**SOUNDING OFF IN THE SAN MARCOS**

With all the pre-race hype surrounding the Richard Mandella-trainee **Boboman** (Kingmambo), winner of his last three starts including the G1 Hollywood Turf Cup Dec. 9, it was Neil Drysdale who stole the show with a come-from-behind charge from Burt and Jane Bacharach's **One Off** (GB) (Barathea {Ire}). Unhurried in eighth early behind pedestrian fractions carved out by **Hello Sunday** (Fr) (Poliglote {GB}), who was flanked by favorite Boboman, the seven-year-old had yet to improve his position after a mile in 1:37.41. **Notable Guest** (Kingmambo)--one of three horses in the field trained by Bobby Frankel--closed from off the pace and looked like a winner midstretch, but it was

One Off who had the most momentum late as he swept to the fore in the final strides to give Drysdale his third victory in the San Marcos. The favorite faded to finish last of eight. "It didn't look like there was any pace on paper, so Neil [Drysdale] told me I wouldn't have to take the horse back," said winning rider Brice Blanc. "The plan was to be on the lead or sit second or third early. Two jumps out of the gate I got squeezed and my horse threw his head a little bit, so I got a little further back early than I wanted. The way it ended up, we had a comfortable pace and I was trying to save ground and then move out and keep him clear. When I asked him to pick it up, he really came on." *cont. p3*

**1340 NOMINATIONS FOR WORLD CUP CARD**

The \$21-million Dubai World Cup Card attracted a record 1340 nominations from 23 countries. Entries for the day's featured event, the \$6-million G1 Dubai World Cup, are highlighted by G1 Breeders' Cup Classic winner **Invasor** (Arg) (Candy Stripes) and G1 Cigar Mile H. winner **Discreet Cat** (Forestry). Other nominees are **Lava Man** (Slew City Slew), **Premium Tap** (Pleasant Tap) and Japanese star **Admire Moon** (Jpn) (End Sweep). Lava Man and Admire Moon are also nominated to the \$5-million G1 Dubai Duty Free, as are **Daiwa Major** (Jpn) (Sunday Silence) and **Bullish Luck** (Royal Academy). G1 English Derby winner **Sir Percy** (GB) (Mark of Esteem {Ire}) is entered for the \$5-million G1 Dubai Sheema Classic. He is joined on that list by G1 Melbourne Cup winner **Delta Blues** (Jpn) (Dance in the Dark {Jpn}), G1 Breeders' Cup Turf winner **Red Rocks** (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) and G1 Hong Kong Vase winner **Collier Hill** (GB) (Dr Devious {Ire}). *cont. p2*

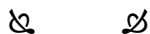


**Nominations for World Cup cont.**

GI Breeders' Cup Sprint winner **Thor's Echo** (Swiss Yodeler) has been entered in the \$2-million G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen, while **Win River Win** (Virginia Rapids) and **Jack Sullivan** (Belong to Me) highlight nominations to the \$2-million G2 Godolphin Mile. "To hopefully have the two best horses [in Invasor and Discreet Cat] in the world compete at Nad al Sheba for the world's richest race, has all the makings of a classic," said Frank Gabriel, Jr., chief executive officer of the Dubai Racing Club. "The standard of entries for the other six races at the meeting is also of the highest order and the count-down to what should be a truly spectacular meeting is well and truly on." The World Cup card, scheduled for Mar. 31, features four Group 1 races and two Group 2 races for Thoroughbred, plus a Group 1 race for Purebred Arabians.

**LAVA MAN & 'SAINT' READY FOR MILLIONS**

Eclipse Awards finalist **Lava Man** (Slew City Slew) worked six furlongs at Hollywood Park Sunday morning while preparing for the Sunshine Millions Turf at Santa Anita Jan. 27. Under regular rider Tony Romero, the six-year-old completed the task in 1:12.80, the ninth fastest of 40 works at the distance. "Fantastic, just great," said trainer Doug O'Neill, describing the

move. According to O'Neill, the gelding will follow the turf with a start on the grass in Dubai before possibly trying to repeat last year's feat of capturing Southern California's triumvirate--GI Santa Anita H., GI Hollywood Gold Cup and GI Pacific Classic. Also preparing for the Sunshine Millions series, **Sweetnorthernsaint** (Sweetsouthernsaint) worked four panels in :49 flat at Gulfstream Park Sunday. The gelding, who is expected to start in the nine-furlong Classic at Gulfstream, was the 10<sup>th</sup> fastest of 29 moves yesterday. The four-year-old, winner of the GII Illinois Derby and runner-up in the GI Preakness S. last term, finished third in his 2007 debut in the GIII Hal's Hope H. at Gulfstream Jan. 6.

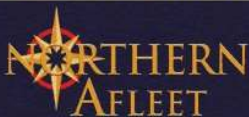
