Making only his second career start, **Curlin** (Smart Strike) overcame a wide trip to take the GIII Rebel S. by 5 1/4 lengths at Oaklawn Park yesterday. NEVER IN JEOPARDY

Merv Griffin is back in business. A year after having winter-book GI Kentucky Derby favorite Stevie Wonderboy sidelined, the show business legend watched as **Cobalt Blue**

(Golden Missile) led every step of the GII San Felipe S. at Santa Anita yesterday.

"It's alive again," Griffin said, referring to his dream of winning the Derby. "You know, he was born on Abraham Lincoln's birthday--Feb. 12--and his first big win as a three-year-old came on Valentine's Day. Today is St. Patrick's Day, and Derby Day is Cinco de Mayo! He's a holiday horse." Cobalt Blue's next start is expected to be the GII Illinois Derby at Hawthorne Apr. 7. Cont. p3

Making Sense...**

Second in his career opener, Street Sense was tabbed as a *TDN* Rising Star when graduating next out at Arlington Aug. 19. He ran third over a sloppy track in the GIII Arlington-Washington Futurity Sept. 10, and followed that with a similar effort over Keeneland's Polytrack when third to Great Hunter in the GI Lane's End Breeders' Futurity Oct. 7. But a huge performance in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile--he rallied from 11 lengths back, came up a lively rail and scored by 10 lengths--earned him an Eclipse Award as the nation's top two-year-old colt, as well as winter-book favoritism for the GI Kentucky Derby. He was freshened up by trainer Carl Nafzger and didn't hit the worktab this year until Jan. 29. Nafzger had originally intended to start Street Sense back in the 7 1/2-furlong GII Hutcheson S. Mar. 3, but opted to give the colt two more weeks and a slightly longer race for his comeback. After weighing his options, Nafzger opted for Tampa, despite the expected presence of the talented Any Given Saturday.

Back in the Picture...

Street Sense went postward here as the second choice to odds-on Any Given Saturday, winner of the Sam F. Davis S. at Tampa Feb. 17. The champion came away well from post two under Calvin Borel and saved ground in fourth on the first turn, several lengths off the lead. He still had plenty to do approaching the far turn, but quickly made up ground while committed to the rail. He poked his head in front as they straightened into the lane, while the favorite loomed up to the outside. Street Sense appeared to have the race in the bag in midstretch, but Any Given Saturday fought back gamely in the final sixteenth before the Tafel colt took it by a nose and set a new track record. "We had to start somewhere and this seemed like the best place to start," Borel commented. "Believe you me, he's 20 lengths better than he ran today." Nafzger added, "I've said a thousand times, he's a helluva colt. And Any Given Saturday, as I told [trainer] Todd [Pletcher], of all the three-year-olds that have come along except for the Breeders' Cup horses, this horse is about the best. He really ran his race." Street Sense will now head to Kentucky. "We're going to the [GI] Blue Grass S. [Apr. 14, Keeneland] and the [GI Kentucky] Derby," Nafzger confirmed. Any Given Saturday's connections were gracious in defeat. "We ran a super race and got beat by a champion," said Elliott Walden on behalf of co-owner WinStar Farm. "It was a great race."

