FULL FIELD READY FOR DASH

The year's penultimate Grade I race will be the feature on today's Laurel card, with 14 sprinters lining up for the GI Frank J. DeFrancis Memorial Dash. Favored on the morning line is **Tiger Heart** (Scatmandu), who will be hoping to cap a memorable season for trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. The progressive four-year-old ran second in the GI Vosburgh S. Oct. 1 at Belmont, with Taste of Paradise winning and Lion Tamer third. He stayed in the barn when stablemate Silver Train upset the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, leading home the aforementioned Vosburgh duo. **Elusive Jazz** (Elusive Quality) earned a 110 Beyer Speed Figure in winning the GIII Phoenix Breeders' Cup Sprint at Keeneland Oct. 8. He had a rough trip in the BC Sprint en route to a fifth-place finish.

ROCK HARD RETIRED

Multiple Grade I winner **Rock Hard Ten** (Kris S.--Tersa, by Mr. Prospector), scratched on the eve of the Breeders' Cup with a bruised foot, has been retired due to worn cartilage in his left front sesamoid, according to *Thoroughbred Times*. The colt had been perfect in three outings this season; stud plans have not yet been determined. "After his undefeated four-year-old campaign we are saddened by this decision, but felt it was in 'The

Rock's' best interest to retire him at this point," trainer Richard Mandella told the publication. "Given the tremendous interest in him as a stallion prospect we hope his career at stud will be as great as his racing one was." Rock Hard Ten burst on the scene in the winter of 2004 with a pair of wins at Santa Anita for trainer Jason Orman. He missed by head in the GI Santa Anita Derby, but was disqualified to third. That demotion left him without the requisite graded earnings to contest the GI Kentucky Derby. The towering colt came back to run second in the GI Preakness S. and later added the GII Swaps Breeders' Cup S. in July. He faltered as the favorite in the GI Haskell Invitational H. at Monmouth in August, however, and was sidelined with a fever following that sixth-place finish. In his first start for Mandella, the ebony colt unleashed a furious rally to take the GI Malibu S. at Santa Anita Dec. 26. He added a game score in the GII Strub S. Feb. 5 at the Arcadia track, but finally came into his own with a masterful performance in the GI Santa Anita H. Mar. 5 ([Video](#)). Sidelined again, Rock Hard Ten returned with a facile victory in the GII Goodwood BC H. Oct. 1 at Santa Anita and looked set to be the one to beat in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic. However, he developed a bruise in his left front foot, and though he was shipped to New York Oct. 26, problems surfaced in his right front foot. After a nuclear scan earlier this week showed problems in his ankle, Rock Hard Ten was scheduled for an arthroscopic procedure, which apparently revealed the extent of the problem. Produced by a half sister to GI Kentucky Derby hero Gato del Sol, he retires with a record of 11-7-1-1 and \$1,870,380 in earnings.

TWO WEANLINGS TOP KEENOV FINALE A pair of weanling colts, one by Black Minnaloushe and one by Golden Missile, each brought bids of \$55,000 to share top honors on the final day of the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale. Hip [4245](#), from the consignment of Four Star Sales, was sired by Black Minnaloushe from the Personal Flag mare Pretty Personal. Grand Oaks Stable signed the ticket for the bay colt. Hill 'n' Dale Bloodstock purchased the other top-priced youngster, hip [4442](#), from the Denali Stud draft. The Canadian-bred chestnut is by Golden Missile out of the swift Forever Partners (Not for Love). The weanlings were two of the 2,816 head sold during the 12-day auction, which grossed \$289,602,900. It was the third-highest gross in the sale's history, but records were established for total average and median of \$102,842 and \$35,000, respectively. The sale also saw a new world record established for broodmare/racing prospect when champion **Ashado** (Saint Ballado) sold for \$9 million at the opening session. "We had a consistent and strong market during every day of the sale," commented Geoffrey Russell, Keeneland's director of sales. "Last year we had the Jess Jackson factor and the year before that there was a strong group of horses for The Thoroughbred Corporation. This year, with the exception of Ashado, who was the star like we thought she would be, it was what I would call a 'typical' breeding stock sale."

