourth Grade I triumph for Saint Liam, a grandson of Halo. The team at Lane's End Farm--soon to be home to Saint Liam--must be fervently hoping that history is going to repeat itself in another way, with Saint Liam developing into as good a stallion as the phenomenal Sunday Silence, who revolutionised Japanese breeding.

With Halo, Saint Ballado, Roberto, Kris S., Lear Fan and Silver Hawk all gone, any top-class recruit from the Hail To Reason line is all the more welcome. This line should also eventually be strengthened by Rock Hard Ten, the son of Kris S. who was expected to provide the stiffest opposition to Saint Liam in the Classic until he bruised his foot. Then there's Southern Image, a three-time Grade I winner by a son of Halo who will be making his debut in 2006 for the WinStar-Taylor Made partnership.

Perhaps we can look forward to a resurgence from this line, as I have also been impressed by More Than Ready, another grandson of Halo. More Than Ready has several Grade I performers to his credit from his first Australian crop, including the recent Victoria Derby winner Benicio. His excellent early results with Danehill mares suggest he could have an important role to play "Down Under" and he is also doing pretty well in the Northern Hemisphere.

I have to admit that there were times when I was confused as to the exact merits of Saint Liam's sire, Saint Ballado, who was only 13 when he died in 2002 (his death meaning that his final batch of two-year-olds are racing this year). **Cont. p5**

Nearly four years ago I made the following comment in this column:

“If he can sire Grade I winners of the calibre of Captain Bodgit, Sister Act and Yankee Victor when he was standing at only \$2,500, what might he achieve at fees of \$20,000 and \$30,000?”

For a while I was a little disappointed with Saint Ballado’s answer. His first Kentucky crop, sired at a fee of \$20,000, contained nothing better than a couple of Grade III winners, but his first \$30,000 foals, born in 2000, has hit the graded stakes target through Saint Liam, Freedom’s Daughter, Ocean Terrace, Saintly Look and Savedbythelight, and there were several other notable performers, such as the Grade I-placed colts Saint Buddy and Truckle Feature.

Saint Ballado’s fee had risen to \$40,000 by 2000, and again there could be few complaints, as his foals included the admirable Ashado, plus the Grade II scorers St Averil and Lord of the Game and plenty of graded-placed winners.

But what happened when his fee rose to \$125,000 in 2001 and 2002? His 2002 foals have yet to throw up a graded/group winner, although Portrayal looked capable of winning at that level when she recently won a Listed race at Newmarket. So far there are only a handful of winning juveniles from his final crop, with the stakes-winning Mykindasaint among them. Perhaps the fortunes of these high-priced crops will improve in time. After all, Saint Liam didn’t race at two and didn’t become a stakes winner until he was four.

There is some two-year-old ability in the bottom line of Saint Liam’s pedigree, as his second dam, the Lyphard mare Misty Dancer, is a three-parts sister to Minstrella. This fast daughter of The Minstrel won the Phoenix S. and Moyglare Stud S. prior to being awarded a third Group 1 success in the Cheveley Park S. in 1986.

Misty Dancer is also a half sister to Misty Gallore, who received 124 pounds on *The Blood-Horse* Free Handicap for older females of 1980, her weight being just two pounds below the top-ranked Glorious Song (who, coincidentally, was a sister to Saint Ballado and Devil’s Bag). Misty Gallore’s exploits no doubt provided the inspiration for sending Saint Liam’s dam to a son of Halo.

Breeders who like their stallions to descend from a notable female line can have no complaints about Saint Liam, as his fifth dam is Gallorette. This champion handicap mare numbered the Beldame, Brooklyn, Whitney, Carter and Metropolitan H. among her long list of stakes successes.

Saint Liam is the second foal of the talented Quiet American mare Quiet Dance. Quiet American’s rise up the broodmare sire list has been one of the features of this season. To put his achievements into perspective, I need to remind you of his background. After failing to win in three appearances in modest company on turf in Britain, he returned to his native land, where he finished his three-year-old season with a pair of allowance victories. We finally saw the real Quiet American at four in 1990, when he won the GI NYRA Mile H., but he managed only one start in 1991, so he was something of a forgotten horse by the time he commenced stallion duties at Gainsborough in 1992. **Cont p6**

His first five crops, born between 1993 and 1997, were all sired at a fee of \$10,000. Even though he was reasonably priced, he wasn't in huge demand until his fifth season, after four of his first-crop daughters had highlighted his potential. They were headed by Cara Rafaela, winner of the GI Hollywood Starlet S. after finishing second in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, and they also included Saint Liam's dam Quiet Dance, runner-up in the GII Demoiselle S., and the stakes-placed Hidden Lake, who was to develop into the champion older mare of 1997.

Yet is it the strictly limited number of daughters sired by Quiet American during his \$10,000 years which are almost exclusively responsible for his current success as a broodmare sire (the exception being Quiet Mouse, a 1999 foal off a \$20,000 season who is the dam of the Irish Group 3 winner Ugo Fire).

Quiet American's first-crop daughters have so far produced Saint Liam, his half brother Congressionalhonor (GIII Bay Meadows Derby), Whywhywhy (GI Futurity S.), Flying Glitter (GIII Monmouth Oaks and GIII Indiana Oaks) and the Group 1-placed Ile de France. The Grade II winner Two Trail Sioux is out of Quiet Trail, a mare from his small second crop, while the recent European Group 1 winner Cherry Mix (runner-up in the 2004 Arc) is out of Cherry Moon and the dual Grade III winner Lunarpal are, respectively, out of fillies from his third and fourth crops.

As these first four crops by Quiet American totalled 125 named foals, we are probably talking about 65 daughters at most. It is going to be interesting to see what impact this impressive start has on the Quiet American mares in next week's November Sale, especially as they include Whywhywhy's dam, in foal to Giant's Causeway.

The question which needs asking is why Quiet American is doing so well as a broodmare sire. The most likely answer is that he has a very unusual but strong pedigree, fortified by 3x2 inbreeding to the outstanding Dr. Fager and 4x3 inbreeding to Cequillo, a mare who left a considerable legacy. Although Dr. Fager lived long enough to sire only 255 foals, he made quite an impact as a sire of broodmares, with Fappiano, Shared Interest, Cure The Blues, Too Chic and Quiet American among his daughters' Grade I winners.

ROMAN RULER RETIRED TO HILL 'N' DALE

Three-year-old **Roman Ruler** (Fusaichi Pegasus--Silvery Swan, by Mr. Prospector), who was forced to miss the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint due a foot problem, has been retired and will head to Hill 'n' Dale Farm in Lexington to begin his stud career. Purchased for \$500,000 by David Shimmon as yearling, the dark bay went on to win five of his 10 career starts, taking the GII Best Pal S. and the GII Norfolk S. at two and the GII Dwyer S. and GI Haskell Invitational H. at three. He was also third in the GI Travers S. and ended his stint on the track with a second

behind Rock Hard Ten in the Oct. 1 GII Goodwood BC H. His earnings totaled \$1,220,800. "Roman Ruler was brilliant from the word go, he was just very fast," trainer Bob Baffert said. "I've been fortunate enough to train some very fast two-year-olds and Roman Ruler was definitely the fastest two-year-old I've ever trained. He combines the three main ingredients you need in a great sire--brilliant speed as a two-year-old, awesome good looks and a blue blooded pedigree. Roman Ruler has it all." Roman Ruler will join his half-brother, Grade I winner and top freshman sire El Corredor, at Hill 'n' Dale. He will stand for a fee of \$30,000 live foal. "We are excited about the prospects of this talented and royally bred racehorse," said John G. Sikura, president of Hill 'n' Dale. "He brings all the prerequisites of a serious sire to stud with him...and his half-brother El Corredor is off to a brilliant start at stud."

Spills Send Jockeys to Hospital:

Jockey Gary Bain and apprentice rider Alexis Freites were taken to Memorial Regional Hospital in Hollywood, Florida after separate spills at Calder Monday. In the first race, Bain was unseated when his mount Touch of Magic clipped heels heading into the homestretch. He was alert and talking, but was taken to the hospital for further evaluation. In the second race Freites fell from Local Forecast after bumping another horse a few jumps out of the starting gate. Freites suffered an arm injury and was taken to the hospital for x-rays. Neither horse was injured in the spills. Calder, which had been closed since Hurricane Wilma swept through the Miami area last week, reopened Sunday with an abbreviated five-race turf program and held a similar program yesterday. The track is dark Tuesday and Wednesday, but will reopen Thursday with a nine-race card.
