**DERBY TRAIL HEATING UP**

The road to the GI Kentucky Derby heats up with major prep races on both coasts Saturday. Trainer Barclay Tagg will saddle an early Derby favorite in **Nobiz Like Shobiz** (Albert the Great) in the GII Fountain of Youth S. at Gulfstream. The once-beaten bay is coming off a 1 1/2-length victory in the Feb. 3 GIII Holy Bull S. and the colt has moved forward off of that effort, according to Tagg. "He's doing fine," Tagg said during a national teleconference yesterday. "He hasn't missed any works. We were slowed down a little by bad weather, but he didn't miss any works. He came out of the Holy Bull well. I don't think it was a hard race on him and I thought [jockey] Cornelio [Velasquez] was pretty conservative with him, which I wanted him to be." Nobiz Like Shobiz, who has only started four times, showed some immaturity down the stretch in the Holy Bull. "He's a bit green," Tagg admitted. "He's a great big horse, and he was probably looking at the crowd. I think we got that corrected and I hope we won't see that anymore, but you never know." Tagg, who also trained Nobiz Like Shobiz's dam Nightstorm, said the mare exhibited the same behavior. "She was a typical Storm Cat," Tagg said of Nightstorm. "She was antsy, good-feeling, tough to handle, but a very nice filly and a very, very talented filly." Tagg thinks Nobiz Like Shobiz is an ideal Kentucky Derby candidate. "If you were to sit down and design a horse for the Derby, this horse is it," he said. "He is the most perfect type that you could ever go into a race like this with. He has very, very beautiful conformation, he's a great big horse and he does things very very easily, and his mental attitude is very good."

**Gorham Goes For the Gold in the FOY...**


Also going postward in the Fountain of Youth is trainer Michael Gorham's **Adore the Gold** (Formal Gold). The dark bay colt will be stretching out to 1 1/8 miles after winning the 6 1/2-furlong GII Swale S. in his most recent start Feb. 3. "I don't have a problem with him routing," Gorham said yesterday. "In his second start he won at 1 1/16 miles at Delaware and he rated kindly. He's the kind of horse that is speedy, but not the headstrong type of horse where he doesn't rate. I'm certain two turns won't be a problem." After romping home while in for a \$50,000 tag in his debut at Delaware last September, Adore the Gold won that track's Dover S. He suffered his only loss when fifth in the GIII Nashua S.--a defeat Gorham blamed on his charge not handling the track--but rebounded with a stakes win at Laurel in December. "I'm just gauging day to day with the horse," Gorham said. "He's done everything we've asked of him and hopefully he'll continue on that way."

**O'Neill Troops in the Hunt...**

Saturday's major West Coast prep is the GII Robert B. Lewis S. which has attracted **Great Hunter** (Aptitude), one of an army of Derby hopefuls from the barn of Doug O'Neill. The dark bay, winner of the Oct. 7 GI Lane's End Breeders' Futurity, has been off since running third in the Nov. 4 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. Of the long layoff, O'Neill explained, "He's already proven himself. He had a good campaign as a two-year-old. Our goal with him is the first Saturday in May, so we gave him a breather." O'Neill said Great Hunter is ready to race Saturday, but admitted the horse will not be pressed too hard, too soon. "He's doing great, but we're definitely not going to have him super-involved in the race early," O'Neill said. "So we'll be at the mercy of the pace. If they're not going that fast, we might not be able to get them. But fitness-wise, he's great. When you give a horse a breather, you hope when they come back to build and build and build and that's what we hope he does this year." Cont.



