“ALEXANDER” RUNS FOR REPEAT GOLD

In the 10-year history of the Hong Kong International Races, precious few have been able to post victories in consecutive years. Among the quartet able to accomplish the feat are two-time Sprint hero Silent Witness (Aus) and the popular globe-trotter Jim and Tonic, who took the Mile in '98 and the Cup in '99. Today, Mrs. Noel O'Callaghan's **Alexander Goldrun (Ire)** (Gold Away {Ire}) attempts to add her name to that short list in her

title defense in the G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Cup at Sha Tin. The winner this season of the G1 Pretty Polly S. and G1 Nassau S. against her peers, she missed by three-parts of a length when a troubled third to Oratorio (Ire) in the G1 Irish Champion S. Sept. 10. A disappointing third at odds-on in the G1 Prix de l'Opera on Arc day Oct. 10, she failed to land a blow when eighth in the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket 13 days later. Pointed for this spot all season long, she has looked well on the track and completed her preparation with a solid 400-meter move in :23.4 Thursday morning. "She did a super piece of work there," commented her jockey Kevin Manning. "She did it very easily and she was very well within herself when I pulled her up." **HK Cup, cont. p2**

DON'T CRY FOR ME ARGENTINA

A pair of Argentine imports will vie for the top spot in an event named for their compatriot, the GII Bayakoa H. at Hollywood Park this afternoon. **Halo Ola (Arg)** (Southern Halo), a Group 1 winner on the grass in her native country, bids for her first victory since heading to North America. The five-year-old has raced exclusively on the turf in her six U.S. starts, running third behind Megahertz (GB) in the Oct. 1 GI Yellow Ribbon Invitational H. and fourth in the Nov. 5 GII Las Palmas H. She was on the board in all four dirt tries south of the equator, including a third in a Group 2 event 14 months ago, but trainer Luis Seglin is concerned about the surface switch. "She has been training well on dirt here, but the question is, 'Will she get tired?'" said Seglin. "She doesn't get tired on turf. In Argentina, she got tired after seven furlongs on the main track." **Star Parade (Arg)** (Parade Marshal) won only once in seven outings in Argentina, but has annexed a pair of Grade I scores in three seasons in America. The six-year-old captured the Bayakoa in 2003 and was successful in the GI Santa Maria H. and GI Milady BC H. last year. Winless in eight trips to the post this term, she was second in the Oct. 2 GII Lady's Secret BC H. and third in the Las Palmas last time out. GISW **Dream of Summer** (Siberian Summer) pushed her earnings over the \$1-million mark with her win in the Nov. 6 Cal Cup Matron H. The gray is three-for-four at the Bayakoa trip and three-for-five at Hollywood. **Bayakoa field, p6**

Vengeance of Rain (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}), the likely favorite, represents the best chance for the locals. The bay strung together five wins in a row earlier this year, including a rare sweep of the Hong Kong Derby, G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup and Champions and Chater Cup. Trainer David Ferraris was pointing him for the G1 Cox Plate in October, but could not get a suitable prep and abandoned those plans. The champion stayer was not a factor in shorter events Oct. 2 and 16, but hinted at better things to come with a victory over **Green Treasure (Aus)** (Danehill) in the International Cup Trial Nov. 20. The connections of Vengeance of Rain were pleased to draw post four with the short run to the first turn, and their runner will also benefit from a strong pace. That is ensured by the presence of German raider **Epalo (Ger)** (Lando {Ger}), the 2004 World Series Racing champion, as well as America's **Willow O Wisp** (Misnomer), who set a track record of 1:45 4/5 in winning the GII Del Mar Derby in September. Gary Tanaka's **Touch of Land (Fr)** (Lando {Ger}) looks to improve on his third-place finish from a year ago, when he was 3/4 of a length behind Alexander Goldrun.

