THANKSGIVING DAY PARADE

Eugene Melnyk's homebred **Indian Vale** (A.P. Indy) continued her progression with a dominating performance in yesterday's GII Falls City H. at Churchill. After crushing a pair of allowance fields at Saratoga, the chestnut had a hiccup in the Oct. 1 GII Cotillion H. at Philly Park, finishing fifth as the 2-5 chalk. But she wired older fillies in the GIII Turnback the Alarm H. at Aqueduct Nov. 5 and went off as the favorite here. Indian Vale bounded out of the gate and raced in second as **Flying Glitter**

(Glitterman) set the pace. The big filly ranged up on the far turn, and the race was over as she pulled away while kept busy by John Velazquez. Winning trainer Todd Pletcher just might be her biggest fan. "It's a shame that she kind of got a late start to the season, because I think she's probably one of the best--if not the best--three-year-old fillies around," he said.

DOZEN GATHER FOR CLARK

Many of racing's stars have either been put away for the winter or retired to the breeding shed, but there are still plenty of talented runners to fill a \$500,000 race.



Perfect Drift Sherackatthetrack

That's evident in this afternoon's GII Clark H. at Churchill, where an accomplished dozen have gathered for one of the last big events of the year. The multi-millionaire **Perfect Drift** (Dynaformer) heads the cast, coming off a third in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, but several others should have a say in the outcome.

The tactical speed of **Alumni Hall** (A.P. Indy), unbeaten in a pair of Churchill starts and one of three in the race for his sire, is a big plus considering what will likely be a modest pace. Candidacy for front-running duties falls to **Suave** (A.P. Indy), who attended the pace in the Classic before tiring to be a very good fifth, beaten only three lengths. Winner of the GII Saratoga Breeders' Cup H. in August, the four-year-old also ran second in the Oct. 1 GI Jockey Club Gold Cup and is a horse on the improve. "No doubt it's going to be a tough race, but I see my horse as the horse to beat," said trainer Paul McGee. "If he goes out there and runs like I think he will, he'll be tough to beat." Four sophomores line up, including the underrated **Magna Graduate** (Honor Grades). He comes off wins in the GIII Pegasus S. and GIII Discovery H. and tackles older horses for the first time here.
