CITY SHOWDOWN

Today's GII Falls City H. at Churchill Downs will be the final career start for morning-line favorite **Pampered Princess** (Indian Charlie), winner of the GI Spinster S. at Keeneland Oct. 9 last out. But the 123-pound highweight does her best running on the front end, and she'll have to contend with the lightly raced **Indian Vale** (A.P. Indy) here. The three-year-old glided to an impressive 9 1/2-length win against her elders in the GIII Turnback the Alarm H. at Aqueduct Nov. 5 and will be

a tough opponent. With an abundance of speed present, the Falls City just might be a perfect setup for a horse who can come from off the pace, such as **Miss Fortunate** (Deputy Minister) or **Bending Strings** (American Chance). The latter comes off a sharp win in the GII Chilukki H. going a mile over this surface Nov. 6. "She is a much more

relaxed filly lately," explained trainer Wally Dollase. "She's not in a hurry, and that's the whole secret of going a mile and an eighth."

PLEASANT HOME RETIRED

GI Breeders' Cup Distaff winner **Pleasant Home** (Seeking the Gold--Our Country Place, by Pleasant Colony) has been retired from racing and will be bred to Breeders' Cup Classic winner **Awesome Again** next year, according to *The Blood-Horse*. The Ogden Phipps homebred was sent to Claiborne Farm near Paris, Kentucky at the beginning of November. A consistent performer before her Distaff romp, Pleasant Home won this season's GIII Bed o' Roses Breeders' Cup H. and was second in the GI Juddmonte Spinster S. and the GI Ballerina S. But the four-year-old filly took her career to the next level in the Breeders' Cup. Dismissed at 30-1, Pleasant Home roared home by a resounding 9 1/4 lengths. On the board in 10 of 12 starts, she retires with five wins and earnings of \$1,378,070. She is a full sister to multiple graded stakes winner **Country Hideaway**. Pleasant Home's second dam, GI Alabama S. heroine **Maplejinsky** (Nijinsky), is the dam of champion **Sky Beauty** (Blushing Groom {Fr}). **Awesome Again** capped a perfect 1998 season with his victory in the Breeders' Cup Classic. Standing at Adena Springs Kentucky, the 11-year-old stallion is the sire of last year's Horse of the Year **Ghostzapper**.

HIGH FLY RETIRED Grade I winner **High Fly** (Atticus--Verbasle, by Slewpy), who was scratched on the eve of the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint with a medial condylar fracture of his right front fetlock, has been retired because of that injury. Stud plans for the three-year-old colt have not been finalized. A homebred of Charlotte Weber's Live Oak Stud, High Fly established himself as one of the best of his generation earlier in the year with a stellar Florida campaign. The chestnut, who began his career with trainer Bill White,

won the Aventura S. and finished third in the GIII Holy Bull S., then stepped up his game and won the GII Fountain of Youth S. and GI Florida Derby after being moved to Nick Zito's barn. One of the favorites for the GI Kentucky Derby at 7-1, he loomed a threat leaving the turn before flattening out down the lane, finishing 10th, and went unplaced in the GI Preakness S. two weeks later. Given the summer off, High Fly returned to be a good second to eventual Sprint winner Silver Train in the Sept. 11 GII Jerome H., his final start. High Fly worked a half mile from the gate in :48.06 in the mud at Belmont a week before the Breeders' Cup, but a subsequent examination revealed the injury. "It's a very tough injury to come back from," explained Live Oak's farm manager John Rasmussen. "The likelihood he could come back and race at the same high level wasn't good, and we felt it was best to go out on a high note." High Fly is out of GISP Verbasle, who was euthanized in August after a bout with laminitis, and is a half to MGSW Estimraar (Holy Bull) and SW Smokey Mirage (Holy Bull). High Fly concludes his career with a record of 9-5-1-1 and \$927,300 in earnings.

