### PUTTING A NEW SPIN ON THE LANE'S END

**Hard Spun** (Danzig) reversed the trend of longshot winners in the GII Lane's End S., opening up on his rivals as they raced down the stretch to win by 3 1/4 lengths as the 5-2 second choice at Turfway Park yesterday. With the victory, the handsome bay erased the memory of his only loss, a fourth-place finish in the Feb. 19 Southwest S. at Oaklawn Park. "We were getting a lot of hype early on and stumbled, but picked ourselves back up today,"

owner Rick Porter said. Added trainer Larry Jones, "We all agreed that he was not getting over the Oaklawn track. Thank goodness we had the opportunity to come here." As for what's next, Jones said, "More than likely, and in a perfect world, our next start will be in the [Apr. 14 GI Toyota Blue Grass S. at Keeneland]. He seems to like Polytrack, and Keeneland is almost like home. We definitely want one more prep. Hopefully we can have him ready to peak in two more races."

### "GOLD" FIRES BULLET AT GULFSTREAM

GII Swale S. hero **Adore the Gold** (Formal Gold), prepping for the Mar. 31 GI Florida Derby, worked five furlongs in a bullet :57 3/5 at Gulfstream Park Saturday morning. Exercise rider Carlos Reyes was in the saddle. "He did just what we were looking for and came back fine," trainer Michael Gorham said. "The time was pretty fast, but I think the track was playing that way, and we wanted him to get something out of it. We're all set." The three-year-old, four-for-six lifetime, was fourth in the GII Fountain of Youth S. last time out, just a length behind winner Scat Daddy. Jockey Cornelio Velasquez, who was aboard the dark bay in the Swale, will be back in the irons for the Florida Derby. Also getting ready for the nine-panel Florida Derby, **Notional** (In Excess {Ire}) drilled six furlongs at Hollywood Park, going in 1:12.40, second-fastest of 21 at the distance. The bay is perfect in two starts this term, taking the Jan. 13 GII San Rafael S. and Feb. 10 GIII Risen Star S. Fellow Doug O'Neill trainee **Liquidity** (Tiznow) was also sharp at Hollywood yesterday, going five-eighths in :58.40, the second-fastest of 67 at the trip. Sixth in the Mar. 10 GII Louisiana Derby last time out, he is pointing for the Apr. 7 GI Santa Anita Derby.

**Hard to Hold...**

Hard Spun opened his account with an 8 3/4-length maiden score at Delaware Park Oct. 22 and came back to take an overnight stakes at that track Nov. 14. He

made it three in a row when beating up on fellow Keystone State-breds in the Dec. 18 Pennsylvania Nursery S. at Philly Park (a race also won by GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness hero Smarty Jones), and was the even-money chalk in the Jan. 13 Gill Lecomte S. at Fair Grounds. Unchallenged

during that 6 1/2-length tally, the bay was 1-2 to keep his record unblemished in the Feb. 19 Southwest S. at Oaklawn, but finally threw in a clunker, weakening late to be fourth. Hard Spun was relegated to the role of second choice for the first time in his career, but put himself back on top in the Lane's End. Content to settle in third as Starbase (Tale of the Cat) cut out fractions of :47.24 and 1:11.62, the colt was still in hand as he gained the lead on the final bend and he put daylight between himself and the field in the final furlong. "This horse will do anything you want him to do," Larry Jones said. "I could tell he was waiting to run, but he listened for [jockey Mario Pino] to ask him. He makes more money than Mario and I, but he'll still listen to us. He's very coachable." Pino was pleased to see his mount return to form. "At the quarter pole, he was full of run," the rider said. "He pricked his ears and was waiting on horses. Turning for home I shook him up and he took off again. I knew I had a ton of horse from the moment he came out of the gate, which just goes to show he didn't handle the track at Oaklawn." He hadn't had his picture taken since winning the GI Clement L. Hirsch H. at the 2005 Oak Tree meeting, but Fourty Niners Son was back to his best yesterday. The six-year-old ended the '05 season with a ninth-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf, then returned to be second in an allowance at Hollywood May 20. Third in the July 2 GII American Invitational H., he capped off the abbreviated campaign with a fourth in the GI Eddie Read H. three weeks later. The chestnut horse took on tough company in his return, a money allowance at Santa Anita Mar. 3, and was not disgraced when finishing fourth behind Icy Atlantic. He was ready to role in his second start off the layoff. Fourty Niners Son tracked A.P. Xcellent (A.P. Indy) early, but joined him on the front end after the opening mile. Maryfield was the front-running winner of the Nov. 4 Very Subtle S. at Churchill in her 2006 finale, but didn't take to her surroundings at Santa Anita. The bay failed to finish in the money in the Jan. 1 GIII

