FOLK ROMPS IN UAE 1000 GUINEAS

In training under Tom Albertrani's care at Payson Park until recently, the three-year-old filly **Folk** (Quiet American) proved an effective traveler and yesterday coasted home clear by 4 3/4 lengths in the \$250,000 UAE

1000 Guineas under the lights at Nad Al Sheba in Dubai. The bay finished second to Boca Grande in a Belmont maiden in mid-October, then came back to destroy a field of Aqueduct maidens by 10 1/4 lengths Nov. 26. Folk worked at Payson Park as recently as Jan. 27, when she earned the

bullet for a five-furlong breeze, before joining Ismail Mohammed's stable in Dubai. Running yesterday in the colors of Sheikh Hamdan bin Mohd Al Maktoum, Folk quickly took command in the about-one-mile event and never looked back. "I only had her four days as she was in quarantine, having come from America, but she was training very well, and we never had a problem with her in the short time we've had her," said Mohammed. "She has shown just how fast she is and we will go for the UAE Oaks [Mar. 8 at Nad Al Sheba] next." **For video of the race, click [here](#).**

FIRST FOAL FOR AZERI

Horse of the Year **Azeri** (Jade Hunter--Zodiac Miss {Aus}, by Ahonoora {GB}) delivered her first foal Wednesday at Hill 'n' Dale Farms near Lexington, Kentucky. The nine-year-old chestnut, barren to a Storm Cat cover in 2005, produced an A.P. Indy colt on Valentine's Day. Mare and foal are owned by the Allen E Paulson Living Trust. During a stellar racing career, Azeri was named Horse of the Year and champion older mare in 2002. She was again named champion older mare in 2003 and 2004. Among her 11 Grade I victories were the 2002 Breeders' Cup Distaff, 2004 Spinster and 2002 Santa Margarita Invitational H. Azeri also won three straight renewals of the GI Apple Blossom H. She hit the board in 21 of 24 starts, with 17 wins and earnings of \$4,079,820. Azeri will be bred back to Storm Cat this year.

PREMIUM TAP KICKS OFF 2007

Multiple Grade I winner **Premium Tap** (Pleasant Tap) will make his seasonal bow today in the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques Cup--also known as the King's Cup--over 1 1/2 miles at King Abdul Aziz Racecourse in Janadriyah, Saudi Arabia. After his victory in the GI Clark H. Nov. 24 at Churchill, the bay was purchased privately by Saudi King Abdullah bin Abdul Aziz and his sons. He has remained under the care of trainer John Kimmel. Premium Tap breezed five-eighths in :59.80 last Friday at Gulfstream, then left Florida Monday for this engagement. Twice a Grade I winner at nine furlongs, the five-year-old was third in the 10-furlong GI Breeders' Cup Classic Nov. 4, and will be stretching out to 12 furlongs here. "You never know when they go one and a half miles, if a horse is going to handle it," Kimmel said. "But good horses can do good things." His cause will be helped by the fact that the final three furlongs are slightly downhill. Kent Desormeaux has the mount aboard Premium Tap, who will race today under the name Allam. Premium Tap will face **Forty Licks (Arg)** (Not for Sale {Arg}), a champion in Argentina who now races for a member of the Saudi royal family. Forty Licks, trained by Ian Jory and ridden by Mick Kinane, comes into this contest on the strength of a nine-length victory over the local course Jan. 12. Both he and Premium Tap are expected to compete in the G1 Dubai World Cup at Nad Al Sheba Mar. 31.

SUPER FROLIC RETURNS TO TRAINING Graded stakes winner **Super Frolic** (Pine Bluff), originally expected to begin his stud career this year at Millennium Farms, has instead been returned to training with Steve Asmussen. "He was going to get a good crop of foals, but we felt the numbers still wouldn't give him his best chance to succeed as a sire," explained Millennium Farms Controller Jay Ted Neel. "We're talking to several Mid-Atlantic stallion operations who are interested in standing him after this racing season." The seven-year-old has earned over \$1.3 million in five seasons of racing. He won the 2005 GII Hawthorne Gold Cup H., was second in the 2006 GII Californian S. and 2004 GIII Spend a Buck H. and was third in last year's GI Pacific Classic S. and GI Hollywood Gold Cup S. "I'm excited to bring him back to the races," said Asmussen, who trained Super Frolic in his two most recent starts. "He was very sound for an older horse who had competed at the top level of our sport for five straight years."

