## WHO'S YOUR DADDY?

It wasn't easy to beat Todd Pletcher at Gulfstream Park yesterday. The reigning Eclipse winner captured five of the 11 races on the card, including three of four graded stakes. **Scat Daddy** (Johannesburg), who gave Pletcher his record 93rd stakes win of the year when taking the GI Champagne S. last October, capped off the day with a nose score over the gallant **Stormello** (Stormy Atlantic) in the GII Fountain of Youth S. It was his first step down the Triple Crown trail.

"He overcame a lot to wear down a nice group of horses," Pletcher said. "I've never doubted he could go two turns. We'll come back in the Florida Derby [GI, Mar. 31], with five weeks to Churchill [GI Kentucky Derby, May 7]." 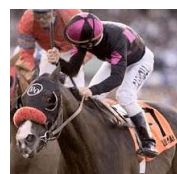
## KING OF THE HUTCHESON

They might think about renaming the race. Trainer Todd Pletcher captured the GII Hutcheson S. for the fifth consecutive year when he sent out **King of the Roxy** (Littleexpectations) for a 2 1/4-length score at Gulfstream Park yesterday. "It's been a great streak," Pletcher said. "It's hard to win a race two years in a row, so it's been fun." A modest \$8,000 KEESEP yearling, King of the Roxy was purchased privately from owner/trainer Richard Matlow after breaking his maiden at Hollywood Park in his second start July 2. Runner-up behind the ill-fated Chace City in his first start for Team Valor, the Aug. 17 GII Saratoga Special BC S., he came back to take the GII Futurity S. at Belmont Sept. 23. The dark bay tried two turns for the first time in the Nov. 4 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile and, after a rough trip, finished a well-dusted eighth. Pletcher felt that his charge was hindered by the fact that he was caught behind horses and got dirt in the face for the first time, but added, "He's probably best in a one-turn situation." The three-year-old joins Lion Tamer (2003), Limehouse ('04), Proud Accolade ('05) and Keyed Entry ('06) in adding a Hutch trophy to his trainer's display case. **Pop the Cork...**

**Scat Daddy** kicked off his career with a 5 1/4-length maiden tally in the mud at Belmont June 3. He came back to beat Teufflesburg by a neck in the July 27 GI Sanford S., but couldn't overcome a stumbling start in the Sept. 4 GI Hopeful S. and finished second to stablemate Circular Quay. The dark bay rebounded with a 3/4-length decision over **Nobiz Like Shobiz** in the Oct. 14 GI Champagne S., and was a well-backed 7-2 in the Nov. 4 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. Trying two turns for the first time, Scat Daddy ran into traffic early and weakened late to finish fourth, 15 lengths behind Street Sense. He made his sophomore bow in the Feb. 3 GIII Holy Bull S. and tired after chasing "Nobiz" around the track to be third. The Holy Bull hero was sent off at 3-5 yesterday, but Scat Daddy turned the tables. Changing tactics, jockey John Velazquez allowed the colt to drop back as the crowd's choice chased GI Hollywood Futurity winner **Stormello** through a half in :46.06 and six panels in 1:09.89. Cornelio Velasquez turned Nobiz Like Shobiz loose as they straightened for home, and it looked like he'd inhale the pacesetter and hold on to his front-row seat in the East Coast three-year-old class. But the bay drifted inside during the stretch run and had to steady briefly. Stormello proved his grit when outgaming Liquidity in the Hollywood Futurity and fought the good fight on the rail here, but Scat Daddy, who took the long way home, drove past the leaders in the dying strides to take the tight photo. "We were wide all the way around, but we got the trip we wanted," Todd Pletcher remarked. "Our plan was to stay right behind Nobiz Like Shobiz. We felt our best chance was to repeat our Champagne effort, and make a run at him late." Nobiz Like Shobiz ran on well enough to be third, and trainer Barclay Tagg was unsure where he would head next with the favorite. "I don't know why he ran like that," Tagg said. "The jock said he was lugging in at the top of the stretch, and you lose a little ground when you straighten him out. The whole thing surprised me. I thought he'd lay third, then go to the front and win. I thought we'd go to the Wood Memorial [GI, Apr. 7], but now I don't know."