O'Neill's other Derby contenders include **Liquidity** (Tiznow), **Notional** (In Excess {Ire}) and **Cobalt Blue** (Golden Missile). Liquidity was passed late when second in the Dec. 16 GI Hollywood Futurity and again in the Feb. 3 GIII Sham S. O'Neill said he doesn't think Liquidity's problem is stamina, but admitted, "He might have a trainer problem," while adding he was debating whether to take blinkers off for the colt's next start. "Liquidity is a little lazy and hasn't figured out being super competitive down the lane," O'Neill said. "But I think he might be the most talented of the group that I have." Liquidity will likely go next in the Mar. 10 GII Louisiana Derby and could return to California for the Apr. 7 GI Santa Anita Derby. Plans for GIII Risen Star S. winner Notional remain undecided, while recent allowance winner Cobalt Blue will aim for the Mar. 17 GII San Felipe S. Also in the O'Neill mix is the newcomer **Family Talk** (Talk is Money), who recently broke his maiden at Fair Grounds for trainer Steve Asmussen. The bay is expected to start next in the Mar. 10 GIII El Camino Real Derby at Bay Meadows.

**ALL-WEATHER DAM SIRES: GET APPROVAL**

Following the publication of our list of leading all-weather sires last week with seven or more all-weather starters at the tracks covered, we've reviewed the material and have prepared some statistics on all-weather dam sires covering the same period. While conceding that statistics on all-weather racing are in their infancy (and therefore are going to take plenty of tweaking), and that it's awfully early to be raising the bar as far as the number of all-weather starters is concerned, I felt the accompanying "leaders' lists," based on sires and dam sires with 25+ all-weather starters (rather than seven-plus) are perhaps more meaningful. We've still kept a file with seven as the line of demarcation, covering 760 broodmare sires with seven or more all-weather runners (click [here](#)), as well as an alphabetical file with all 2,588 dam sires of one or more all-weather starters during the period, and at the tracks covered (click [here](#)). What we're publishing in this issue is the Top 50 Dam Sires of All-Weather Starters in North America and Great Britain, listed by cumulative average-earnings index, as well as the Top 50 Sires, compressed from last week, also with 25+ all-weather starters.

The first name that jumps out from the dam sires list is With Approval, bought by Kirsten Rausing's Lanwades Stud and transferred to Britain from Brookdale Farm in Kentucky for the 2006 season. Caro is proving a major influence for gray coat color for starters, as he's the dam sire of both Unbridled's Song and Maria's Mon, but he's also proving a major influence for 'class in the dam' and class, generally, for that matter. With Approval, a gray, is by Caro out of the Buckpasser mare Passing Mood (later the dam of Touch Gold), and all he did was win the 1989 Canadian Triple Crown for his breeders, Kinghaven Farm. In his new role as King of the All-Weather dam sires, With Approval stars as the dam sire of the ill-fated With a City, winner of the GII Lane's End S. at Turfway last March and Twilight Meteor, winner of the off-the-turf Bourbon S. at Keeneland last October. That gives With Approval a 3.50 cumulative AEI as an all-weather broodmare sire, and that tops the charts by a wide margin. Silver Hawk ranks second, with a 2.47 AEI.

You may remember from last week that the ratio of winners to starters is right around 22 percent for all sires, both in North America and Great Britain. While it is a relatively small sample size of a database still in its infancy, I thought it was interesting that the top three dam sires all had winners-to-starters percentages well above 30 percent.

While a lower percentage doesn't really constitute a big negative, especially when an index is based on earnings (and a non-winning stakes placing can be worth a lot of points), it is nonetheless true that seeing a percentage in the 30s is good news. Thus, dam sires like Silver Hawk (49 runners, 36.73 percent), Alydar (46 runners, 34.78 percent), Efisio (67 runners, 32.84 percent), and Last Tycoon (119 runners, 33.61 percent)--all of whom have all-weather dam sire cumulative AEI's above 1.75--are combining consistency plus class, at least in this context.

I made a few notes looking through the lists. On the Top 50 Dam Sires list, I noticed Kingmambo ranks number six overall, with a 2.22 index. As a sire, he does seem to prefer Europe, and it's interesting that he arrives at his dam sire ranking from an 0.51 index in North America (15 starters on the all-weather as a broodmare sire), but a 4.19 rating (13 all-weather starters) in Europe. It's especially interesting because it's my view that he ranks right alongside Quiet American, generally, as another of the very best living broodmare sires around.

