TEUFLESBERG UPSETS SOUTHWEST

All the pre-race hype centered on unbeaten **Hard Spun** (Danzig), but it was the front-running **Teuflesberg** (Johannesburg) who powered to a 1 1/2-length victory



in yesterday's Southwest S. at Oaklawn Park. The well-seasoned Teuflesberg, making his 13th trip to the post, set the pace while under a snug hold. He opened up at midstretch and was easily the best. Hard Spun had been on the lead at every

call in his four previous starts, including a wire-to-wire victory in the Jan. 13 Gill LeComte S. But the bay colt, breaking from the outside nine post yesterday, was taken back off the pace while racing wide. He moved into contention turning for home, but flattened out to finish fifth.

SHIPPING PLANS FOR INVASOR

Horse of the Year **Invasor (Arg)** (Candy Stripes), pointing for the Mar. 31 G1 Dubai World Cup, is expected to head to the United Arab Emirates Mar. 20. "We'll leave...about 11 days before the race," said Neil McLaughlin, assistant to his brother, trainer Kiaran

McLaughlin. "We'll do all the work here and just gallop [after shipping]. We pretty much know you don't want to be there too long. But we want to try and do the same things as last year because he came back so well. Heck, he never lost another race after coming back, so we're hoping that happens again." Invasor finished a distant fourth behind Discreet Cat

in his first start at Nad Al Sheba, the 2006 G2 UAE Derby, but was unbeaten in four U.S. outings last season. He followed up on his GI Breeders' Cup Classic score in November with a troubled victory in the Feb. 3 GI Donn H. The five-year-old worked an easy half in :51 4/5 at Palm Meadows Sunday. "There's a lot of time until the World Cup, so we just wanted to get a real easy breeze with him," the assistant remarked.

CONVEYOR'S ANGEL HAS THE BEST VIEW

Conveyor's Angel (Conveyor)'s late kick has earned her the nickname of The Tornado back at the Christopher Paasch barn and that powerful finish was on full display yesterday in the GII Buena Vista H. at Santa Anita. The five-year-old mare overtook **Singalong (GB)** (Singspiel {Ire}) for a first-place finish at 48-1 in the Jan. 24 Tuzla H., only to be disqualified and placed seventh for interference. Looking for revenge yesterday, Conveyor's Angel settled at the back of the eight-horse field as **Mea Domina** (Dance Brightly) was loose on the lead. The pacesetter was overtaken first by **Attima (GB)** (Zafonic) with Conveyor's Angel and Singalong joined the fray passing midstretch. Conveyor's Angel was moving best of all on the outside as Singalong fought gamely between rivals to just nab the runner-up spot. Asked if the Buena Vista victory made up for his charge's disqualification in the Tuzla H., Paasch said, "Well, I would have liked them both, but I'll take this one." "I had a lot of confidence in her," jockey Saul Arias said after winning his first stakes race aboard Conveyor's Angel. "I knew this race was going to be a little tougher than last time, but Christopher told me this filly was really doing well. I knew I was caught a little wide there at the top of the stretch, but I felt she would win."

Tight Spot for Singalong

Singalong (GB) (Singspiel {Ire}) was a narrowly beaten second after fighting her way between rivals in the final yards. "I had a really good trip," commented the mare's rider Garrett Gomez. "I was down inside the whole way. I had to squeeze her a little bit more than I wanted to about the three-eighths pole to get up inside a couple other horses. Down the lane she was tight the whole way and I couldn't get her focused enough where I felt she could get that other gear. She was worried about either side of her the whole way down the lane, but she ran a good race. She was second best today." **Berbatim** (Bernstein) was forced to miss the one-mile contest after tying up.

