OBRIGADO PROVES BEST IN SAN LUIS OBISPO

Obrigado (Fr) (Enrique {GB}) failed to find the winner's circle after closing well in four recent starts, but finally got the job done in Sunday's GII San Luis Obispo H. at Santa Anita. A distant third behind a runaway

Bravo Maestro (Stravinsky), who led by 18 lengths after a half mile in :47.32, Obrigado--in tandem with **Notable Guest** (Kingmambo)--reeled in the tiring leader in the final quarter of a mile. With something left in reserve, Obrigado overtook Notable Guest midstretch and held on gamely to score by a half-length

over stable-mate **One Off (GB)** (Barathea {Ire}). One Off, who brushed the oncoming **On the Acorn (GB)** (Inchiner {GB}) in the final sixteenth, was disqualified and placed third. "It was a strangely run race as far as pace and I was concerned that [Obrigado] didn't have any cover," said winning trainer Neil Drysdale. "He was out there just galloping along and he's a European horse and they want to be covered up." Winner of the restricted Oceanside S. at Del Mar last summer, the gelding ran second in three consecutive graded stakes, including the GI Hollywood Derby Nov. 26. In his only start this term, Obrigado rallied to be third in the GII San Marcos H. Jan. 21. Drysdale indicated that the GII San Luis Rey H. Mar. 24 could be next. ROYAL HIGHNESS REIGNS IN THE VERY ONE

Already a group winner in France, **Royal Highness (Ger)** (Monsun {Ger}) carried that form overseas, winning Sunday's GIII The Very One H. at Gulfstream Park

in Hallandale. Making only her second start for trainer Christophe Clement, the five-year-old tracked respectable opening splits of :23.78 and :48.36 for the half. Up with a swift move on the outside, the bay collared 2-1 second choice **Safari Queen (Arg)** at the top of the stretch and drove past the GII Long Island H. and GII La Prevoyante H. winner late to win by two lengths. "When I turned my filly loose, I felt very confident because I could feel she had so much left," explained winning rider Edgar Prado. "When we went on with that other filly [Safari Queen], I knew she had it. Christophe was very confident before the race."

Bend a Little (Benny the Dip), also trained by Clement, broke down and was vanned off the track after finishing seventh. Preliminary evaluation revealed that both sesamoids in the front left were fractured, according to Dr. Mary Scollay. "The injuries are career-ending, and possibly life-threatening," said Scollay. Bend a Little was expected to be retired following the race. **cont. p2**

Silent Witness (El Moxie) cantered down the Sha Tin stretch for the last time yesterday as a crowd of 35,000 cheered the champion into retirement. Jockey

Felix Coetzee was in the irons for the special farewell appearance and owners Archie and Betty de Silva fought back tears as trainer Tony Cruz looked on with pride. "I just wanted to say goodbye to him," said Archie deSilva. "I just hope that he is happy and healthy and I'm looking forward to paying him a visit in Australia." Silent Witness will enter quarantine in March before

shipping to Melbourne where he will enter the Living Legends home for retired champion Thoroughbreds. "He was the flag bearer for Hong Kong racing and the level of attention Silent Witness received was unprecedented--it still is, judging by the send-off he is receiving today," said Winfried Engelbrecht-Bresges, chief executive officer of the Hong Kong Jockey Club. "We all wish him a happy retirement."

CECIL CONFIRMS CANCER RUMORS

Famed trainer Henry Cecil has revealed to the *Racing Post* that he has been receiving treatment for stomach cancer. Following persistent rumors in Newmarket surrounding the health of the multiple Classic-winning conditioner, Cecil issued a statement which read, "Because of the rumours surrounding my health I am making a statement. I didn't want to discuss it, but I have been having treatment for non-Hodgkin's lymphoma for the last nine months. The treatment has been going well, I am on the mend, and it hasn't affected my work in any way and I have been carrying on as normal throughout and enjoying it. Everyone at Warren Place is looking forward, hopefully, to having a good season and it is business as normal."

Cecil Barn Mapping Out 2007..

