**SANTA ANA WIN WITH A TWIST**

On paper, it appeared that **Citronnade** (Lemon Drop Kid) would have things her own way on the front end heading into yesterday's GII Santa Ana H. at Santa Anita, and the four-year-old filly followed the script to a T, setting a stakes record in the process. "There was no speed in the race, so we just put her on the lead nice and easy," said winning rider David Flores. Quickly out of the gate and in front of the pack, the bay led the field through comfortable splits of :24.14, :48.10 and 1:10.93. Still in command and locked in cruise control, the Adena Springs homebred showed her dominance late by galloping home 5 1/4 lengths in front of her nearest pursuer **Conveyer's Angel** (Conveyer), with **Memorette** (Memo {Chi}) 2 1/4 lengths back in third. "She was confident and happy," added Flores. "At the top of the stretch, I turned her loose a little bit and let her run. Wow, she can really run. She's competitive and she's getting better and better with every start." Citronnade, who was giving trainer Bobby Frankel his record seventh win in the race, covered the 1 1/8 miles on turf in 1:46.21, improving on the stakes record of 1:46.23 that had been set in 1993 by MGISW Exchange. **cont. p2**

**GEORGE RETURNS TO TRAINING**

**George Washington (Ire)** (Danehill), last year's winner of the G1 2000 Guineas and G1 Queen Elizabeth II S., is back at Ballydoyle and has resumed training after his stallion career was put on hold following the discovery of infertility problems. The four-year-old, who was retired last fall, was recently replaced at Coolmore by the G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere hero Holy Roman Emperor (Ire). "He is in an isolation yard and is doing light exercise," O'Brien told *Racing Post*. "You could call it pre-training and we will just have to wait and see how things go with him. He has been entered for the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh on May 27, but it is far too soon to be talking about where he might run and it's quite possible that the Tattersalls race could come too soon for him."

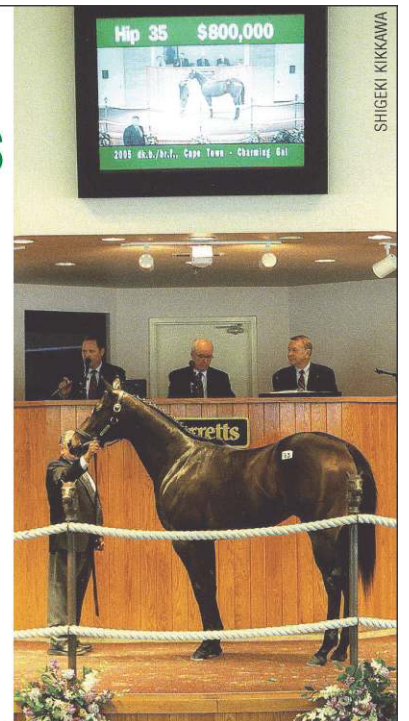

Citronnade kicked off her career north of the border, graduating second time out by nine lengths at Woodbine last June. Sent to Belmont the following month, the filly won on the dirt in a \$75,000 optional claimer before finishing runner up going seven panels in an off the turf allowance at the Spa. In the winner's circle following the restricted Graceful Darby S. Sept. 21, she failed to fire and finished ninth in the GI Queen Elizabeth Cup S. at Keeneland Oct. 14. "She probably should be undefeated on the turf, but we messed up," said Bobby Frankel. "I think it was miscommunication between Edgar [Prado] and myself that day. He took her back and

she didn't like it. But she's a good filly." Back in California for Hollywood's Audrey Skirball-Kenis S. Nov. 12, Citronnade came from just off the pace to win by 3/4 lengths and added a win in the Jan. 7 GII San Gorgonio H. at Santa Anita. "She's a big, strong filly," said Frankel, winning his 10<sup>th</sup> stakes victory of the meet, tying him with Doug O'Neill. "She always has a good day, never has a bad day. That's why she's so good. She's happy every day and she's a pleasure to train." According to Frankel, "We'll definitely keep her on the turf [GI Gamely Breeders' Cup H. at Hollywood Park, 1 1/8 miles turf on May 28]. **Invasor Casts a Large Shadow in Dubai**


