### WILDCAT HEIR RETIRED WITH KNEE INJURY

Grade I winner **Wildcat Heir** (Forest Wildcat--Penniless Heiress, by Pentelicus), who stumbled and fell just after crossing the wire in 10th in Saturday's GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, exited the race with a knee injury and has been retired. The injury, which will not require surgery, was described in a release as a hairline fracture of the accessory carpal bone--the bone at the back of the knee. Stud plans for the five-year-old have yet to be determined. "With Wildcat Heir's value at stud, we decided the best thing to do was to retire him," said Eb Novak, who bred and owns Wild-

cat Heir under the New Farm banner. Conditioned by Ben Perkins, Jr., Wildcat Heir secured his biggest career victory winning the 2004 renewal of the GI Frank J. De Francis Memorial Dash S. over Midas Eyes. He came into the Breeders' Cup off a rousing 5 1/4-length tally in the Aug. 7 Teddy Drone S. at Monmouth, a race that earned him a 117 Beyer figure. From the immediate family of GI Preakness S. winner Louis Quatorze, Wildcat Heir is a full sibling to MGSW Forest Heiress and SW Forest Heir. He concludes his career with a record of 12-6-4-0 and earnings of \$424,460.

### MASS MEDIA RETIRED TO HILL 'N' DALE

Grade I winner **Mass Media** (Touch Gold--Sultry Allure, by Forty Niner) has been retired and will begin his breeding career in 2006 at Hill 'n' Dale Farm in Lexington, Kentucky. The four-year-old will stand for \$7,500, live foal, as the property of Gary and Mary West. "We have enjoyed considerable success with Buddha at Hill 'n' Dale and therefore decided to stand Mass Media there, as well," said Gary West. Produced by a half sister to Grade I-winning millionaires Sultry Song and Solar Splendor, the dark bay won two of three starts at two before defeating older runners as a three-year-old in the 2004 GIII Sport Page H. for trainer Bobby Frankel. Second in the GII San Fernando Breeders' Cup H. in January and third in the GII True North Breeders' Cup H. in June, Mass Media rallied to take the GI Forego H. at Saratoga Sept. 3. His record stands at 16-6-1-2 with earnings of \$396,420.



### GIANT'S CAUSEWAY, MONTJEU FEES UPPED

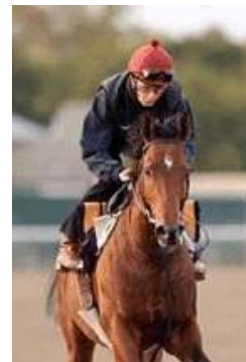
Coolmore Stud announced the stud fees for some of its biggest names yesterday. **Giant's Causeway**, based at Coolmore's Ashford division in Kentucky and the sire of GISW First Samurai and European stars Footstepsinthesand (GB), Shamardal and Maids Causeway (Ire), has had his fee upped from \$200,000 to \$300,000. Coolmore also raised the fee for the Irish-based **Montjeu (Ire)**, who had a banner year in Europe this season with three Classic winners--Motivator (GB), Hurricane Run (Ire), and Scorpion (Ire)--from his first crop. The son of Sadler's Wells will stand for €125,000, or approximately \$150,000, for 2006, up from €45,000 last term. Coolmore announced that the fee for **Fusaichi Pegasus**, sire of 2005 Grade I winners Bandini and Roman Ruler, would remain at \$125,000.

### Oratorio Retired to Coolmore...

In related news, three-time Group 1 winner **Oratorio (Ire)** (Danehill--Mahrah, by \*Vaguely Noble) has been retired and will take up stud duties at Coolmore Ireland. Named champion two-year-old last year in France off his win in the G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere-Grand Criterium, Oratorio went on to beat Motivator twice while also facing older horses in the G1 Coral Eclipse S. and G1 Irish Champion S. "Oratorio is an amazing horse," said Aidan O'Brien, who conditioned the sophomore for Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor. "He has everything--speed, stamina and a big heart." Oratorio, who went unplaced in his lone start on the dirt in last Saturday's GI Breeders' Cup Classic, retires with a record of 15-6-3-1 and earnings of \$1,919,669.

