ALL DOLLED UP

Pussycat Doll (Real Quiet), off since a gritty victory in the GI Humana Distaff H. last May, showed no signs of rust with an authoritative four-length victory in yesterday's GI Santa Monica H. at Santa Anita. The five-year-old mare led the second flight behind a four-way battle for the early lead. She charged to the front in upper stretch and easily drew clear for her third Grade I victory. The impressive performance off a nine-month layoff did not surprise winning rider Garrett Gomez. "She had been training really well and I got the opportunity to work her a couple times, so I knew she was ready," said Gomez. "On paper it looked like the one, [Maryfield], three [Indian Flare] and 10 [Win McCool] would all show a lot of speed, so I didn't want to be in too much of a hurry, but I didn't want to give her too much to do late either. I was able to find a good spot and we ended up in great shape." Winning trainer Bob Baffert, who saddled his first winner 28 years ago yesterday, has given Pussycat Doll plenty of time between races. "When you have a really good one like this, you have to take care of it," he explained. "She was in a good spot [down the backstretch] and when I saw :44 flat, I thought it should suit her fine." The victory was vindication for owner/breeder Mike Pegram. "Now I know why we didn't breed her," he said.

RAZZMATAZZ FROM RAMAZUTTI

Ramazutti (Honor Grades) took charge a furlong from home and held sway late to score by 1 1/4 lengths in yesterday's GI Mac Diarmida H. at Gulfstream Park.

The five-year-old gelding was winless in 10 starts last year while racing exclusively in graded company, but he did hit the board in the 2006 renewals of the GIII Pan American H. and GIII Louisville H. He had been off since running third in the off-the-turf GII W L McKnight H. Dec. 16.

Ramazutti enjoyed a perfect stalking trip yesterday, racing in third as **Mending Fences** (Forestry) set solid fractions. "I definitely didn't want to be in the lead," explained winning jockey John Velazquez. "There was some speed out there and I didn't want to go head-to-head. It worked out good for me." When Velazquez asked his charge for more, Ramazutti moved confidently to the lead and was always holding **Dreadnaught** (Lac Ouimet) for the win. Winning trainer Anthony Sciametta, Jr., deputizing for Todd Pletcher, said the Mac Diarmida provided the traditional front-running Ramazutti with an education. "Johnny and I talked about it and we thought that if Mending Fences went, this could be a great chance for him to learn how to sit off the pace," Sciametta said. "The only question with him was how would he run behind horses, but he did it very impressively. He needed this." **Chart p3**

NZB LAUNCHES NATIONAL YEARLING SALE

A total of 1362 yearlings have been catalogued through the first three sessions of this year's New Zealand Bloodstock Sales Series, headed by the two-day Premier Sale which begins today in Karaka. The Premier session will be immediately followed by the Select Yearling Sale and the single-session Festival Sale before resuming with next month's Carnival Sale. The Premier session features 459 lots, including 16 yearlings out of Group 1-winning mares and 26 individuals that are full or half-siblings to Group 1 winners. A pair of first foals out of Australasian champion mares are expected to bring plenty of attention at this year's sale. [Lot 137](#), a colt by Stravinsky offered by Pencarrow Stud, is the first foal out of G1 Melbourne Cup and G1 Caulfield Cup heroine Ethereal (NZ) (Rhythm); while Cambridge Stud will be well armed with [Lot 411](#), a colt by Zabeel (NZ) out of Sunline (NZ) (Desert Sun {NZ}), who was Horse of the Year in Australia on three occasions (2000-02) and also collected that title in her native land from 1999 through 2002. "We are pleased with the selection on offer at the Premier Sale, with some exciting stars among a quality catalogue that we think boasts strength and depth to appeal to a wide range of buyers," said New Zealand Bloodstock Marketing and Public Relations Manager Petrea Vela. A total of 16 first-season sires represented by their first southern hemisphere crops will be featured in the Premier portion of the sale: Captain Rio (GB), Dubai Destination, Ekraar, Elusive City, Exceed And Excel, Falbrav (Ire), Grandera (Ire), Hawk Wing, Hold That Tiger, Ishiguru, Lonhro (Aus), Lucky Owners, Reset (Aus), Spartacus (Ire), Statue of Liberty and Thorn Park (Aus). A total of 593 yearlings have been catalogued for the Select Sale, which begins at 2 p.m. Jan. 31 and continues through Feb. 2; and the one-day Festival Sale concludes the week with 310 yearlings offered Feb. 4. In addition, over 200 yearlings will be offered at the single-session Carnival Sale held on March 9 during the Auckland Racing Club's Cup week.



