A weanling colt by Tiznow topped all bids Sunday during the seventh session of the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale in Lexington. Selling as hip 2538,

the dark bay son of stakes-winner Financial Lady (Distinctive Pro) elicited an offer of \$230,000 from Lobo Farm. The Mar. 26 foal was consigned by Eaton Sales, agent. **Ozzie Cat** (Storm Cat), a five-year-old stallion prospect, brought the second highest price of the session when I T C International Thoroughbred Consultants went to \$210,000. Out of

the Mr. Prospector mare Hopespringsforever--a full to Miswaki--Ozzie Cat (hip 2272) is from a successful Overbrook family. The chestnut is a half to GISP Union City and a full to SW Apollo Cat and MGSP Steady Cat, the dam of Jump Start. Ozzie Cat was consigned by Eaton Sales, agent for Overbrook Farm. **You Glitter Girl** (Glitterman), a racing or broodmare prospect, led all mares on the afternoon on the strength of Greathouse Bloodstock's \$150,000 bid. A Bluewater Sales consignee, the five-year-old won Calder's Sara's Success S. this term and has banked \$210,156 winning eight of 24 starts. Consignor Taylor Made Sales Agency achieved another landmark yesterday, establishing a new mark for gross sales from a consignment.