STEVENS SET TO RETIRE AGAIN Hall of Fame jockey Gary Stevens is expected to announce his retirement from the saddle during a press conference Friday at Churchill Downs, according to *Daily Racing Form*. The 42-year-old will most likely make his final trip to the post aboard Stream Cat in the GIII Kentucky Jockey Club S. at Churchill on Saturday. This will be Stevens's second retirement. He unexpectedly retired in 1999 when bothered by chronic knee problems. During that 10-month retirement, Stevens worked as an assistant trainer and as a jockey's agent. Named to the Hall of Fame in 1997, the Idaho native won the GI Kentucky Derby three times; in 1988 with Winning Colors, in 1995 aboard Thunder Gulch and in 1997 on Silver Charm. He has also ridden the winners of two GI Preakness S., three GI Belmont S. and eight Breeders' Cup races. He captured the 1998 G1 Dubai

World Cup aboard Silver Charm. He has ridden the winners of 5,005 races worldwide and the earners of more than \$221 million in North America. Stevens earned the Eclipse Award as the country's leading rider in 1998.

SIPHON RELOCATED TO REGAL HEIR Siphon (Brz) (Itajara {Brz}--Ebreia {Brz}, by Kublai Khan {Arg}), sire of Saturday's GI Frank Frank J. De Francis Memorial Dash S. winner I'm the Tiger, has been relocated to Regal Heir Farms in Pennsylvania. His 2006 fee has been set at \$6,500 for out-of-state mares and \$5,000 for in-state mares. The 14-year-old previously resided at Airdrie Stud in Kentucky, where he stood the last season for \$10,000. "We're very excited about him, especially with the slots providing us with such a big boost," said Regal Heir's Dennis Madonna, who said that Siphon is still owned by the syndicate that stood him at Airdrie. A two-time Grade I winner of over \$2 million on the track, Siphon is represented by at least five stakes winners in five crops, including GISW Siphonic and graded winners Siphonizer and Sharp Impact. His progeny have earned nearly \$8 million to date.

LEVY BOARD SHAKE UP BREEDERS' PRIZES

Britain's Breeders' Prize system received a major boost this week when the Levy Board announced an investment of £1.8 million in the revamped scheme in 2006. The Thoroughbred Breeders' Association recommended that the prizes increase for longer-distance races and for fillies and mares. In an attempt to maintain the diversity of the British racing calendar, payments to fillies and mares in open competition will be worth 50 percent more than those awarded to colts and geldings, while races run over an excess of 11 furlongs will see greater sums handed out by the initiative, which also includes a BHB-funded owners' premium scheme of £1.2 million. "The new scheme will benefit from being better targeted and more focused," explained the Levy Board's Chief Executive Tristram Ricketts. "The combined allocation to the Breeders' Prizes and Owners' Premium Schemes of £3-million next year is excellent news for racing and breeding."

Former jockey and trainer Bruce Hobbs has died at the age of 84. The youngest rider to win the Grand National also handled the Irish Derby winner Tyrnavos (GB) as well as champion juveniles Jacinth (GB), Tromos (GB) and Cry of Truth (GB) during a 21-year training career. Upon his retirement in 1985, Hobbs was elected a member of the Jockey Club and sat on the disciplinary committee. He had recently had a leg amputated after a failed bypass operation. "To me he was not only an exceptional horseman and horse master, he was one of the nicest men who ever sat astride a horse," Sir Peter O'Sullivan told the *Racing Post* yesterday.

WITNESS, WESTERNER HEAD HKIR INVITEES

A total of 54 horses, representing 10 racing jurisdictions from around the world, have been extended invitations to the Cathay Pacific International Races, scheduled for Sunday, Dec. 11 at Sha Tin Racecourse. The list is headed by Hong Kong's own **Silent Witness (Aus)** (El Moxie), whose quest for a third consecutive victory in the G1 Hong Kong Sprint is in limbo due to illness. But trainer Tony Cruz is increasingly optimistic of making the 1000-meter event after being forced to miss a key prep in last weekend's International Sprint Trial. "The horse has definitely improved, to my eye, over the last couple of days and a lot of the colour and gloss has started to come back in his coat," the conditioner told *South China Morning Post*. He added that Silent Witness will have a barrier trial this coming Tuesday, after which a decision on his HKIR status will be finalized. "My personal feeling, at this moment, is that we're going to make it. I really do feel that," Cruz told the publication.

