By this time of the year, California-based juveniles have sorted themselves out, but with Breeders' Cup Juvenile hero Stevie Wonderboy staying in the barn, a case can be made for nearly every horse in today's GII Hollywood Futurity S. Patrick Valenzuela has ridden three of the legitimate chances and has decided to retain the mount on GIII Hollywood Prevue S. hero **Your Tent or Mine** (Forest Camp), who tries a route of ground for the first time. Rested in typical Neil Drysdale fashion off a

debut win at Del Mar Sept. 4, the attractive bay rolled home to win the Prevue by a widening 2 1/2 lengths, giving every indication that he wants more distance. **Brother Derek** (Benchmark) bested **A.P. Warrior** (A.P. Indy) by 3/4 of a length in the GII Norfolk S. at Santa Anita Oct. 2 prior to a respectable fourth in the Juvenile Oct. 29. "He's on tilt and ready to go," trainer Dan Hendricks commented. "[Jockey] Alex [Solis] said he is stronger and more mature than he was going into the Breeders' Cup." *Cont. p2*

REDDAM TO SPONSOR CASHCALL MILE

Prominent California owner John Paul Reddam, who has campaigned the likes of Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner Wilko and Travers S. hero Deputy Commander, has entered into a three-year agreement with Hollywood Park to sponsor the \$750,000 CashCall Mile as part of a two-day international package with the GII American Oaks, also worth three-quarters of a million dollars. Reddam is the founding president of CashCall, a consumer lender that makes unsecured loans. He was also responsible for the mortgage lending company

ditech.com. "I think it will be a good promotion for our company because it kind of fits naturally," Reddam said. "And with Hollywood Park stepping up--giving cash for people to bet the CashCall Mile that day--I'd like to see if we can put more people in the seats. Hopefully, it's contagious." Hollywood Park will give each paid admission a \$5 mutuel voucher on CashCall Mile Day. The agreement also calls for CashCall to advertise the race. The CashCall Mile replaces the Royal Heroine S. and carries its Grade III status.

REVVED UP THE MCDADDY

Revved Up (Sultry Song) can eclipse the \$1-million mark in earnings with a victory in this afternoon's GII W.L. McKnight H. at Tropical at Calder. The Live Oak homebred has had a terrific seven-year-old season, with five wins and two runner-up finishes from his seven trips to the post. Three-for-five at today's marathon trip, the gray gelding won the July 3 GIII Stars and Stripes Breeders' Cup H. and the Sept. 5 GII Niagara Breeders' Cup H. over 12 furlongs before dropping the 1 3/8-mile GII Sky Classic H. by a neck Oct. 2. He bounced back in his latest, defeating subsequent GIII Tropical Turf H. hero Silver Tree by 2 1/2 decisive lengths in the nine-furlong Bonnie Heath Turf Classic H. Nov. 12.

Trainer Bob Baffert has won this event three times (Real Quiet--1997, Captain Steve--1999 and Point Given--2000) and looks for the four-bagger with Stonerside Stables' **Bob and John** (Seeking the Gold). Runner-up to A.P. Warrior in a Santa Anita allowance Nov. 4, the dark bay looked well on his way to victory in the Nov. 26 Real Quiet S., but had his number taken down in a much-maligned disqualification. Tons the best that afternoon, the homebred came in slightly past midstretch and won by six clear lengths, but the stewards saw fit to disqualify. "You wanted him to do it in that kind of fashion," Baffert told *Daily Racing Form*. "He's still learning. You hope he keeps moving forward."

Film Maker, runner-up to Ouija Board (GB) in the 2004 GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf, kicked off this year with a victory in the GIII Gallorette H. at Pimlico May 21. The five-year-old hasn't had her picture taken since despite excellent efforts against the best in her division. She was third, beaten a length, in the GI Flower Bowl Invitational Oct. 1 before mirroring that effort in the Breeders' Cup at Belmont Oct. 29. In her first attempt at 12 furlongs, she reunites with jockey Edgar Prado, who was aboard for her victory in the GIII All Along Breeders' Cup H. at Colonial Downs last year. Film Maker will have to run down **Moscow Burning**, who returned from a seven-month hiatus to wire the field in the Cal Cup Distance H. at Santa Anita Nov. 6. Also in the field are **Spotlight**, who had the lead before settling for second in the GII Long Island H. at Aqueduct Nov. 5; and **Milwaukee**, a French mare making her U.S. bow following a third in the Listed Prix Belle de Nuit at Saint-Cloud Nov. 22.

I would like to make one comment on why our best Thoroughbreds are retired early with injuries. On the biggest days of racing, every racetrack gets the track surface as fast and hard as possible. Fast times and track records make great press and enhance a horse's value, but the cost is very high--the soundness of the horse.

From Peggy Augustus

I found Bill Finley's column very interesting and it reminded me of a conversation I had with Alex Harthill, who I consider the best vet ever. I asked him if he felt more horses broke down from being overtrained or undertrained and he emphatically answered, "under-trained."

FUNNY CIDE READIES FOR '06 Sackatoga Stables' **Funny Cide** (Distorted Humor), the champion three-year-old of 2003 off his victories in the GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness S., looked sharp yesterday morning as he breezed five furlongs over the main track at

Gulfstream Park. The chestnut gelding, soon to turn six, had exercise rider Robin Smullen in the saddle for the work, accomplished in :58 1/5, the fastest of eight moves at the distance. The winner of the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup in 2004, Funny Cide had a limited five-year-old campaign owing to back problems, finish-

ing off the board in each of his three starts. Trainer Barclay Tagg has indicated that his charge could have his return race in the six-furlong GIII Mr. Prospector H. Jan. 7. That event could serve as a prep for the GI Donn H. Feb. 4. Funny Cide is unraced since finishing sixth in the GI Suburban H. last July.

SUNSHINE MILLIONS NOMS ANNOUNCED

A total of 338 California- and Florida-bred horses were nominated at the first stage for the Sunshine Millions series, to be run at Gulfstream Park and Santa Anita Park Sat., Jan. 28. Among the possibles for the \$1-million Classic are last year's GI Santa Anita Derby hero, the Florida-bred and California-based **Buzzards Bay** (Marco Bay), while Cal-bred **Lava Man** (Slew City Slew), winner of the GI Hollywood Gold Cup, could represent the West Coast team. **Valentine Dancer** (In Excess {Ire}) might be back for an attempt at a third straight victory in the Filly and Mare Turf while other former champions nominated include **Valid Video** (Valid Wager), who took the inaugural Dash, and **Sweet Lips** (Kris S.), successful in last year's Distaff.