Latvian President Invited to Kentucky Derby:

Catherine Todd Bailey, the U.S. Ambassador to the Republic of Latvia, has extended an invitation to President Vaira Vike-Freiberga to be the guest of the United States at this year's Kentucky Derby. Born in the Latvian capitol of Riga, Vike-Freiberga fled the country on Jan. 1, 1945 to escape the Soviet occupation. She relocated to Canada in 1954, where she earned a Bachelors and Masters from the University of Toronto and a Ph.D. from McGill University in Montreal. Elected to office in 1999 and re-elected in 2003, Vike-Freiberga, deemed by President George W. Bush as "The Iron Lady of the Baltics" in a 2006 speech, has played a leading role in achieving NATO and European Union membership for her country. She was named a Special envoy of the reform on the United Nations in 2005 and was a candidate for Secretary General of the U.N. in 2006.

GOFFS TRADE MOVES TO A HIGHER PLANE

Part Two of the Goffs February Sale, featuring breeding stock, began with strong trade comfortably eclipsing the best of Part One's offerings as four lots broke through the €200,000 barrier at the Co. Kildare venue yesterday. Giacinto Guglielmi, who purchased the sale topper in 2006, walked away with the top-priced lot after shelling out €400,000 for hip 775, the three-year-old filly **Leavingonajetplane (Ire)** (Danehill). Offered by Pasture Stables, the twice-placed juvenile, who cost €660,000 at the Orby Sale two years ago, is out of a sister to the smart stakes scorer Briolette (Ire) and a half to Pilsudski (Ire) and Fine Motion (Ire). Guglielmi warmed up for his session-topping cameo when securing the stakes-placed eight-year-old mare **Kirtle (GB)** (Hector Protector) for €240,000. Consigned on behalf of a partnership by Gary Swift Sales as hip 754, the three-time winner, in foal to Elusive Quality, hails from the family of G1 Prix du Cadran winner Invermark (GB) and produced her first foal, a War Chant colt, last year. The veteran Italian breeder's name was also on the docket for hip 750, the Castlebridge Consignment's **Kesh Kumay (Ire)**. Closely related to G1 Prix de l'Opera victress Kinnaird (Ire), the nine-year-old winning mare by Danehill--in foal to Peintre Celebre--has already produced the winning juvenile Hard to Explain (Ire), her only representative on the racetrack to date. "The Danehill is a lovely filly from an excellent family," commented Guglielmi, who also outlined immediate plans for his purchases. "They will all come back to my stud in Italy, but they will be covered here in Ireland at Coolmore before then." Brendan Bashford enjoyed the winning nod at €230,000 for hip 840, the Ronald Rauscher-consigned Night Shift mare **Nenuphar (Ire)**, who was sold in foal to Monsun (Ger). "I've bought her for Tony Smurfit," the agent revealed, adding, "She's in foal to a very good sire and has proven herself both ways. She's a stakes winner herself and has produced a champion juvenile and a German Derby runner-up."

Can You Hear Me Now?

Epona Bloodstock's Paul McCartan went to €220,000 for Pasture Stables' Danehill Dancer (Ire) filly **I Hearyou Knocking (Ire)**, hip 721, and commented, "She's a lovely filly from an excellent pedigree and Mr. Brosnan was delighted to get her. She is also by my favourite sire, Danehill Dancer." Peter Doyle, acting for Plantation Stud, gave the Newmarket nursery a welcome boost when acquiring Jockey Hall Stud's hip 887, the four-year-old **Puzzling (GB)** (Peintre Celebre), for what may prove a bargain €160,000. Her page received a major boost when Passage of Time (GB)--who was produced by a half-sister to Puzzling--bested the colts in a strong renewal of the G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud and that close relation is currently second favorite in all ante-post books for the June 1 G1 Epsom Oaks. "She will be visiting [resident stallion] Arafa and, hopefully, Passage of Time can continue to do well for the family this year."
