“LEROI” RETIRED TO STONEWALL

Multiple Grade I winner **Leroidesanimaux (Brz)** (Candy Stripes--Dissemble {GB}, by Ahonoora {GB}), a

leading Eclipse Award candidate, has been retired to Stonewall Farm in Versailles, Kentucky. The chestnut will stand for a fee of \$30,000, live foal. “Leroidesanimaux is a strong, beautiful horse and fits the profile of a Stonewall stallion,” said farm owner Audrey Haisfield. “Like Medaglia d’Oro, he was a Grade I winner who consistently proved himself against

the very best competition.” From the immediate family of champion Banks Hill (GB) and French highweight Dansili (GB), Leroidesanimaux was Group 1-placed in his native Brazil for Stud TNT. After a close fourth in his U.S. bow, the powerfully built runner reeled off eight straight victories for trainer Bobby Frankel. Included in that winning streak were six graded stakes, including Grade Is. His first win at the top level came in the 2004 GI Citation H. at Hollywood, and he added another this past spring in Santa Anita’s GI Frank E. Kilroe Mile. The five-year-old then travelled East and set a Saratoga course record of 1:39.92 for 1 1/16 miles in the GII Fourstardave H. Leroidesanimaux followed that with a rousing, 7 3/4-length triumph in the GI Atto Mile at Woodbine in September. Favored in the GI Breeders’ Cup Mile at Belmont Oct. 29, he very nearly overcame a wide post and aluminum pads to miss by 3/4 of a length to Artie Schiller in the \$1.8-million contest. Leroidesanimaux heads to stud with a record of 13-9-2-0 and earnings of \$1,749,337. He will be participate in the Stonewall Breeders incentive program for owners of Grade I/II-winning mares, or producers of recent Grade I/II winners.

The field is headed by **Linda’s Lad (GB)** (Sadler’s Wells), who will be bid to give Andre Fabre a third winner since 1993. After winning the Listed Criterium du FEE at Deauville Aug. 20, he finished runner-up to the sub-

sequent G1 Criterium International hero Carlotamix (Fr) in the Sept. 17 G3 Prix des Chenes at Longchamp. The two-year-old returned to that venue Oct. 16 and relished a step up in distance to 8 1/2 furlongs when taking the G3 Prix de Conde last time. Criquelette Head-Maarek, who collected this contest in 1994 with Poliglote (GB) and three years later with Special Quest (Fr), relies on **Customary (GB)** (Anabaa), who looked in need of the extra distance when winning a conditions event at Longchamp on his last start Oct. 16. Mario Hofer, who won this race 12 months ago with Paita (GB), puts forward **Flashing Numbers** (Polish Numbers), who opened his account at first asking at San Siro Oct. 5.

BACK TO THE FOLD Olin Gentry, bidding on behalf of Gaines-Gentry Thoroughbreds, went to a session-topping bid of \$625,000 for hip [1530](#), the four-year-old filly **Scrambling** (Silver Deputy), during yesterday's fifth session of the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale in Lexington. Gentry and partner Thomas Gaines are no strangers to the family. Produced by Canadian champion sprinter Apelia, Scrambling is a half sister to Saoirse (Cure the Blues), champion older mare in Canada in 2000, and was purchased by Gaines-Gentry in utero for \$850,000 at the 2000 November sale. She was resold to Bob and Beverly Lewis for \$575,000 at the last Keeneland July sale in 2002, and Gaines has been eager to get her back. "We've been anticipating that she'd be resold and we were very determined to buy her back," he said. "It's a great family and she's absolutely beautiful." Scrambling is in foal to Mr. Greeley; her offspring will be bred on the exact cross that produced GISW and promising sire El Corredor.

Jess Jackson, The Seller...

Jess Jackson, in the words of Keeneland Director of Sales Geoff Russell, 'made' the 2004 November sale, purchasing over \$20 million in breeding stock. Jackson has been one of the top buyers again this year, but he has also taken on the role of seller. Yesterday's first lot was hip [1390](#), a Taylor Made-consigned colt bred by Jackson's Stonestreet Mares. From the first crop by Harlan's Holiday, the half-brother to MGSW and GISP Gators N Bears was knocked down for \$130,000 to the bid of Tony Lacy, agent. Jackson was the successful bidder on the dam, I'll Be Along, last November, going to \$210,000. Harlan's Holiday has had an impressive run over the first five days of the sale. The six-year-old stallion, who stands at Brereton C. Jones's Airdrie Stud, had eight first-crop weanlings sell for gross receipts of \$1,034,000. The average of \$129,250 is nearly 7 1/2 times his 2004 stud fee of \$17,500.

Walden Active in New Venture...

Ben Walden Jr. went right to work for his new Hurricane Hall operation, snapping up five horses yesterday, including the day's top foal. Sitting alongside former English trainer David Hanley, Walden was extended to \$215,000 for hip 1476, a colt by El Prado (Ire) and the first produce of MSP Peanut Gallery (Mister Baileys {GB}). Walden signed the ticket in the name of Aspiration Stud. "He's a very nice horse and he's very typical of his sire," Hanley commented. "He's a very good first foal and the mare could run a bit. We were really impressed with him." Walden Jr. indicated that a decision will be made later whether to resell the colt or whether he will join the new operation's racing program. The Feb. 8 foal was consigned by Eaton Sales as agent. Later on in the session, the duo went to \$500,000 for hip 1551, the four-year-old filly Song Track (Dixieland Band). Produced by the A.P. Indy mare Happy Tune, a half sister to champion Storm Song, the bay is a three-parts sister to High Cotton (Dixie Union), who since the catalogue broke his maiden at second asking Sept. 17 and was most recently second, beaten just a neck, in the GIII Iroquois S. at Churchill Downs Nov. 5. Song Track was part of the draft from Lane's End.

Greathouse Secures Season for 'Song...'

David Greathouse won a 2006 guaranteed live foal season to **Songandaprayer** (Unbridled's Song) in a raffle to benefit the victims of Hurricane Katrina and Habitat for Humanity, according to *The Blood-Horse*. A representative for the charitable organization drew Greathouse's winning ticket at Keeneland's pavilion during yesterday's session of the November Sale. In all, 78 tickets were sold at \$500 apiece to raise \$39,000 for Lexington Habitat for Humanity and Operation Home Delivery. The season was donated by Bobby Leslie Hurley, whose colors Songandaprayer carried on the racetrack. Among the leading freshman sires this year with a pair of graded-stakes winners, the seven-year-old will stand at Walmac Farm in 2006 for a \$35,000 fee.

Underwood S. and the Ack Ack H. in 2004 before succeeding at the highest level in the Vosburgh. He retires with a record of 28-6-3-4 and earnings of \$1,019,455. Studs plans for the dark bay have not yet been finalized.



A pair of fillies, one based in Australia and the other in the U.S., are set to take their place in the G1 Hong Kong Sprint in four weeks' time, when they will face the world's top-rated turf sprinter Silent Witness (Aus). **Segments (Aus)** (Mossman {Aus}) was good enough to run the talented Fastnet Rock (Aus) to a length when second in the G1 Oakleigh Plate last February and posted her first win at group level two back, running off with the G2 Schillaci S. at the Caulfield Carnival Oct. 8. Trained by Peter Moody, the bay was bred this spring on Southern Hemisphere time and has tested in foal to Encosta de Lago (Aus). **Nicole's Dream** (Northern Trend) started for a \$7,500 claiming tag at two, but has become a win machine at turf sprint distances. The Florida-bred, trained by Larry Rivelli, has won 16 of 27 attempts at the specialist trips while amassing earnings of \$567,638.
