His half-brother Giacomo could do no better than fourth in the GI Santa Anita Derby of 2005 before going on to bigger and better things four weeks down the road. Suffice to say that **Tiago** (Pleasant Tap) is off to a much better start, after the Moss homebred sprung a 29-1 upset over **King of the Roxy** (Littleexpectations) in yesterday's Kentucky Derby prep at the Great Race Place outside of Los Angeles.

**CHICAGO'S HIS KINDA TOWN**

Trainer Todd Pletcher had his Derby hopefuls spread out across the map Saturday afternoon and, although Any Given Saturday couldn't quite get the job done in the Big Apple, WinStar Farm and Gulf Coast Farm's **Cowtown Cat** (Distorted Humor) made amends in the Windy City, leading his rivals on a merry chase en route to a 2 1/4-length victory in Saturday's GII Illinois Derby. **Cobalt Blue** (Golden Missile), the even-money choice off his win in the GII San Felipe S. Mar. 17, was never in it, finishing a distant seventh.

***Promise From Day One...***

From the time **Nobiz Like Shobiz** was just a foal, trainer Barclay Tagg told owner Elizabeth Valando that the colt was "the one." Nobiz Like Shobiz did little to tarnish that high regard, winning his debut by 10 3/4 lengths Sept. 9, then ran second to Scat Daddy in the GI Champagne S. Oct. 14. He ran off to take the GII Remsen S. by 6 1/2 lengths Nov. 25, leaving the impression that his best was yet to come.

***An Unfinished Item...***

Even as Tagg readied Nobiz Like Shobiz for his sophomore campaign, he had some things to work on, namely his colt's penchant for drifting and looking around in the latter portion of his races. He was classy enough to overcome his greenness to take the GIII Holy Bull S. Feb. 3, but lost his focus late during the Fountain of Youth and could not seal the deal, crossing the line third, a half-length adrift of Scat Daddy.

***In Search of Some Focus...***

Tagg gave his charge five weeks to prepare for this race and made the decision to add a set of blinkers and ear plugs in an effort to sharpen his focus. Drawn in the inside barrier, Nobiz Like Shobiz was ridden for speed and keenly contested the pace, tugging against jockey Cornelio Velasquez as second choice **Any Given Saturday** (Distorted Humor) stalked four wide through a half-mile in :47.26. The two chief protagonists had the race to themselves as they circled the far turn, but, when Any Given Saturday began to weaken, **Sightseeing** (Pulpit) was commencing his rally. The Phipps runner stayed on gamely and was making inches on the winner at the wire, but the result was never seriously in doubt. "My horse broke sharp. He really wanted to go," the winning jockey explained. "I liked that he really finished good. I think he's got a very good chance in the Kentucky Derby." Tagg indicated he'd be inclined to ship in to Louisville on the late side. "I don't like to go and mess around with that crowd. It's hard on the horses to be chased around all day every day," he said.

Whereas Giacomo was Grade I placed at two, Tiago waited until there were five days remaining in 2006, finishing a debut third over seven panels of this track Dec. 26. He finished second, but was placed first in one of the strangest maiden events seen in some time Jan. 21, where he was forced seven deep into the stretch and missed by a head. He was last seen finishing a distant seventh in the GII Robert B. Lewis S. Mar. 3, but was getting blinkers off and Mike Smith--regular rider of Giacomo--for this test. Allowed to lope along near the back of the pack, Tiago advanced on the turn, came wide at midstretch and finished with a rush to catch King of the Roxy. "I thought there would be plenty of pace and that they'd come back to us and they did," Smith said. "I did want to be sure to keep him focused, keep him moving forward. The versatile Christmas Kid now has three wins this year over three different surfaces. After kicking off 2007 with a victory on the Calder grass in the Tropical Park Oaks Jan. 1, the Edward Evans homebred galloped home a four-length winner over High Again (High Yield) in the GII Davona Dale S. Feb. 10 going a mile on the dirt at Gulfstream. She settled for second to that filly in the nine-furlong GII Bonnie Miss S. at that track Mar. 10, but gained her revenge here at 9-1. Bumped at the start, the big bay cruised along in fourth before being sent up the rail turning for home. She seized command in midstretch and had enough left to stave off odds-on Octave in the final strides. "She kicked in down the stretch unbelievably," said winning rider Rene Douglas. "I feel like I should have won last time so I wanted to make sure I got the job done today. I rode her with so much patience. Oxbow Racing purchased Ermine as a yearling and attempted to pinhook her the following season, but bought her back after she failed to meet her reserve. While that might have left a bad taste in connections' mouths at the time, the filly has done more than earn her keep and posted the most important victory of her career in Oaklawn's lone Grade I event. The narrow winner of the GII Falls City H. at Churchill last November, the 2006 GI Kentucky Oaks runner-up headed west this winter, where she finished runner-up to Sugar Shake in the GI Santa Maria H. Feb. 10 and to Balance in the GI Santa Margarita Invitational H. Mar. 10. Ermine was well handled by Eddie Castro, who held up his mount in sixth as Take D'Tour set the pace. She rallied four wide into the stretch and overhauled the Florida invader to win comfortably. Breeders' Cup Distaff winner Round Pond was closer to the pace than usual and raced evenly into third.

