'SUNDAY' COLT SETS RECORD AT MM FRIDAY

In 2001, it took one bid of A\$1 million to make a filly by Sunday Silence--Denise's Joy (Aus) the highest priced yearling to sell at Magic Millions. Named Sunday

Joy (Aus), that filly went on to become a Group 1 winner and was bred to the all-conquering Sadler's Wells in 2004. The result of that mating--a flashy colt in the mold of his sire--lived up to the standard set by his dam when a single bid of A\$2 million secured him for a partnership. Trainer Gai Waterhouse, who conditioned Sunday Joy, signed the ticket. She stymied any potential opposition

by dispatching husband Rob Waterhouse to an unobtrusive position near a side entrance, well away from her table in front of the sale ring, and there he fired his single salvo on behalf of his wife. The price bettered last year's MM record price of A\$1.55 million paid for the recent Sydney stakes-placed two-year-old Arlington (Aus). "I just couldn't believe the quality of this colt; we have never been lucky enough to have a horse as well-bred as this offered for sale in Australia--he has three generations of Oaks winners behind him and he would have made dramatically more at a sale overseas," Waterhouse enthused. "This is just rarefied air. People here have not been exposed to this sort of breeding. He has been purchased on behalf of a group of people in Australia and overseas who realise the value of him. He is worth every penny; he is the most exciting horse ever to have gone through a sale ring in the Southern Hemisphere." John Singleton raced Sunday Joy, and his bloodstock representative Duncan Grimley confirmed that Singleton would retain a share in the bay. "It would have been a shame if the horse was sold and he had nothing to do with it ever anymore so he is going to retain 10-20 percent of the horse; other than that, it is fully done," Grimley said. "The opening bid blew the reserve out the water." **Cont. p4**

But in the Dec. 26 event, the colt got trapped along the rail in the stretch, checked a few times, and generally looked uncomfortable as he came home a disappointing seventh as the 2-1 favorite under Garrett Gomez. In today's GI San Fernando Breeders' Cup S. at Santa Anita, Brother Derek

TRUART TOPS DAY 5 AT KEENELAND

Truart, a four-year-old filly by Yes It's True, topped yesterday's fifth session of the Keeneland January Sale in Lexington, Kentucky. The Florida-bred, who completed the trifecta behind Folklore and Fifth Avenue in the GI Adirondack S. in 2005, was knocked down to John & Martha Jane Mulholland for \$150,000. Selling as a broodmare prospect, **Truart**, out of the Copelan mare **Artistic One**, was consigned by Hill 'n' Dale Sales Agency. She is a half-sister to the stakes-placed duo of **Yasou Daniel** (Pentelicus) and **Niko the Greek** (Future Storm). The five-year-old mare **Quite a Ruckus** (Richter Scale--Ada Ruckus, by Bold Ruckus) was the second-highest-priced horse yesterday, selling to agent Fergus Galvin for \$145,000. A stakes winner, she was consigned by Castle Park Farm (Noel Murphy). **Cont. p2**

Another who had some trouble in the Malibu was **Arson Squad**. Winner of the GII Swaps Breeders' Cup S. in July, the Bruce Headley-trained colt was hit hard at the break and never really recovered, checking in just behind Brother Derek in eighth. "You can't be that far back if you're struggling for your feet in the first four or five strides," Headley told *Daily Racing Form*. Garrett Gomez, switching mounts with Alex Solis, will ride Arson Squad, which suits Headley just fine. "Garrett is riding like he's possessed," commented the trainer. Also coming out of the Malibu are runner-up **Spring at Last** and third-place finisher **Midnight Lute**. The latter, who broke slowly before putting in a game rally, is stretching out to two turns for the first time.

