HAPPY TO BE BACK

Happy Ticket (Anet), winner of the GI Ballerina S. at Saratoga this summer, breezed for the first time Sunday since having surgery to repair a breathing problem.

Sideline after finishing a well-beaten 11th in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff, the bay turned in a three-furlong move at Louisiana in :36.60, the third-fastest out of 18 works at the distance. "It was an easy blowout for her," trainer Andy Leggio told *Daily Racing Form*. "She's a laid back filly. Nothing really bothers her." Happy Ticket began her career with nine straight victories, but

had that streak come to an end in the GII Princess Rooney H., where she was second to Madcap Escapade. The Louisiana-bred rebounded from that loss with a victory in the prestigious Ballerina, then placed second in the GI Beldame S. She closed out the 2004 season with a disappointing run in the Breeders' Cup. A possible return to the races may come in the Jan. 22 Louisiana Lagniappe Ladies S. "We're going to try to run in that race, but we won't break our neck to get there," Leggio added.

COLE NORMAN UNDERGOES SURGERY

Trainer Cole Norman, injured Monday in an accident involving an all-terrain vehicle at his Haughton, Louisiana home, underwent surgery yesterday at the Louisiana State University Medical Center in Shreveport to remove a damaged disc in his neck, according to *Daily Racing Form*. Norman, who will turn 37 on New Year's Eve, is expected to wear a brace for the next three months. "They went in through the front, and they're going to take out the damaged disc and fuse the vertebrae together with plates and screws," his wife Tamara told *DRF*. "They're saying if surgery goes well, he could go home maybe tomorrow or Friday." Norman is currently fifth on the North American list of trainers for 2005.

CASTLEDALE TO CRESTWOOD FARM

Castledale (Ire) (Peintre Celebre--Louju, by Silver Hawk), winner of the GI Santa Anita Derby and the GI Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile, will enter stud in 2006 at Crestwood Farm in Lexington, Ky. He will stand for \$6,000. Castledale, who took the GIII Generous S. as a juvenile, posted his biggest career victory in the 2004 Santa Anita Derby, defeating Rock Hard Ten and Imperialism. He went on to add graded stakes victories on the grass this season in the GII San Francisco Breeders' Cup Mile H. and the Shoemaker. He retired with five wins from 17 starts and \$866,636 in earnings.

Overlord Takes U.S. Debut:

Overlord (Aus) (Danehill), who sold for a then Australian record A\$2.2 million at the 2004 Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale, made a winning start to his new career in America, taking a Turfway entry-level allow-

ance this past Sunday. Owned by the partnership of Michael Tabor and Susan Magnier, the colt made a pair of starts for trainer Lee Freedman in Australia, winning his maiden at first asking at Caloundra this past May 27--while still a Southern Hemisphere two-year-old--and a third at Werribee in August. Produced by Prawn Cocktail

(Artichoke), a half sister to Storm Cat's dam Terlingua and to Royal Academy, the bay was sent to the barn of trainer Patrick Biancone, who saddled the colt to a 3/4-length victory in Sunday's 6 1/2-furlong race. Overlord has further pedigree appeal, as he is a brother to Australian group winners Langoustine (Aus) and One World (Aus).

New Orleans H. Next For Brass Hat:

Brass Hat (Prized), winner of the GII Ohio Derby and GII Indiana Derby at three, will start next in the GII New Orleans H. Jan. 7, according to *Daily Racing Form*. Brass Hat posted an impressive 2 1/2-length tally in last Saturday's Prairie Bayou S. at Turfway. "He came out of the race in great shape," trainer Buff Bradley told *DRF*. "After the race my father [owner, Fred] and I started to figure out what to do next and we said 'Let's go for the big money.' He's earned a shot to at least try."

Monmouth to Host 2006 NATC Futurities:
