TATTERSALLS DECEMBER GETS UNDERWAY

Today marks the first of 10 days of trading at Tattersalls, with bidding on the 267-lot December Yearling catalogue beginning at 10 a.m. in Newmarket.

Many of the Tattersalls yearlings have been offered at auctions earlier this autumn, but either missed their previous date through injury or failed to change hands. Highlights of the sale include two representatives of the great Sadler's Wells. [Lot 217](#), the first foal of Group 3 winner Love Everlasting (GB) (Pursuit of Love {GB}), was withdrawn from the Tattersalls October Part 1 sale. The colt was bred by Gary

and Lesley Middlebrook and is consigned from Airlie Stud. The other Sadler's Wells is [Lot 214](#), a May 25-born half-brother to G1 2000 Guineas second Tamburlaine (Ire) (Royal Academy), bred by Paget Bloodstock and Ocean Bloodstock and offered through agent John Troy. Other notable lots in what appears a strong catalogue are [Lot 142](#), a Point Given half-brother to dual Group 1 winner Fiji (GB) (Rainbow Quest), presented by Voute Sales; and [Lot 128](#), an Usk Valley Stud-bred Fantastic Light colt out of Croeso Cariad (GB) (Most Welcome {GB}), who was another October Sale absentee. Among the pinhooked yearlings are [Lot 175](#), a colt by Johannesburg out of Rozel (Ire) (Wolfhound), who was bought for 115,000gns by Gay O'Callaghan at Tattersalls in February; and [Lot 28](#), a colt by Tiger Hill (Ire) named Dawnhill (Ger) who was picked up by vendor Emma O'Gorman for €49,000 at Baden Baden in September. "It's a good strong catalogue and we would expect to see the strength of the earlier yearling sales to carry on through to the December Yearlings," said Tattersalls' Marketing Director Jimmy George. Miraculous Miss Takes Valley Stream (cont. from p1)

Miraculous Miss (Mr. Greeley) began her career with a narrow victory in a 4 1/2-furlong maiden at Delaware Park Sept. 19. She returned to earn a one-length victory sprinting 5 1/2 furlongs at that track Oct. 17. "She's a little bit deceiving because she does what she has to do get by," trainer and co-owner Steve Klesaris said after watching his filly win yesterday's GIII Valley Stream S. How confident was he that Miraculous Miss would win her stakes debut? "She had a lot of ground to make up, but she's got a tremendous late kick," Klesaris said. "I think this was her best race so far." Miraculous Miss will get the rest of the year off. "We're going to take her down south and figure out a plan for next year," Klesaris commented. Winning rider Ramon Dominguez is already looking forward to 2006. "I think she will be very exciting if she keeps improving," Dominguez said.

Favored India Tires to Third

India (Hennessy), purchased for \$2 million after her 12-length maiden win at Saratoga in July, had been sidelined since running a well-beaten seventh as the favorite in the Sept. 17 GI Matron S. Sent off the 4-5 Valley Stream favorite, the chestnut was pressed by **Princess Sweet** (Precise End) through fractions of :21 3/5 and :44 4/5 and tired late to be third.

America Alive, who won the GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic over this course and trip in May, returned from a two-month freshening and was all out to win an Oct. 26 Keeneland allowance over a yielding course last time out. Returning to the stakes ranks, the bay colt tracked the pacesetters while racing four wide. He angled out six wide for the drive and was fully extended to overtake defending champ G P Fleet in the final jumps. "Down the backside I knew it was a slow pace, so I knew it was just a matter of getting a good trip," commented winning rider Robby Albarado. "I was in the pocket the whole way and I only had a few horses in front of me. So I always had my sights on where to go with him. When I did turn it on--bang--he just turned it on like always." 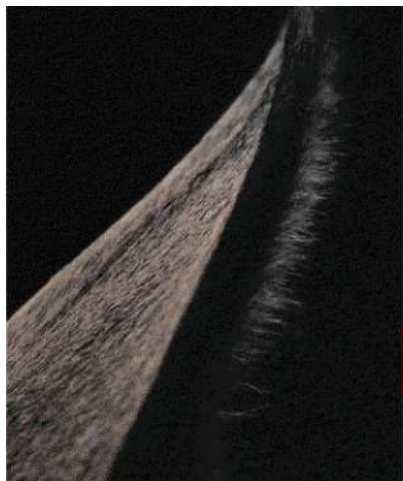

Record Pix Six Pool Falls at Churchill:

A Pick Six pool at Churchill Downs that reached a record \$5,698,493 ended its 10-day run on Saturday when 125 winning tickets were purchased at the track and at simulcast outlets. The pool was hit after heavily favored Arch Assault won the day's 10th race. Winning payout on a minimum \$2 wager was \$38,865.20. Ten of the winning tickets were purchased at Churchill. A record carryover of \$1,694,336 accumulated over nine days and grew Saturday when fans poured \$4,004,157 into the pool. The previous record pool was the \$2,891,518 accumulated during a three-day run in 2004.

Clark Hopefuls Work:

Perfect Drift (Dynaformer), coming off a third-place effort in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, worked five furlongs Saturday at Churchill Downs. Preparing for Friday's GII Clark H., the veteran gelding covered the distance in 1:02.40 over a fast track with jockey Joe Deegan in the irons. "The work went fine," said trainer Murray Johnson, who said the drill was planned for a half-mile. "The track was a little deep, but he handled it fine. He's an old pro and it was just a little work for him, so everything went very well." "She is a good-looking Diesis mare and is in foal to Captain Rio (GB), whose foals sold very well here this week," Reilly commented. "She has been bought to stay in Ireland." There were more offerings from His Highness the Aga Khan's Studs, including hip [1573](#), **Dablana (Ire)** (Dr Fong). From the family of Saturday's million-euro mare Dalara (Ire), the three-year-old was knocked down to European Bloodstock for €64,000.