Favored over Belgravia in the GIII Hollywood Prevue S. in November, **Notional** finished third to that foe, then came back to be an even sixth, beaten 2 1/2 lengths by Stormello, in the GI Hollywood Futurity S. Dec. 16. This marks the return to conventional dirt for the \$235,000 Barretts March juvenile, who won his debut sprinting over this strip in impressive fashion Oct. 21. The bay was well back in the Hollywood Futurity in the early going and gets blinkers here, perhaps in order to get the colt to lay closer to the pace. **Grapelli** needed five tries to break his maiden, but the son of the good racemare Bella Bellucci seems to be the kind that will improve with age and has three good works under his belt in recent weeks. He comes out of a 1 1/4-length winning effort in a Hollywood maiden Dec. 3. **Tenfold**, a \$725,000 Keeneland September yearling who hails from trainer Bob Baffert's barn, won a seven-furlong maiden over this course on opening day and fired a blistering, best-of-52 bullet in :58 3/5 at Santa Anita in his most recent work Jan. 4.

Conrad Jupiters Magic Millions

Ode to Joy...

When Sunday Joy--bred by Arrowfield's John Messara and Magic Millions co-owner and Strawberry Hills Stud owner John Singleton--went through the sale ring amid much fanfare in 2001, there was a single bid for a then-record A\$1 million from Gai Waterhouse. Singleton bought Messara out of the beautifully bred filly from G1 Oaks winner Joie Denise (Aus) (Danehill) that January and, by December, Sunday Joy had won the Listed Tommy Smith Slipper. She placed fourth in the Magic Millions 2YO race won by Lovely Jubly (Aus) and really came into her own at three, winning the G1 AJC Oaks over 2400 meters at Randwick as 3-1 favorite after a series of unlucky placings. Notably, Sunday Joy beat Liberty Rose (Aus)--the dam of Thursday's A\$1.5-million Redoute's Choice (Aus) colt--in the G3 Stock S. over a mile, a race in which subsequent three-time G1 Melbourne Cup heroine Makybe Diva (GB) was fourth. Singleton sent Sunday Joy to Dermot Weld in Ireland, but she tailed off last in her only overseas start, in the Challenge S. at Leopardstown in July 2004, and was retired with three wins and six placings from 18 attempts and A\$683,030 earnings. The savvy Singleton sent Sunday Joy to Sadler's Wells while she was in Ireland, and her resulting flashy colt was offered yesterday. Grimley could not hide his delight at the outcome, since the colt was a late bloomer. He confirmed Singleton would retain a share. "It is an amazing thing when Sunday Joy was sold: John [Singleton] bid a million dollars--one bid--and now her first foal goes through the ring four or five years later and [A\$] 2 million dollars, one bid, so history has repeated itself," Grimley added. "[Singleton] said they obviously learned the lesson when he bought the mother!" Waterhouse, whose late father trained the filly's granddam Denise's Joy (Aus), pointed out Sunday Joy had a half-sister in G2 Wakeful S. winner Tuesday Joy (Aus) (Carnegie {Ire}), who had also proven precocious at two and effective at three.

Barbaro Update

BARBARO COMFORTABLE OVERNIGHT

KENNETT SQUARE, PA...According to his medical team, Kentucky Derby winner Barbaro rested comfortably [Thursday night]. "We do not believe that this setback puts him all the way back to where he was in July," said Dr. Dean W. Richardson, Chief of Surgery. "He has much more healthy tissue on the bottom of the left foot than he had at that time. He spends part of each day in his sling, and he is eating well and acting bright." The colt's right hind leg, injured at the Preakness on May 20, 2006, is also being closely monitored. "We have a solid column of bone to work with in the right hind limb," said Dr. Richardson. "There are no signs of infection in either limb at this time. It is very disappointing to have him go through this setback, but we will continue to try to keep him comfortable and assist his healing with reasonable and humane measures." Barbaro remains in the Intensive Care Unit of Penn's George D. Widener Hospital at New Bolton Center. The next update will be posted on Tuesday, Jan. 16, unless there is a significant change in Barbaro's condition.

Perfect Addition...

