**STREAKING FILLIES MAKE THE TRIP**

**Trickle of Gold** (Formal Gold) and **Great Intentions** (Cat Thief) both enter today's GI La Brea S. at Santa Anita riding winning streaks, but will have their hands full in this wide-open affair. The former has tasted defeat only once this year and that came when she was second in her seasonal debut at Delaware June 29. The dark bay has gone on to take six straight, including the GIII Safely Kept Breeders' Cup S. Oct. 16 and the Anne Arundel S. last out Nov. 19. Trickle of Gold's regular rider Jeremy Rose will be aboard. "I have all the

confidence in the world in her," Rose commented. "She does have a lot of gas out of the gate and she's got a lot of stamina. I've had horses press her on the backside and let them almost get a head in front and she's never had a problem. I've never had a horse get really close to her down the lane yet. I haven't really gone to the whip on her." Great Intentions was freshened up after finishing a distant fourth in the GIII Old Hat S. Feb. 5 and has returned to take three in a row. The Barry Schwartz colorbearer notched a Saratoga allowance Sept. 4 in her first start off the bench, then dead-heated with Reunited in Belmont's Oh What a Windfall S. Sept. 25. She was last seen winning the GII First Flight H. Oct. 30. "You would have to think they have to look at us and say 'Wow'," trainer Mike Hushion told *Daily Racing Form*. Likely favorite **Leave Me Alone** (Bold Badgett), winner of the prestigious GI Test S. this summer at Saratoga, looks to make amends after a dismal eighth as the 4-5 chalk in Keeneland's GII Raven Run S. Oct. 22. "I don't think the track condition will be a factor for my filly if it's off," trainer Eric Kruljac commented. "I think she'll like a wet-fast track. If that's what she gets here, I think she'll love it. There's only one way to find out, but she couldn't be doing any better."

**STATE SHOWS NYRA THE MONEY** The New York Racing Association has agreed to the terms for a \$30-million state financial assistance package that will keep NYRA tracks in operation in 2006, it was announced yesterday. The package consists of \$5 million from the Port Authority of New York/New Jersey for parcels of land near Aqueduct, a \$5-million loan from the Empire State Development Corporation and a \$20-million loan from the State Division of the Lottery, which will be repaid through Video Lottery Terminal vendor fees. "We particularly appreciate the efforts of the Governor [George] Pataki and his staff in working with NYRA to complete this package under tight time constraints," NYRA President and CEO Charles Hayward said. "Moreover, we appreciate the efforts of the Governor, Senator [Joseph] Bruno and Assembly Speaker [Sheldon] Silver in rallying to the support of the New York racing industry during this critical period."

Gilchrist told the publication that the star sprinter will train very lightly in January and is targeting the Apr. 22 Golden Gate Fields Breeders' Cup Sprint for the colt's four-year-old debut. "I don't think he is going to take that many trips this year," Gilchrist said of Lost in the Fog, who raced nine times at seven different tracks in 2004. "If he stays sprinting, we will try to stay in California."

**GOODWOOD TO RESCHEDULE CLASSIC PREPS**

Officials at Goodwood Racecourse have applied to move their Derby and Oaks trials, the Predominate S. and the Lupe S., to Guineas weekend due to their unusually close proximity to the Epsom Classics in 2006. **HRSA INSTITUTES CONTROVERSIAL LASIX POLICY** Harness Racing South Australia has given preliminary approval for the use of Lasix, with the new rules likely to take effect Mar. 1. Lasix is banned in both harness and Thoroughbred racing in Australia; Harness Racing SA's departure from the policy means it risks becoming isolated, with other states banning horses trained in SA from competing at their tracks. Chairman of Stewards Gerrard Lalor said the divergence from the national drug free policy was prompted by a recommendation from South Australia's industry advisory committee, which indicated Lasix had the potential to prolong the racing life of the local horse population and perhaps attract others from interstate to capitalise on the relaxed rules. "There are strong arguments suggesting that it is performance enhancing and there are equally strong arguments that it doesn't," Lalor said in a report in Friday's *Daily Telegraph* newspaper. "The same applies to its effectiveness to prevent bleeding. There will be stringent rules governing its use, with horses required to be on course three hours before they race in order to have the furosimide administered by the course veterinarian. And once a horse races on Lasix, it will have to for the rest of its career."
