**HARD SPUN POSTS BULLET AT OAKLAWN**

Unbeaten **Hard Spun** (Danzig), preparing for the Southwest S. Feb. 19, drilled a bullet five-eighths in 1:00 3/5 at Oaklawn Wednesday morning. Working in company with a pair of stablemates, the bay completed the final quarter in :24 3/5. "Hard Spun's work was perfect," just what we wanted," trainer Larry Jones said of Rick Porter's colt. "The idea was to have some dirt kicked in his face, and it worked out fine. When [exercise rider] Gina [Suiter] nudged him on the shoulder at the quarter-pole, he took off, and finished up great."

Hard Spun captured the GIII Lecomte S. last month at Fair Grounds, and had originally been slated to return to New Orleans for the GIII Risen Star S., which has attracted a full field of 14. Last week, his connections opted to stay at home for Oaklawn's three-year-old series. "Maybe it's just as well we didn't go to the Risen Star," Jones added. "We probably would have pulled the 14." Wednesday's work was designed to teach the free-running Hard Spun to rate. "Up to now," Jones continued, "no horse has gotten in front of him in a race, so he's never had to deal with dirt in the face. But as the races get tougher, he's going to have to learn to deal with it. So this was a good experience for him." He added, "We weren't sure how Hard Spun would handle the Oaklawn track, but he showed us today he likes it. And he also showed he doesn't mind getting a little dirt kicked in his face."

**CURLIN SOLD**

The three-year-old colt **Curlin** (Smart Strike), who made an impressive debut last Saturday on the GI Donn undercard at Gulfstream Park, has been purchased privately by a partnership that includes Satish Sanan, Jess Jackson and George Bolton. The purchase price was not disclosed for the chestnut, who had raced for Midnight Cry Stable and trainer Helen Pitts. Tabled as a *TDN Rising Star* after his 12 3/4-length victory ([video](#)), Curlin was shipped to Fair Grounds yesterday and will bed down with trainer Steve Asmussen. "It's sad and disappointing, but that's the business," said Pitts. Curlin, a son of the Deputy Minister mare Sherriff's Deputy, was a \$57,000 KEESEP yearling.

**CANADIAN CHAMPION QUIET RESOLVE DIES**

Canadian Champion and Horse of the Year **Quiet Resolve** (Affirmed--Quiet Cielo, by No Louder) died after sustaining an injury while in recovery following colic surgery Feb. 1. After undergoing surgery successfully at the Ontario Veterinary College--part of the University of Guelph--the 12-year-old suffered an irreparable injury while attempting to stand during recovery. Campaigned by his breeder Sam-Son Farm, the bay won 10 of 31 lifetime starts, including the 1999 GI Atto Mile and GI Dixie S. the following year and finished runner-up in the 2000 GI Breeders' Cup Turf. Retired to Sam-Son Farm in 2002 with earnings of \$2,346,768, the Sam-Son homebred was buried at the Milton-area farm. "Quiet Resolve was a courageous race horse both on and off the track," said Sam-Son Farm President Tammy Samuel-Balaz. "He was a sentimental favorite of the farm and a horse who always gave you 110% effort in everything he did. He loved to race and to win and will be deeply missed. He was one of a kind."

A total of \$4.4-million in stakes money will be up for grabs during the meet, set to begin May 12 and continue through Sept. 2. "The stakes schedule we're announcing is just the beginning of what will certainly be a tremendous and exciting year at Monmouth Park," said Dennis Dowd, senior vice president of racing for the New Jersey Sports & Exposition Authority, which operates Monmouth Park. **LAWRENCE THE ROMAN BOUGHT BY IEAH**  
International Equine Acquisitions Holdings (IEAH) has purchased a controlling interest in **Lawrence the Roman** (Point Given), a winner in three lifetime starts in New York, including an 11-length gallop in his latest going 8.5 furlongs in the restricted Damon Runyon S. at Aqueduct Dec. 10. Campaigned by Lawrence Roman and conditioned by Richard Dutrow Jr. last year, the sophomore, will remain under the care of Dutrow. Sanford Robbins is also among the shareholders in the colt. "We've had a lot of nice horses with Rick," said Mike Sherack, Vice President of Investor Relations for IEAH. "We've put a lot of faith behind what Rick thinks of horses and our people want to go to the big races." The bay, who breezed three furlongs in :36.95 over Aqueduct's inner track yesterday morning, is expected to make his first start outside of New York-bred company in Saturday's Whirlaway S. at Aqueduct. "I'm expecting the same kind of race from him," said Dutrow. "He's continued to train very well." Dutrow indicated that the colt will be pointed toward the GIII Gotham S. Mar. 3.

Sidelined off that effort, the \$385,000 FTSAUG yearling made just one more appearance in 2006, a disappointing third in Saratoga allowance company July 29. Corinthian won the break here and relaxed just off a moderate pace while Jazil saved ground from sixth. The Belmont winner made a sharp middle move into contention as they raced into the far turn, but Corinthian accelerated from the three path and put the race to rest within a matter of strides. Trainer Jimmy Jerkens is looking for a big year from his more mature charge. "He was really good in the paddock today," he commented. "He ran about as good as I could want today." There was little cause for concern in the Jazil camp. "We were second best today. We ran into a buzzsaw," said Kiaran McLaughlin. "There aren't a lot of excuses."