Curlin debuted in the colors of Midnight Cry Stable Feb. 3 at Gulfstream while under the tutelage of Helen Pitts. He came home clear by 12 3/4 lengths despite drifting out, covered seven furlongs in 1:22 1/5, earned big speed figures and was a *TDN* Rising Star. Not surprisingly, some big names in the business teamed up to purchase the handsome chestnut for a reported \$3.5 million, with Midnight Cry retaining an interest. Curlin joined Steve Asmussen's string at Fair Grounds and impressed his new conditioner in recent weeks. Trying two turns for the first time, he bounced out of the eight hole and was caught a bit wide on the clubhouse turn. He settled in striking position down the backstretch, then pounced four wide on the far turn. Curlin hit the front at the top of the stretch and opened up in the final sixteenth. A coppery chestnut, Cobalt Blue won at first asking last June at Hollywood in a five-furlong maiden, but never factored in the GII Best Pal S. Aug. 13 and came out of the race with a hock injury. Trainer Doug O'Neill took his time with the powerfully built colt and got him back to the races Feb. 14, when he rallied three wide to take a first-level allowance in 1:09. Breaking from the inside, Cobalt Blue was in front after a few strides and set fractions of :23.56, :47.57 and 1:11.64 with Level Red at his flank. Favored Air Commander took a run at him in the stretch, but Merv Griffin's colt shrugged off that challenge and ran on willingly. Trainer Doug O'Neill, who has already had Great Hunter and Notional win Triple Crown prep races this year as well as the MGSP Liquidity, will be juggling his schedule. "Liquidity is going to the Santa Anita Derby, so this guy will probably head out of town," he said. "We'll make sure he comes out of it good, but we were talking about maybe the [GII] Illinois Derby [Apr. 7]." Sweet Fervor, winner of her lone juvenile start, kicked off 2006 by airing in Tampa's Gasparilla S. last January. The Kinsman homebred lost her perfect record when fifth in the GII Forward Gal S. last March, and mirrored that effort in the GII Fantasy S. Apr. 14 before heading to the sidelines. She returned with a sharp allowance tally over this surface Jan. 28 and responded well to this rise in class. Unhurried early at the back of the pack through fractions of :22.51 and :45.38, the chestnut took to the outside in the stretch and set her sights on favored Any Limit. She swished her tail several times, but continued to close and forged ahead late. "She showed ability from the beginning...but just didn't go on in her training," winning trainer Bill Mott explained. "She didn't have any serious problems or need surgery--she just needed time. This was a big race for her today, but I'm not sure how far she wants to go. A six-length winner of the Listed Lingfield Oaks Trial S. in May 2005, Cassydora ran seventh in the G1 Oaks itself, but rebounded with a second in the G1 Nassau S. July 30 and concluded her tenure under John Dunlop with a close third in the G3 Prix de la Nonette in August. Sent to Christophe Clement, the dark bay faded to 11th in the GI E.P. Taylor S. at Woodbine in October and missed her entire four-year-old season. Cassydora returned to action from the Todd Pletcher barn with a Gulfstream allowance victory Jan. 11 and added the Endeavor Breeders' Cup H. over this course Feb. 17. Favored to make it three straight, the five-year-old was eager to get to the lead, though jockey John Velazquez was able to persuade her to settle through fractions of :49.67 and 1:13.34. My Typhoon took a run at her in the lane, but Cassydora had enough left in the tank and turned back the Live Oak mare for her first graded win.

The steadily improving Tuesday Joy brought up the second leg of a Group 1 double for trainer Gai Waterhouse when she produced an eye-catching late sprint to win a rain-soaked edition of the G1 Coolmore Classic. Jockey Darren Beadman was content to dawdle one from last until the home turn, when he weaved his way through the field and came down the outside of the track to reel in the leaders. "She met very seasoned older horses, but running over 2500 metres last spring probably toughened her up," Beadman said. "The runs just kept coming, I crossed to the outside and she just powered from there." Runner-up behind Miss Finland (Aus) in the Nov. 9 G1 VRC Oaks, Tuesday Joy resumed to finish second in the G2 Surround S. at Warwick Farm last time Mar. 3. Asked where Tuesday Joy would head next, Waterhouse said the G1 Arrowfield S. on Golden Slipper day Mar. 31 would be her next assignment before a tilt at either the G1 AJC Oaks or Derby.

