MICHAEL OSBORNE DIES

Leading racing and bloodstock figure Michael Osborne died Wednesday night after a short illness at the age of 71. Some of the world's most influential names yesterday

paid tribute to the iconic character, who helped transform the face of international racing with his work in Dubai and who played a major role in some of the most powerful breeding operations in Europe and the United States. After spells at the helm of the Irish National Stud and North Ridge Farm, Osborne was hand-picked by Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum to discover the Irish base of the Darley operation and he arranged the purchase of Kildangan

Stud in County Kildare. In recent years, the Naas-born former vet was at the forefront of the inception of racing in Dubai and was made chief executive of the Emirates Racing Association, overseeing the transformation of Nad Al Sheba Racecourse and the launch of the world's richest race. Sheikh Mohammed was one of those offering his thoughts yesterday. "Michael was a wonderful man," he said. "My thoughts and sympathy are with his family. We had some marvelous times together and I will always remember the great work that he did. He was a hugely influential figure in world racing. It was Michael who established the Dubai World Cup as a great international race." Osborne also engineered the World Series, and had this year taken on the chairmanship of the World Racing Championships in order to revamp the concept. "Michael always had enormous enthusiasm--for horses, for Ireland and for Dubai," Sheikh Mohammed added. "Nearly 20 years ago, he was the one who bought Kildangan Stud for me. He really loved the farm, and it is fitting that he is going to be laid to rest in the graveyard at Kildangan." Cont. p2

CALIFORNIA DREAMING

Attila's Storm (Forest Wildcat), who began his career a year ago in California before making his name in New York, will return to Santa Anita for the GI Malibu S. on opening day Dec. 26. The three-year-old finished fourth at 45-1 in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint Oct. 29, then defeated his elders on Thanksgiving in the Fall Highweight H. Trainer Richard Schosberg opted to send the colt out for the seven-furlong Malibu. "It's a Grade I, it's for straight three-year-olds and he's a top sprinter," Schosberg said. "It looked like a good plan to come here. So far, everything's worked out well. He's been here for a couple of weeks under the care of Eduardo Inda...He started his career at Santa Anita, so we didn't think he'd have trouble adapting." Entries for the Malibu will be drawn this afternoon.

Osborne was also a senior steward of the Irish Turf Club, director of the Irish Horseracing Authority and Horseracing Ireland and chairman of Punchestown and Curragh racecourses. Among the many paying homage to him yesterday was Horseracing Ireland's Chief Executive Brian Kavanagh. "Michael Osborne was Ireland's foremost international racing figure of recent times," he commented. "Over four decades he occupied every significant role in the Irish racing and breeding industries and set new standards of excellence in every position he filled. His outstanding quality was his ability to relate to and work with people of all ages and backgrounds. His unique talents and enthusiasm saw him succeed wherever he operated and throughout the racing and breeding world his legacy will endure for a very long time." Osborne was instrumental in the twinning of his home county Kildare with Lexington, Kentucky. Spendthrift Farm's former General Manager and friend John Williams reflected on his influence in the States. "Michael was a lovely man--he meant so much to me and to so many people in the U.S. and elsewhere," he said. "He touched so many, many people. The things he did just spread exponentially. He did amazing things for people." Following yesterday's funeral service, a Requiem Mass will take place at St Brigid's Church in Kildare today at 11 a.m.

TURFWAY BARN QUARANTINED Barn 26 at Turfway Park in Florence, Kentucky has been placed under quarantine after a three-year-old filly trained by Chuck Simon began showing signs of equine herpesvirus, according to published reports. The disease is contagious, affecting the upper respiratory and neurological systems. "This horse has never had any respiratory problems or a temperature," Simon told *The Blood-Horse*. "She was having a neurological problem. It could be quite a few things--equine herpesvirus is just one of them." The affected filly has been shipped to Hagyard-Davidson-McGee in Lexington, but the remaining horses in the quarantined barn will not be permitted to train or race pending test results. Those are expected today, after which it will be determined whether the quarantine should be ended or extended.

MTHA Rejects Magna Dates:

Maryland's 2006 racing dates were left undecided when the Maryland Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association rejected the latest proposal from Magna Entertainment Corporation Wednesday, according to *Baltimore Sun*. Magna, which owns Laurel Park and Pimlico Race Course, offered to run 180 days of racing, provide year-round stabling and requested contributions to help cover operating costs. In rejecting that plan, MTHA president Richard Hoffberger said the board accepted the 180 days of racing, but wanted Magna to race during the summer months. Magna cited increased competition from nearby states as the reason to keep its tracks closed during the summer. The MTHA agreed to an expense contribution, but not the one proposed by Magna. Under the current deal, Maryland will race five days a week through June, 2006.

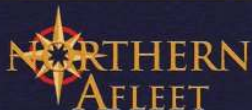

MARAAHEL TO REMAIN IN TRAINING Sheikh Hamdan Al Maktoum's **Maraahel (Ire)** (Alzao), most recently a good third to Vengeance of Rain (NZ) in the G1 Hong Kong Cup at Sha Tin Dec. 11, will remain in training in 2006, with a tilt at the G1 Dubai World Cup a distinct possibility. Winner of this year's G3 Huxley S., the four-year-old was never out of the top three in any of his five subsequent starts, including a half-length third to Electrocutonist and Zenno Rob Roy (Jpn) in the G1 Juddmonte International S. at York in August. Visored for the first time when third in the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket Oct. 15, the bay fell just one length short in the Hong Kong Cup. "Maraahel has progressed since we fitted him with a visor and we were delighted with the way he ran in Hong Kong," Angus Gold, racing manager to Sheikh Hamdan, told *Racing Post*. "The plan now is to go to Dubai with him..the World Cup is one of a range of options." The bay contested last year's G1 Sheema Classic in the desert, finishing a well-beaten eighth. "Maraahel is a more mature horse now and hopefully he will do better out there this time around," Gold added.