The lightly built Serenade Rose continued trainer Lee Freedman's phenomenal rampage through the Melbourne Spring Carnival when she made him the first trainer since Lou Robertson in 1935 to send out the winners of the Cox Plate, Melbourne Cup, Victoria Derby and Victoria Oaks. The mighty Makybe Diva accounted for the former two, while Benicio (Aus) landed the Derby. Serenade Rose, a A\$400,000 Inglis Easter yearling purchase, announced her presence winning the G2 Edward Manifold S. over 1600 meters. She was widely considered unlucky when third in the G1 Thousand Guineas Oct. 12, but entered this off an impressive victory in the G2 Wakeful S. Saturday. Jockey Steven King settled the filly one off the rail in fourth position and angled out as the field rounded the final turn, easily collaring the leaders to win going away." Freedman, winning his fourth renewal of this race, was celebrating his big season. "She was the best filly all spring and she should have won the 1000 Guineas; she has won the Oaks in a canter," he said. "This is a fantastic thing, to win the Derby and the Oaks, in a year when I thought my three-year-olds were ordinary--I must be a fool!" Click for the [brisnet.com pedigree](#).

**UNFORGETTABLE MAX TO STONEWALL** The five-year-old **Unforgettable Max** (Northern Afleet--Maggy Hawk, by Hawkster)--a full brother to dual Classic winner Afleet Alex--will retire to Stonewall Farm in Versailles, Kentucky, for the 2006 breeding season. A stakes-winning and multiple-graded-stakes-placed performer, Unforgettable Max will stand for \$7,500, live foal. "Unforgettable Max is a very solid-looking individual," said Stonewall's stallion manager Bert Welker. "I think that breeders will be taken with him when they see him. He was a very determined racehorse and consistently held his own against some of the best horses in training." Unforgettable Max was first or second in nine of 23 starts and has earned \$384,079.

**BARN FIRE AT FAIR HILL KILLS 24 HORSES** A devastating barn fire at Fair Hills Training Center in Elkton, Maryland killed 24 Thoroughbreds Tuesday night. No humans were injured in the blaze, the cause of which is under investigation. "The timeframe from the fire being noticed until the barn was consumed was very quick, a matter of minutes," said trainer Bruce Jackson, who lost 11 horses. "Although the barn was engulfed by the time the first firefighters arrived, their efforts and those of over 100 others from Maryland, Pennsylvania and Delaware departments secured the safety of surrounding barns, for which we are grateful." Four horses in the barn were saved.

**NYRA REACHES VLT AGREEMENT WITH HORSEMEN, BREEDERS** The New York Racing Association announced that it has reached a revenue-sharing agreement with the New York Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association and the New York Breeding and Development Fund regarding the distribution of gaming revenue from Aqueduct's video lottery terminals. The horsemen will receive a percentage of the facility gross gaming revenues, as follows:

- Years 1-3: 7.5 percent
- Years 4-5: 7.75 percent
- Years 6+: 10 percent

A NYRA release stated that horsemen will dedicate \$3.5 million of their share annually for capital improvements on the backstretch for as long as NYRA retains its franchise. The percentage that the Breeding Fund will receive is as follows:

- Years 1-5: 1.25 percent
- Years 6+: 1.50 percent

"I am incredibly excited for racing in the State of New York," said C. Steven Duncker, co-chairman of the NYRA Board of Trustees. "This once again proves that NYRA is committed to presenting the best racing in the world. We congratulate the horsemen and breeders in reaching this agreement today." A total of 4,500 VLTs are slated to begin operation at Aqueduct next fall.

**BETFAIR A GO FOR TASMANIA** Betfair, in a 50-50 joint venture with Kerry Packer's Publishing and Broadcasting Ltd (PBL), will be licensed to operate by the Tasmanian Government, subject to a strict regulatory regime, according to Tasmanian Premier Paul Lennon. The British-based betting exchange has operated on Australian racing for three years, but an Australian licence will allow the company to advertise and promote its business and to establish an office in Hobart. Tasmania has negotiated an arrangement which will earn 35 percent of the gross racing profit on all Australian racing events, 15 percent of the profits on other sporting events and 10 percent of the profits on international events. The state government will retain five percent from each category as tax revenues and distribute the rest to the racing industry through Tote Tasmania. Victorian-based Tabcorp had threatened to block Tasmanian racing out of the national betting pool, but Lennon said the state's tote agency had a commercial agreement with Tabcorp until 2008. "This is providing choice and opportunity for the people who keep racing alive in the country: punters. And this is the best deal that punters could have--more competition in the marketplace," Lennon said. PBL executive chairman James Packer said Betfair's introduction to Australia would help improve racing's prosperity by attracting new punters to the sport and providing more benefits for existing punters. "It's the best company in the world operating in the betting exchange space," he told *AAP*. Victorian Premier Steve Bracks slammed the move, saying Victoria would not follow suit by licensing Betfair. Bracks said he doubted that the necessary legislation would be passed in Tasmania's Upper House.