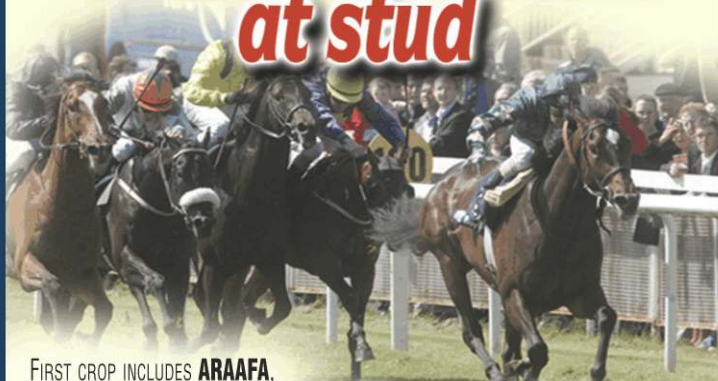

Jockey Hugh Bowman crossed over the field to lead comfortably aboard the gelding, and he and the runner-up scooted to a four-length advantage from the rest of the field at the home turn. Desert War went forward, only to be challenged by Confectioner, but he fought back for a win that underscored his reputation as a tough and durable performer. "There is a lot of hard work behind the scenes and it is a privilege to ride a horse like this--what a warhorse he is," said Bowman. "We got a good break down the back. He is not a sit-and-sprint horse, but when Confectioner came at him he fought back." Trainer Gai Waterhouse said he would be aimed at the G1 BMW S. at the same venue in a fortnight. "I started to get worried when he was only a length or so in front of his opposition, but there is a lot of wind out there and maybe Hugh was being conservative," said Waterhouse. Desert War began his autumn campaign winning the G2 Winning Edge S. Feb. 17 at Rosehill before finishing a short neck second to He's No Pie Eater (Aus) in the G1 Chipping Norton S. Mar. 3.

Trainer Kieran McLaughlin had originally intended on working reigning Horse of the Year **Invasor (Arg)** (Candy Stripes) Saturday at Palm Meadows, but with the threat of stormy weather in the South Florida region, decided to work the G1 Breeders' Cup Classic winner Friday instead. With regular exercise rider Danny Wright aboard, Invasor fired a best-of-19 five-furlong bullet in :59.60. "We wanted to have a decent work because it's his last before he leaves [on Tuesday]," McLaughlin said. "It was perfect...he makes our life easy because he does everything so well. He's such a professional and great to be around." The Shadwell colorbearer suffered his only career defeat at Nad al Sheba, a fourth-place finish behind Discreet Cat in last year's G2 UAE Derby.

STORM MAYOR DUBAI BOUND

Argentine champion **Storm Mayor (Arg)** (Bernstein), two-time winner of the G1 Gran Premio Carlos Pellegrini, has been purchased by Saudi Arabian interests and will contest the \$6-million G1 Dubai World Cup Mar. 31, according to *La Nacion*. The bay has not raced since taking the Carlos Pellegrini Dec. 16 at San Isidro for owner Angel Dijiani. Also sold to the same interests and joining Storm Mayor on the flight to Dubai will be **Bartola (Arg)** (Roy), a three-year-old filly who landed the 2500-meter G1 Gran Premio Criadores Mar. 3 in her most recent start. She will take on males in the \$2-million G2 UAE Derby on the World Cup card.

Undefeated **Discreet Cat** (Forestry), who missed his return to the races in the Mar. 1 G3 Lahan Burj Nahaar due to an elevated temperature, worked one mile in company with stablemate **Count Trevisio** (Danehill) in 1:38 at Nad al Sheba yesterday. He goes next in the G1 Dubai World Cup Mar. 31. Discreet Cat, with jockey Frankie Dettori aboard, bested his stablemate by three lengths after tracking him early. "This was his main work before the Dubai World Cup, so it was pleasing to see that," trainer Saeed bin Suroor said. "He has taken everything in his stride and we're firmly on course. He will have one more blow-out over around five furlongs and that will be it." Dettori

What did you do to celebrate your 3,000th win? My wife had plans, so I just went home and made dinner for the kids and was in bed by about 8:30 p.m. I'm not real big on celebrating milestones. Honestly, it was fun, but I looked at it as another winner. It didn't feel any different from my 2,999th winner.

So it must have been a real drag missing the winter weather at Aqueduct, right? [laughs] Yeah, I saw they cancelled racing today [Friday]. I'm real happy to be out in Southern California. I love it out here, and it's exciting to be home. You can't beat the weather, and I love looking at the same mountains that I looked at growing up.

Most talented horse you've ever ridden? Bayakoa (Arg) and Sunday Silence were two horses that went on to become great horses. I rode them at an early stage in my career and an early stage in their careers. (note: Gryder rode Sunday Silence to a 2nd-place finish to Houston in a Santa Anita allowance when the colt was 2). When Sunday Silence first came to Santa Anita, I rode him in the first work he ever had for (trainer) Charlie (Whittingham). He went in company with another horse and worked five-eighths in 1:02 4/5, and I remember the feeling that he gave me. But I had no idea he'd win the Kentucky Derby.

Favorite vacation spot? Hawaii. I've been there five times. I love the beach. And I was in Dubai three weeks ago, just hanging out on the beach, and I love it.

Were you in Dubai to ride? I was actually riding in the King's Cup in Saudi Arabia. Then I went to Dubai for three days just to hang out. I've ridden in the King's Cup five or six times now and won it twice, in back-to-back years with a horse named King's Boy (Ger).