Cecil enjoyed success at the highest level in November when Khalid Abdullah's filly **Passage of Time (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) captured the G1 Criterium de Saint Cloud and that homebred will lead a team of around 80 horses from the Warren Place yard in 2007, including the Niarchos family's G2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano scorer **Multidimensional (Ire)** (Danehill). "In general, the string has wintered really well and I am very pleased with how the older horses have done," Cecil revealed on his website henrycecil.com. "We shall have around 80 horses in training for 2007. Last season was a more encouraging one for us and with a little luck this year there could be further progress. We have hopes for some of the horses who have already run with promise--although it is fair to say there are quite a few unknown quantities. Of those that have run, I should mention Multidimensional, while fellow four-year-old **Sound of Nature** (Chester House)--as long as his health problems are behind him--could hopefully become a horse to be respected. Of the three-year-old colts, **Ajaan (GB)** (Machiavellian), **Many Volumes** (Chester House), **Tempelstern (Ger)** (Sternkoenig {Ire}), **Phoenix Tower** (Chester House) and **Walking Talking (GB)** (Rainbow Quest) are among those who could be a great help to the team. Of the fillies, **Passage of Time**, who will probably be trained for the Oaks, and **Brisk Breeze (Ger)** (Monsun {Ger}) are likely to be the spearhead. **Elounda (Ire)** (Sinndar {Ire}), **Galipette (GB)** (Green Desert), **Handset** (Distant View), **Light Shift** (Kingmambo), **Teodora Adivina (GB)** (Fantastic Light) and **Voice (GB)** (Zamindar) all performed as if they should add to the winner's total as long as things go the right way."

BROTHER DEREK TO MISS BIG 'CAP **Brother Derek** (Benchmark), winner of last year's GI Santa Anita Derby, will miss an intended engagement in Saturday's GI Santa Anita H. after a chip was detected in his left ankle. "Basically, he's got a little chip that has to come out and then we're going to turn him out and we'll bring him back for a fall campaign," said trainer Dan Hendricks, who expects the four-year-old to be out for four months. "It's not the end of the world. We'll do a

nuclear scan Tuesday." Owned by Cecil Peacock, the bay was third in his most recent start in the Feb. 3 GII Strub S. at Santa Anita. In related news, Alex Solis, who was slated to ride Brother Derek in the Big 'Cap, will now ride GI Hollywood Turf Cup winner **Boboman** (Kingmambo) in Saturday's feature. In preparation for the 1 1/4-mile test, the bay worked five furlongs on Santa Anita's main track in :58.80 Sunday. "He was very impressive," said Solis, who was aboard for the move. "The work went like [trainer] Richard [Mandella] wanted it."

EHV-1 CASE LEADS TO MARYLAND, VIRGINIA RESTRICTIONS *By Erin Ryder, courtesy bloodhorse.com*

A confirmed case of neurologic equine herpesvirus-1 (EHV-1) at an equine hospital in Leesburg, Va., has resulted in numerous hold orders at farms in Maryland and Virginia as horses released from the hospital after being exposed to the sick horse are tracked back to their home farms. "All the horses that are still here are now quarantined and isolated," said Dr. Nat White, director of the affected hospital, Virginia Tech's Marion duPont Scott Equine Medical Center. "Horses that were discharged before we knew what the situation was have gone back to their farms. The state veterinarians in both Maryland and Virginia are contacting those farms and making a decision about quarantining and or monitoring." Although there are no suspected positive cases in Maryland, state officials there have placed 13 facilities under investigational hold orders, restricting equine movement onto or off the property. Ten private facilities in three Virginia counties have also been quarantined. According to the Virginia Department of Agriculture, these restrictions cover approximately 175 horses. Three horses at the equine medical center in Leesburg, Va., have shown neurologic signs consistent with EHV-1 and are in isolation. The entire hospital has been quarantined with 15 horses remaining at the facility. No new cases will be admitted until officials release all of the horses. This is the first time the center has been quarantined since it opened in 1984. According to White, the index case was admitted to the hospital in early February for colic surgery. This horse recovered in the hospital for several days before exhibiting a fever, at which time it was immediately isolated from other horses. EHV-1 is a strain of herpesvirus that can cause respiratory disease, abortions, fevers, and neurologic signs that range from incoordination and weakness in the hind limbs to paralysis.

Last year's juvenile filly champ Dreaming of Anna was looking to get back on track after losing her unbeaten record in the GIII Old Hat S. two weeks ago, but once again came up short, this time to the Todd Pletcher-trained Audacious Chloe.

Trainer Wayne Catalano had no excuses for Dreaming of Anna. "It's never encouraging if you don't win, but we were just second best today," he said.