Silver Wagon concluded his 2006 campaign with a 5 1/2-length tally in the GIII Sport Page Breeders' Cup H. over course and distance, then ran a respectable third, beaten 1 1/4 lengths, when stretched to nine panels in the Sunshine Millions Classic at Gulfstream Jan. 27. He returned to seven furlongs for the GII General George BC H. at Laurel Feb. 19 and came through with a 1 1/4-length success at odds-on. Again at his favored distance here, Silver Wagon was content to lay well back as Kazoo (Tabasco Cat), Latent Heat (Maria's Mon) and Keyed Entry (Honour and Glory) mixed it up through :21 3/5 and :44 1/5 splits. Silver Wagon came charging down the middle of the track in tandem with Diabolical and outfinished that foe for the win. "He's been training lights-out since we got back from Florida," said winning training Rick Dutrow, Jr. "Down there, he didn't want to train. Cowtown Cat took care of business in the Windy City, breezing to victory with Fernando Jara in the irons. The \$1.5-million topper at last year's Barretts March sale, Cowtown Cat was a well-beaten sixth in the GIII Nashua S. Nov. 3, but resurfaced to take a first-level allowance at Gulfstream Jan. 14. Though he could not quite negotiate graded company when third in the GII Swale S. Feb. 3, he successfully handled the stretch to two turns in his latest, taking the GIII Gotham S. by 2 1/2 lengths Mar. 10. Sent immediately to the front, Cowtown Cat set an easy pace from Catman Running (Tactical Cat) with Bold Start tucked in behind in third. Cowtown Cat responded when asked and kicked clear as Reporting for Duty closed well from midpack to be second.

Unbeaten in three previous starts over the Oaklawn surface, Lawyer Ron was bet down to 1-2 to keep his record at the track unblemished and made the odds look generous with an easy victory. The chestnut colt wired the field in the Apr. 15 GII Arkansas Derby in his last appearance in Hot Springs, but was never in the hunt in the May 6 GI Kentucky Derby, finishing 12th. Given time to catch his breath after that experience, he returned to take the Aug. 26 St. Louis Derby and was runner-up in the Sept. 23 GII Super Derby. Lawyer Ron was handed over to trainer Todd Pletcher prior to the Nov. 4 GI Breeders' Cup Classic, but stopped after showing brief speed in that event and ended up ninth. He was freshened for three months before getting back on track with a troubled win in an optional claimer at Gulfstream Feb. 11. Allowed to settle in fourth through the opening half here, the four-year-old carried jockey Edgar Prado to the front as they raced around the far turn and easily held Brother Bobby at bay to the wire.

Purchased last year for the express purpose of serving this owner's English Channel as a rabbit, Icy Atlantic accomplished his goal in the Oct. 7 GI Turf Classic Invitational, setting the table for his barnmate before finishing seventh, but was 11th in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf, while the more accomplished English Channel was third. The blaze-faced bay split rivals late to be second to Lava Man in the Sunshine Millions Turf at this venue Jan. 27 and was coming into this off a two-length allowance success over nine furlongs Mar. 3. Jim Bolger will return to his Coolcullen base, which houses the homebred Teofilo (Ire), warmed by this impressive performance by that star colt's supposed inferior. Still a maiden entering this contest, Creachadoir had shown enough when third behind Eagle Mountain (Ire) on debut and fourth behind Holy Roman Emperor (Ire) in the G2 Railway S. at The Curragh last summer to suggest he could be a money-spinner this term. Camarilla was the highest-priced youngster in Darley's first-ever Easter draft last April, fetching A\$900,000 from the Ingham family's Woodlands Stud. Next week's G1 Champagne S. could be on the winner's agenda.
