**KITTEN'S JOY TO STAND FOR \$25K**

Ken and Sarah Ramsey's reigning turf champion **Kitten's Joy** (El Prado--Kitten's First, by Lear Fan) will enter stud for a fee of \$25,000 at Ramsey Farm in Nicholasville, Ky. Kitten's Joy enjoyed his best season as a sophomore, notching the GIII Virginia Derby, the GI Secretariat S. and the GI Turf Classic Invitational. He closed out his championship year with a second-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf. The handsome chestnut only faced the starter twice this season, taking the GII Firecracker Breeders' Cup H. in his four-year-old bow and placing second in the GI Arlington Million. He retires with nine wins from 14 starts and \$2,075,791 in earnings.

**'ATTILA' STORMS HIS WAY INTO THE DASH**

**Attila's Storm** (Forest Wildcat), fourth in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint behind Silver Train, has drawn into the GI Frank J. DeFrancis Memorial Dash with the scratch of **Sensibly Chic** (Distorted Humor). "He's a pretty nice colt," trainer Rick Schosberg commented. "He'd done all that we've asked of him. He put in a good effort in the Breeders' Cup and came out of it in great shape. We were hoping for a better post [14] in the DeFrancis Dash. We're confident that he belongs in the race." Connections of Sensibly Chic have

opted to keep their charge against her own sex and have entered her in the Stefanita S. on the Dash undercard. "At the end of the day this made the most sense," trainer Tim Tullock said. "I don't think she was overmatched in the Dash, but she wasn't a standout either and she is a standout in the Stefanita."

**SHADEED DIES**

Classic-winning champion **Shadeed** (Nijinsky--Continual, by Damascus) was euthanized Nov. 13 due to complications from an illness, according to a press release. The 23-year-old stallion was buried at Gainsborough Farm in Versailles, Kentucky, where he had been standing at stud. Bred in Kentucky by the partnership of Cherry Valley Farm and Gamely Corp., the bay sold as a yearling for \$800,000 at Keeneland July and was sent to England to race in the colors of Sheikh Maktoum al Maktoum. Shadeed captured the Houghton S. as a two-year-old for trainer Michael Stoute before developing into a star as a three-year-old in 1985. Following his win in the G3 Craven S., he won the G1 2000 Guineas and the G2 Queen Elizabeth II S., and was the highweighted three-year-old miler in England. Shadeed crossed the Atlantic for the GI Breeders' Cup Mile at Aqueduct for his final career start. He finished fourth, but was placed third via disqualification, and retired with a record of 7-4-1-1 and earnings of \$292,545. He sired Italian champion Free Thinker in his first crop, and was represented by G1 1000 Guineas winner and champion Shadayid in his second. Alydeed, hero of the Queen's Plate and second in the G1 Preakness S., came from his third crop. Shadeed later sired millionaire Sayyedati (GB), a Group 1 winner in England, Ireland and France to complement her third-place finish in the 1995 Breeders' Cup Mile. From 17 crops to race, he sired 15 stakes winners, 10 of which scored at group/graded level.

**WILDCAT HEIR TO CLOVERLEAF FARM** The Grade I-winning five-year-old **Wildcat Heir** (Forest Wildcat--Penniless Heiress, by Pentelicus), retired after sustaining an injury in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint Oct. 29, will enter stud at Cloverleaf Farm in Reddick, Florida as part of a Taylor Made/WinStar Farm venture. His stud fee will be \$8,000 live foal. The full brother to MGSW Forest Heiress and MSW Forest Heir captured last year's GI Frank J. DeFrancis Memorial Dash for owner/breeder New Farm. "We were looking for the right horse to stand in Florida, and Wildcat Heir really fits the profile of highly successful Florida stallions," said Brent Fernung, Cloverleaf's general manager. "He had a lot of speed, has a strong pedigree that is well known to breeders in Florida and, most importantly, is a very good physical." Those sentiments were echoed by trainer Ben Perkins Jr. "My father and I have trained some very fast horses, and there is no doubt in my mind that Wildcat Heir is by far the fastest horse that we have ever had anything to do with," said the conditioner.

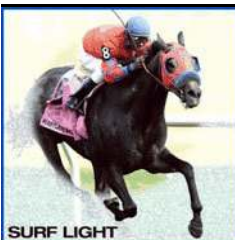

**SHACONAGE RETIRED** Multiple graded stakes winner **Shaconage** (El Prado {Ire}--Carita Tostada {Chi}, by Gallantsky) has been retired after sustaining a tendon injury. The five-year-old had been scheduled to contest Saturday's GIII Cardinal H. at Churchill Downs. "She was a good filly," commented trainer Mitch Shirota. "She was a tough filly to train and was always tough on herself. I'd worry about her

when she went out in the mornings, so it's a little relief that

she's retired." Shirota added that Shaconage had been sent to owner Andrena Van Doren's farm near Georgetown, Kentucky, but that breeding plans were undecided. A daughter of Chilean Group 1 winner Carita Tostada, the grey is a half sister to multiple Grade I-placed Chile Chatte (Storm Cat) and GSW Jadada (Jade Hunter). Shaconage earned her first graded stakes victory in the 2004 GIII Argent Mortgage S. and added another in the GIII Locust Grove H. She won this year's Ellis Park Breeders' Cup Turf S. and hit the board in an additional five graded events. She heads to the breeding shed with a record of 29-6-3-7 and earnings of \$534,051.

