### DRAMATIC ENDING TO 2006

On Jan. 1 trainer Bobby Frankel celebrated the New Year with a victory in Santa Anita's GII San Gabriel H. with Badge of Silver, and the New York native closed out 2006 the same way, this time getting the job done with Gary Tanaka's **King's Drama (Ire)** (King's Theatre

{Ire}) in yesterday's renewal of the race. The only runner in the field with an Grade I victory in the U.S. to his credit, the six-year-old tracked pacesetter **Railroad** (Double Honor) through early splits of :24.40, :49.32 and 1:13.23. Ready to pounce with a sixteenth left to negotiate, the handsome bay was

asked for more late, and he delivered, getting up for a half-length victory over his game foe, who was one length in front of **Hendrix** (Sultry Song) at the wire. "He's a good horse," said the Frankel. "The Tin Man proved you're never too old to win on the turf. This horse tries hard and he's a gelding, so he's going to be around a long time, as long as I take good care of him." **cont. p2**

### DECLAN'S MOON READIES FOR RETURN

Former two-year-old champion **Declan's Moon** (Malibu Moon) received his final major preparatory work at Hollywood Park yesterday in advance of Saturday's GII San Pasqual H. at Santa Anita. Posting the second fastest of 133 moves Sunday, the five-year-old completed five furlongs in a crisp

:59.40. "He hasn't hit his best form, that's for sure," said trainer Ron Ellis. Seventh in the GII Pat O'Brien BC H. at Del Mar Aug. 20, the Maryland-bred finished third next time out in the GIII Vernon O. Underwood H. Hollywood Park Dec. 3. "He had a lung infection in the Del Mar race, and in his last

race. I always thought he was a two-turn horse, and he got caught going :44 flat [half mile] in the Underwood, and it gave him more than he wanted to do. He should be more suited to the distance on Saturday." Declan's Moon, owned by Jay Em Ess Stable, won his first five career starts, including the GII Santa Catalina S. at Santa Anita at three, but is winless in three subsequent starts.

**Foxysox** (GB) (Foxhound), who was withdrawn from Saturday's GI La Brea S. because of a bruised foot, may make her next start in the GII El Encino

S. at Santa Anita Jan. 14. According to trainer Carla Gaines, the injury is believed to have occurred after the four-year-old was transferred from Hollywood Park to Santa Anita prior to the La Brea. "Her foot was pulsing and it was hot," Gaines told DRF. "It will take a few days to work it out." The English-bred, winner of the GIII Providencia S. and GIII Senorita S. earlier this term, came home a narrow winner in her most recent start in the GII Bayakoa H. at Hollywood Park Dec. 3.

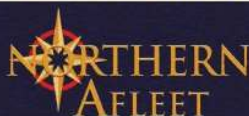

King's Drama, winner of the G3 Prix De La Jonchere at three, enjoyed arguably his best season to date was 2005 when he took the GI Sword Dancer H. and GII Red Smith H., and was only a neck back in second behind 2004 Breeders' Cup Turf champion Better Talk Now in the GI Man O War S. With only three prior starts this term, the bay came home third in the GII San Luis Obispo H. at Santa Anita Feb. 26 before taking the GII San Luis Rey H. Mar. 25. On the sidelines for over two months after that effort, the gelding returned with a second-place finish to Lava Man in his latest start in the GI Charlie Whittingham Memorial H. June 10.

Since 1950, the George Woolf Memorial Jockey Award has been presented annually to a rider who demonstrates high standards of personal and professional conduct, on and off the racetrack.

**January 5, 1980...****Spectacular Bid** began his undefeated four-year-old season, winning the Malibu S. by five lengths at Santa Anita; the gray colt finished his 1980 campaign with a perfect nine-for-nine record.

Rene Douglas, who was first banned from racing at Calder and subsequently barred from Tampa Bay Downs, Philadelphia Park and Gulfstream Park, will be allowed to ride at Hawthorne today, the Cicero, Illinois, track's final day of the winter meeting. Douglas is listed as the rider of Gostoso, who is expected to run in the seventh of the nine-race card. "Right now, I have no idea what they're holding him up on," Tim Carey, president of Hawthorne told *DRF*.
