**HOT HOT HEAT**

Trainer Bobby Frankel may have been in Rio de Janeiro for Carnival, but that didn't stop the show back home. Juddmonte's **Latent Heat** (Maria's Mon) prevailed in the GII San Carlos H. yesterday at Santa Anita after a thrilling battle with **Proud Tower Too** (Proud Irish). Jockey Edgar Prado was in for the ride. "I was very proud of my horse," he said. "Every time I asked my horse to pick it up a little, he found more."

**JERKENS DOUBLES UP**

There were two graded stakes contested at Gulfstream yesterday for older fillies, and a familiar face was in the winner's circle for both. Hall of Fame trainer Allen Jerkens saddled **Swap Fliparoo** (Exchange Rate) to take the one-mile GIII Sabin S. and, three races later, was on hand for **Any Limit** (Limit Out)'s score in the GIII Hurricane Bertie H. "I don't allow myself to get confident, but both fillies were doing well," Jerkens said. "It was a little ticklish mid-week, not knowing what to do

with them in the mud [training]. If you work them in the mud, and something goes wrong, they'll ask you what were you doing sending them out there in the mud. But if you don't work them, they'll get tired [in the race]." Jerkens has the same major goal for both four-year-olds. "It would be nice to get them to the [Breeders' Cup] Filly & Mare Sprint, because the Breeders' Cup is close to home this year [at Monmouth Park], but that's a long way off," he said. The prohibitive 1-5 chalk to start his three-year-old campaign, **Any Given Saturday** (Distorted Humor) posted a professional victory in the Sam F. Davis S. at Tampa Bay Downs yesterday. After breaking his maiden second time out last January, Latent Heat ran third in the GII Santa Catalina S. Mar. 4, but missed the rest of the spring. He returned with a facile romp going seven panels at Belmont June 24 and, after finishing third going two turns in the GIII Long Branch BC S. at Monmouth July 15, paired up allowance/optional claiming victories Aug. 11 and Sept. 8 at Saratoga and Belmont, respectively. The bay faltered to finish only ninth in the GIII Perryville S. at Keeneland Oct. 13, but came out of the race with a minor illness, and trainer Bobby Frankel opted to save his charge for the GI Malibu S. at this track and trip Dec. 26. The result? A stylish two-length victory in 1:21 1/5 that made him even-money here despite the presence of a pair of Grade I winners in Proud Tower Too and Siren Lure (Joyeux Danseur). Latent Heat broke alertly and came up to take the rail away from Proud Tower Too. They were able to put up a relatively soft opening quarter of :22.53, but the Juddmonte colt began to claim the advantage heading into the turn. Despite drifting out a bit, Proud Tower Too came up to engage him approaching the stretch, and the two were on even terms before Latent Heat asserted himself in the final sixteenth. "He broke nice and clean and I didn't want to rush him," jockey Edgar Prado added. "I know Proud Tower Too is very competitive and that he was going to be tough...Both horses fought very hard and I knew if I was going to get beat, it was going to be the bob of a head." For Frankel, the San Carlos was his 863rd victory at Santa Anita (not including Oak Tree). He is just six wins behind all-time leader Charlie Whittingham. Oprah Winney, who captured Aqueduct's Randaroo S. at two and ran third in the GIII Cicada S. last March, posted a front-running victory in the Bouverie S. for New York-breds at Belmont May 7 before heading to the sidelines. The iron grey filly missed the rest of 2006, but returned with a wire-to-wire win in the Interborough H. on New Year's Day at the Big A and was the second choice here. With Tony Dutrow subbing for his suspended brother, trainer Rick Dutrow Jr., Oprah Winney came away cleanly from her rail post and was soon in front. After shrugging off a challenge from stablemate Carmandia (Wild Rush) and GSW Great Intentions (Cat Thief) on the turn, the four-year-old kept on going and found the wire safely in front of the rallying local star Silmaril. "We weren't sure if she'd get 7/8 of a mile, but I knew from her last race when I hit her in the midstretch she kind of resented the whip, so I thought maybe today...I leave my stick down, she might finish better," said winning rider Mike Smith. Swap Fliparoo hadn't had her picture taken since winning the historic GI Test S. at Saratoga, but got back on track with this sharp effort. At times, the grey miss had been at the mercy of her late-running style, and she closed out 2006 with a third to her elders in the GII First Flight H. Nov. 4 at Aqueduct. The Florida-bred rallied from way out of it to claim the runner-up spot in her return, the Sunshine Millions F/M Sprint Jan. 27 over this surface, and was the second choice here to even-money Oonagh Maccool (Giant's Causeway). Swap Fliparoo broke alertly and settled several lengths off the pace set by the favorite and Sugar Swirl (Touch Gold), who both began to tire after a half in :46.57. After saving ground early, the Hobeau homebred angled out turning for home, hit the front in midstretch and opened up in the final furlong. She could try a bit more distance next in the nine-furlong GII Rampart H. Mar. 11. "The only thing is that a mile-and-an-eighth race there might not be enough pace," said winning trainer Allen Jerkens. "She's used to some wicked pace in front of her." straight. The Joseph Shields homebred went up to vie for the lead with Contrast (Unbridled) through an opening quarter of :22.27, but that third choice began to back up on the turn. That threat had barely gone away when My Lucky Free came on the scene. Any Limit turned back that challenge and strode home a determined winner. "Today she showed more speed than I thought she would, but she broke so well, [jockey] Rafael [Bejarano] just let her stay out there," said winning trainer Allen Jerkens.

