**ECLIPSE AWARDS NOMINEES ANNOUNCED**

There were few surprises yesterday when the National Thoroughbred Racing Association, National Turf Writers Association and *Daily Racing Form* announced the finalists for the 2006 Eclipse Awards. Breeders' Cup champions were given plenty of respect by the voters, including Classic hero **Invasor (Arg)** (Candy Stripes), who leads the way in the Older Male category. **Lava Man** (Slew City Slew), a Grade I winner on turf and dirt last season, and GI Clark H. winner **Premium Tap** (Pleasant Tap) round out the field. Eye-opening Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner **Street Sense** (Street Cry {Ire}) and game Juvenile Fillies heroine **Dreaming of Anna** (Rahy) figure to take the crown in their respective divisions. The Three-Year-Old Male category is one of the best compiled in recent years with GI Kentucky Derby winner **Barbaro** (Dynaformer) and GI Preakness S. hero **Bernardini** (A.P. Indy) going head-to-head. Breeders' Cup Distaff victress **Round Pond** (Awesome Again) and MGSW **Fleet Indian** (Indian Charlie) will vie for Older Female honors, while Breeders' Cup Sprint winner **Thor's Echo** (Swiss Yodeler) locks horns with **Discreet Cat** (Forestry) and GI King's Bishop S. winner **Henny Hughes** (Hennessy) in the Sprint division. The globe-trotting mare **Ouija Board (GB)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) only made one start in the U.S., but made quite an impression annexing the Breeders' Cup F/M Turf. The Lord Derby colorbearer, as well as GI Beverly D. S. winner **Gorella (Fr)** (Grape Tree Road {GB}) and GI Yellow Ribbon S. victress **Wait a While** (Maria's Mon) were nominated in the Turf Female category. Turf Male nominees include GI Breeders' Cup Mile winner **Miesque's Approval** (Miesque's Son), GI Turf Classic Invitational S. hero **English Channel** (Smart Strike) and GI Arlington Million winner **The Tin Man** (Affirmed). Nominees for champion Three-Year-Old Filly include the ill-fated **Pine Island** (Arch). Darley and Lael Stables were both nominated for champion owner and breeder. Winners will be announced at the 36th annual Eclipse Awards ceremony at the Beverly Wilshire Four Seasons hotel in Beverly Hills, Ca. Jan. 22.

**JOCKEY CLUB INSPECTS BROODMARES** In late December, the Jockey Club sent representatives to farms in nine states to inspect broodmares with early 2006 breeding or foaling dates. A rule revision to Section V of the Principal Rules and Requirements of The American Stud Book in August 2005 added provisions for field inspections. "Our Registry staff observed a small number of foals that had been born prior to January 1, which will be registered as foals of 2006," explained Alan Marzelli, president of The Jockey Club. "Those who choose to breed mares early may risk having foals born prior to January 1." My editors gave me a lot and leeway and I appreciated it very much."

## FLORIDA OFFICIALS OPTIMISTIC EHV-1 IS UNDER CONTROL

Florida racetrack and state officials said they're cautiously optimistic the current outbreak of equine herpesvirus-1 is over, with no new cases detected. A sixth Florida horse died Dec. 29. That horse was part of a group already under state-imposed quarantine. On Dec. 26, track officials at Calder Race Course lifted restrictions on horses shipping there, though two barns are still under movement restrictions pending negative EHV-1 test results. The test samples were collected late the week of Dec. 24 but results were delayed because of the holiday. Dr. Mary Scollay, track veterinarian for Calder and nearby Gulfstream Park, said she anticipates receiving those results Jan. 3. "Those horses have been clinically normal, and we do not anticipate anything but good news there," Scollay said. "We're comfortable this outbreak is under control, and hopefully we've got smooth sailing for a while." A racehorse from Calder was exposed to the virus while visiting an equine hospital in Wellington, Fla., for an unrelated illness. It returned to Calder and stayed for five days before shipping to Ocala. Once in Ocala, it began showing neurologic signs and was confirmed positive for EHV-1. Horses at Calder were last exposed to the horse Dec. 11. **Cont. p2**

Payson Park Training Center remains under state-imposed quarantine after a horse there died Dec. 22 and was confirmed positive for EHV-1. Scollay said she expects some horses--those considered to be at low risk--to be released Jan. 5. Gulfstream is accepting entries for those horses for the races of Jan. 6. There are no virus restrictions at Gulfstream. In California, Golden Gate Fields, Bay Meadows, and Pleasanton's Alameda County Fairgrounds are under quarantine after a 3-year-old gelding tested positive for EHV-1 Dec. 29.
