CHARMING DOZEN

Twelve of the top turf distaffers still in training will line up for today's GIII My Charmer H. at Calder. The headliner is **Sand Springs** (Dynaformer), who has shown her best form this year at five. She has captured three graded stakes over the course of the season, capped by the GI Diana S. at Saratoga. A close fourth in the 10-furlong GI Flower Bowl Invitational S. Oct. 1, she backed up to finish 11th in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile Oct. 29, but won't meet the likes of those foes here. Looking to get back on track is **Ticker Tape (GB)** (Royal Applause {GB}), a multiple Grade I winner at three. Things haven't gone as smoothly for her in 2005, and the bay winds up here from her California base after the cancellation of the GI Matriarch S. "The fact there's no turf at Hollywood is pretty much the reason I'm coming," trainer Jim Cassidy told *Daily Racing Form*. A solid third to subsequent BC heroine Intercontinental (GB) in the GII Palomar H. at Del Mar Sept. 3, she reportedly tied up several days prior to running eighth to the same filly in the GII WinStar Galaxy S. at Keeneland last out Oct. 9.

FOUR NEW GRADE I RACES FOR 2006

Four stakes races elevated to Grade I status for 2006 after Thursday's annual meeting of the American Graded Stakes Committee of the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association. They are Calder's Princess Rooney H., the Clark H. at Churchill Downs, the Spinaway S. at Saratoga and Santa Anita's Oak Leaf S. Both of the latter races for two-year-old fillies were previously Grade I events; the Princess Rooney and the Clark have achieved that status for the first time. The Princess Rooney, part of Calder's annual Summit of Speed in July, will be the first Grade I event for the Miami, Florida track. No Grade I races were downgraded from 2005 for a total of 104 such races to be contested during the upcoming year. Seven races were upgraded to Grade II for 2006: the Jefferson Cup S. at Churchill Downs; the Virginia Derby at Colonial Downs; the Jim Murray Memorial H. at Hollywood Park; the Bed o' Roses Breeders' Cup H. at Aqueduct; Keeneland's Jenny Wiley S. and Vinery Madison S.; and the Ballston Spa Breeders' Cup H. at Saratoga. A pair of Grade II contests at Gulfstream Park, the Orchid H. and the Pan American H., both were downgraded to Grade III. The committee also announced that 12 races were upgraded to Grade III status for 2006: a trio of races at Santa Anita, the Sham S., Sir Beaufort S. and Santa Paula S.; the Fair Grounds Breeders' Cup H.; the Dallas Turf Cup H. at Lone Star; John B. Connally Breeders' Cup H. at Sam Houston; Hollywood's Ack Ack H.; the Kenny Noe Jr. H. and the Stage Door Betty H., both at Calder; the Bourbonette Breeders' Cup S. at Turfway; the Arlington Oaks; and Saratoga's Victory Ride S. A total of three races were downgraded from Grade III and will now be ungraded in 2006: the Flash S. at Belmont; the Lafayette S. at Keeneland, and the Desert Stormer H. at Hollywood Park. The Laurel Futurity, previously a Grade III event, but contested on the turf in 2005, was not eligible for grading in 2006. All told, 475 graded stakes races are scheduled to be contested in 2006.

Thoro-Graph Race of the Week

Ran decent figures at about the same level in his first three starts, then jumped forward big time to run second in a state-bred stakes. That effort looked even better than it was because he saved ground on the turn (1w), and he will need to run at least that well again today, stretching out, to be a factor here. If that jump had been part of a pattern of steady development we would like him more, but since it came from an established level, a bounce is more likely. Note the conflicting Thoro-Graph information regarding this one's chances of handling the distance. Neither the dam nor her previous three foals was even tried at a mile or more, which can't be a plus, and the trainer is right around 8 percent both first-time route and sprint-to-route, compared to 15 percent overall. On the other hand, first-crop sire Ecton Park has a TGI (Thoro-Graph Index, average top of his runners) that is almost 5 points better at routes than sprints.

Came out in May, and has a nice developmental pattern with a big effort in August (5 3/4) that set him back slightly in his last two. In his last he earned a figure as good as that of Big Lover, despite being well beaten, once we factored in the ground loss (3w). The timing is right now for a top effort, and this colt gets an inside draw this time, and almost 1 point worth of weight (5 pounds = 1 Thoro-Graph point) from every one but Big Lover. Note that Rehoboth is a full brother to GISW Silver Wagon, and that the TGI for Wagon Limit's runners shows they get much better with age and distance.