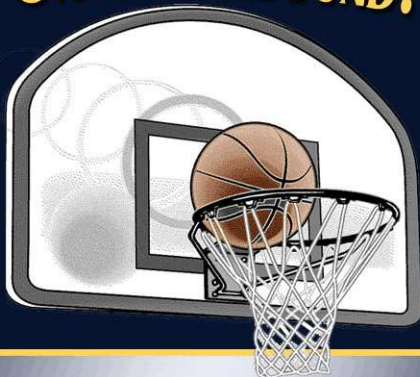

He has trouble on the road, but Lava Man continued his dominance of the California scene with this workmanlike victory. The veteran has now won nine in a row in the Golden State, suffering his last defeat when third behind Borrego in the 2005 GI Pacific Classic. Seven-for-eight last season, with Grade I wins in the Mar. 4 Santa Anita H., June 10 Charlie Whittingham H., July 8 Hollywood Gold Cup and Aug. 20 Pacific Classic, he prepped for the GI Breeders' Cup Classic with a victory in the Oct. 7 GII Goodwood BC H., but failed to fire at the World Thoroughbred Championships, finishing seventh behind Invasor (Arg). Freshened after that effort, he picked up where he left off in his return, taking his earnings over the \$4-million mark with a two-length tally in the Jan. 27 Sunshine Millions Turf at Santa Anita. Back on the dirt for his Big 'Cap title defense, Lava Man settled in third behind longshots Ball Four (Grand Slam) and Spring At Last (Silver Deputy). He forged to the front at the top of the lane and did just what he had to do to get to the wire on top. "We're going to celebrate this moment," trainer Doug O'Neill said. Kip Deville was purchased privately following a four-length victory in Lone Star's Grand Prairie Turf Challenge S. Apr. 29 and made instant dividends for his new owners, finishing second behind Showing Up in the \$1-million Colonial Turf Cup S. June 24. The gray failed to hit the board in the July 15 GII Virginia Derby and the Sept. 9 GIII Kent Breeders' Cup S., but bounced back with a victory in Keeneland's Bryan Station S. Oct. 15. Stepped up in company for the GI Hollywood Derby Nov. 26, he faded to finish sixth. Kip Deville cut back to one mile for the GIII Sir Beaufort S. Dec. 26 and rallied to a one-length tally. Looking for his second straight victory here, the IEAH Stables' colorbearer rated kindly in third for jockey Richard Migliore, rallied to the front in deep stretch and found the wire in time. Great Hunter could have wrapped up a championship season with a victory in the Nov. 4 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, but, after beating Street Sense into third in the Oct. 7 GI Lane's End Breeders' Futurity, the dark bay had to settle for a distant third on the first Saturday in November. That may prove fortuitous on the first Saturday in May, however, as the BC Juvenile winner has yet to wear the blanket of roses. Picked up privately by owner J. Paul Reddam after breaking his maiden at Lone Star Park, Great Hunter was runner-up in the July 4 GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship S., Aug. 13 GII Best Pal S. and, with blinkers added, in the Sept. 6 GII Del Mar Futurity in his first three tries under new management. The Pennsylvania-bred handled two turns and the Keeneland all-weather in his next outing, but couldn't match strides with Street Sense on Breeders' Cup Day. Far from cranked for his first appearance since, Great Hunter had just one horse behind him after a half in :46.83. He hit the gas on the far turn to grab the lead in the stretch and held Sam P. at bay to the finish. His next stop is the Apr. 14 GI Bluegrass S. He made it closer than was absolutely necessary, but Corinthian improved his record to four-for-seven with this narrow score. The irascible four-year-old evidenced bad behavior during the stretch run of the GII Fountain of Youth S. last year and, after hitting the line first, was DQ'd and placed third. He made just one more sophomore start, running a distant third behind Hesanoldsalt and Take the Bluff in a Saratoga allowance test July 29, and was sidelined for the rest of the year. The chestnut returned in an optional-claiming event and was the second choice behind GI Belmont S. hero Jazil, but handed that rival a 9 1/2-length drubbing. He was the even-money chalk to earn his first stakes success. Off to a good start, Corinthian tracked Noble Causeway (Giant's Causeway) through a half in :48.20. He took control as they raced around the final turn and looked to be on his way to an easy score, but allowed Hesanoldsalt to come back at him in the final furlong and was only a head in front when they hit the wire. Half Ours had to hold off the late charge of Park Avenue Ball, but he maintained his unbeaten record in his graded-stakes debut. The roan followed a 10 3/4-length maiden score with a 4 1/4-length victory in the Three Chimneys Juvenile S. in May of 2005. He missed the rest of his two-year-old campaign and nearly all of his sophomore season before returning to take an optional claimer at Aqueduct Dec. 14. Sold at Keeneland November to dissolve the partnership between Aaron and Marie Jones and Barry K. Schwartz, he was hammered down to the Joneses for \$6.1 million. Half Ours followed with an optional-claiming score at Gulfstream Feb. 4 and was the crowd's choice to carry his form into the graded ranks. Half Ours battled Bright One (Dance Brightly) through a half in :43.72, finally shook free of that rival inside the eighth pole, then was all out to hang on at the wire. "He's a really special horse, very talented," trainer Todd Pletcher said. "All the credit goes to the Jones's for their patience. They love this horse."
