### FIRST CLASS

**Lattice (Ire)** (Inchinor {GB}), winner of the G1 French Oaks last season, looks to be the class of the field in today's GII Long Island H. at Aqueduct. The four-year-old began her 2005 campaign in the U.S., winning the Aug. 12 Waya S. in Saratoga, then went to the bench. "We had a little hiccup after [the Waya]," trainer Jonathan Sheppard said. "She bled in a workout and bled fairly strongly." Adding Lasix for her second outside start, Lattice came back to finish third behind **Spotlight (GB)** (Dr Fong) as the 3-5 chalk in the Oct. 3 Cicada S. at Delaware Park, then made amends for that defeat in fine fashion, finishing a sharp second in Woodbine's GI E.P. Taylor S. Oct. 23. That effort earned her a berth in the Long Island. "We were looking for another spot, but the Long Island was the only race that made much sense," Sheppard said. "She's taken everything in stride since the E.P. Taylor, so we thought it was worth crossing our fingers and hoping there is enough gas left in the tank." **Olaya** (Theatrical {Ire}) makes her first start in this country for trainer Graham Motion after racing eight times in France. The bay notched the Listed Derby du Languedoc S. at Toulouse June 19, but was a well-beaten fifth in the Deauville's G3 Prix Minerve S. last time Aug. 23.

### DEHERE RETURNING TO ASHFORD

Champion **Dehere** (Deputy Minister--Sister Dot, by Secretariat), the sire of millionaires Take Charge Lady and Graeme Hall, will return to Ashford Stud in Versailles, Kentucky from Japan for the 2006 breeding season. "We expect him to be in high demand," said Aisling Duignan, Coolmore America's director of sales. "He gets great-looking stock and he's an all-American sire." Named for a top basketball player, Dehere began his career in 1993 with four straight wins, including an historic triple of Saratoga's two-year-old stakes races: the GII Saratoga Special S., the GIII Sanford S. and the GI Hopeful S. He lost his unbeaten record to future Horse of the Year Holy Bull when second in the GI Futurity S. at Belmont, but rebounded to take the GI Champagne S. by four lengths the following month, thereby sealing his Eclipse Award as champion two-year-old colt. Second in his three-year-old debut, Dehere defeated a star-studded field in the GII Fountain of Youth S. at Gulfstream, with subsequent Kentucky Derby winner Go for Gin finishing second and Holy Bull running further afield. That proved to be his final start, and Dehere retired to Ashford with a record of 9-6-2-0 and earnings of \$723,712. He proved to be a versatile stallion from the start. Dehere was represented by nine stakes horses in his first crop, including juvenile graded winner Millions and the multiple stakes winner Arrested Dreams, who narrowly missed in the GI Matron S. From his second crop came the multiple graded stakes winning three-year-old Graeme Hall; the swift Millencolin, a graded-stakes winner at two and three and third in the GI King's Bishop S.; and Here's Zealous, a graded stakes-winning sprinter. Dehere also sired Take Charge Lady, one of the finest fillies of her generation who twice captured the prestigious GI Spinster S. at Keeneland; and the brilliant Soto, a multiple graded-stakes winner who set a track record of 1:46.29 at Monmouth. Dehere also distinguished himself in the Southern Hemisphere as the sire of champion Belle du Jour (Aus) and Group 1 winners Defier (Aus) and Bolinger (Aus). His stud fee will be announced at a later date. "We are so pleased to be able to offer him to American breeders," Duignan added. "He's by a sire-of-Secretariat, who is the broodmare sire of top stallions Storm Cat, A.P. Indy and Gone West."

**Mea Domina**, three-for-four at a mile, is perfect in three starts over the Santa Anita lawn. The four-year-old filly won back-to-back allowance races over the course in January and April, then weakened to finish fourth behind **Pickle** after a troubled trip in the Apr. 23 GIII Wilshire H. She makes her first start since going gate to wire in the nine-panel GI Gamely BC H. May 30. "She had a quarter crack behind," Hall of Fame trainer Ron McAnally said. "We had to treat it last summer. She's coming around now. She's settled down nicely-- she used to be kind of hyper." Sixth in the Gamely in her U.S. debut, **Halo Ola** improved to be third behind Megahertz (GB) in the June 25 GII Beverly Hills H. Off the board versus Grade I company in her next two starts, the five-year-old returned after a short break to run third in the 10-furlong GI Yellow Ribbon Invitational H. Oct. 1. Pickle made it two in a row in the May 21 GIII Yerba Buena BC H. at Golden Gate, but couldn't handle Intercontinental (GB) in her next outing, finishing fifth behind that rival in the July 3 GIII Royal Heroine H. Second in a pair of Northern California stakes over the summer, she made up some ground late to be fourth behind **Elusive Diva** and **Chasethegold** in the Sept. 28 GIII S.K. Maddy H. Stretching out off that 6 1/2-furlong test, Elusive Diva is also unbeaten in three starts on the Santa Anita turf.

**Indian Vale** certainly looked like the goods taking her first three starts by a combined 25 lengths, including a pair of Saratoga allowances, but disappointed in her first chance versus stakes company, finishing fifth in the Oct. 1 GII Cotillion H. at Philly Park with Hall of Famer Angel Cordero, Jr. aboard. "She didn't seem to handle the track at all that day," trainer Todd Pletcher said. "Angel said he knew he was in trouble when she was going into the first turn. She's come back in good shape and we're anxious to stretch her out to a mile and an eighth."