The second-highest rated horse (126) ever to be invited to the International Races, Europe's two-time defending champion stayer **Westerner** makes his final racecourse appearance this afternoon. The imposing bay won six consecutive starts from September of last year to this June, capped by a neck victory in the 2 1/2-mile G1 Ascot Gold Cup at the Royal meeting June 16. Dropped back to 2400 meters for the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden Sept. 9, he finished 2 1/2 lengths back in third to the repeating **Warrsan**, and was most recently a tremendous second to Hurrigan Run (Ire) in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Oct. 2. The distance might not be his best, however, and he could prove vulnerable as the chalk. Trainer Ed Dunlop admits that today's trip is not optimal for **Ouija Board**, who comes in off a solid fifth in the G1 Japan Cup two weeks back. "Her ideal trip is 2200 meters, but she's adaptable and has speed," the conditioner commented, adding that last year's Vase winner emerged from the Tokyo showpiece. "Phoenix Reach (Ire) finished in a similar position in the Japan Cup last year before coming on here to win the Vase, so that's a good omen."

Japanese horses scored an International Race treble in 2001, including a victory in the Mile by Eishin Preston. The Land of the Rising Sun has two realistic chances in this year's renewal, headed by the high-strung **Asakusa Den'en**. The English-bred is familiar to the locals as conqueror of Silent Witness (Aus) in the G1 Yasuda Kinen in June at Tokyo Racecourse. The chestnut has just one start since, a very good fourth in the 2000-meter Tenno Sho Autumn, a distance well

past his best. On the negative side, he must break from the far outside in this bulky field. "Racing from the outside is a bit better than being sandwiched in, I suppose, but it would have been better to be in the middle," admitted trainer Michifumi Kono. The other Japanese representative is G1 Mile Championship hero **Hat Trick**. Breaking from post 11, the four-year-old has won seven of his 12 starts, taking the Mile Championship by a nose in his latest Nov. 20. Drawn more favorably in his career finale is **Rakti**. Seventh in last year's Cup, the G1 Lockinge S. winner has been inconsistent this season. Trainer Michael Jarvis says the race could be won or lost at the start. "I hope Rakti will jump well from the stalls, race handily, and we'll take it from there," he commented. **Bullish Luck**, a game second in last year's Cup, shortens up to his best trip for this. The champion miler in Hong Kong handed Silent Witness his first setback in the Champions Mile in May, but the six-year-old is winless in three tries since, including a close runner-up effort to **Dave's Best** in the Mile Trial Nov. 20. "I'm very happy with Bullish Luck," trainer Tony Cruz said. "Everything has progressed well with him...he's just about at his peak."

The absence of Silent Witness (Aus) gives the veteran **Cape of Good Hope** an opportunity to take center stage. The chestnut, who makes his fourth appearance in this race, was second to the champ last year. He has showcased his talent overseas this season, with victories in the G1 Australia S. at Moonee Valley in February and the G1 Golden Jubilee S. at the Royal Meeting at York. Third in the G1 Salinger S. Oct. 29 and in the G2 The Age Classic Nov. 5 in Australia, he has every chance today, but trainer David Oughton is taking nothing for granted. "It's a winnable race, but it's winnable for any of a half dozen of these," he offered. "He's been a real warrior. He's not the greatest horse in the world, but he's very tough." **Chineur** had Cape of Good Hope back in third in the G2 King's Stand S. at York, but is winless in four tries since, including an odds-on fourth in the G3 Prix de Seine-Oise Nov. 11. Nonetheless, young trainer Michael Dezangles is cautiously optimistic. "I have a slight concern about the fact that he has been on the go since March," he said. "However I'm pretty hopeful that we'll see a solid show in what looks to me to be a very open race." **Nicole's Dream** is the winningest horse at the meet, with 20 victories to her credit. She runs fast times, gets a clear run from the outside draw and could factor in the outcome.

Philanthropist broke his maiden in his second start at Belmont in June of 2004 and came back to add a Saratoga allowance tally in his fourth outing that August. He was sent off the chalk in a NW2X event at the end of the meet, but finished a disappointing fifth and went to the shelf. The chestnut colt was in action again at the Big A in March, taking his next condition, but had to settle for second in three of his next four appearances before getting back to the winner's circle after a 6 1/2-length score in an optional claimer at Belmont Sept. 16. He made it two in a row going a mile at Aqueduct Nov. 18, but was the fourth choice in this five-horse field. Sent right to the front by jockey Eibar Coa, Philanthropist led the way into the stretch, then was caught by West Virginia from the outside and We Can Seek from the rail as they hit midstretch. He battled back gamely to retake the lead in the final yards.

