**A DIAMOND OUT OF THE ROUGH**

There was a roughly run stretch duel going on to his inside, but **Awesome Gem** (Awesome Again) avoided the scrimmage in the GII San Fernando Breeders' Cup S. at Santa Anita yesterday and got up to beat **Midnight Lute** (Real Quiet) by a nose. First or second in five of his first six starts, the chestnut gelding picked up his first stakes score with the effort. "He's a runner," said trainer Craig

Dollase, adding, "We've got three weeks till the next one [GII Strub S., Feb. 3] and, if he's good enough and stays sound, we'll think about the Big 'Cap [GI Santa Anita H., Mar. 3], but we don't want to get ahead of ourselves; one race at a time." **Cont. p2**

**SHAKING IT UP AT SANTA ANITA**

Trainer Bobby Frankel, with four stakes wins already to his credit this meet, goes for number five in the GII El Encino S. at Santa Anita this afternoon. Frankel saddles two of the six starters in the mile-and-a-sixteenth affair, Stronach Stables's **Sugar Shake** (Awesome Again) and Juddmonte Farm's **Cantabria (GB)** (Dansili {GB}). Sugar Shake has been off the board just once in her nine career starts, finishing seventh on a muddy track behind fellow El Encino contender **Wonder Lady Anne L** (Real Quiet) in the GI Coaching Club American Oaks in July. She came back to be second in a Belmont allowance in September, and was last seen going gate to wire in a Churchill allowance test Nov. 17.

Twice group placed in England, stablemate Cantabria opened her U.S. account with a 4 1/4-length score in an entry-level allowance on the Hollywood all-weather Dec. 6, but will try her luck on the dirt for the first time. "The only unknown is how the form will transfer from the Cushion Track," her jockey, Richie Migliore, told *Daily Racing Form*. "If she holds her form, she should be pretty tough." Wonder Lady Anne L, freshened after fading to sixth in the Aug. 19 GI Alabama S., has worked sharply for her first appearance in nearly five months. **Field, p7**

**HARD TO BEAT**

If he's entered, undefeated **Hard Spun** (Danzig) will be the horse to beat in the Mar. 10 GII Louisiana Derby after a dominating victory in the GIII Lecomte S. at Fair Grounds yesterday. The colt is based at Oaklawn Park, but trainer Larry Jones said, "He looked like he handled the course real well, so the Louisiana Derby is a definite possibility. We're certainly not going to rule anything out. We'll just head back to Oaklawn and see what's next." **Cont. p2**

**Remember the Main...**

Beaten a nose when trying the main track for the first time in his second start, a Del Mar maiden test in August, **Awesome Gem** missed by a neck on the grass Sept. 2. He came back to earn his first victory on the Oak Tree dirt Sept. 29 and made it two in a row on the surface in an entry-level allowance Oct. 26. Freshened after that performance, the versatile runner was back on the grass for the Dec. 26 GIII Sir Beaufort S. at Santa Anita and got up to be second, a length behind Kip Deville. **Awesome Gem**, off at 8-1 to carry that form to the main track, rated off the pace early. The trio of **Midnight Lute**, **Brother Derek** and **Halo Steven** (Halo's Image) were fighting it out at the top of the lane, with **Midnight Lute** lugging in to cause a bumping match, but **Awesome Gem** was finishing fast on the outside and proved narrowly best. **Click for the [brisnet.com chart](#) or the [free brisnet.com catalogue-style pedigree](#). Hard Spun kicked off his career with an 8 3/4-length maiden score at Delaware Park Oct. 22 and added a five-length tally in the Nov. 14 Port Penn S. at that track. He romped by 7 3/4 lengths in the Dec. 18 Pennsylvania Nursery S.--a race won in 2003 by Kentucky Derby hero Smarty Jones--and proved he could handle graded foes with equal aplomb. Favored to remain perfect while trying two turns for the first time, the bay was dogged by Izzie's Halo through a half in :46.78 and had Teufflesberg at his flank on the far turn, but galloped away from his rivals down the stretch. "The pace was fast, but he did it very easy," jockey Mario Pino said. "When I asked him, he kept giving me more. This is a real good horse. Adding blinkers after running sixth in the Dec. 16 GI Hollywood Futurity, Notional was the odds-on chalk to respond to the equipment change and lived up to those odds. The bay was sent off the chalk in the Nov. 18 GIII Hollywood Prevue S., but was caught in deep stretch and finished third. Rated off the pace while making his two-turn bow in the Futurity, he couldn't mount the needed late rally, but still was beaten just 2 1/2 lengths by Stormello. Notional was allowed to settle just off the pace yesterday, tracking Tenfold through a half in :46.29. He moved to challenge at the quarter pole and was much the best as he drew clear down the lane. "I wanted to make sure he ran around the turn today, because that's the kind of move you have to make the first Saturday in May," said winning jockey Corey Nakatani. Mimi Lebrock, who races for prominent Melbourne-based owners Les and Susan Smith and their daughter Mia, gave trainer Bart Cummings his second win in this event, and his first since 1989, with this gallant effort. Racing on the pace, the filly was under plenty of pressure at the 100 meters, but found something extra to edge clear in the waning yards. "Mimi Lebrock was a bit inexperienced and I had to help her 'round, but she was very tough at the finish," reported jockey Hugh Bowman. "I always felt confident she was going to fight off Husson Lightning." Added Cummings, "She's been a perfect filly to train. Not many good sorts are as well-behaved as her. I was sure she was in great order for this race." The A\$170,000 yearling purchase will head to the G1 Golden Slipper S. at Rosehill Mar. 31, where she will aim to become only the second horse to complete the Magic Millions-Golden Slipper double. She has a full sister catalogued as [lot 718](#) at the Magic Millions Sale Sunday.