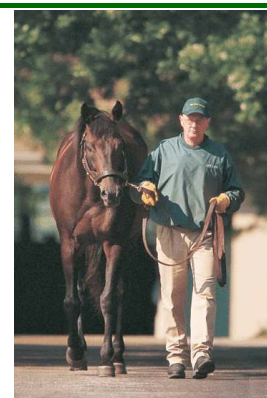

Royally bred **Flanders Fields**, a son of champion **Flanders** and a 3/4-brother to champion **Surfside**, followed a second-place finish in his career opener at the Spa Aug. 13 with a 6 1/2-length score going a mile at Belmont Sept. 10. The Overbrook colorbearer was sidelined by illness after that effort. "We were heading toward the [GI Champagne S.], but unfortunately he got sick," said trainer Dallas Stewart. "The Breeders' Cup came up and we just weren't ready. Hopefully, we're ready now--we think we are. He's had two good works here, and he only missed about five or six days training, so we're hoping that he's tight enough." Million-dollar Barretts juvenile purchase **Grand Survival** broke his maiden by a half-length in his Saratoga debut Aug. 6, but faltered as the even-money chalk in the Sept. 18 GIII Arlington-Washington Futurity and finished seventh. He adds Lasix for his third start.

**NEW PURSE STRUCTURE IN CALIFORNIA** Officials at Hollywood Park found themselves with a purse surplus of \$2.3 million after cancelling the 11 stakes races scheduled to be run on the turf during the upcoming fall meet. Where will that extra money go? The track yesterday announced that it has forged an agreement with the Thoroughbred Owners of California to increase the overnight purses at the Hollywood meet by 14 percent. There will also be two new two-year-old races added to the Hollywood stakes program--the Nov. 26 \$100,000 Real Quiet S. at a mile and a sixteenth, and the Nov. 27 \$100,000 Sharp Cat S. for juvenile fillies at the same distance--and Golden Gate Fields will receive \$166,000 to supplement the purses of selected turf races. "The money will raise the Golden Gate purses to the level of the originally announced Hollywood Park purses, providing Southern California horsemen the opportunity to run for the same money up north," said Hollywood GM Eual Wyatt Jr., adding, "The agreement was reached in a series of meetings. Both sides concluded this is the best solution to a set of extraordinary circumstances." Connections will not have to pay to ship Southern California-based horses to Golden Gate for the selected turf races. Hollywood will also reduce the number of days of its fall meeting from 31 to 27, but exactly which racing days will be cut has not yet been decided. The Inglewood oval was forced to call off all grass racing because a newly installed course failed to take root. That course has now been torn up, and new sod is expected to be put in place Monday.

**WOKE UP DREAMIN TO MILLENNIUM FARMS**

He heads to the breeding shed with a record of 16-6-1-3 and earnings of \$578,475 for owner Mike Pegram and trainer Bob Baffert. "Woke Up Dreamin is a sensationally fast horse who took his 'A' game coast to coast," said Millennium Manager William Hardin. "We believe he is an excellent stallion prospect and exceptional value at this fee." Woke Up Dreamin, whose second dam is two-time champion Flawlessly, has arrived at Millennium and is available for inspection.

**BREEDERS' CUP XXII SETS HANDLE RECORDS**

Breeders' Cup XXII at Belmont Park set new marks for total handle, Breeders' Cup-only handle and simulcast handle. A total of \$124,009,593 was bet from all sources on the 10-race card, breaking the record of \$120,897,141 set at Lone Star in 2004. The all-sources handle on the eight Breeders' Cup events was \$116,465,923, a six-percent jump from last year's record of \$109,838,668. Simulcast wagering reached a new high of \$109,267,073, 88-percent of the total handle.

**Breeders' Cup to Establish Board of Trustees:**

The Board of Directors of the Breeders' Cup has approved changes to the organization's by-laws that will establish a Board of Trustees. The Trustees will be determined by the current shareholder voting system, which is based on Breeders' Cup foal and stallion nominations, then will elect a 13-member Board of Directors. "These changes to our governance structure are the product of a careful planning process which the Board has undertaken this year," said Breeders' Cup President D.G. Van Clief, Jr. "We feel that these modifications will allow us to respond more efficiently to the challenges of a rapidly changing marketplace while continuing to provide broad representation to our constituents." The election process will begin this month, and it is expected that the new Board will be in place at the next scheduled meeting in January. The Board has also revised the Breeders' Cup mission statement, which now proposes to promote the Thoroughbred industry and its economic growth through:

- A World Championship day with supporting events
- Encouraging participation both within the industry and among the fan base
- Maintaining the highest level of integrity within the industry
- Continuing to improve the Thoroughbred breed
- Providing leadership to the industry

**CHRB Outlines New Weighing-Out Procedure:**

The California Horse Racing Board has unveiled new guidelines for the procedure jockeys follow when weighing out for races. The guidelines call for jockeys to weigh out in full view of the public, then proceed to a designated common area or to the paddock. A steward or his representative will observe the weighing-out process, and tracks will be required to install video cameras to record the proceedings. While riders will weigh out while carrying all equipment to be used in the race, the track's official program will include the following statement: "A jockey's riding weight includes riding clothing, saddle, undergirth, and pad. The weight listed in the program does not include the jockey's safety equipment, which consists of the helmet, goggles, safety vest and overgirth, and may also include a pommel pad, girth channel and/or chamois. The total weight of this excluded safety equipment shall not exceed five pounds. The saddlecloths, whip and bridle are not included in the five-pound limitation on safety equipment. The weight of the saddlecloth, bridle, whip and all safety equipment is additive to and not included in the program weight or announced overweight." The riders at Santa Anita, Golden Gate and Los Alamitos have been provided with the new rules, but it has not yet been determined when they will go into effect.