Silver Wagon, who ended 2006 with an authoritative win in the Nov. 4 GIII Sport Page Breeders' Cup H., was a late-closing third in the Jan. 27 Sunshine Millions Classic in his six-year-old debut. Here, the gray was allowed to settle into stride under Edgar Prado. He moved to the outside for the stretch run and reeled in Ah Day late before spurting clear. "He broke sharp and I was right behind the speed," explained Prado. "I was able to take him outside and you saw what he can do. I wanted to be three or four lengths off the lead and I was pretty comfortable with where I was. My horse has another gear." Trainer Chip Dutrow, deputizing for his brother Tony who was standing in for his suspended brother Richard, said, "He broke really sharp, but going down the backside, I sensed that he was going to be pinned down inside. Teufflesberg was a regular in graded stakes company even before breaking his maiden at Keeneland Oct. 22, with his best effort a narrow runner-up finish behind Scat Daddy in the July 27 GII Sanford S. After running 10th in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, the bay returned to take a Churchill allowance Nov. 25 and added the Dec. 24 Sugar Bowl S. PADUA ACQUIRES INTEREST IN ANY GIVEN SATURDAY

Padua Stables has acquired an interest in Saturday's Sam F Davis S. winner **Any Given Saturday** (Distorted Humor) from the colt's owner WinStar Farm. "Because WinStar farm is run as a business, we continually strive to remain fiscally responsible, which often relegates us to the role of seller," explained WinStar Vice President Elliott Walden. "In the same way that WinStar sold champions Funny Cide and One Cool Cat, and most recently sold Spring at Last, who ran second in the Strub S. last time out, we are happy to become partners with the Sanan Family with such an outstanding Kentucky Derby prospect. We expect great things from Any Given Saturday." Any Given Saturday, who will now race in the colors of WinStar and Padua Stables, is being pointed towards the GIII Tampa Bay Derby on Mar. 17.

STORM MILITARY TO U.S.

Castleton Lyons has acquired a 50-percent interest in MG1SW **Storm Military (Arg)** (Bernstein--Shy Mandona {Arg}, by Shy Tom) from Charles Blaquier's Haras La Biznaga, and the five-year-old will ship to the U.S. to continue his racing career. Bred by La Biznaga, the dark bay has won six of his nine career starts, including the G1 Joaquin S. de Anchorena at a mile in December and the G1 Miguel A. Martinez de Hoz in his most recent outing Feb. 11. He set a San Isidro course record in that race, going 2000 meters in 1:56.82, and has earned \$69,422 to date. Storm Military will join trainer Bobby Frankel's stable in the upcoming week. "I expect Storm Military's performance in North America to further confirm the strength and potential of the Bernstein bloodline," said Castleton Lyons owner Dr. Tony Ryan. "Bernstein has had five Group 1 winners, 15 graded stakes winners and 23 stakes winners. One in every seven of his horses in North America is a stakes horse, even though he had relatively small crops prior to coming to Castleton Lyons." Ten-year-old Bernstein (Storm Cat), a two-time group winner in Ireland, shuttles between Castleton Lyons and Haras La Biznaga.

STREET SENSE RETURN STILL UNDECIDED

Trainer Carl Nafzger said yesterday that Eclipse Award winner **Street Sense** (Street Cry {Ire}) exited Sunday's work in good order, but he has not yet determined when the colt will make his three-year-old bow. The champion breezed five furlongs in 1:00 4/5 over the Palm Meadows main track, the second-fastest work at the distance. "He finished strong," Nafzger said. "I don't know what they got for his last three-eighths, but he looked strong doing it. He hit it right." As to when Street Sense will make his sophomore debut, he added, "I don't think we'll know in a couple of days--I might not know for two weeks."

When Flare Pass was recruited to the Juddmonte broodmare team in 1982, she appeared to have plenty going for her, even though she had failed to win in 11 attempts. For a start, she was a daughter of the exceptional Buckpasser, who was to gain the first of his three broodmare sire championships in 1983. Also, she was a sister to Buckaroo, a Grade II winner who was to become North America's champion sire in 1985, thanks to the magnificent efforts of Horse of the Year Spend A Buck. For good measure, Flare Pass's dam Stepping High was a half-sister to Bebopper, dam of those high-class colts Stop The Music and Hatchet Man.