Trotamondo ended his Chilean career with five consecutive victories. The chestnut took the G1 Chilean 2000 Guineas in September of 2004, added a score in the G1 Gran Criterium the following month and capped a Horse of the Year campaign with a half-length tally in the Dec. 18 G1 Chilean St Leger, completing the sweep of his country's Triple Crown. Making his U.S. bow after nearly 11 months on the sidelines, he closed from midpack to be second behind Preachinatthebar (Silver Charm) in an allowance test at Hollywood Nov. 9. Trotamondo was the crowd's choice to go one better here and did not disappoint. He settled well off the pace of 18-1 Spellbinder, trailing after a half and sitting in eighth after six panels, but closed ground on the turn and found running room down the lane to outfinish Bully Hayes for the score. DANEHILL COLT TOPS HKIS The immortal Danehill has always been a popular commodity in Hong Kong and that trend continued last night when a colt by the late Coolmore stallion topped the Hong Kong International Sale. Owner Lydaa Ng, an executive with toy manufacturer Multitoys, signed the winning ticket on hip 17, a New Zealand-bred son of the Caerleon mare Tamarino (Ire), and was pleased at the hammer price of HK\$3 million (\$386,847). "I think the price was fair," she commented. "There aren't many more Danehills around and I really liked his four white legs. They were very cute. I've had a lot of success with Danehills before and I hope this one can give me the same kind of glory." Ng campaigned Multidandy (Aus), a five-time winner of over \$600,000 in Hong Kong. She was also part of the syndicate which owned Trailthefox, a Grade II-winning juvenile in the U.S. in 2000. Multidandy, 11th in the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen, was conditioned by Tony Cruz, trainer of Silent Witness (Aus), and Ng was hopeful her new purchase would soon join that barn. Also active at the sale was Ronald Arculli, chairman of the HKJC, who purchased two horses for HK\$2.8 million.

Conducted amidst a carnival-like atmosphere in the Sha Tin parade ring, the International Sale saw a total of 27 horses sell for gross receipts of HK\$48 million (\$6,189,555). The average of HK\$1.77 million (\$229,243) was down by 21.5 percent from last year, but the outcome was affected by the late withdrawal of a Redoute's Choice (Aus) gelding which was widely expected to top the sale. HKJC Director of Racing Winfried Engelbrecht-Bresges described it as a "sensible sale after the excessive results of last year." He added, "It was a natural correction, but we have to remember that we are supplying a service for the owners. People were careful today after this year's racecourse performances from last year's sale and I think there was value for money to be had." Last year's sale featured a record HK\$6 million purchase, but that horse, Can Opener (NZ), has earned just over HK\$200,000 to date.

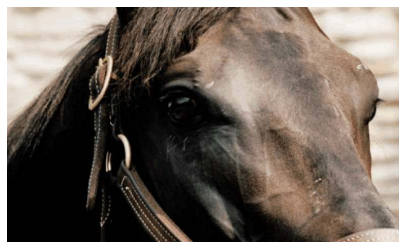

NYRA LAND SALE COULD GENERATE \$5 MIL

A deal is in the works to provide up to \$5 million to the cash-starved New York Racing Association by the sale of land near Aqueduct to the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey. The plan, which was approved by the Port Authority, still needs final approval from state regulators and NYRA, which has been scrambling to raise money to avoid bankruptcy. A new state NYRA oversight panel said in a statement Friday that the Port Authority gave the go-ahead to start negotiations with NYRA to purchase land near Aqueduct that is not used for racing. The Port Authority would use the land for unknown economic development purposes at nearby JFK International Airport. "An amount equal to the funds received by NYRA from the sale of this land, which would not exceed \$5 million, will be reinvested in capital assets of the racing franchise after NYRA's Aqueduct VLT facility becomes operational," the oversight board said in a written statement.