Market Wheel Continues... Geoffrey Russell was pleased with the depth of the bloodstock market. "The top, middle and lower ends of the market were all strong," he said. "We've seen again that there is a premium on quality and a major update can have a massive effect on the sale." The auction company received a big boost when **Heat Lightning** (Summer Squall) sold for \$1.1 million last Thursday. Her value skyrocketed when her two-year-old colt Stevie Wonderboy (Stephen Got Even) won the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile and a likely Eclipse Award. "Certainly, Stevie Wonderboy had a huge impact on the sale," Russell added. The success of this sale came on the heels of a record Keeneland September Yearling Sale. "It was very good to see people reinvest in the market and to see people who made money in September coming back," Russell continued. "Breeders were reinvesting in new bloodlines, buying from each other and going on. We have sold horses to 47 of the 50 states and to [representatives of] 38 individual countries, including several in South America, Korea and India. That epitomizes this as the global marketplace, Central Kentucky in general and Keeneland specifically."

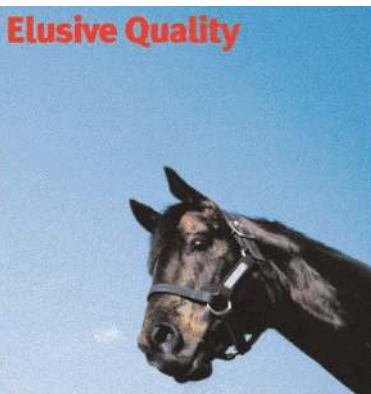
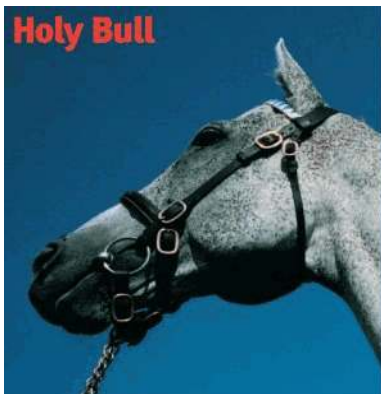

Thoro-Graph Race of the Week

1 Old Thunder	Fusaichi Pegasus	Solis

Old Thunder has moved forward in moderate increments with each start and last time out ran a stakes-level figure when breaking his maiden. It is very difficult to tell at what point a horse that has never gone back (bounced) will do so, or what his limitations are, but there is nothing wrong with either his figures or pattern, and he's had four weeks to recover from that big one--strong contender.

2 Bengal Lore	Tale of the Cat	Gomez
---------------	---------------------------------	-------

Bengal Lore ran on the same day as Old Thunder, and at first glance, his race looks much better--it's a close second in a stakes and earned a much bigger Beyer. But one of the differences between Thoro-Graph and Beyer is that we adjust for ground loss--and once we took into account the relative trips (3w vs. 1w), the two colts earned the same figure (7 3/4). The patterns of the two horses are entirely different, however. Bengal Lore ran a big one first out and bounced badly, taking three starts to return to that level before bouncing again at a short price at Fairplex. Last time out he finally broke through with a big new top, but given his history of bounces from lesser efforts, he's tough to like as one of the favorites. Co-fastest going in, but an underlay.

3 Your Tent Or Mine	Forest Camp	Valenzuela
---------------------	-----------------------------	------------

Your Tent Or Mine won first time out at a short price, and in general his young sire has put up quite a record with first-time starters. But the figure did not come up that fast, and he would need dramatic improvement to have any say in this affair. Trainer Neil Drysdale is known for distance grass horses, but the pedigree here is anything but that. We'll see how this works out.

4 The Five J's	Lost Soldier	Nakatani

The Five J's came out with some moderate figures and an erratic pattern, and then was claimed by Steve Knapp. After a couple of months off he improved enough to break his maiden for a tag, then came back on nine days rest with a much improved effort going long that was concealed because he raced wide on both turns (3w 3w).

He comes back now making his third start in 24 days, off a big jump, so a bounce is likely, but if he can pair that last, he could get a check at a very big price. For the long run, there are a couple of interesting things to look at with this gelding. First, several siblings got a lot better with age, and two ran serious figures at age four. Second, the TGI--the Thoro-Graph Index, average of the best figures of a horse's progeny by category--for sire Lost Soldier. He is one of the big turf move-ups--his runners average about four points better on grass.

5 Da Stoops	Distorted Humor	Espinoza
-------------	---------------------------------	----------

Da Stoops gradually moved forward, before leveling off at decent figures in his last three. If he were on his way to being a top horse, that last probably would have been better, and on only 15 days rest he probably won't make a big forward move. But he's very solid at a level that's competitive here, and a new top of a couple of points is very possible.