Of other leading sires, Storm Cat (1.70), A.P. Indy (1.59), Seeking the Gold (1.53), and Shirley Heights (1.47, from 139 all-weather starters in GB) all ranked among the top 50 dam sires on this list. Perhaps they should be among the leaders anyway, I don't know.

We do have to recognize that all-weather racing, particularly in Britain with its 0.22 percent stakes winners-to-starters ratio, has generally been the venue for moderate horses. That's less the case for North America, as we discussed last week. Given the massive 'infancy' caveat, the likely best application of the statistics so far is to be able to say that certain sires in North America seem to operate well on the all-weather. There is always more of a distribution among broodmare sires anyway, which in a funny way means it is probably more meaningful when these top sires have good all-weather ratings as broodmare sires. It probably does mean they're good all-weather dam sires.

A couple of other things struck me about the dam sires list. One was the prevalence of Pleasant Colony, and Ribot generally. Pleasant Tap (2.38) ranks number four on the hit parade, while his sire, Pleasant Colony (1.77), and another of his sons, St. Jovite (1.37)--now a jump sire in Ireland--also show good form as all-weather broodmare sires. Lost Code (1.45) and Stalwart (1.40) are two other Ribot-line sires on the list. The Forli-line sire Efisio, unfortunately recently deceased, is noteworthy in that he ranks among the top 25 on both lists, with a very similar profile in each. As an all-weather sire, he has 34.29 percent winners to starters (36 of 105), with a cumulative all-weather AEI of 1.92. As a broodmare sire, he has 32.84 percent winners to starters (22 of 67), and a cumulative all-weather AEI as a broodmare sire of 1.85. The message is that, very clearly, Efisios handle the all-weather. Finally, it was pretty interesting, again back on the broodmare sire front, that Dominion has a cumulative all-weather AEI as a broodmare sire of 2.02, one of only eight sires with 25+ all weather starters to have a dam sire index over 2.00. He ranks seventh. Ranking sixth, one place ahead of him, is his son Nomination with a 2.20 index. Message: don't be afraid to try anything with Dominion's name in the pedigree on the all-weather.