Westerner (GB) (Danehill) looms the one to beat in the 2400-meter G1 Hong Kong Vase. Best known as one of Europe's top stayers, this year's G1 Ascot Gold Cup hero has proved nearly as classy at middle distances and was most recently second to Hurricane Run (Ire) in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Oct. 2. **Ouija Board (GB)** (Cape Cross {Ire}), who goes in Sunday's G1 Japan Cup, is also invited, but her participation hinges on her performance on the weekend. European runners have reigned supreme in the Vase, with five victories in the last six years. The G1 Hong Kong Cup over 2000 meters has attracted a talented field, including defending champion **Alexander Goldrun (Ire)** (Gold Away {Ire}), G1 Audemars Piguet QE II Cup hero **Vengeance of Rain (NZ)** (Zabeel {NZ}), the globetrotting **Rakti (GB)** (Polish Precedent) and **Epalo (Ger)** (Lando {Ger}), the reigning World Racing Champion. **Asakusa Den'en (Jpn)** (Singpiel {Ire}) heads a highly competitive field assembled for the G1 Hong Kong Mile. The top-rated miler in Japan, he is best known for defeating Silent Witness in the G1 Yasuda Kinen in June. He is joined by his compatriot **Hat Trick (Jpn)** (Sunday Silence), winner of last weekend's G1 Mile Championship at Kyoto; and **Bullish Luck** (Royal Academy), who missed by a short head in last year's Cup. Four horses represent the U.S.--**Whilly (Ire)** (Sri Pekan) and **Willow O Wisp** (Misnomer) in the Cup; **Designed for Luck** (Rahy) in the Mile; and the mare **Nicole's Dream** (Northern Trend) in the Sprint.



MANNINGTON TO BE BRED ON NH TIME

Mannington (Aus) (Danehill--Bint Marscay {Aus}, by Marscay {Aus}), purchased from Vinery by Darley for a record A\$2.05 million at the Inglis Easter Broodmare Sale, will leave Australian shores in mid-December to be covered by Elusive Quality to Northern Hemisphere time. Mannington foaled a Red Ransom filly Sept. 3, and she also has a Fusaichi Pegasus two-year-old filly. Her colt Benicio (Aus) (More Than Ready), a \$525,000 Easter graduate, won the G1 Victoria Derby after Darley purchased Mannington. "It is always nice when it works works out like that; when we bought her we knew she was a lovely mare, but we weren't banking on Benicio winning the Derby," said Darley Australia general manager Olly Tait. "It was lovely when it happened."

DANBIRD TO SHUTTLE Group 2 winner **Danbird (Aus)** (Danehill) will shuttle from Eliza Park Stud in Victoria to Beechwood Grange in Yorkshire in 2006. "We were looking for a son of Danehill and are delighted to have secured Danbird," declared stud principal Steve Knowles. "He has the looks, the pedigree and the performance, and is the complete package. With Danbird's race record and pedigree I have no doubt he will be extremely well received here in Yorkshire." Danbird covered 120 mares in his first Southern Hemisphere season.



FARMS TO COMBINE FORCES Hunter Valley stud farms Byerley, Ashleigh Thoroughbreds and Riversdale Stud will combine to sell yearlings under the banner of Southern Cross Breeders. Byerley Stud's Martin Hawcroft said, "It's a logical progression. In this modern era of super-sized studs, many smaller studs have to increase their broodmare numbers in order to stay competitive. The problem arises that we could end up with more mares of inferior quality with little competition for their yearlings, and we would all rather aim for something much higher than that." He continued, "We are also finding that service fees are becoming more expensive, and predicting what will be commercially viable in three years is a real issue for smaller breeders.