Hall of Fame trainer Lee Freedman had captured every Group 1 race on offer in Victoria over 24 seasons, except this one. It was the tough mare Miss Andretti who finally gave her conditioner the longed-for win when she took out this second leg of the 2007 Global Sprint Challenge yesterday. Settled midfield early, Miss Andretti began to reel in her rivals about 400 meters from home. At the home turn, she had only to conquer the tearaway early leader Virage de Fortune (Anabaa) before holding off a surprise salvo from outsider Any Suggestion. "She is the complete racehorse over that distance and she is very genuine," Freedman said. "That is probably her main attribute, apart from her brilliance." Miss Andretti is entered for the Mar. 10 G1Newmarket H. and Mar. 31 G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen, but her trainer indicated the only certainty for her future campaign is a trip to Royal Ascot in June for the G2 King's Stand S. and the G1 Golden Jubilee S., the third and fourth legs of the Global Sprint Challenge. The mare has a commanding lead in the Challenge after winning the first two legs of the seven-race series.

One of three horses in the race for trainer Hideyuki Mori, Dubai World Cup nominee **Seeking the Dia** looks to improve on his runner-up effort in this from a year ago. Bred in Kentucky by Jayeff B Stables, the six-year-old was second in the JBC Classic Nov. 3 and followed that by finishing runner-up in the Japan Cup Dirt for the second consecutive season. He hasn't been out since his third-place effort to **Blue Concorde** in the Tokyo Daishoten at Ohi Dec. 29. The latter concluded 2006 with three wins from four starts, but was only ninth in the Japan Cup Dirt.

FOALING NEWS



Ron Franklin, who became a teenage sensation in 1979 when he rode Spectacular Bid to victory in the first two legs of the Triple Crown, is expected to appear before the Maryland Racing Commission Feb. 20 to ask for reinstatement as a jockey. Franklin, now 46, rode 'Bid to wins in the GI Kentucky Derby and the GI Preakness before finishing third in the GI Belmont S. when he was much-criticized for his ride. Since those heady days, he has struggled with substance abuse. When he appears Tuesday, it will be one of many appeals to the commission, which took away his jockey license in 1992. "Ron Franklin has an extensive history with the Maryland Racing Commission," said Jose Molina, Franklin's lawyer. "I think on the surface, it will appear to go smoothly. He's done just about everything they've asked him to do in terms of establishing a level of sobriety. I think they'll be somewhat impressed by the support and monitoring system in place for him in Louisiana. But his track record suggests he is a chronic relapsor."