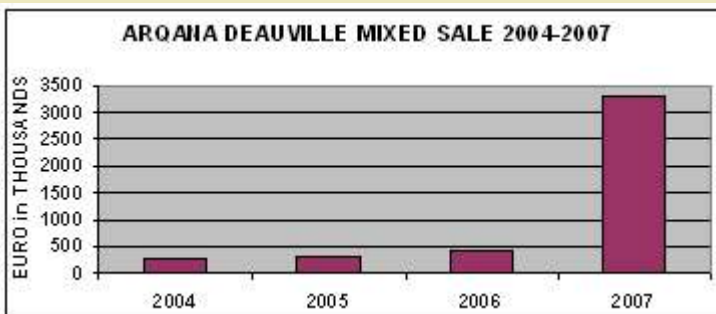

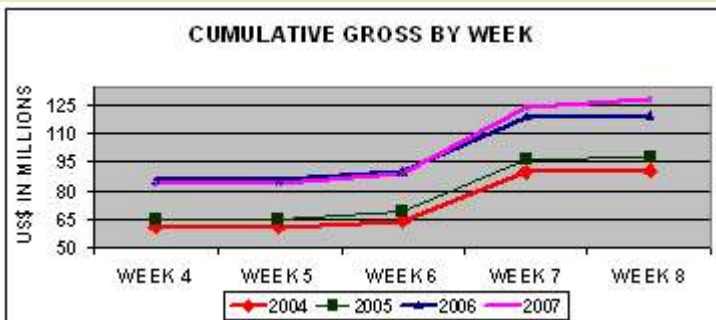
## BRADLEY THOROUGHBRED BROKERAGE

J'ray was one of the dominant two-year-old turf fillies of her crop in 2005. After finishing off the board on dirt in her debut, she switched to the grass to take a maiden at Saratoga, the Jessamine County S. and the Selima S. She then added a fourth consecutive victory by taking the Tropical Park Oaks on her third birthday. Surprisingly beaten as the favorite for the Appalachian S. next time out, J'ray was then sidelined for six months. She returned to finish sixth--although beaten less than three lengths--in the GIII Valley View S., and was then narrowly beaten in the three consecutive graded attempts. After closing to miss by a neck in the GII Mrs. Revere S., she fell just a head short in the GIII Francis A. Genter S. In the GIII Suwannee River H., J'ray did get in front close to home, but was caught late by Naissance Royale. But by last weekend, J'ray was apparently tired of close calls, as she left no doubt in the GIII Bayou Breeders' Cup H. when she powered clear by 4 3/4 lengths.

J'ray's sire Distant View was an English-trained son of Mr. Prospector. He had something of an unusual career in that he won only two of his seven starts. One of which came in a maiden event, and yet ended his career as the highest-weighted colt of his crop.

Although beaten in a maiden race on his debut, Distant View challenged for the G1 2000 Guineas in only his second lifetime start. Given his inexperience, he ran well there to take fifth in a field of 23, beaten just under four lengths by the winner Mister Baileys. After breaking his maiden, Distant View once again tackled the best in the G1 St. James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot. He led in deep stretch before being caught on the line by a head to Grand Lodge, but with Turtle Island and Green Tune--respectively winners of that year's G1 Irish and G1 French 2000 Guineas--behind him. Distant View's next race saw him produce the performance which gained him top ranking on the year-end classifications. Accounting for his elder Barathea, Distant View took the G1 Sussex S. in record time, with Grand Lodge, Mister Baileys and the G1 1000 Guineas heroine Sayyedati all behind him. After this spectacular victory, Distant View's two subsequent starts were an anti-climax. He finished fifth as favorite in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S.--when he may well have been unsuited by the rain-softened going--and he could do no better than seventh in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile, won by his Sussex victim, Barathea.

Retired to Juddmonte Farms' Kentucky nursery, Distant View never succeeded in establishing himself as a really commercially popular sire. That said, he did sire more than his share of very talented performers, even though he only has 16 stakes winners from nine crops. In fact, in his first crop he came out with Observatory, a champion at three in England by virtue of his win in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. (over Giant's Causeway) and G1 Prix d'Ispahan; Distant Music, winner of the G1 Dewhurst and G2 Champagne S. at two; Decharchy, successful in the GII Frank E. Kilroe Mile H. and GIII Tanforan H.; the multiple graded-stakes winning sprinter Explicit; and Fateful Dream, who took the GIII Inglewood H. Had this strike rate been maintained, Distant View might have been on his way to stardom, but his second crop produced no group or graded winners, and just one stakes winner. Distant View's third crop supplied his two highest earners, Keeneland Swan, who earned over \$2.6 million in Japan; and Sightseek, a brilliant filly at four and five, when she captured seven Grade I events. Since then, Distant View's only group/graded scorers have been J'ray and Distant Way, who captured the G1 Premio Presidente Della Repubblica in Italy last year. The chestnut stallion has now been pensioned.

J'ray's dam Bubbling Heights was purchased for 22,000 guineas on behalf of J'ray's owner and breeder, Lawrence Goichman by John Walsh Bloodstock at the 2000 Newmarket December Sale. At the time, she had produced a non-winner by Dr. Devious, a Desert King colt, who was subsequently stakes-placed in France, and a colt by Entrepreneur, who eventually won once in France. The foal she was carrying was a non-winning Gold Away colt. Her first U.S.-conceived foal--born the year before J'ray--was Strike Eagle, an El Prado filly who suffered a paddock injury prior to her racing career. She is now in Goichman's broodmare band. Bubbling Heights is also the dam of The Ag, a three-year-old Bahri filly who is in training with Todd Pletcher; and a two-year-old Street Cry colt who is entered in the Tattersalls Craven Breeze-Up Sale. She will be bred back to Street Cry this spring.

