**GOOD FORTUNE AT LONGCHAMP**

Trainer Aidan O'Brien doubled his tally in the G2 Prix Noailles, sending out **Soldier of Fortune (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) to take yesterday's renewal at Longchamp by

1 1/2 lengths from France's champion juvenile **Spirit One (Fr)** (Anabaa Blue {GB}). O'Brien was also successful with Ballingarry (Ire) in 2002. That champ was unable to parlay his win in this race into Classic success, but Soldier of Fortune staked a claim for Derby glory in the event. Defeated twice by fillies in a three-race campaign last term, the G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud runner-up confirmed juvenile promise in his sophomore bow yesterday. He required only two taps of the persuader to record an impressive victory at the sun-kissed Bois de Boulogne track. "I called the race live for Aidan and he was delighted at the result," explained Coolmore representative Robert Nataf, adding, "He was not fully tuned for the race and will certainly come on a lot for the run. Aidan confirmed he is a probable for the G1 Prix du Jockey Club [at Chantilly June 3], but we don't know if he will run again beforehand." **Cont. p2**

**KING OF THE ROXY TO AWAIT PREAKNESS**

Team Valor's **King of the Roxy** (Littleexpectations), beaten a half length as runner-up in Saturday's GI Santa Anita Derby, will skip the GI Kentucky Derby and wait for the May 19 GI Preakness S. "He ran well enough to compete in the Kentucky Derby and he has more than enough graded earnings to make it into the starting gate," said Barry Irwin, president of Team Valor. "However...we feel it would compromise the colt's future to run him back on the first Saturday in May. I have said all along that I did not consider him to be a Kentucky Derby candidate because, after last fall's Breeders' Cup, he became ill and was not able to make his initial start at three until the first week of March. The extra two weeks will give Todd Pletcher a better chance to get him ready for the Preakness." Irwin added, "We think he belongs with the horses that will be in the Kentucky Derby field, but that is not the point. Team Valor is not in the habit of trying to fit square pegs into round holes. The point is that we want to run him when the timing and the race conditions better fit him so that he will be able to compete throughout the year, not in just one race." The winner of the GII Futurity S. at two and the GII Hutcheson S. at three, King of the Roxy has been first or second in five of seven starts and has earned \$466,400.

**Soldier of Fortune** was beaten a short head by the filly **La Conquistadora** (GB) on debut at Gowran Park Oct. 6, but made a quick reappearance and lost his maiden status in good style at Navan 11 days later. Upped to the highest level for his final juvenile start, he just lost out to **Passage of Time** (GB) in a rousing finish to the Nov. 12 G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud as the pair quickened clear of a strong field. The bay, venturing back to France for his sophomore bow, was settled three lengths off the pace as old foe **Spirit One** pulled to the front in the early stages. Jockey Christophe Soumillon urged the winner closer once into the home straight and, having administered two flicks of the whip, guided **Soldier of Fortune** by that rival inside the final eighth and on to a commanding success. "We are exactly where we want to be with a horse of Classic potential and it was most satisfactory to see him win that way," said Robert Nataf.

Mending Fences was an overmatched sixth in his seasonal debut in the 11-furlong GII Mac Diarmida H. at Gulfstream Jan. 28. Runner-up to the classy English Channel in a nine-furlong allowance over that turf course Feb. 22, the five-year-old was sent off the second choice behind GSW Silver Tree (Hennessy) this time. In front soon after the start, the dark bay carved out modest early splits, was challenged at the head of the stretch and had enough left in the tank to fend off late-running Embossed. "He's a great horse to ride; I can't find many of those," said jockey Quincy Hamilton. "He broke great and settled in perfectly and when I called on him, he was all there. I saw [Embossed] coming at the end, but my horse was very game." Favored Silver Tree stalked the early pace, mounted a brief challenge a sixteenth from home, but weakened late to be fifth. "The yielding course was very much a factor," explained John Gaver, assistant to trainer Bill Mott. "The last 12 starts have been on firm ground, so as soon as it started raining [yesterday morning], I was getting worried. "But barrier one in a good-size field, where there is generally good early speed, means we can ride him in the manner that will give him every chance." Haradasun hung out badly in the run to the post in the Mar. 31 George Ryder, and Vasil said he has had jockey Glen Boss practicing with the whip in his left hand. He

added the glamour colt was likely to have less difficulty in his second try on Sydney's left-hand course. "It was pretty obvious that he wanted to get off the track in the straight last Saturday," Vasil said. "If he'd gone straighter, he would have won by more. He went sideways in the straight, but still ran home in :21.90. Scary, isn't it?" The three-year-old has fully recovered from a hoof abscess that was causing him problems earlier this season. "Fitness-wise, he's at his peak and he has an extra nine days for his hoof to grow back," Vasil said. "He just needed time after those hoof problems, so he'll be more comfortable again in the Doncaster than he was on Saturday. Finally, I think we've got him just right."