The exciting filly Gold Edition bounced back from an ignominious last-start defeat to prove she is more than a "speedy squib." Fifth in the Magic Millions 2YO Classic last year, she went on to capture the G2 Magic Night S., Listed Ken Russell Memorial and G2 Champagne Classic and concluded her two-year-old season with a second in the G2 QTC Sires' Produce S. Gold Edition added victories in the Aug. 23 G3 San Domenico S. and Sept. 2 G3 Silver Shadow S. in her first two sophomore outings and made it a perfect three-for-three on the year in the Nov. 4 G1 Ascot Vale S. at Flemington. Off the board as the 4-11 choice in the Dec. 30 Vo Rogue Plate, she came through at 4-1 yesterday. The winner crossed to lead from her outside draw and sprinted from the 200-meter mark to post a handy score. "This filly is outstanding, there's no question about that," jockey Darren Beadman said. Gold Edition, a A\$130,000 buy, could point for the Apr. 29 G1 Champions Mile at Sha Tin.



## Conrad Jupiters Magic Millions

**FAR EAST FLAVOR AT MAGIC MILLIONS**

The penultimate session of the select portion of the Conrad Jupiter Magic Millions Yearlings Sale lacked million-dollar fireworks, but it was nevertheless solid. The Japanese bench, steadily active at Magic Millions with 10 purchases to date, took the top seller yesterday, with Katsumi Yoshida going to A\$625,000 for a colt by Redoute's Choice (Aus) out of the Bellotto mare Aphrodite (Aus). Aphrodite, a sister to SW Seto Flowerian (Aus), was exported to Japan and herself produced SW Fusaichi Junk (Jpn). Yesterday's topper, catalogued as hip 490, was offered by Yarraman Park, agent. Agent Rob McAnulty had to go to A\$600,000 for the session's second-best seller, a colt by Bel Esprit (Aus). A half-brother to Fusaichi Pegasus, the stallion was purchased for A\$9,000 and won at the Group 1 level at two and three. Consigned as hip 526, the yearling was consigned by Coolmore Stud, agent.

**Trend-Spotting...**

With three sessions in the books, a couple of trends have emerged at the Magic Millions sale. Australian-bred and raced sons of dual hemisphere sires such as Danehill are enjoying a solid run. The success of Redoute's Choice (Aus) is certainly no surprise, but 13 of the 14 top lots Saturday were by homegrown stallions. Offspring by Redoute's Choice have averaged A\$478,800 for 25 sold, and Encosta de Lago (Aus) is also enjoying a super sale, averaging A\$352,632 for 19 sold. Exceed and Excel (Aus) is having a dream debut, with 17 sold at an average of A\$262,941. Another local making his presence felt is first-crop sire Lonhro (Aus), who was represented by a pair of fillies Saturday that sold for A\$400,000 and A\$380,000.

A second trend is one that has been in evidence in years past. While the international bench is more discernible this year, their activity is dominated by two prominent offshore players from perhaps 100 potential international buyers present at the sale--Charles Laird has spent A\$5.5 million on 15 yearlings and the Hong Kong Jockey Club has thus far acquired 13 for A\$2.5 million. The duo are the only international interests to crack the top 10, as John Ferguson's purchases for Darley (A\$3.3 million on five horses thus far) are likely to remain in Australia.

**ITALIAN CLASSICS HIT HARD** Three of Italy's four Classics were dealt a blow by the European Pattern Committee and have been downgraded for 2007. While the May 20 G1 Derby Italiano maintains its prestige, the filly equivalent, the June 17 Oaks d'Italia, has been demoted to Group 2 status, and Rome's two mile Classics, the Apr. 29 Premio Parioli (2000 Guineas) and May 13 Premio Regina Elena (1000 Guineas) will be run as Group 3 events. In total, prize money for the four events has been cut by 10 percent.

**MORE UPGRADES FOR IRELAND** Irish racing has received a boost to its 2007 program after a quintet of upgrades by the European Pattern Committee. Five Listed events--Leopardstown's May 13 Amethyst S., July 28 Tyros S. and Aug. 19 Ballyroan S.; Cork's Aug. 6 Give Thanks S.; and The Curragh's Sept. 16 Solonoway S.--have been promoted to Group 3 status. "We are delighted that the high quality of our black-type program has allowed us to increase the number of Pattern races by 50 percent over the past five years, from 38 in 2002 to a record new level of 57 in 2007," Horse Racing Ireland's Racing Director Jason Morris commented. "It is testimony to the strength of our flat horse population." Leopardstown's General Manager Tom Burke added, "We are happy to have secured the promotion of three Listed races to Group 3 status, all of which play a vital role in the Irish black-type program. The Ballyroan has produced four of the last five winners of the Irish St Leger, the Tyros featured Teofilo (Ire) last year, and the Amethyst provides an important early season opportunity for older milers." The Curragh's May 26 Ridgewood Pearl S., inaugurated in 2004, has been downgraded from Group 2 to Group 3 status after failing to meet its required rating parameters.