Ran poorly in two sprints before jumping forward to a decent figure (8) going long to break his maiden, then bouncing in a stakes. This colt will take money because of his connections, but he's not fast enough yet to compete here, and his pattern doesn't give any reason to believe a big new top is coming.

Had a nice pattern of gradual development, then leveled off to pair up at the 11 level in his last two. He is the slowest horse in the race going in, and there is no reason to expect a big jump.

5	Changing Weather	Storm Boot	Bravo

Ran well (6) to break his maiden first out when heavily bet at Saratoga, then bounced, but managed to get second in a weak GII Futurity S. In his last he had some trouble at the start, but once we factored in his ground loss he earned a decent figure, though not quite as good as in his debut. This is a tricky pattern to read, and the situation is exacerbated by this being his first try around two turns. Storm Boot's TGI indicates that his runners tend to be a good deal better sprinting.

6	Flanders Fields	A.P. Indy	Bailey

Has about as much pedigree as you could want, and has been bet accordingly in all three starts. He found lots of trouble in his debut, then ran a good one (6 3/4) to break his maiden, before bouncing and going down in flames as the favorite in the GIII Iroquois S. This one is borderline on previous ability going in, and has an additional question mark because he shows a work at Churchill less than a week ago. As it gets cooler, shipping north to south becomes more problematic.

7	Electrify	Delaware Township	Castro

Ran decent figures sprinting and routing in his first two, then jumped way forward last time with the addition of Lasix to a 4 1/2, good enough to win a stakes. He comes into this as the fastest horse, but he is returning on only three weeks rest after a big new top, and the first Lasix last time makes the situation tough to read. He does have enough early speed to offset his post, and if he runs his race he'll be tough.

Overview: With a field of lightly raced juveniles that haven't established their limits yet, it's tough to dismiss anyone's chances. But the value should be Rehoboth, who has a lot of things going for him, and is better than he looks to the public.

Jerry Brown formed Thoro-Graph in 1982 to service the needs of horsemen and professional handicappers. Since then, Thoro-Graph has been responsible for the purchase of Belmont winner and champion Victory Gallop, two-time Breeders' Cup Mile winner Da Hoss, multiple track record setter and leading sire Distorted Humor--a total of 70 horses who have gone on to win stakes for their clients. AZAMOUR HAS COLIC SURGERY His Highness the Aga Khan's **Azamour (Ire)** (Night Shift) is recovering from colic surgery after being admitted to Troytown Hospital Wednesday. This year's G1 Prince of Wales's S. and G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. winner, who had been retired to Gilltown Stud after his third-place finish in the Oct. 29 GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Belmont, was operated on by Michael Sadlier and Hugh Dillon. "He has made an excellent recovery from the surgery and anaesthetic and we are pleased with his progress at this stage," Sadlier commented. The four-year-old is expected to be recover in order to commence his breeding career at the start of the 2006 season.

NEW YORK LEGISLATOR WANTS NYRA FRANCHISE DECISION WITHIN SIX MONTHS

A powerful New York legislator says the Thoroughbred franchise for Aqueduct, Belmont and Saratoga racetracks should be awarded in the next six months in order to ensure the continued viability of racing in the state. "Let's do it sooner rather than later," said Senate Majority Leader Joseph Bruno. The New York Racing Association franchise expires at the end of 2007. While a state panel has partially formed to deal with the process of picking a new franchise holder, Bruno suggested some in the industry are trying to delay the matter. Bruno also issued a threat to NYRA not to put up any roadblocks to the request for proposals process that will choose a new franchise holder. "If they won't voluntarily understand that they need to go forward in a viable way to maintain the best racing in the country, if they don't willingly understand that we have to put an RFP together, then I think we have to try to pre-empt them," Bruno said. TIGER HEART RETIRED Tiger Heart (Scatmandu--No Small Miracle, by Silver Deputy), second in the GI Vosburgh S. and the GI Frank J. De Francis Memorial Dash S. in his final two career starts, has been retired from racing due to a torn tendon in a front leg, according to published reports. Bred in Kentucky by Audubon Farm, the chestnut sold for \$150,000 as a FTKJUL yearling. The Buckram Oak colorbearer retires with four wins from 13 starts and \$314,184 in earnings. Stud plans have yet to be announced for the four-year-old.