Reigning Horse of the Year **Invasor** (Candy Stripes) looked like the horse to beat in Saturday's World Cup when he stepped on to the track at Nad al Sheba yesterday for a preparatory move. The five-year-old galloped 1 3/8 miles over the main track, his first extended exercise around the course. "He's great, he's fabulous," said Trish McLaughlin, assistant and sister-in-law to trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. "He's a real happy and fresh horse who thrives in training." Trainer Kiaran McLaughlin is scheduled to arrive in Dubai this afternoon. "[Invasor] shipped over awesome," McLaughlin added. "He's such a well travelled horse and he's so classy and so laid back, that nothing bothers him." A final major work has not been scheduled for the winner of the Breeders' Cup Classic. The horse completed his final serious prep for the 1 1/4-mile World Cup in Florida prior to shipping east Mar. 20.

**Lava Smoldering**

**Lava Man** (Slew City Slew) took his first look at the Nad al Sheba turf course yesterday in advance of an intended engagement in Saturday's G1 Dubai Duty Free. "He loves it here," said rider Tony Romero, who was smiling ear to ear following the move. "He's really doing good." Also readying for the Duty Free yesterday, **Linngari** (Ire) (Indian Ridge {Ire}) worked 600 meters, stopping the clock in :32.77. "Linngari worked like he usually does and I'm very happy," said trainer Herman Brown. "I think he has a good chance as anything in the race, especially as he is acclimatized here, unlike a lot of the others."

**Rags to Riches Heads Straight to Oaks**

**Rags to Riches** (A.P. Indy) will train straight up to the GI Kentucky Oaks at Churchill Downs May 4, according to trainer Todd Pletcher Sunday. The Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith-owned filly worked four furlongs in :50.80 at Hollywood Park Sunday. "She went well and we're happy with her," said Pletcher, currently in Florida. "We thought about the Santa Anita Derby a lot, but after discussing it with Demi O'Byrne and Michael Tabor, we decided on the Oaks." Explaining the decision to train straight up to the filly Classic, Pletcher added, "She's a special filly, but she's light on seasoning and there are a lot of important races down the road. She could compete against the boys at some point, but there's no reason to rush her." Likely for the Apr. 7 Santa Anita Derby is GIII El Camino Real Derby winner **Bwana Bull** (Holy Bull), who worked six furlongs in 1:12.80 at Bay Meadows Saturday. "The horse galloped out very nicely and if all goes well, we would ship in at a convenient time," said trainer Jerry Hollendorfer. Russell Baze will ride.

**Boogie Boggs Confirmed for Florida Derby**

Trainer Nick Zito has confirmed that My Meadowview Stable's **Boogie Boggs** (Dixie Union) will start in Saturday's GI Florida Derby. A maiden winner at Saratoga in his only start at two, the grey finished second in his latest, a 7 1/2-furlong allowance at Gulfstream Mar. 3. "You've got to take some chances when they're doing good, particularly with young horses," said Zito, explaining his ambitious placement of the colt. "You can't learn anything about them leaving them in the barn. You have to give them a chance. Just going a distance for the first time can make all the difference." Jockey Joe Bravo will ride the \$650,000 KEESEP yearling purchase for the first time in the Florida Derby.

Sharp Susan couldn't find her winning stride in her first four career starts last year, but found her first attempt past a mile and the grass to her liking, scoring at Belmont Sept. 29. Asked to go nine panels over the yielding turf there Oct. 22, the dark bay showed some early speed but faded badly to be 10<sup>th</sup> under the wire in the Miss Grillo S. Maneuvered from off the pace in her latest--a mile allowance at Gulfstream Feb. 18--she drew clear to post a 1 1/4-length victory as a 7-2 shot. Backed down to 9-5 favoritism for her graded stakes debut, the filly made the most of a slow early pace and had more than enough in reserve to post the easy victory.