**ASMUSSEN BACK ON TRACK** Trainer Steve Asmussen, suspended since July 10, was back in action yesterday. The 41-year-old conditioner had his license reinstated Wednesday, Jan. 10, and sent out his first starters since the ban yesterday, with four runners at Sam Houston, three at Aqueduct, and one each at Delta Downs and Turfway Park. Asmussen's first starter, the four-year-old claimer Trailing Twelve, was the even-money favorite in the third race at the Big A, and finished third. The South Dakota native celebrated his first victory just two races later, when Not On My Turf romped by six lengths as the 2-1 chalk in a state-bred allowance test. Asmussen was handed the suspension after his charge No End In Sight tested positive for the prohibited substance mepivacaine at Evangeline Downs in March, and served a concurrent six-month ban for an acepromazine positive incurred in New Mexico. Despite missing nearly six months, he finished the season as the third-leading trainer in the country in races won, and ninth-leading trainer in money won. Asmussen had 1,141 starters and 241 winners last year, earning \$7,715,373 in purses.

**SPLENDID BLENDED RETIRED...AGAIN** Five-year-old **Splendid Blended** (Unbridled's Song--Valid Blend, by Valid Appeal), who was brought out of retirement to win three of her seven starts last year, is now officially headed to the broodmare band. The Florida-bred won three of four outings as a juvenile, including the GI Hollywood Starlet S. She started just twice at three, taking the GI Vanity Invitational H. by a head in July. It appeared her racing career was over when she was injured that summer, but she recovered and added three stakes wins in 2006, including the GII Shirley Jones H. in March and the Dec. 3 Marina de Chavon S. at Calder in what proved to be her final race. Owned by Peter Vegso, Splendid Blended retires with a record of 13-7-1-0 and earnings of \$742,060. "It's absolutely sad to see her go, but she deserves it," trainer Bill Mott said.



## Barbaro Update

### BARBARO UNDERGOES PLANNED PROCEDURE

KENNETT SQUARE, PA...As previously planned, Kentucky Derby winner Barbaro was placed under general anesthesia (yesterday) morning to fully examine his left hind foot. "While his condition was unchanged over the last two days, we were unable to fully assess his left hind foot with him in his stall," said Dr. Dean W. Richardson, chief of surgery. "In today's procedure, another area of undermined hoof wall was removed. The left hind deep digital flexor tendon was cut to help decrease the pull on the coffin bone by that tendon. This was previously done in July, but the tendon had healed and was pulling on the coffin bone, contributing to the malalignment of the coffin bone. Because he has been more uncomfortable on his left hind, we put a cast back on the right hind lower limb for additional support." Dr. Richardson reports that, "Barbaro was awoken from anesthesia once more in the recovery-pool and had an uneventful recovery. He continues to receive intensive management for his discomfort on the left hind foot." Barbaro remains in the Intensive Care Unit of Penn's George D. Widener Hospital at New Bolton Center. The next update will be posted on Tuesday, Jan. 16, unless there is a significant change in Barbaro's condition.

With no official word coming on the cases of 10 jockeys banned from tracks in Florida and Pennsylvania last month, many of the riders in question have been forced to seek employment outside of their respective circuits while attorneys continue looking into their legal options. According to Jockeys' Guild representative Herbie Rivera, several of the banned jockeys are working as exercise riders on farms in Ocala, Florida. They are in limbo awaiting results from meetings between track management and attorneys in a case that reportedly involves a TRPB investigation of suspicious wagering on one or more races at Great Lakes Downs in Muskegon, Michigan. Rivera and fellow Jockeys' Guild representative Larry Saumell are seeking access for the riders on the East Coast. "We're trying to put together something where they can hopefully ride somewhere in the next week or so, even if it's just galloping," Rivera said. "Usually when tracks deny access because of the private property law you're still allowed to ride in other jurisdictions, so it was a major setback when Gulfstream didn't let them ride." The wave of bans began Dec. 15, when officials at Calder Race Course enacted their rights as private property owners to eject jockey Rene Douglas from the grounds. Jose Bracho was ruled off that track on Dec. 16, three days before officials at Tampa Bay Downs banned Jorge Bracho, Derek Bell, Luis Castillo, Jose Delgado, Terry Houghton, Joseph Judice and Ricardo Valdes. "Zabeel is fine, and after we overcame problems in early spring he will end up with 100 in foal from 106 covered," Hogan said. "But he is 20 now and what we will be doing from this season onwards is restricting his book to 100 mares. He is the greatest active sire [in Australasia] with 35 individual Group 1 winners, but because his horses aren't early types, he had a slow start."