Earlier in the day, Darley Australia's Oliver Tait went to A\$1.4 million to secure a full-sister to G1 Oakleigh Plate winner Snitzel (Aus), a son of Redoute's Choice who just completed his first season at Arrowfield at a fee of A\$33,000. The price was a record for a filly at Magic Millions; the previous mark was set in 2001 by the aforementioned Sunday Joy. The filly was offered by Yarraman Park on behalf of Francois Naude, who owns only one mare--the multiple-Listed winner Snippets' Lass (Aus), and Yarraman's Arthur Mitchell said she had easily exceeded her reserve. The South Africa-born Naude, the managing director of Coral Sea Farms Australia now based in Queensland was enthusiastic about his continuing success with his lone mare. "She's the only broodmare I've got," Naude confirmed. "And what a broodmare she is! I would have been delighted with a million--but [A\$] 1.4 million is just brilliant." Snitzel, a A\$260,000 yearling purchased by trainer Gerald Ryan here in 2004, won seven races and retired with more than A\$1 million in earnings. His half-brother Weiner, by More Than Ready, fetched A\$350,000 the following year and placed in the Listed Gimcrack S. Last year, Dale Sutton of Wadham Park bought a Royal Academy filly from Snippets' Lass for A\$775,000. "She will always be a full-sister to Snitzel and she is an ideal candidate for our broodmare band," reasoned Tait, "but she is also a racy, sharp athletic filly who will hopefully have won a nice race by this time next year." He continued, "The sale has been really strong and she is one of the fillies of the sale. She isn't very big, but she's a lovely filly. And she's a sister to one of Redoute's Choice's best colts." Tait said the sale price of A\$1.4 million was "about" where he and the remainder of the Darley team had valued her. "Sheikh Mohammed was very keen to get her," he added.

(Dehere). "Gary and I buy a lot of horses here at the sale and with a couple of clients who have been terrific supporters we looked at a bunch of horses and then said, 'Why don't we try and put something nice together and buy a proper horse?'" Cox explained about the decision to secure the colt from the Twin Palms Stud draft. "We didn't think we were going to get him, but we decided about 48 hours ago to have a real shot at him, lined up our soldiers, dug deep and had a crack at him."

Cox Gets His Choice cont.

Notable previous purchases for Cox include a A\$925,000 Dehere colt last Easter and a US\$950,000 mare at Keeneland, but his enthusiasm over this coup was palpable. "This is just fantastic, I'm a little bloke who has been four years out on my own," he said. "Since we bought the horse a number of studs have come and approached us to take a leg in him, but I don't think we will do that. We don't necessarily need to reduce our exposure, and it reduces our leverage at the end of the day, if and when he wins a nice race." Cox added, "I saw him at the farm a month ago, and he was a lovely, athletic horse from a family I am very familiar with. I watched the mare race; she was only a little midget of a thing, but she had a ability and was probably limited by her own physical attributes. [She was] a small, short-coupled thing, but she could gallop, she had a lot of speed, a lot of zing about her. This will be the most expensive horse in Gary's yard and he deserves it; he is a good trainer who has just lacked clients with the firepower. We've been buying horses together for the best part of 10 years and knocking around with cheap-ass things, so to put together a bit of money and line up for a horse like this is very exciting."

