"The price was just about what he expected and I don't think he had a lot more to

### Genre Unlikely for Futurity:

**Genre (GB)** (Orpen), put up to the victory in last Saturday's Real Quiet S. for two-year-olds at Hollywood Park, is unlikely to go on to the GI Hollywood Futurity Dec. 17, trainer Ben Cecil told *Daily Racing Form*. "He's had a long hard go of it," the conditioner told the paper. "This race was a lot to ask." The bay was having the ninth start of his juvenile campaign after debuting in late June. From eight starts overseas, he won twice and was third in the Listed Zetland S. over the Newmarket turf Oct. 29. However, the demoted **Bob and John** (Seeking the Gold) will make his next start in the 8 1/2-furlong event. "It was a good prep," trainer Bob Baffert told *DRF*. "I know he's getting better and better. I was just hoping he'd put on a show." Bob and John is a son of GSW Minister's Melody (Deputy Minister) owned and bred by Stonerside Farm.

### New Internet Gambling Bill Introduced:

Congressman Jim Leach (R-IA) has introduced The Unlawful Internet Gambling Enforcement Act (H.R. 4411), which prohibits the use of credit for the purposes of Internet gaming, but includes exclusions for horse racing, along with intrastate wagering and tribal gaming. The legislation excludes from the definition of "unlawful Internet gambling" "intrastate horseracing" which is defined as "[the] placing, receiving or otherwise transmitting [of] a bet or wager that is governed by and complies with the Interstate Horseracing Act of 1978."

**GODOLPHIN SWOOP FOR AGA QUARTET**

Godolphin added more high-profile names to a swath of recent acquisitions when announcing that they had purchased four horses from His Highness the Aga Khan. Heading the team is this year's G1 Irish Oaks and G1 Prix Vermeille winner **Shawanda (Ire)** (Sinndar {Ire}), last seen when sixth in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp. She will be joined by this year's G1 Prix d'Ispahan and G1 Queen Anne S. victor **Valixir (Ire)** (Tremolino), who bowed out this term when 10th in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile at Belmont. Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid al Maktoum's operation has also snapped up **Caradak (Ire)** (Desert Style {Ire}). Trained by John Oxx, the four-year-old colt was successful in the G3 Desmond S. and G3 Minstrel S. before finishing a head second in the G1 Prix de la Foret at Longchamp on his latest outing at Longchamp. That track was also the scene of the greatest hour of the sophomore filly **Oiseau Rare (Fr)** (King's Best), who annexed the G2 Prix de Royallieu before finishing fifth in the G1 Prix Royal Oak back there last time. "We are pleased to have added these horses to our team for 2006," Godolphin Racing Manager Simon Crisford explained. "Valixir and Caradak will probably be seen in action at Nad Al Sheba in the spring. Shawanda and Oiseau Rare will also stay in training and when they eventually retire, they will be great additions to Sheikh Mohammed's broodmare band."

He concluded his career with a victory in the Hong Kong Mile. On the board in 14 of 22 starts, the bay won nine times and earned \$2,710,749. He will stand for £3,500, Oct. 1 terms.



**SHAMDALA TO CONTEST VASE**

His Highness The Aga Khan's three-year-old filly **Shamdala (Ire)** (Grand Lodge) has been added to the field for the G1 Hong Kong Vase Dec. 11, it was announced yesterday. She will represent the first horse to carry the famed green and red colors of her owner in Hong Kong, although the Aga Khan's Daliapour (Ire), winner of the 2000 Vase, was purchased by local property tycoon Robert Ng Chee prior to that race and ran in the silks of the new owner. "We have always said that we are getting closer to our goal when our international meeting is on the agenda of the world's great owners and breeders and the Aga Khan is one of the great names in international top class racing," Winfried Engelbrecht-Bresges, executive director of racing for the Hong Kong Jockey Club told *South China Morning Post*. Shamdala has won four of her seven starts this year, including the G3 Prix de Lutece and the G2 Prix Chaudenay in France. She was most recently third to Alcazar (Ire) and fellow Vase contender **Reefscape (GB)** (Linamix {Fr}) in the 3100-meter G1 Prix Royal Oak Oct. 23.

**ALKAASED IN, THEN OUT OF VASE** After observing **Alkaased** (Kingmambo) in the days following his thrilling victory in the G1 Japan Cup last Sunday, trainer Luca Cumani first pronounced the five-year-old as an intended runner in the G1 Hong Kong Vase. But, in its Thursday edition, the *South China Morning Post* is reporting that he has been withdrawn from the race following the completion of a deal to stand stud in Japan next year. This newest development means that Alkaased must return immediately to England to do a pre-import quarantine before returning to Japan, where he will be quarantined again before launching his new career. **Ouija Board (GB)** (Cape Cross {Ire}), fifth in Sunday's race, and 13th-placed **Warrsan (Ire)** (Caerleon), are scheduled to compete, though there remains a small chance that **Ouija Board** could be re-routed to the G1 Hong Kong Cup over 2000 meters. There were five horses withdrawn from the races yesterday, including **Whilly (Ire)** (Sri Pekan) from the Cup and **Caradak (Ire)** (Desert Style {Ire}) from the Mile. The latter was purchased yesterday by Godolphin.