However, when Juddmonte sent Flare Pass to the sales in 1991, she created minimal interest, selling for a mere \$6,500, in foal to the Derby winner Shahrastani. The subtext, one would think, was that Flare Pass had been a major disappointment during her years at Juddmonte, so isn't it strange that the family descending from her is developing into one of the most important in the Juddmonte stud book?

The family's survival at Juddmonte depended entirely on Flare Pass's Mr. Prospector filly Proflare. Mr. Prospector had established himself as an attractive mate for Buckpasser mares by siring Miswaki, a Group 1 winner at two in Europe in 1980 before developing into a classy sprinter in the U.S. With Miswaki's success earning Mr. Prospector more Buckpasser mares, this cross soon came up with three other very notable runners in Woodman (the top-ranked Irish two-year-old of 1985), Mining (GI Vosburgh S.) and Seeking the Gold (GI Dwyer S. and GI Super Derby). These four stallions have subsequently underlined the value of this nick by collectively siring over 300 stakes winners.

Without being in quite the same league as those four sons on the racetrack, Proflare also advertised the virtues of the Mr. Prospector--Buckpasser cross. A winner at up to 1 1/8 miles, she earned black-type when runner-up in the Prix Amandine over seven furlongs and was also beaten less than a length when fourth in another listed contest.

Mr. Prospector's career as a broodmare sire was still in its infancy when Proflare made her debut as a broodmare in 1988. Since then, though, this extraordinary stallion has developed into the dominant force among America's broodmare sires and has taken the title nine times in the last 10 years. **Cont. p5**



There have been some exceptionally consistent producers among Mr. Prospector's many successful daughters. Names which spring to mind include Prospector's Delite, Coup de Genie, Gold Beauty, Soundings, Red Carnival, Prospector's Fire, Love From Mom, Madame's Gold, Mine Only and Mr P's Princess.

Although Proflare hasn't been represented by a Grade I winner, she thoroughly merits inclusion in this select company as she has six stakes winners to her credit, including five at group/graded level. Her achievement is all the more admirable because she produced stakes winners to five different stallions--Capote (True Flare and Capital Secret), Riverman (the short-lived River Flare), Kris S. (Apple of Kent), Danzig (War Zone) and Hennessy (Set Alight).

The best known from an American viewpoint are Proflare's Grade II winners Apple of Kent (Shuvee H.) and True Flare. Both these mares are being given every chance of matching their dam's outstanding achievements, which is no easy task. Apple of Kent is scheduled to visit Empire Maker this year after three visits to Storm Cat, but it is the three years older True Flare who has already added further glory to this family.

True Flare, in common with some of Capote's other offspring, is longer in the back than one might wish, but that proved no problem on the racecourse. Criquette Head wasted little time in getting True Flare to the races, with the filly following up a winning debut in June with a Listed win in July.

True Flare didn't race again until the following May, when she kept her unbeaten record in another listed race, and she then ran well in defeat, when beaten about 2 1/2 lengths in the French 1000 Guineas. After her transfer to Bobby Frankel, True Flare ran well enough to show she stayed a mile and an eighth, but her only American victory came in the GII Rare Perfume H. over 1 1/16 miles.

True Flare is doing even better as a broodmare, with all of her first four foals earning black-type. Three of them are stakes winners, and her record looks set to improve further, as she has young sons by Storm Cat (a two-year-old named Eagle Strike) and Empire Maker. She is due to Giant's Causeway in early March.


Speed seems to be Latent Heat's main asset, as he showed with his seven-furlong victories in the GI Malibu S. and GII San Carlos H. As he also

had plenty in hand when he won an optional claimer over a mile at Belmont last September, there appear to be plenty of options for the four-year-old, who represents another compelling advertisement for Maria's Mon.

As Alan Porter pointed out a few weeks ago, when Maria's Mon covers a mare with Seattle Slew in her pedigree, he creates at least four crosses of La Troienne via the related Busanda, Better Self, Busher and Striking. There are six lines of La Troienne in Latent Heat's pedigree, so his pedigree should hold plenty of appeal to American breeders when the time eventually comes for this fast horse to retire to stud.

Minister's Joy was beaten a head when second in an off-the-turf allowance at Keeneland Oct. 28.