6 The Pharaoh	Forest Camp	Court

The Pharaoh will take money off his second to the champ pro-tem in the Del Mar Futurity, but don't confuse that Stevie Wonderboy with the one that showed up in the Breeders' Cup. This colt was another first-out winner for Forest Camp, but he hasn't improved a step since then, and while the cut back to a sprint may help, he has several lengths to make up here. He's just not that fast.

Overview – There are good reasons to go against both Bengal Lore and The Pharaoh, which makes this race very bettable. Old Thunder and Da Stoops are the primary contenders, and The Five J's could be used in exotics at the price.

Jerry Brown formed Thoro-Graph in 1982 to service the needs of horsemen and professional handicappers. Additionally, the last three NTRA national handicapping championship winners used Thoro-Graph data. Thoro-Graph performance figures take into account weight, ground loss, effect of wind on the time of the race, and track speed. The lower the figure, the better the performance. **POLICE INVESTIGATING CHECKS WRITTEN
BY FORMER GUILD PRESIDENT**

The Jockeys' Guild has issued a statement that former Guild president Wayne Gertmenian issued checks totaling \$217,000 to himself, his Matrix Capital Associates, and former Guild vice president Albert Fiss. The checks were allegedly issued and processed at a Monrovia, CA, Bank of America the same day Guild members voted to terminate their relationship with Gertmenian and Matrix, Nov. 15. "It is the view of the Guild that the funds were stolen and that a crime occurred," said Shane Gusman, an associate from the office of Barry Broad, who was appointed temporary Guild counsel on a volunteer basis after the management change. "Obviously, now it is up to law enforcement to make that decision." Lt. Richard Wagnon of the Monrovia Police Department confirmed an investigation is underway after police were called by representatives of the Guild. "It may be embezzlement or it may be something they were entitled to," he said. The Los Angeles District Attorney will determine at the conclusion of the investigation if enough evidence is present to file criminal charges and issue arrest warrants.

DIAMOND OMI DEAD GSW Diamond Omi (Giant's Causeway), who contracted a respiratory infection that developed into pneumonia after finishing 10th in the Oct. 29 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, was euthanized Thursday at Chino Valley Equine Clinic. "She fought so hard," trainer Bob Baffert told *The Blood-Horse*.

"We thought she was going to pull through, but her body just gave up." Purchased by Donald and Irene Disney for \$190,000 at the 2004 Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Sale, the two-year-old filly broke her maiden when stretched out to a mile for her third career start and came back to take the GI Oak Leaf S. at Santa Anita by 3/4 of a length over Juvenile Fillies runner-up Wild Fit. She was diagnosed with a virus after her lackluster effort on Breeders' Cup Day, and did not respond to medical treatment. "She had a walled off abscess in her lung that was close to her heart," Baffert continued. "[The veterinarians] couldn't get to that thing. She was trying to get well, but she couldn't. When young horses like her get stressed from shipping and racing, that's when things like this come along." He added, "I feel awful for the Disneys. They've been really good to me and they're good friends; we've had some great luck together and I couldn't feel worse for them right now. They put in so much into the game to get a nice horse like her. It's devastating to lose her." Diamond Omi had two wins and a third from five career starts and earned \$160,740.

The slight favorite to make it two straight, he recovered to stalk the pace after bobbling at the start. The Phipps homebred fought his way past Infinite Glory in the stretch to post a narrow victory.

Stellar Jayne Headed to Top Flight:

Three-time Grade I winner **Stellar Jayne** (Wild Rush) will make her next start in the Nov. 25 GII Top Flight H. at Aqueduct. The four-year-old filly, who captured the GI Mother Goose S. and GI Gazelle H. last season and added a 1 1/2-length victory in the GI Ruffian H. this September, finished a distant fourth in the Oct. 29 GI Breeders' Cup Distaff. Owned by Godolphin and trained by Saeed bin Suroor, she has eight wins from her 21 career starts for earnings of \$1,444,964.

O'Byrne also stepped in to secure the session's top-priced member of the fairer sex when paying €265,000 for hip **1056**, a Sadler's Wells filly from Ballylinch Stud. Out of a sister to Ebaziya (Ire), she stems from the esteemed Aga Khan family of Enzeli (Ire), Ebadiyla (Ire) and Edabiya (Ire).