Barbaro Update

UPDATE FROM DR. DEAN W. RICHARDSON ON BARBARO'S CONDITION

KENNETT SQUARE, PA — On Saturday, January 27, Barbaro was taken back to surgery because we could not keep him comfortable on his right hind foot. That foot developed a deep subsolar abscess secondary to bruising when he went through a period of discomfort on the left hind foot. It is not laminitis but the undermining of the sole and part of the lateral heel region are potentially just as serious. We attempted to manage the right hind foot in a cast and then in a custom fabricated brace but it was impossible to have access to the foot for treatment as well as acceptable stability and comfort. We elected to place his right hind in an external skeletal fixation device in order to provide the foot a chance to heal. This means that two steel pins have been placed transversely through his right hind cannon bone. These pins are connected to external sidebars that in turn are connected to a lightweight alloy foot plate. This results in the horse eliminating all weight bearing from the foot; the horse's weight is borne through the pins across his cannon bone. There is significant risk in this approach but we believed it was our only option given the worsening of the right hind foot problem. The major risk of the external skeletal fixation device is that the bone bearing the weight can fracture. Unfortunately, we felt we needed to take this risk because this approach offered our only hope of keeping Barbaro acceptably comfortable. He had a perfect recovery from anesthesia and has been in and out of the sling since then. His left hind foot appears to be stable at this time. We remain concerned about both front feet. Remarkably, his attitude and appetite were excellent overnight. We will continue to treat Barbaro aggressively as long as he remains bright, alert and eating. This is another significant setback that exemplifies how complex his medical situation remains because both hind limbs have major problems. Barbaro remains in the Intensive Care Unit of Penn's George D. Widener Hospital at New Bolton Center. Updates will be provided when new information is available. The racing public hammered Armada into near even-money favoritism and the talented chestnut did not disappoint, taking the Stewards' Cup by a deceptively easy 1 1/4 lengths. Winner of the G2-HK International Mile Trial Nov. 19, a race in which he defeated The Duke (Aus) (Danehill) by 3/4 of a length, he was a bit unlucky to fall to that rival by a head last time in the G1 Hong Kong Mile Dec. 10. Fully expected to reverse those placings and confirm his status as the leading local miler, Armada was a handy third as longshot Helene Pillaging (Aus) (Marauding {NZ}) set the pace from The Duke. Eased out three wide for the drive, Armada took a few strides to wind up, but the response thereafter was decimating and the race was won over a furlong from home. Third to Armada (NZ) in the International Mile Trial Nov. 19, Floral Pegasus found open Group 1 company a bit too strong, finishing seventh, but beaten just 2 1/2 lengths, in the G1 Hong Kong Mile Dec. 10. He cut back to 1400 meters to take the G3-HK Chinese Club Challenge Cup H. Jan. 1 and was favored in this first stepping stone to the Hong Kong Derby over 2000 meters Mar. 18. Bounced around a bit at the break, Floral Pegasus settled in centerfield, but was always covering a lot of ground while outside of horses. He found himself with about five lengths to find in the final quarter mile, but he closed determinedly down the center of the track to win easily at the finish. While distance questions surround the gelding, don't count his trainer among the doubters. "He has beaten a very good field by a length and a quarter and nobody could say he was stopping at the finish," Tony Cruz commented. "We will know more when he runs in the Derby Trial [HK-G2, Feb. 20] over the extra 200 meters."