**PANEL MAKES RECOMMENDATIONS TO NYRA: CUT TAKEOUT; DEFER NTRA DUES**

A state oversight panel is recommending the New York Racing Association boost takeout, defer dues to the National Thoroughbred Racing Association, and get a cash advance from its casino partner in order to cope with NYRA's worsening fiscal picture. The oversight board estimates NYRA's operating expenses will exceed its revenues by up to \$7 million by next April, which it blamed on "the extraordinary costs related to NYRA's legal difficulties and resultant fees and fines." In a Nov. 17 letter to NYRA president Charles Hayward, Carole Stone, head of the panel, said as a result, NYRA's fiscal solutions should be done "without diminishing the value of the franchise or shifting the burden of any solution to the state taxpayers or other elements of the industry." The state government oversight board, in Stone's letter, made no mention of two of NYRA's current cash-raising plans--selling off 80 parcels of land in and around Aqueduct and auctioning 19 pieces of artwork. The board has already said it believes NYRA does not have the legal authority to sell the land or paintings without state approval. Stone said NYRA should sell or syndicate its interest in Equibase, with an option to reacquire the interest at a pre-established price at some time in the future. She also recommended NYRA "intensify efforts" to resolve existing lawsuits "in order to achieve a timely cash settlement."

**SANTA ANITA TO OFFER \$12 MILLION IN STAKES PURSES** Santa Anita Park will offer over \$12-million in stakes purses during its 69<sup>th</sup> season of racing, including 10 Grade I events. The 86-day winter/spring meet gets underway Dec. 26 with the GI Malibu S. Other highlights include the GI Santa Anita H. Mar. 4, the GI Santa Anita Derby Apr. 8, as well as the fourth annual Sunshine Millions Jan. 28. A total of 60 stakes races are scheduled--43 of them graded. The inclusion of overnight stakes will be offered for the first time. "We decided to include our overnight stakes so that horsemen can better plan a course of action," said Santa Anita Racing Secretary Rick Hammerle.

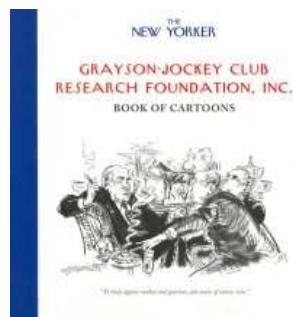



**WRITTEN FORCED TO DISPERSE** William Inglis & Son will sell the racing and breeding stock of the failed Written Bloodstock Syndicate under instructions from receivers Ferrier Hodgson and Sims and Partners, starting with broodmares at next Friday's Christmas Thoroughbred Sale at the company's Newmarket complex in Sydney. Written Bloodstock's 160 horses include multiple stakes winner **Our Egyptian Raine (NZ)** (Desert Sun {GB}) and South African Group 1 winner **Perfect Promise (SAf)** (Caesour). Written Bloodstock, begun three years ago by Larry King and Mark Peters, ran in to financial strife in recent months. Peters was banned from any involvement in racing after Racing NSW stewards ruled he was a defaulter on bets of A\$330,000 with registered bookmaker Harry Barrett. Written Bloodstock hit the headlines in August when Peters advised the group's major trainers, Grahame Begg in Sydney and Robert Smerdon in Melbourne, that all its horses would be removed immediately from their stables. Both trainers declared no horses would be removed until outstanding training invoices were paid, and it then emerged that Written Bloodstock had a substantial list of local and international debtors. The dispersal will continue with a draft at the Inglis Thoroughbred Sale at Oaklands in Melbourne Dec. 3; star offerings such as Our Egyptian Raine are slated to sell at the Easter Broodmare Sale. Inglis managing director Reg Inglis said next Friday's sale had attracted international interest with mares such as **Sheer Brilliance** (A.P. Indy), **Alluring Song** (El Prado {Ire}) as well as the three-year-old Storm Cat filly **Tranquil Storm**. The Christmas Sale catalogue also boasts eight mares with foals at foot by champion first-crop sire and leading second-crop sire More Than Ready, whose 17 stakes winners to date include G1 Victoria Derby winner Benicio (Aus).

**CROWN JESTER DIES** Crown Jester (Aus) (Baguette {Aus}--Anjudy {Aus}, by Wilkes {Fr}), the sire of outstanding stallion and G1 Golden Slipper winner Rory's Jester (Aus) and fellow Slipper hero Guineas (Aus), was euthanized last Monday as a result of problems from arthritis and old age. The 26-year-old had been pensioned at Raheen Stud in Queensland. A champion juvenile himself, he went on to become the top sire of two-year-olds in 1984-85 and continued to produce precocious youngsters. Rory's Jester followed in those footsteps with representatives such as Isca (Aus) and Racer's Edge (Aus). Guineas was bred by the Ingham family, who raced Crown Jester, and went on to win the 1997 Slipper. Crown Jester was retired from stud duties after the 2003 breeding season.