Monrovia H. on the grass, or in the Jan. 28 GI Santa Monica H. and Feb. 24 GIII Las Flores H. on the main track. Trainer Doug O'Neill opted to send her out of town to get her back into the game, and the six-year-old mare responded with a much-improved effort. Maryfield dropped back to last at the break, and had to check as she closed ground along the rail nearing the far turn. Still well off the leaders as they turned for home, she was under the whip as she angled to

the outside, then hit her best stride in the final sixteenth, driving past pacesetter Candy Box in the waning yards and pulling clear. "For some reason, she hasn't been breaking well," O'Neill said from his home base in California. "Jorge [Chavez] breezed her a couple of weeks ago and we put her in a three or four horse team. She outbroke everybody and worked like a beast. But, for some reason, today she broke a step slow. Jorge...made a great call not to rush her. He just let those other fillies do the hard work, and he came with a strong run. The way she ran today, she has opened up a whole new option." For Chavez, who moved his tack from New York to California last summer, it was a happy homecoming. "I rode here so many years, to come back is unbelievable," he said. Duveen was out of his element on the main track, finishing off the board in all three dirt starts, but has proved right at home on the grass. The dark bay tried the turf for the first time in a maiden test at Gulfstream Jan. 13, finishing second by a neck, and came back to earn his diploma by 4 1/4 lengths Feb. 21. Jumping right into the stakes fray as the crowd's second choice, he stalked moderate early fractions while saving ground. Duveen had nowhere to go as they raced into the stretch, but fought his way through the traffic to join Soldier's Dancer inside the eighth pole and outgamed that rival to take the photo. "We had a little traffic problem," jockey Mark Guidry said. "I went to split horses and they came together, but he accelerated once we had a good clear lane." Trainer Dale Romans remarked, "We tried to get him on turf a couple times last year, but the races were forced off. He was a new horse once we got him on turf." Control System remained undefeated with yet another dominant performance. The Pennsylvania-bred broke her maiden at Philly Park Jan. 23, cruising home 11 lengths to the good, and added a 9 1/4-length allowance victory Feb. 18. The Big A faithful were convinced she was the real deal, sending her off as the 2-1 favorite, and were rewarded for their confidence. Control System was in hand as she tracked Golden Dreamer through a half in :45.56. She collared the pacesetter as they turned into the lane and was under the gun to gain control, but asserted her authority in the final sixteenth and drew clear. "She was getting out a bit looking at the other horse," jockey Julian Pimentel explained. "Once she was clear, she just took off. To this point, she has done every thing so easy. I don't really know how good she is." The filly could put her unbeaten record on the line in the Apr. 14 GII Comely S. at Aqueduct. Sealy Hill followed a 7 1/4-length maiden win at Woodbine in her second career start Oct. 20 with an 8 1/4-length triumph in the Nov. 19 Glorious Song S. Freshened after that effort, the dark bay returned to be second in a Gulfstream allowance test Jan. 25 and was a well-backed second choice to get back to the winner's circle in her second sophomore appearance. Rated in fifth while racing three wide down the backstretch, she swept past the field while still taking the long way around the final bend. Sealy Hill was well clear at the eighth pole, but had to dig down deep as they neared the wire to hold off Panty Raid by a head. "She's better than you saw today," said trainer Mark Casse, who won this race with Top Notch Lady last year. "She made the lead at the top of the lane and pulled herself up. He's No Pie Eater proved his upset in the G1 Chipping Norton S. Mar. 3 was not a fluke, as the colt returned to his own age group to take the Rosehill Guineas. Forced to make several runs in the course of the race to hold his position, He's No Pie Eater made the lead with more than a quarter mile to race and dug in gamely late to deny Ambitious General by a half-length. "I was pretty confident he could win," commented victorious trainer Graeme Rogerson. "I think it will be three Group 1s before the autumn is over." Rogerson indicated that his charge would be pointed for the A\$2 million G1 AJC Australian Derby at Randwick Apr. 7. "He'll be very hard to beat in the Derby," the trainer warned. Favored Teranaba (Aus) (Anabaa) never landed a blow and tired to finish second last. The winner's dam was purchased for \$85,000 at the 1996 Keeneland November sale and was subsequently exported to Australia.

**Barn Fire Claims All Seven Horses at Hipp Farm:**

A fire early Friday morning was responsible for the death of all seven horses at Hipp Farm on Ironworks Park in Lexington. Firefighters responded to the scene just after 1 a.m. to find the 12-stall barn fully involved in flames. The blaze did not spread to two nearby barns, nor did it spread to the residence, some 500 yards away. Among the losses were five Thoroughbreds and two Saddlebreds, including a multiple world champion named Chat. "We never even considered putting a price on them, and that is pretty rare for our family, because this is what we do for a living," Calhoun Clifton, the 23-year-old daughter of the farm's owner, told the *Lexington Herald-Leader*. "They have just been a part of the family for as long as we've had them. There is no amount of money we would have ever sold them for." The total losses are estimated to be in excess of \$1 million. The cause of the fire is still under investigation.