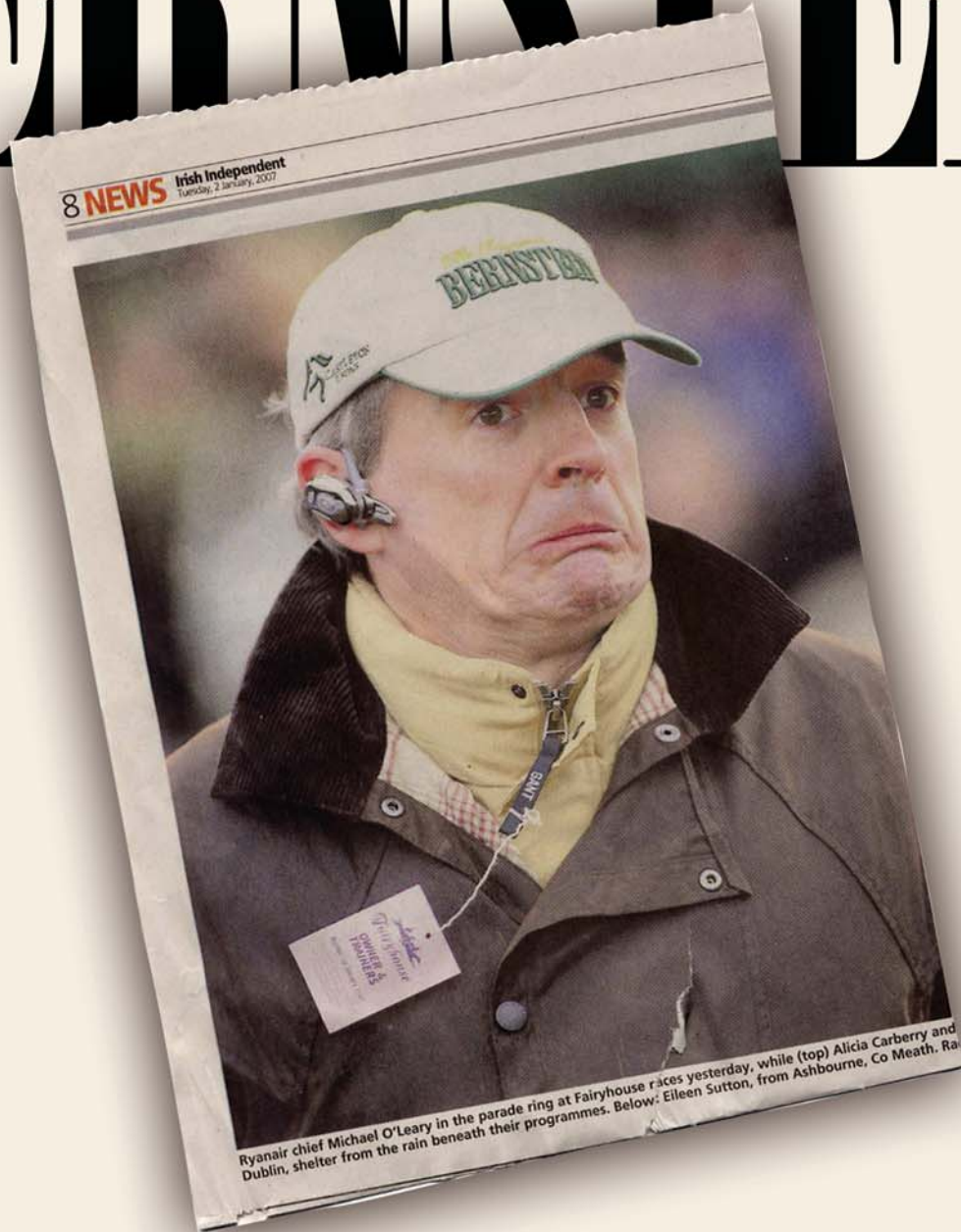

CHURCHILL ANNOUNCES STAKES SCHEDULE

Churchill Downs announced its 2007 stakes schedule yesterday, which features a record \$11.3 million in purses for 47 stakes events. As usual, the highlight of the meeting will be the Kentucky Derby Day program, this year held May 5. The card offers a record \$3.35 million for the 133rd Run for the Roses and five supporting stakes. A total of 13 stakes will see their purses boosted, including the GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic on the Derby undercard, which will be raised \$100,000 to \$500,000-added. Among Churchill's 37 graded events are five Grade I's, 10 Grade II's and 22 Grade III's. The Spring Meet will run Apr. 28-July 8; the Fall Meet will run Oct. 27-Nov. 24. Churchill also announced that three races previously ran as handicap events, the May 4 GII Louisville Breeders' Cup S., the May 5 GII Churchill Downs S., and the June 2 GIII Aristides S., will be run in 2007 under allowance conditions.