A daughter of Darshaan, Bubbling Heights is a 3/4 sister to Kotashaan--1993 Horse of the Year and champion turf horse--who was by Darshaan out of Haute Autorite, a half-sister to Bubbling Danseuse, the dam of Bubbling Heights. Bubbling Heights is also a sister to No Frills, the dam of Singalong, a Singspiel filly who won the Tuzla H. at Santa Anita in January and finished second this weekend in the GII Buena Vista H. In addition Feather Bride, a half-sister to Bubbling Heights, is half-sister to Millennium Dragon (by Mark of Esteem, a son of Darshaan), winner of the GII Appleton H. and runner-up in the GI Manhattan H. J'ray's third dam Premiere Danseuse, a daughter of Green Dancer, won the Prix de la Calonne and finished second in the G3 Prix de la Nonette.

J'ray's pedigree was planned with the specific goal of duplicating Never Bend through Riverman (sire of Distant View's broodmare sire, Irish River), and Mill Reef ( grandsire of Darshaan). The most influential stallion sons of Never Bend, Riverman and Mill Reef also have very similar pedigrees. Riverman is out of a mare by Prince John (by Princequillo out of a mare by Count Fleet) and Mill Reef is out of Milan Mill (by Princequillo out of a mare by Count Fleet). The combination of the genetic relatives appears pretty effective as Riverman and Mill Reef combine in more than 40 stakes winners, 19 of them group or graded, including Grade/Group 1 winners Kalanisi, Alexander Goldrun, Shiva, Golan, Sendawar, Special Harmony and Kanetsu Fleuve. The same pedigree factor also appears in J'ray's Street Cry two-year-old half-brother, so it will be interesting to see if lightning can strike twice.

**New Guidelines for Horses Entering Tampa Bay Downs:**

All horses shipping to Tampa Bay Downs to stable or train must provide a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection dated within the 72 hours of arrival. The certificate, which must be signed and dated by the licensed attending veterinarian, must acknowledge that each horse has been vaccinated against Equine Herpes Type 1 (EHV-1) between 14 and 120 days of arrival. A Tampa Bay Downs release states, "Horse or horses represented on this Certificate of Veterinary Inspection have not originated from, nor been stabled on, a premise which has had Herpes Virus (EHV-1) diagnosed during the previous 30 days." According to officials, no horses will be admitted into the barn area for stabling or training from Maryland, Virginia, West Virginia and Pennsylvania until further notice due to the recent outbreaks of the Herpes Virus.

**Colorado State Team Receives First Elastikon Award:**

A research project to be conducted by a team led by Dr. Chris Kawcak at Colorado State University and aimed at avoiding a common type of fracture in athletic horses has been designated the recipient of the first Elastikon® Equine Research Award. The award is made possible by a grant from Johnson & Johnson Consumer Products Company to the Grayson-Jockey Club Research Foundation. The award-winning project is one of 13 new studies recently approved by the foundation board of directors for funding in 2007. Dr. Kawcak's project addresses the shape of the fetlock joint of horses and how minute differences in shape may be related to condylar fracture, a common injury in race-horses. By developing patient-specific computer modeling, the researchers seek to help horse trainers and managers differentiate between normal progression and the shape and type of change that indicates oncoming injury. "This research can be a significant step in warning horsemen before an injury occurs," said Edward L. Bowen, president of Grayson-Jockey Club Research Foundation. "Great strides have been made in treatment of many injuries, but avoiding them is even better."

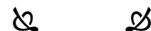
