EYES OF THE WORLD

A year ago, the G2 UAE Derby featured a confrontation between two unbeaten colts, **Discreet Cat** (Forestry) and **Invasor (Arg)** (Candy Stripes). While Discreet

Cat won impressively that day and went on to add three brilliant victories in the U.S., it was Invasor who wound up with the bigger trophies. The Uruguayan champion captured each of his four U.S. outings, all Grade I events, and concluded 2006 by knocking off Bernardini in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic. Those triumphs earned him Eclipse Awards as the U.S. Horse of the Year and champion older horse. In his first start since November, the big

bay overcame adversity to take the GI Donn H. Feb. 3 at Gulfstream Park. He has trained smartly in the interim for Kiaran McLaughlin. "Kiaran's got him perfect," said Rick Nichols, general manager of Sheikh Hamdan's Shadwell Farm. "Invasor does everything so easily. He loves training." To go with having a race under his belt this year, Invasor has another edge over his main rival: he is well proven at a mile and a quarter, with five Grade/Group 1 wins at about that distance. Discreet Cat has not faced the starter since a breathtaking victory in the GI Cigar Mile Nov. 26, when he stopped the clock in 1:32 2/5. The bay was supposed to come back in the G3 Burj Nahaar Mar. 1, but a slightly elevated temperature kept him in his stall. That setback does not concern trainer Saeed bin Suroor. "He is in good order and I am really happy with him," said bin Suroor. "[He] has improved mentally and physically since last year when he was a bit keen in the mornings." He added, "It will be a new distance for him and I want to see him relax in the race." **DWC cont. p3**

plane ride for Stormello, who stayed on gamely in the GI Fountain of Youth S. Mar. 3 before getting nipped at the wire by **Scat Daddy** (Johannesburg). "We know he runs well on this track and we know this horse can travel," said Ignacio Correas, assistant to co-owner/breeder and trainer

Bill Currin. "This horse is very talented, very strong and has a great mind." As much as he'd like the flashy chestnut to wear the orchids this afternoon, Correas has his eyes on roses. "I hope he wins, but I don't think we'll be as disappointed as some others if he doesn't," Correas added. "He should run big if he runs his race." Prior to the Fountain of Youth, Stormello outgamed Doug O'Neill trainee Liquidity to take the GI Hollywood Futurity Dec. 16. Joining him on the plane from California was another O'Neill charge, Notional. **Florida Derby cont. p2**

Sometimes a Great Notion...

Notional rebounded from a sixth in the Hollywood Futurity to win the GII San Rafael S. at Santa Anita Jan. 13, then overcame a wide trip to take the GIII Risen Star S. at Fair Grounds Feb. 10. He is one of three graded-stakes winning three-year-olds campaigned this year by J. Paul Reddam. "This horse is very smart and extra special," said his groom, Antonio Islas. "He doesn't expend any energy except in the race. That's why travelling is no problem." When

asked to compare Notional to some of O'Neill's other top runners, Islas said, "This one is different. He is so focused and more mature than other three-year-olds...I think he's exceptional, but which one is better? We probably won't know until they all run together. I think--I hope--that will be in the [GI] Kentucky Derby [May 5]."

Tapping at the Door...

Trainer John Kimmel kept a watchful eye as **Premium Tap** (Pleasant Tap) had a sprightly gallop Friday. The five-year-old bucked near the end of his exercise before going over to stand in the starting gate. "That was a combination buck and a flying lead change," said Kimmel. "He seems pretty happy." Kimmel has been high on his charge for weeks. "I'm going there to win," the New York-based conditioner told *Racing Post*. "He probably doesn't deserve equal billing with those two--one is

Horse of the Year and the other is undefeated, and I'm just little old Premium Tap. Nobody really considers him a major player, but they just don't know....I think you'd be silly to dismiss him. I'm pleased with him--you're not going to get any excuses from my camp." Premium Tap, a troubled third to Invasor in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, bounced back to take the GI Clark H. at Churchill Nov. 24 before being purchased privately by Saudi King Abdullah bin Abdulaziz and sons. The bay shipped over to Riyadh and captured the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques Cup Feb. 16 in his lone outing this year.

All in the Family...

While Discreet Cat was having his final gallop before the World Cup, his dam, the Private Account mare Pretty Discreet, foaled his half-brother at Hidden Brook Farm in Kentucky. Owned by Mrs. E.P. Robsham, the bay Mineshaft colt was born at 4 a.m. "He's a nice strong colt with a lot of quality and similarities to his brother," said Hidden Brook manager Sergio de Sousa. The 15-year-old mare will be bred back to Forestry. Heroine of the GI Alabama S. in 1995, Pretty Discreet has also produced MSW & GISP Pretty Wild (Wild Again).

READY FOR DUTY

A full field of 16 runners from all corners of the globe will meet in the \$5-million G1 Dubai Duty Free, a race which has perennially been one of the most competitive at the World Cup meeting. The U.S. contingent boasts a top-class trio in **English Channel** (Smart Strike), **Lava**

Man (Slew City Slew) and **Miesque's Approval** (Miesque's Son), but they'll have their work cut out for them in this 1777-meter (8.98-furlong) affair from a tough international group. Daiwa Major (Jpn) (Sunday Silence) will fly the flag for Japan. The chestnut, a Group 1 winner at mile as well as a 1 1/4 miles in his native land, concluded 2006 with a commedable third to champion Deep Impact (Jpn) and Pop Rock (Jpn) in the

1 9/16-mile G1 Arima Kinen Dec. 24 at Nakayama. Shadai Farm's Teruya Yoshida was pleased with Keizo Oshiro's colorbearer yesterday. "I think he is Japan's best chance of victory," said Yoshida. "He is a strong horse, who will be staying on well towards the end, and is a real superstar."

Triple Threat...

Trainer Mike de Kock will saddle three runners here, headlined by **Irridescence (SAf)** (Caesour). The bay was forced to withdraw from last year's Duty Free after an incident in the paddock, but went on to defeat Ouija Board (GB) in April in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup at Sha Tin. She returned from a five-month break Mar. 1 in the G2 Jebel Hatta and stayed on for third behind **Seihali (Ire)** (Alzao) and **Formal Decree (Ger)** (Diktat {GB}). "She is coming to hand at the right time," said de Kock. "She wasn't working well previously, but ran a good race last time...she is a quirky filly, difficult to deal [with], but hopefully we will get her to the start." De Kock also has another standout filly in **Bad Girl Runs (SAf)** (Western Winter), five for seven in South Africa. The bay got up to win a local six-furlong handicap in the last jump Feb. 23. "She is a super filly pound for pound--on ability, she could be better than Irridescence," added de Kock, "but she hasn't had the prep." **Field p5**

A WOMAN AMONG MEN

Members of the fairer sex have fared well in the world's other premier sprint event, with fillies such as Very Subtle, Safely Kept and Desert Stormer having won the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint and others such as Honest Lady and Meafara who have come close. No female runner has ever succeeded in hitting the board in the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen, a race dominated year in and year out by American-based horses, but that could all change tonight in the form of South African phenom **National Colour (SAf)** (National Assembly). And what's not to like? The grey mare clocked :55 3/5 in winning the G1 Computaform Sprint S. over the straight five furlongs at Turffontein last April and added a success in the G1 SA Fillies Sprint May 28, going 1:07 3/5

around a bend. She completed a Group 1 treble by taking the Mercury Sprint S. in July and was crowned the joint Horse of the Year in South Africa. She punched her ticket to the Shaheen with a sharp score in a Feb. 15 conditions event and could prove elusive on the front end. **Thor's Echo** (Swiss Yodeler), last year's Breeders' Cup Sprint hero and reigning U.S. champion sprinter, looks to redeem himself following a disappointing sixth to **Terrific Challenge** (Royal Academy) in the G3 Mahab Al Shimaal over track and trip Mar. 1. The chestnut also looks to improve on his runner-up effort in last year's Shaheen. **Friendly Island** (Crafty Friend) has been known to throw in the occasional big one, as evidenced by his second in the Breeders' Cup Sprint. The New York-bred has had one start since, a 2 1/2-length victory over **Harvard Avenue** (You and I) in the GII Palos Verdes H. at Santa Anita Jan. 20. **Bounty Quest (GB)** (Fasliyev) has been a model of consistency at the Carnival, finishing second to National Colour in the Feb. 15 conditions heat and to Terrific Challenge in the Mahab Al Shimaal. **Field p6**

After capturing a conditions race in his local bow Jan. 18, the bay drew off to take the G3 UAE 2000 Guineas Feb. 9 and followed up with a handy seven-length tally in the Al Bastakiya over track and trip Mar. 1, with **Victory Tetsuni** (Gone West) and **Rallying Cry** (War Chant) rounding out the trifecta in the latter. De Kock plans to send the Argentine colt to Newmarket after his Dubai sojourn and, while he realizes he has the favorite, is keeping an eye on these rivals, especially the impressive filly **Folk** (Quiet American). "I do respect Folk," de Kock said. "She has been putting up the same fractions as him and she ran even faster in her Guineas...she is one of the better fillies I have seen racing in Dubai." He added, "She is getting 13 pounds from us, but my horse is getting better and better. I am quietly confident."

Folk has trounced fillies in each of her two starts since arriving from New York. She captured the Listed UAE 1000 Guineas Feb. 15 before taking the Listed UAE Oaks in a stylish manner Mar. 8. Along with **Eu Tambem (Brz)** (Wild Event), she was transferred from Ismail Mohammed's barn to Godolphin and trainer Saeed bin Suroor. The latter, a multiple group winner in Brazil before taking Argentina's G1 Gran Premio Nacional, defeated his elders last out in the G2 Maktoum Challenge-Round 3 Mar. 1.

Attorney Dan Baren said Reddam and Fifth Third Bank agreed March 29 on court-order language that would keep the Kentucky financial institution from any immediate action to take physical possession of Great Hunter. Baren also said the bank agreed to inform any buyers interested in acquiring its alleged claim that pending litigation was involved in the ownership of the horse. Reddam's legal team filed a lawsuit March 23 in California against Fifth Third Bank, which claims it has a legal interest in Great Hunter because the colt purportedly was part of collateral used on since-defaulted loans extended to the horse's former owner, Ilona Whetstone, and her husband, L. Eric Whetstone. The lawsuit asked for a temporary restraining order against Fifth Third Bank, which was scheduled to be heard in Orange County Superior Court March 29. "It's definitely a positive step," said Baren. "Our fear was that they were going to sell their interest to a third party, and then we wouldn't know exactly what kind of problems could arise by shipping Great Hunter into Kentucky for the Blue Grass Stakes." ASHKAL WAY AND VACARE RETURN SUNDAY


Ashkal Way (Ire) (Ashkalani) and **Vacare** (Lear Fan), Grade I winners on the turf last season, will make their seasonal debut on Sunday's card at Gulfstream Park. Ashkal Way, who races under the Godolphin banner, will start in the Lure S. at 1 1/16 miles on the turf, while Vacare, who is campaigned by Jon and Sarah Kelly, is scheduled to contest the 1 1/16-mile Magna Distaff S. Ashkal Way, winner of last season's GI Citation H., GII Bernard Baruch H. and GII Kelso Breeders' Cup H., is based at Payson Park with Rick Mettee, assistant to trainer Saeed bin Suroor. Undefeated Vacare, who recorded her first three victories of the season at Arlington Park, recorded her biggest victory to date in last October's GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland. The four-year-old filly, who is trained by Christophe Clement, will be ridden by Edgar Prado.

COLLIER HILL SCRATCHED FROM SHEEMA CLASSIC Shoe problems have forced the popular **Collier Hill (GB)** (Dr Devious {Ire}) to be scratched from the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic. The nine-year-old gelding had been third in that contest in 2005 before finishing second last year. "He's had a shoe problem for the last two weeks," explained trainer Alan Swinbank. "It's always the same with these hiccups. It was worse in Hong Kong than it is here. It's hard to train at this level and keep them right. Over the last year he has competed at the highest level. He's won his last two group races, so he owes us nothing." The chestnut has won over £2.3 million, including the GI Canadian International Oct. 22 and the G1 Hong Kong Vase Dec. 10.

DUBAI UNVEILS MEYDAN COMPLEX; FACILITY TO REPLACE RACETRACK by Ron Mitchell *courtesy www.bloodhorse.com*

In what appears to be a project of massive proportions, the Dubai Racing Club Friday night unveiled a scale model of a racing and sports complex that would rival any other facility in the world. Named Meydan (Arabic for "new challenge") the complex would apparently replace the Nad al Sheba racecourse in Dubai that will host the 12th annual Dubai World Cup Saturday. The present facility will accommodate about 45,000 to 50,000 Saturday. The new facility, for which details are expected to be announced prior to the World Cup card Saturday, would apparently handle many more patrons than that. With no official announcement, other than the unveiling that was replete with ceremonial dancers, fireworks, and related accretments, it is widely believed that the complex is being designed with plans for Dubai to bid for the Olympic games. In fact, a video preface into the unveiling showed horses racing while the Olympic fanfare theme John Williams composed for the Olympics played in the background. The video presentation credited many officials and departments within the United Arab Emirates for bringing the concept forward, noting that the major credit goes to Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid al Maktoum, the vice president, prime minister, and ruler of Dubai. Despite the lack of details and only a look at facility onlookers, including many owners and breeders, were impressed with what they saw. "Sheikh Mohammed has a vision that is going to change the Middle East," said horse owner and breeder Peter Bance. "I think you will see other Middle Eastern countries follow suit." 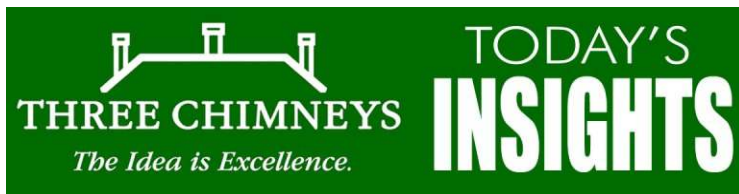
